## [57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a beverage glass or similar article, substantially as shown and described.

## **DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 1 is an elevational view of a beverage glass or similar article showing my new and ornamental design in the size and proportions of a goblet;

FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof;

FIG. 3 is a sectional view taken along line 3—3 of FIG. 1;

FIG. 4 is a sectional view taken along line 4—4 of FIG. 1:

FIG. 5 is a sectional view taken along line 5—5 of FIG.

FIG. 6 is a sectional view taken along line 6—6 of FIG.

FIG. 7 is an elevational view of my new and ornamental design in the size and proportions of a cordial glass;

FIG. 8 is a top plan view thereof;

FIG. 9 is a sectional view taken along line 9—9 of FIG. 7;

FIG. 10 is a sectional view taken along line 10—10 of FIG. 7;

FIG. 11 is a sectional view taken along line 11—11 of FIG. 7;

FIG. 12 is a sectional view taken along line 12—12 of FIG. 7;

FIG. 13 is an elevational view of my new and ornamental design in the size and proportions of a pilsner glass; FIG. 14 is a top plan view thereof;

FIG. 15 is a sectional view taken along line 15—15 of

FIG. 13; FIG. 16 is a sectional view taken along line 16—16 of

FIG. 13;

FIG. 17 is a sectional view taken along line 17—17 of FIG. 13; and

FIG. 18 is a sectional view taken along line 18—18 of FIG. 13.
