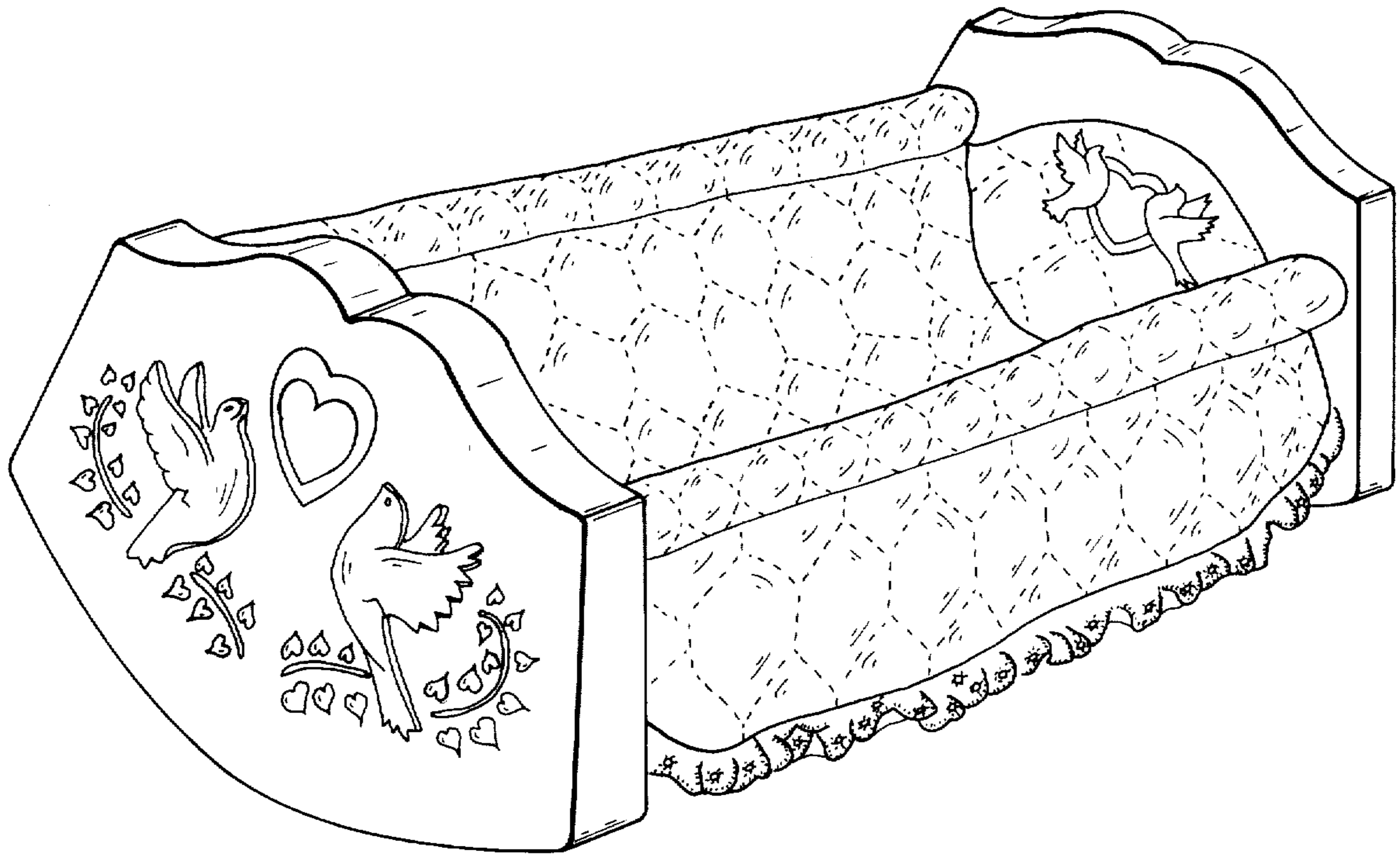

Portions of the design have been omitted in FIG. 3 for ease of illustration.



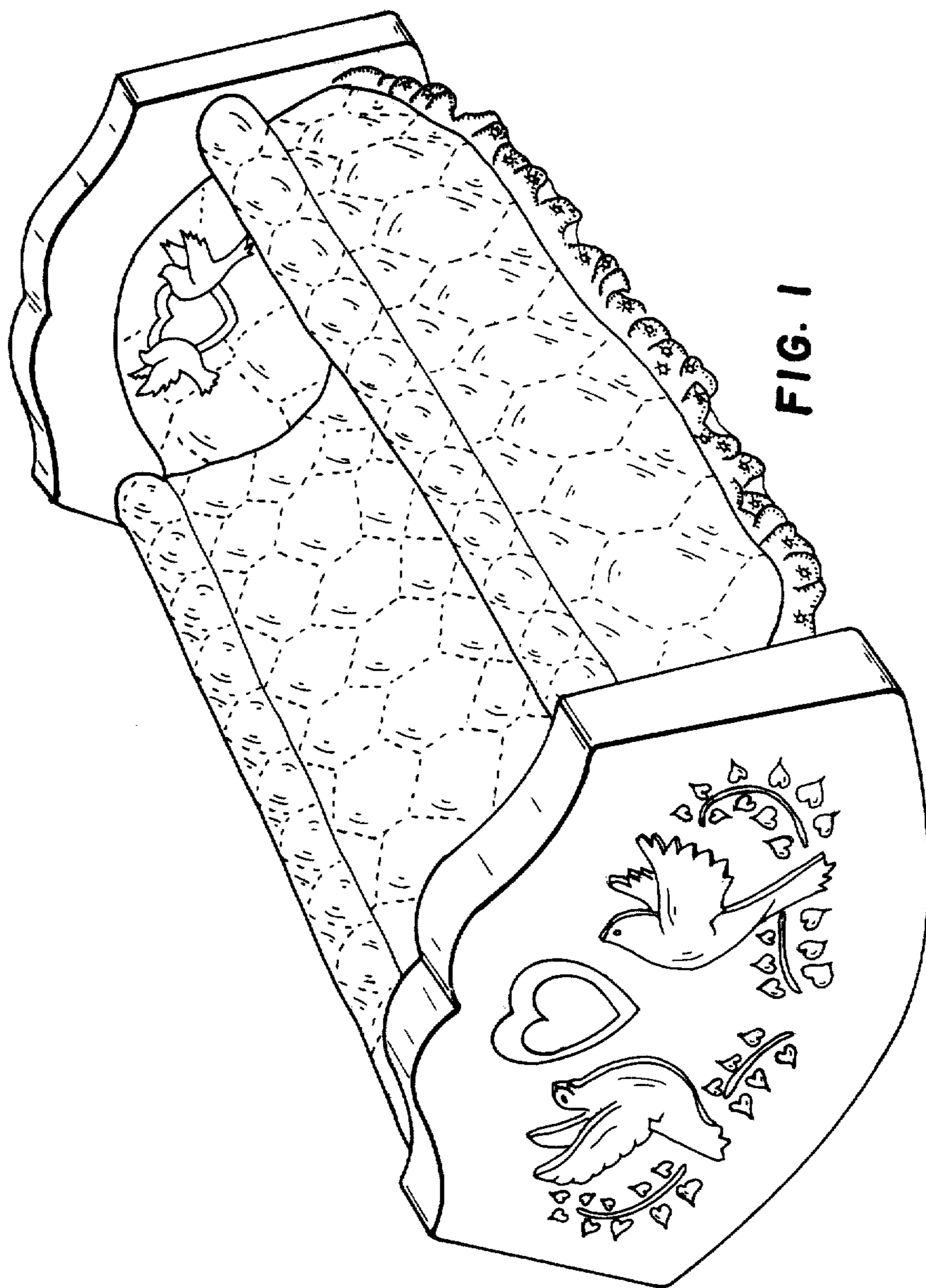

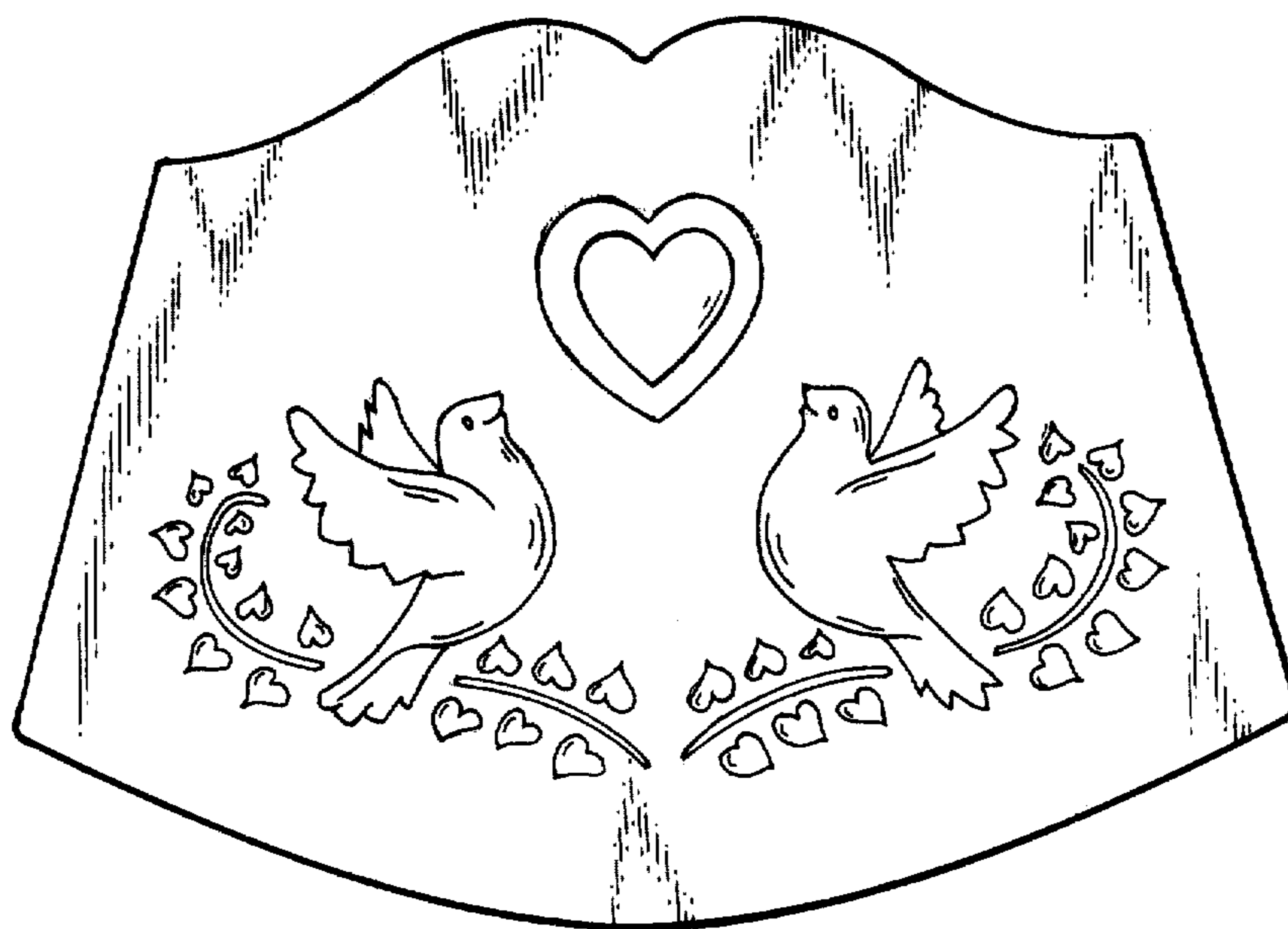

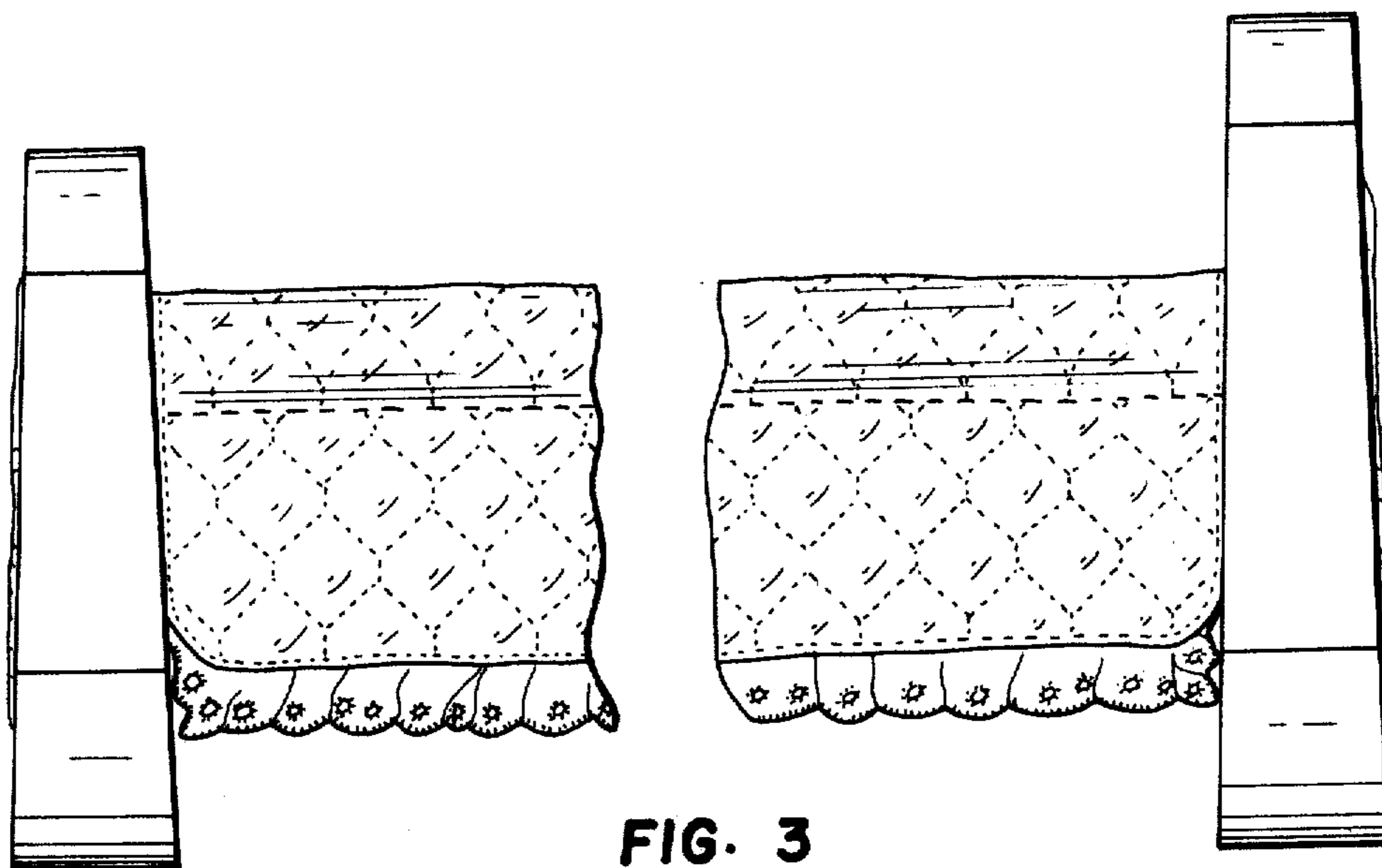

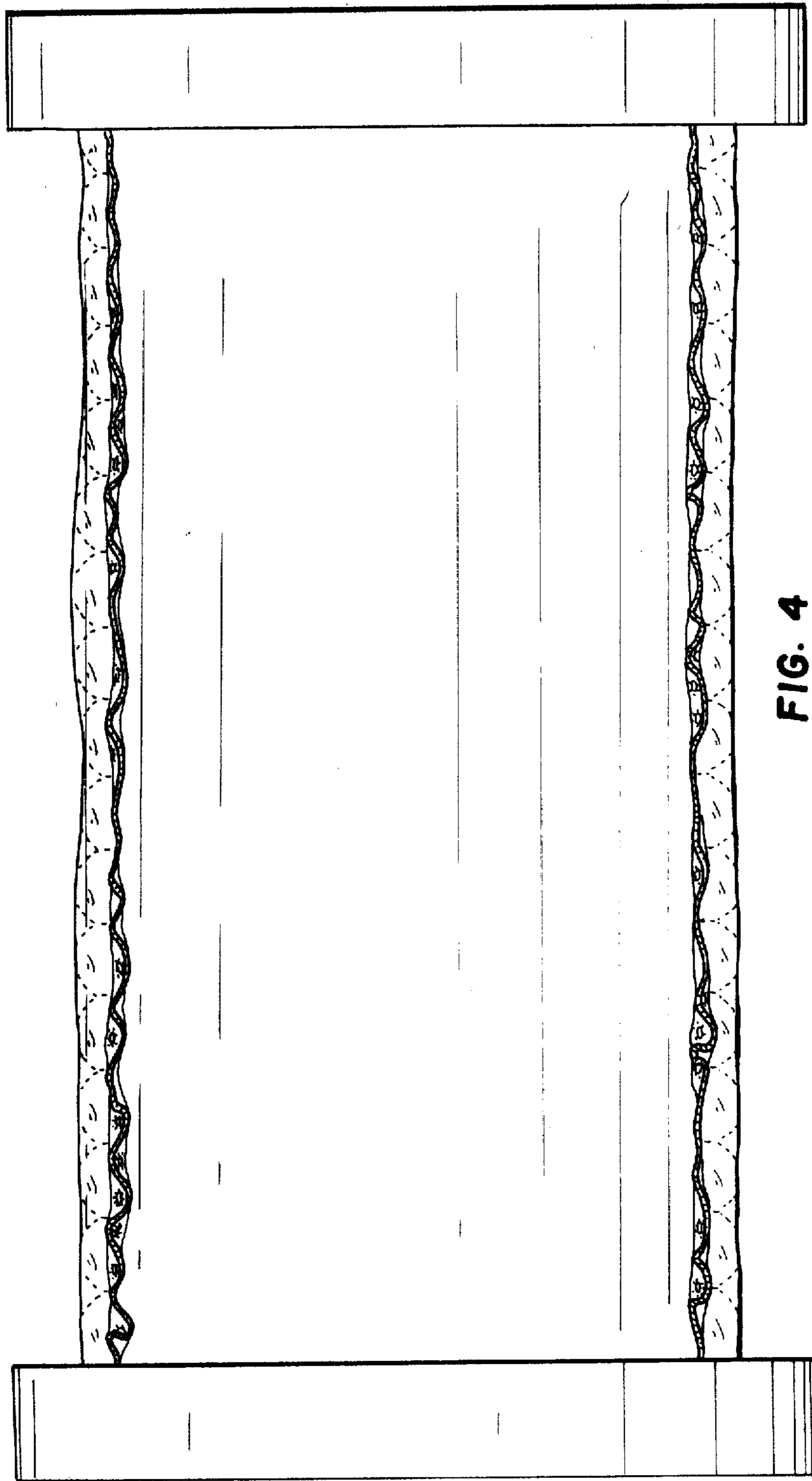
