CLAIM

The ornamental design for a jewelry finding or similar article, substantially as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top plan view of a jewelry finding or similar article showing my new design;

FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof corresponding to FIG. 1, but showing the same in opened condition;


FIG. 3 is a side elevational view thereof in opened condition;

FIG. 7 is a bottom plan view thereof.














