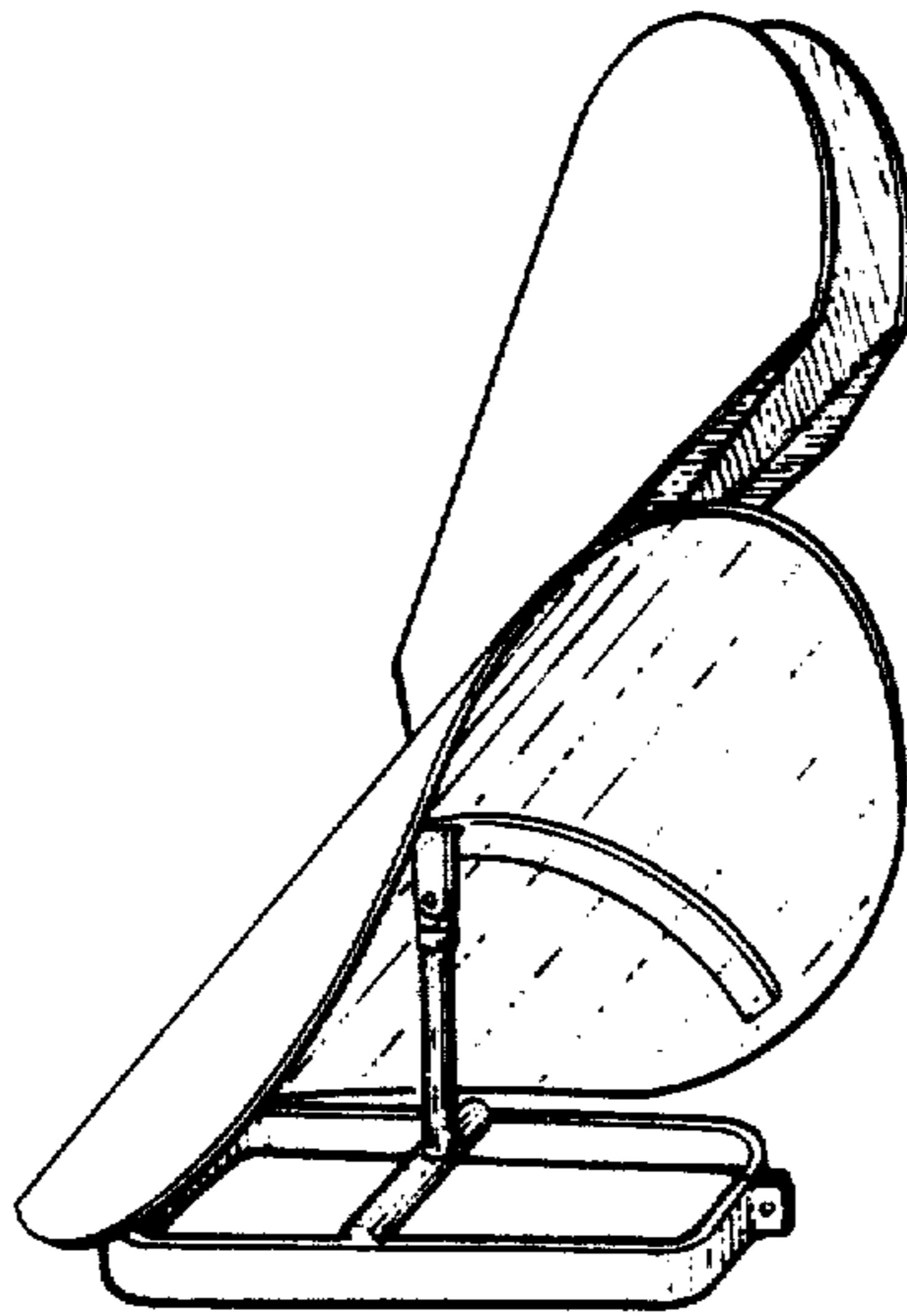

 FIG. 4 is a left side elevation thereof, the right side being a mirror image of the left side shown thereof.



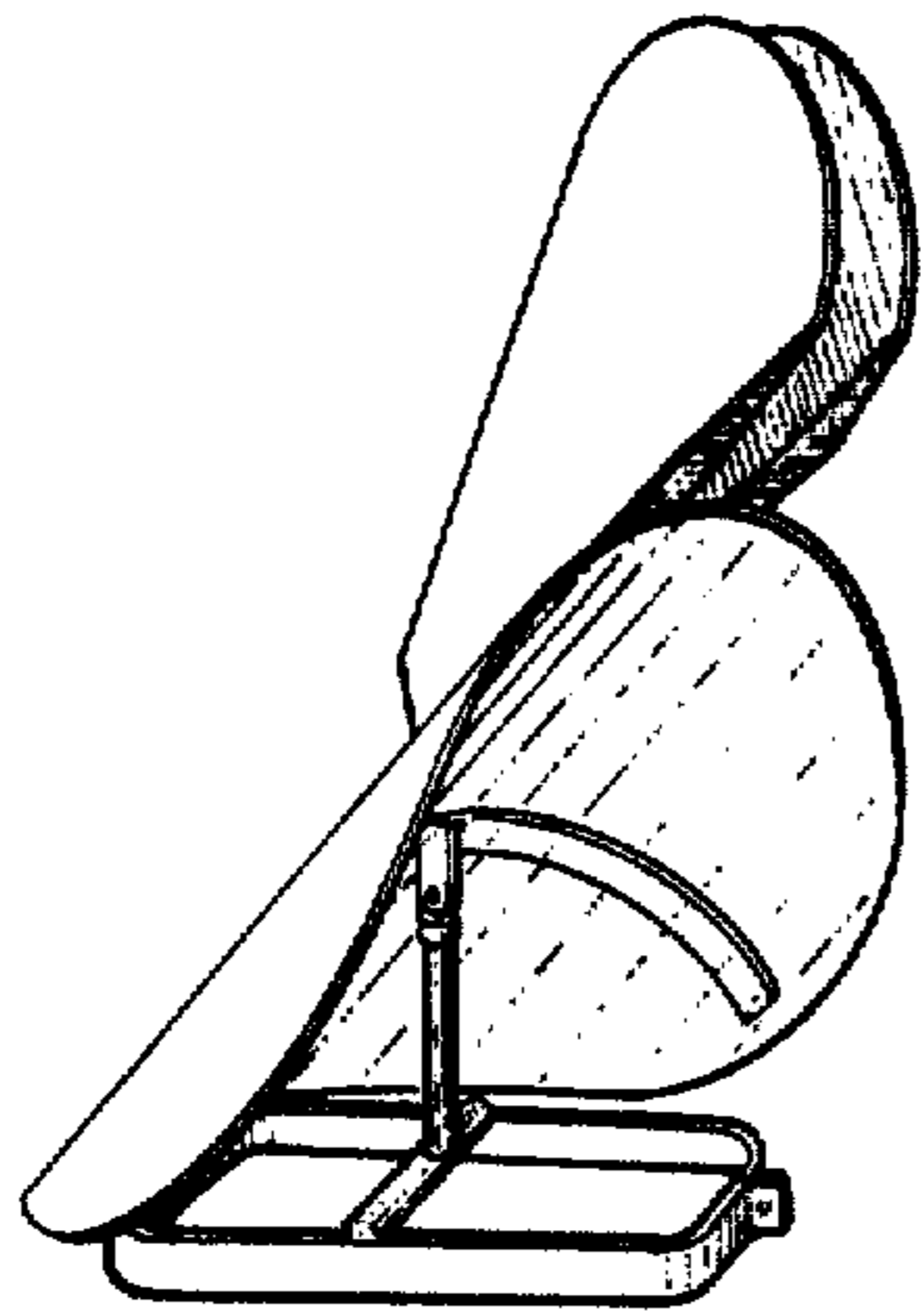

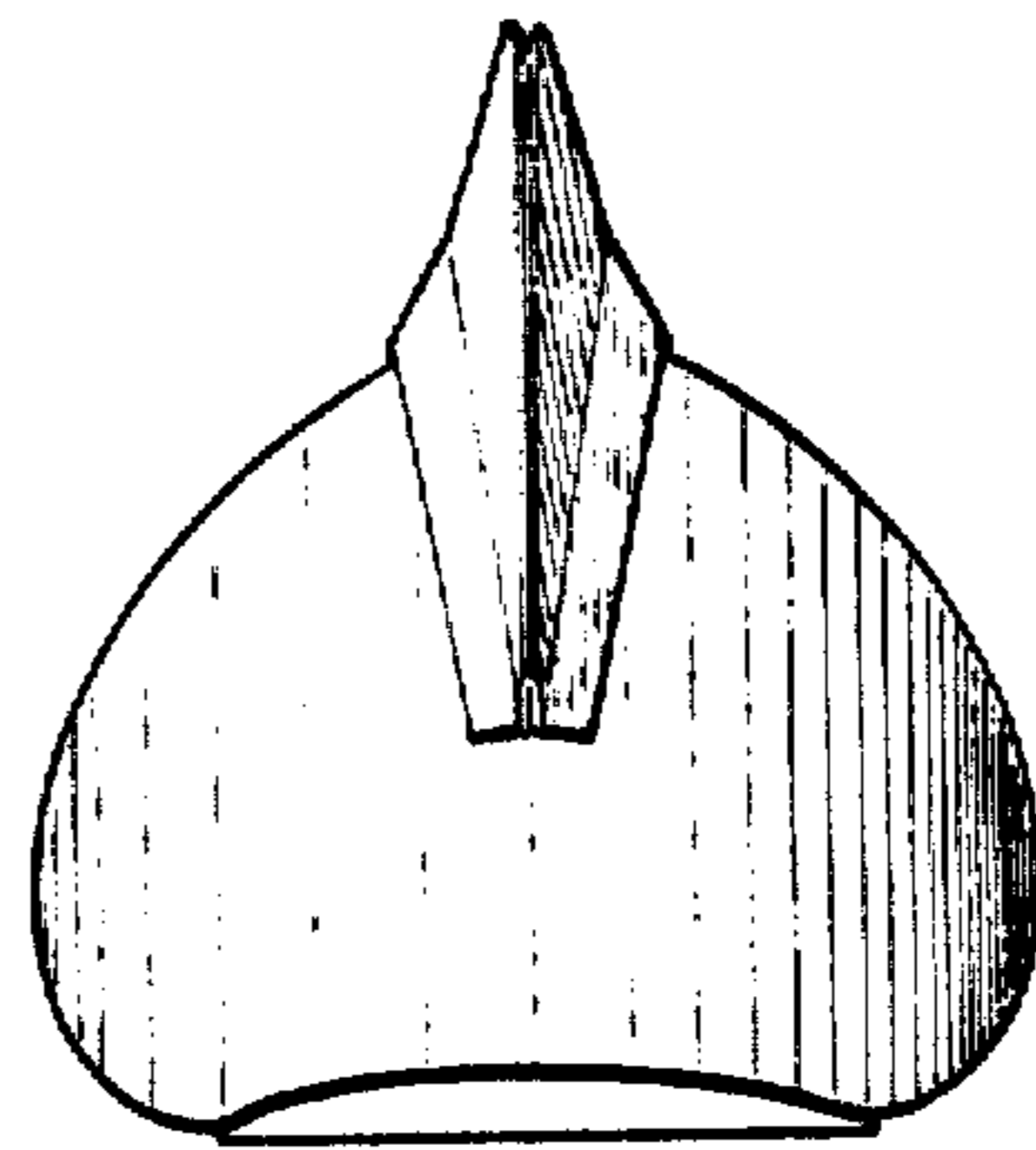

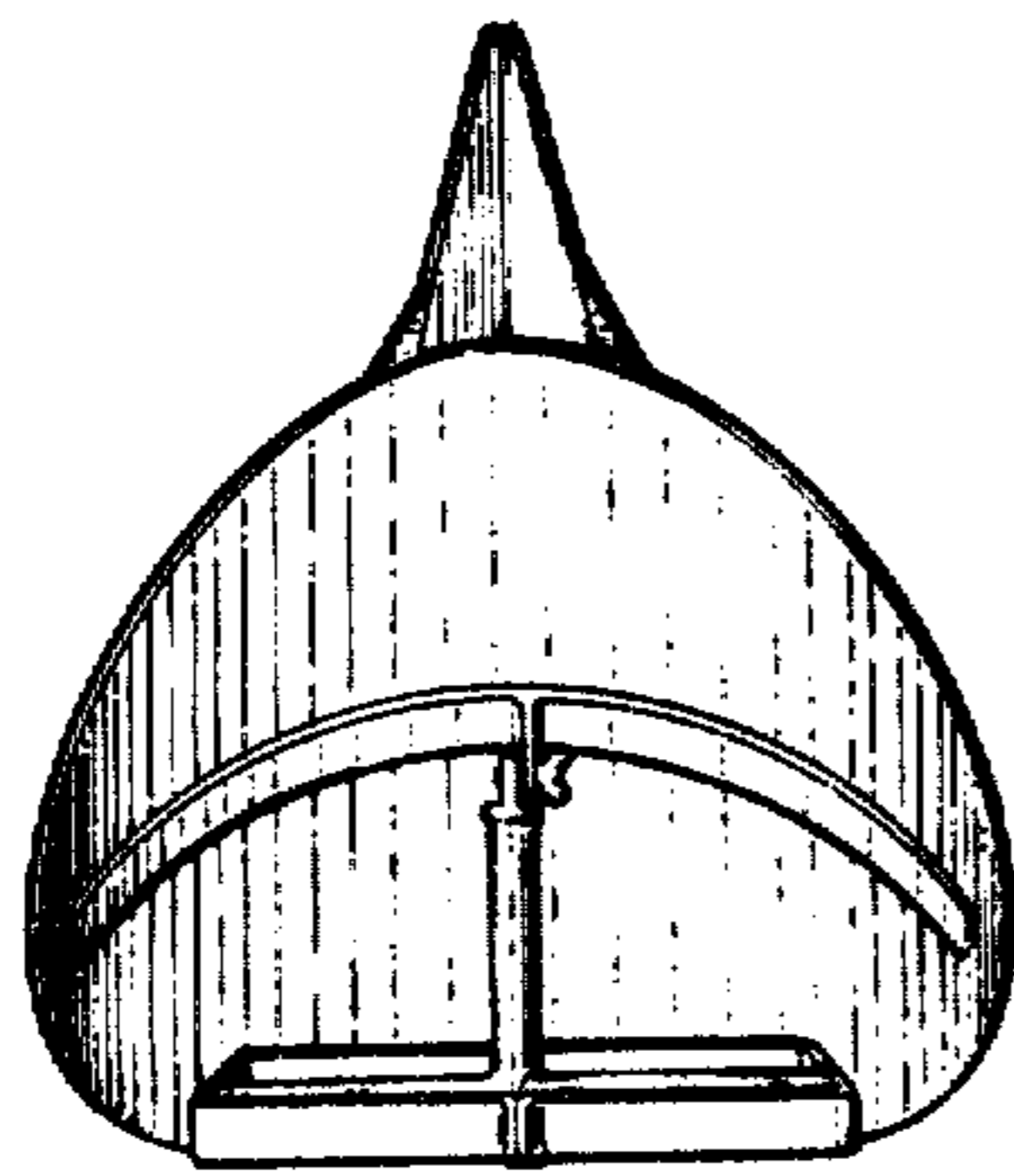

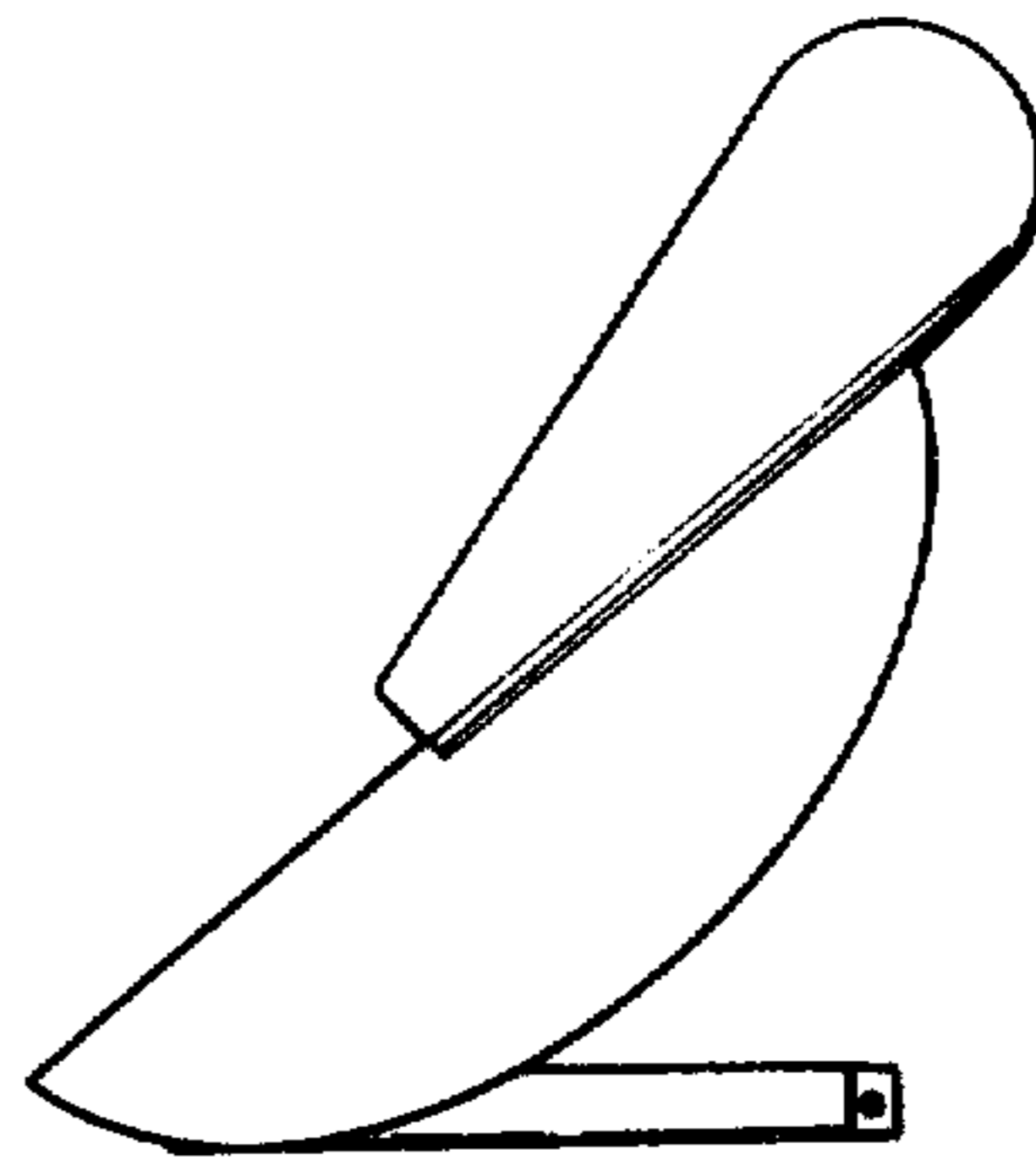
