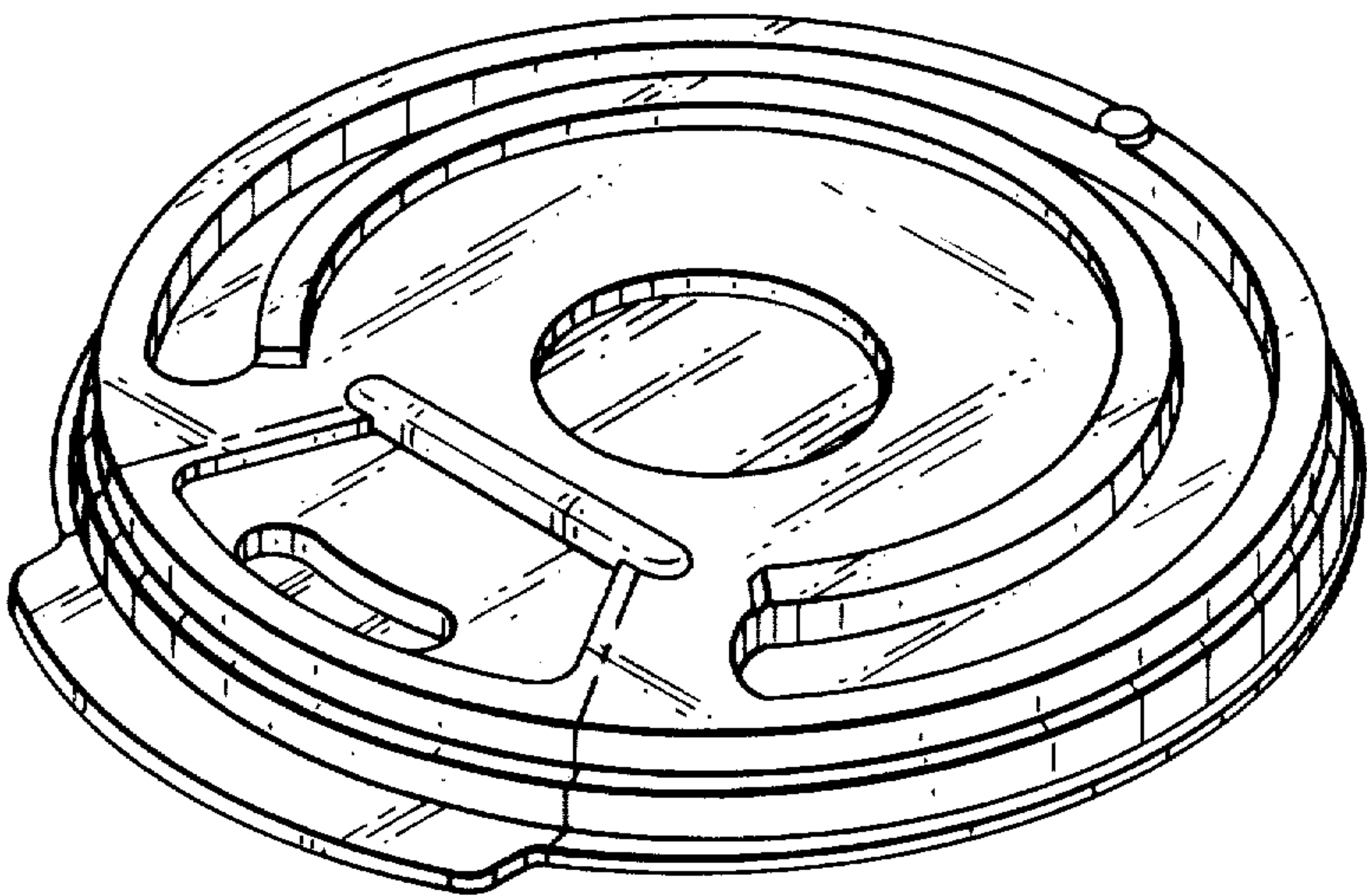

[57] CLAIM
The ornamental design for a disposable tear-tab lid, substantially as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION
FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a disposable tear-tab lid showing my new design;

The dash lines in FIGS. 1, 3 and 4 represent score lines.



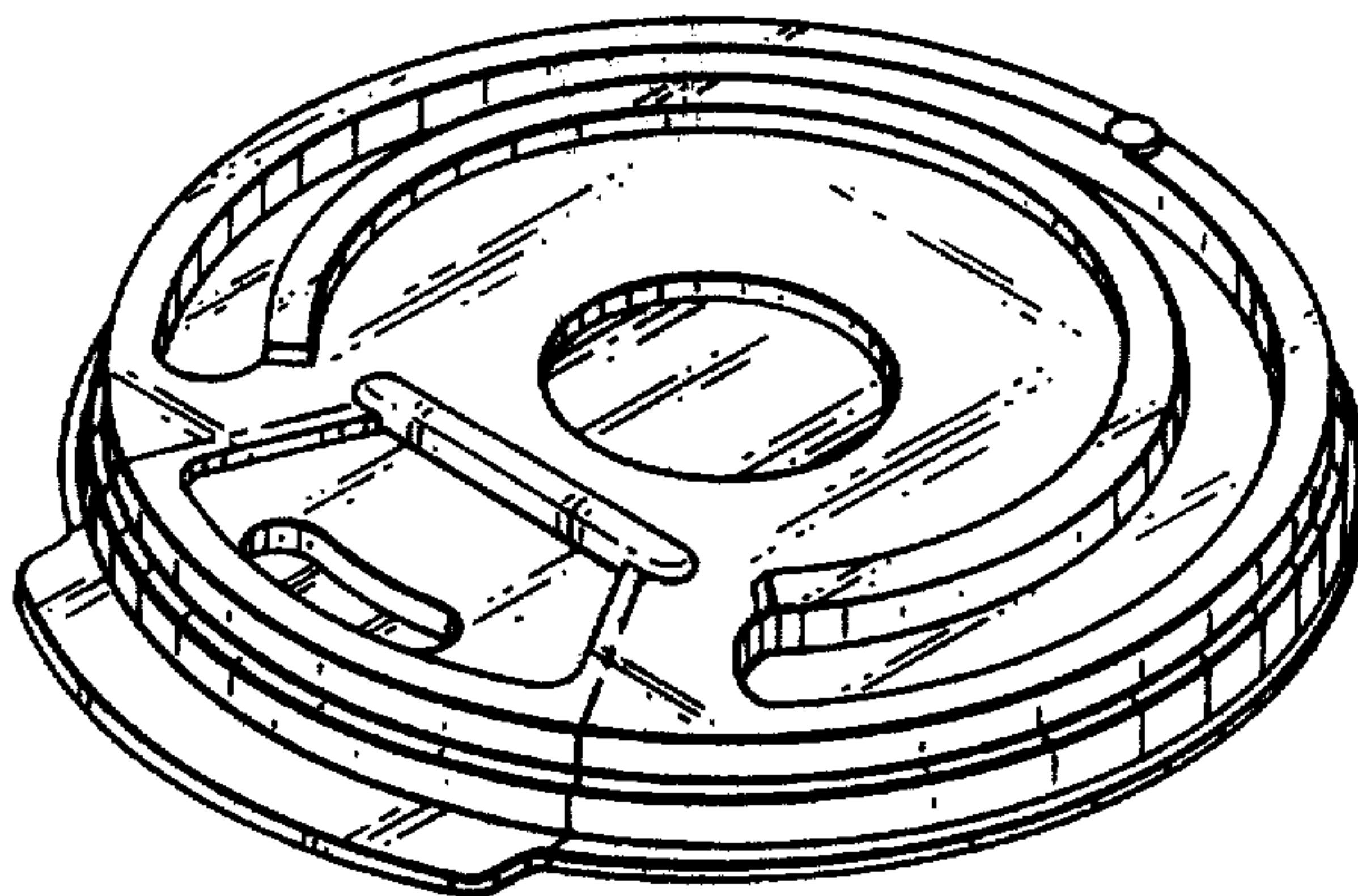

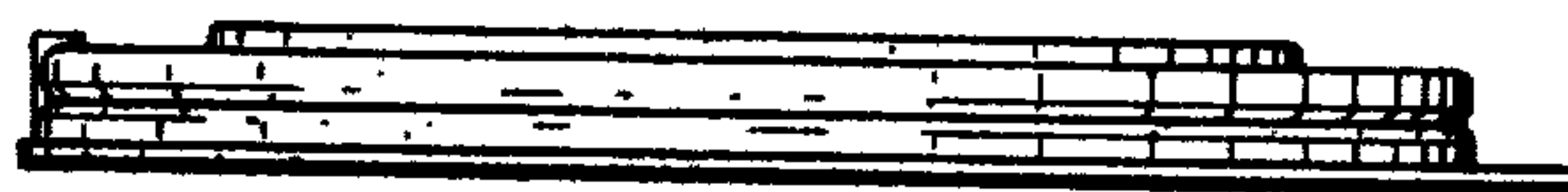

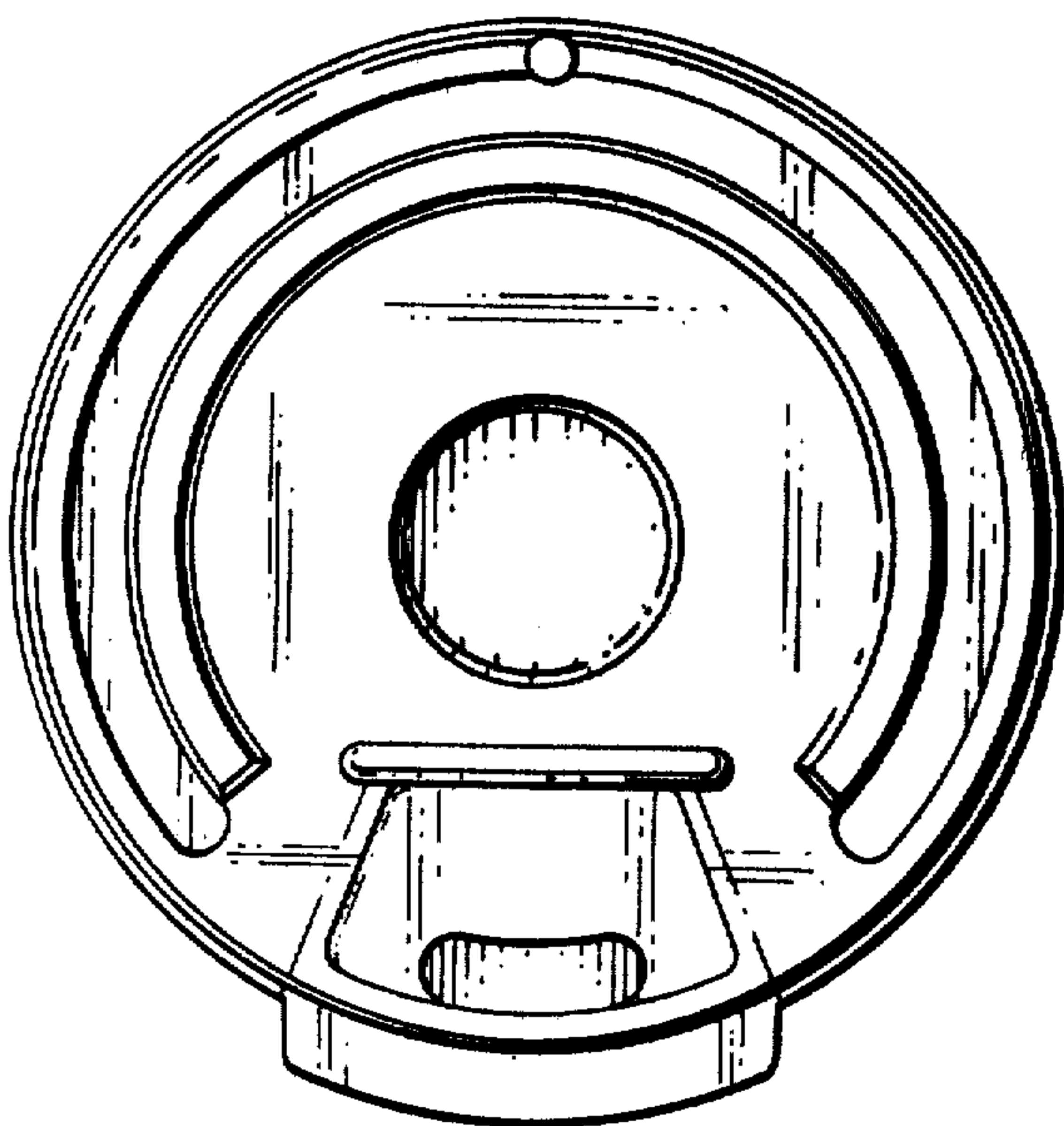

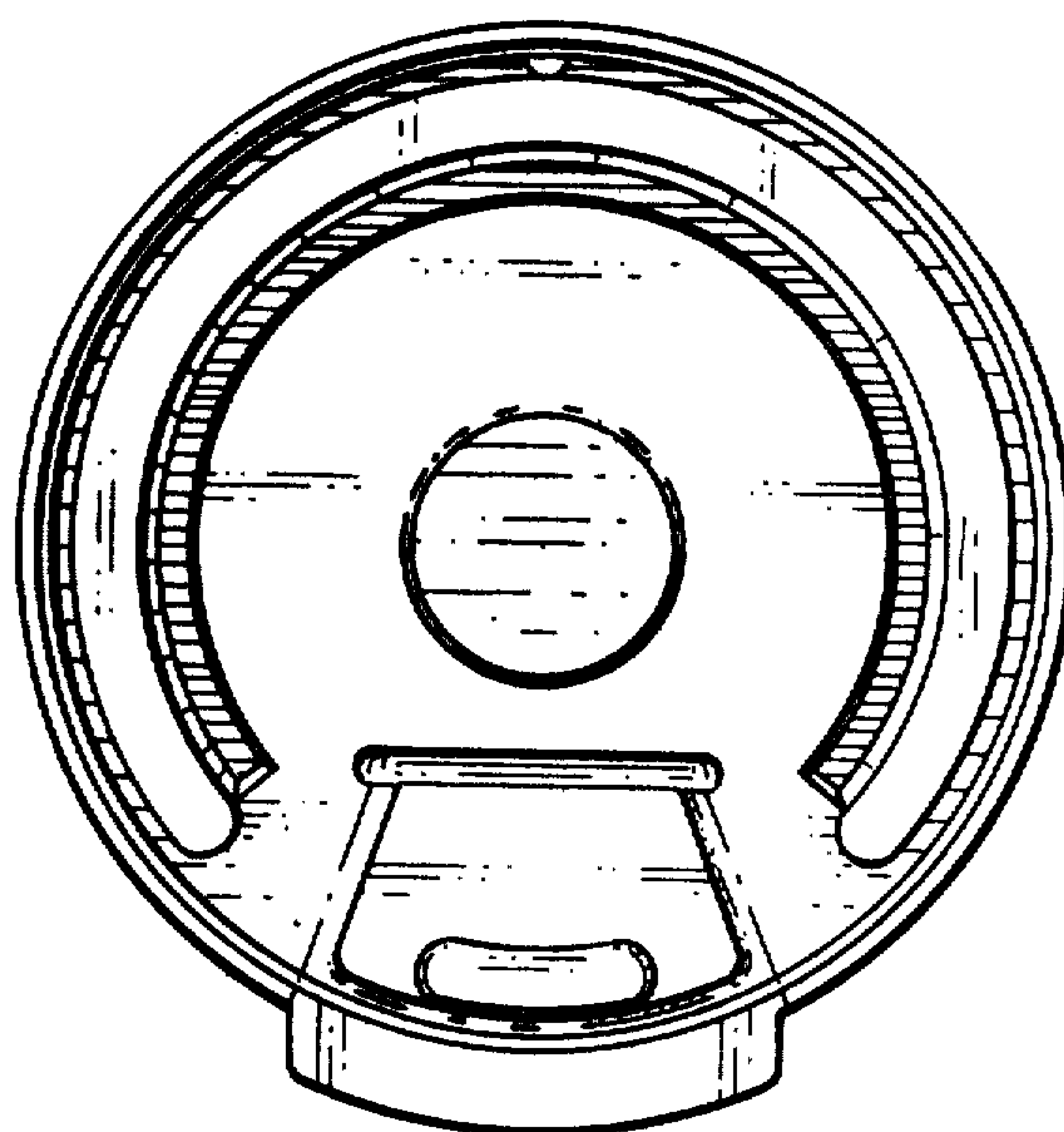
