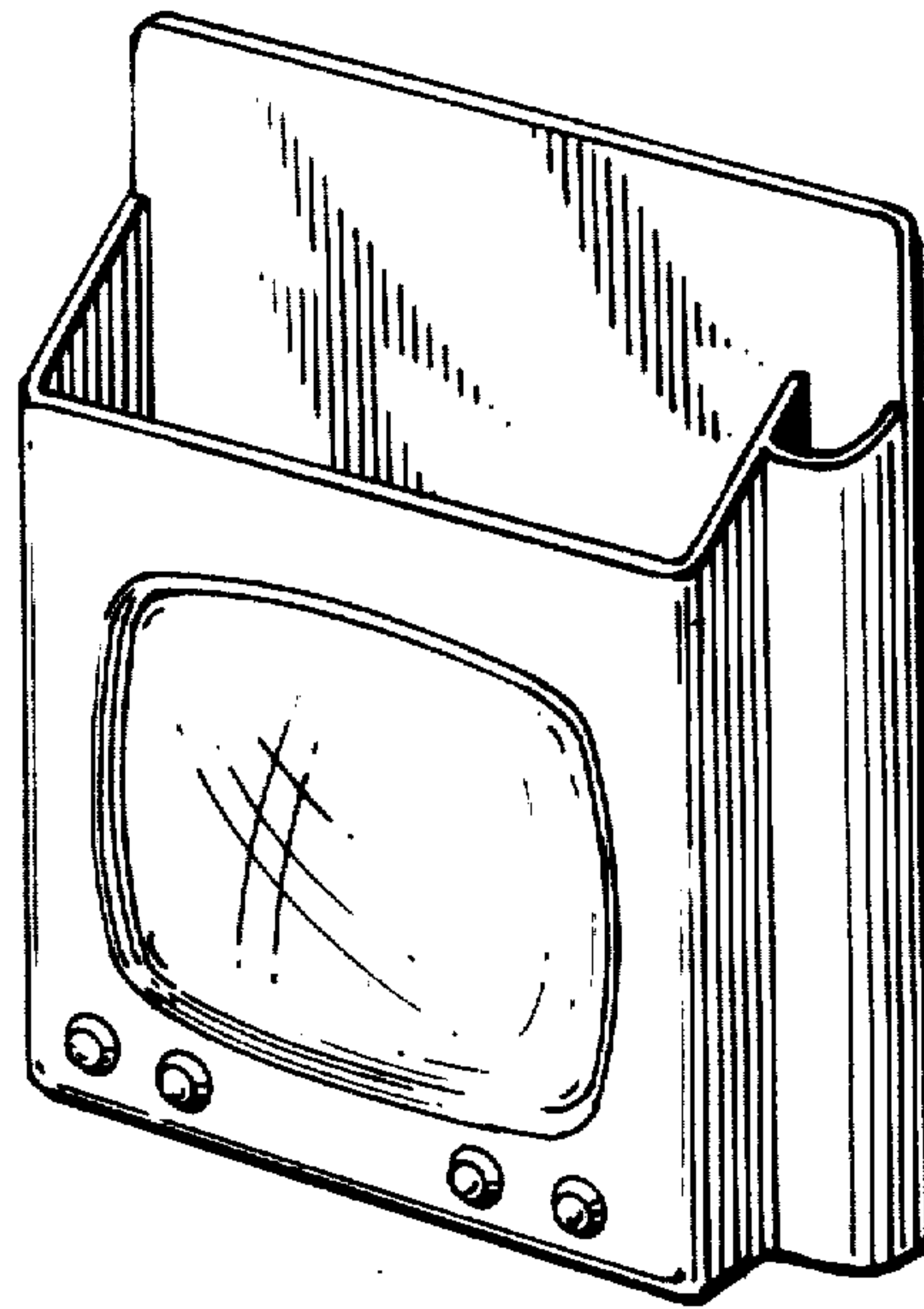

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a combined periodical and writing instrument holder showing my new design; FIG. 2 is an enlarged scale left side elevational view; FIG. 3 is a top plan view thereof; FIG. 4 is a front elevational view thereof; FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view thereof; FIG. 6 is a rear elevational view thereof; and FIG. 7 is a right side elevational view thereof.



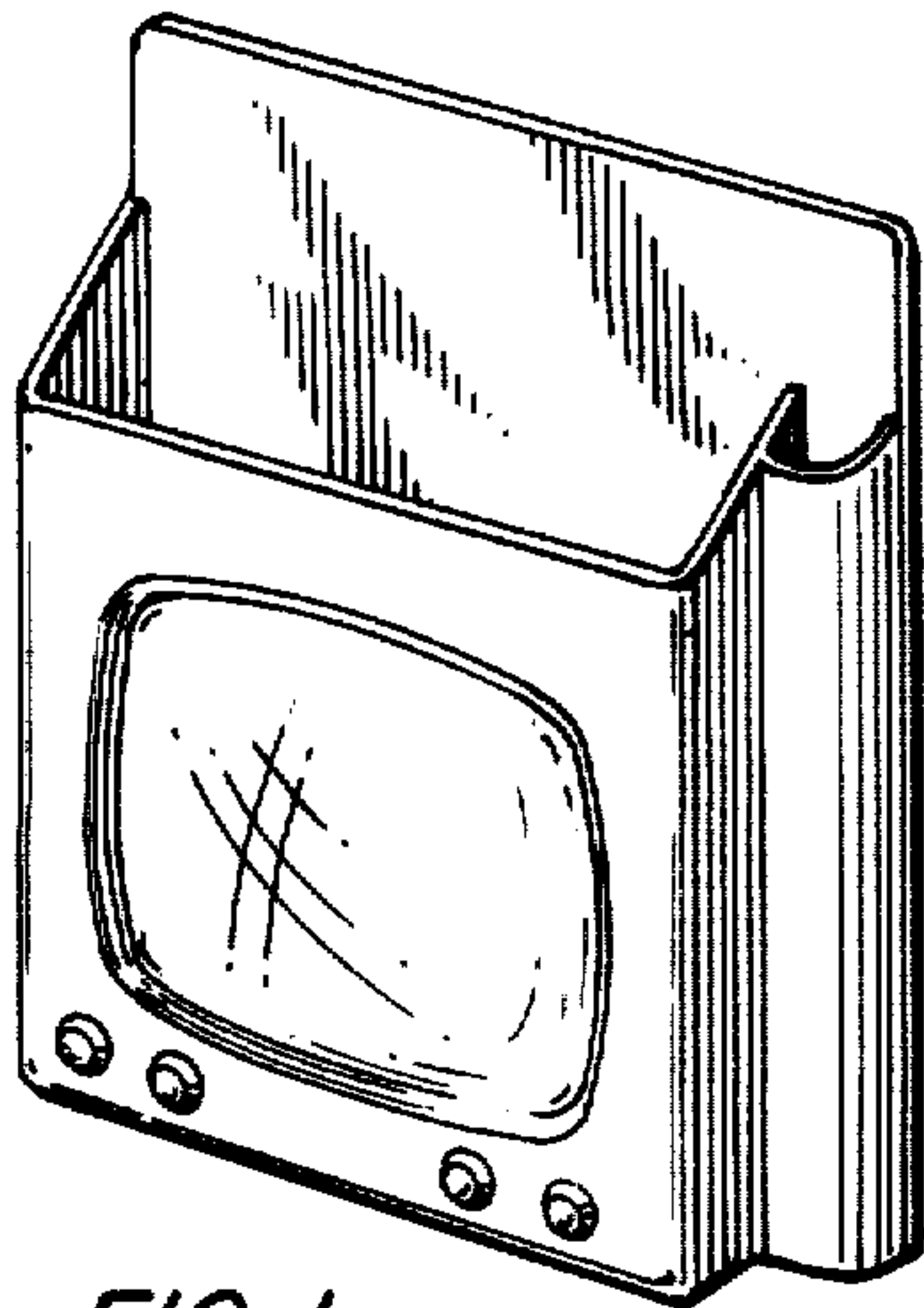

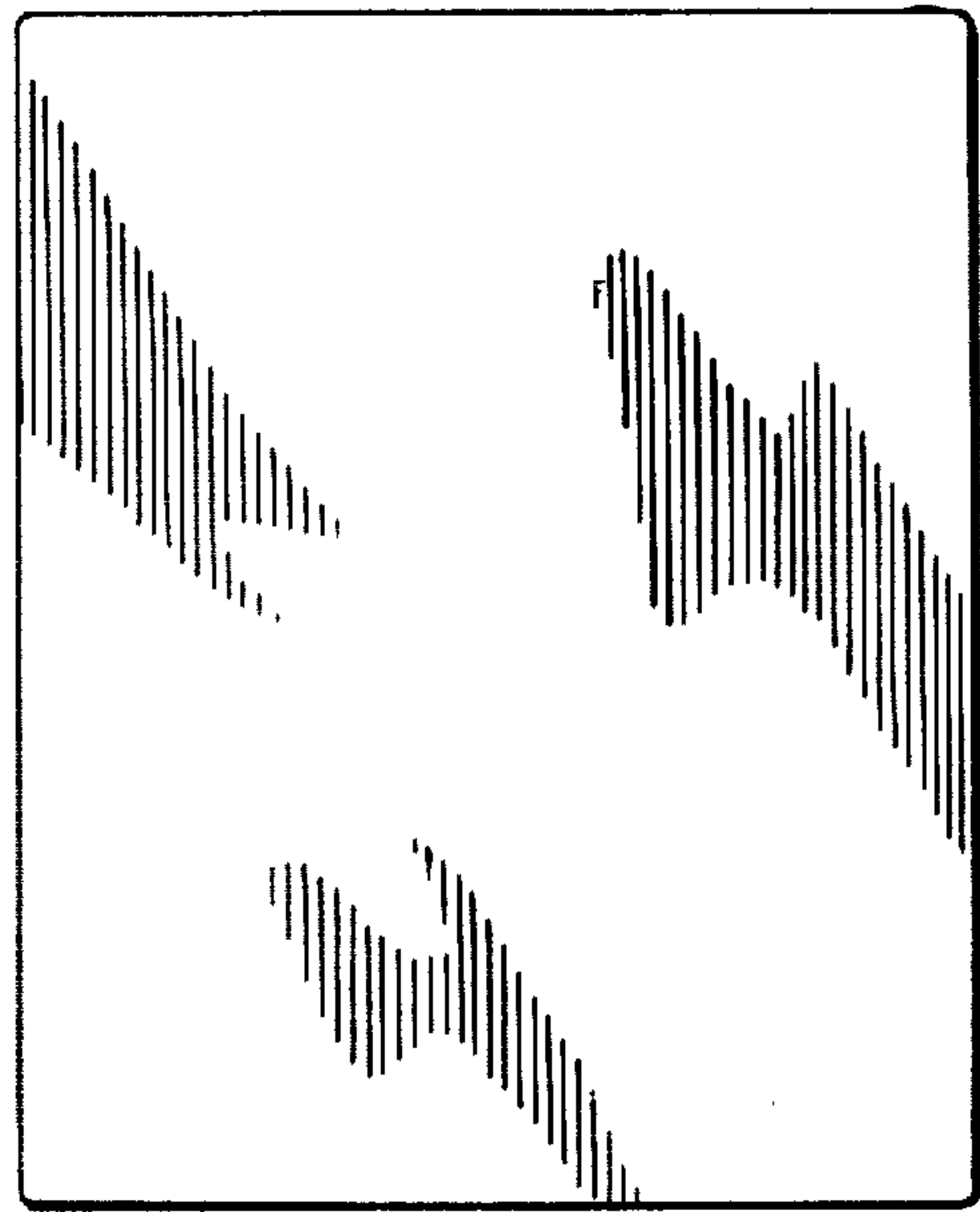

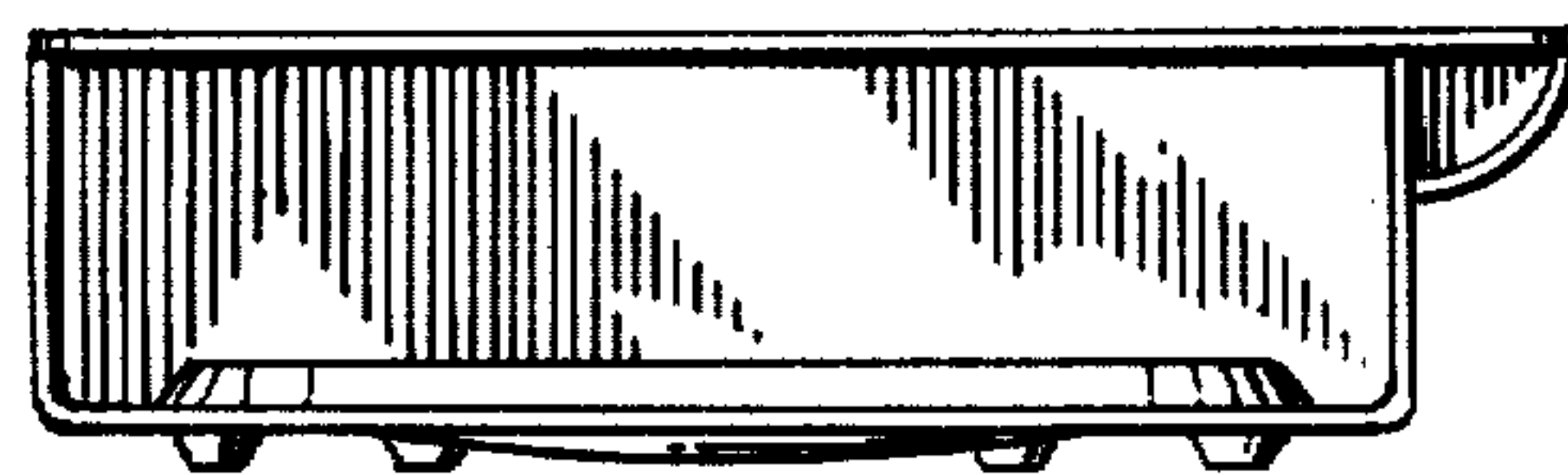

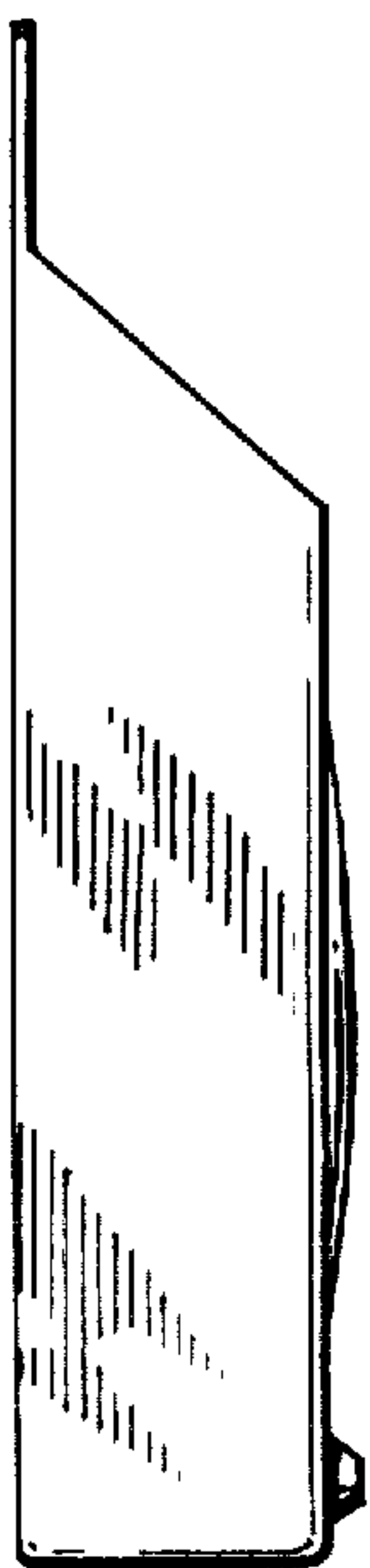

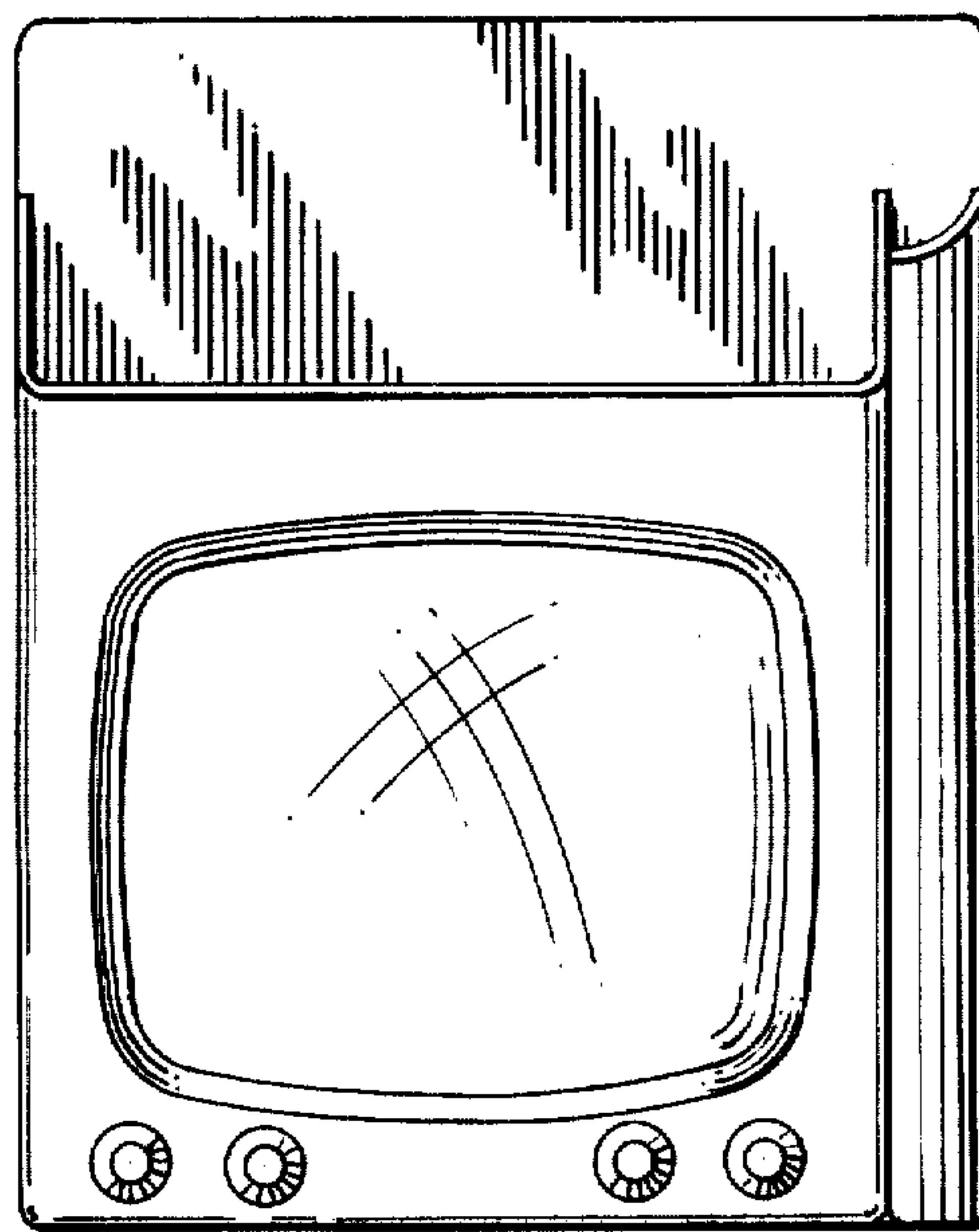

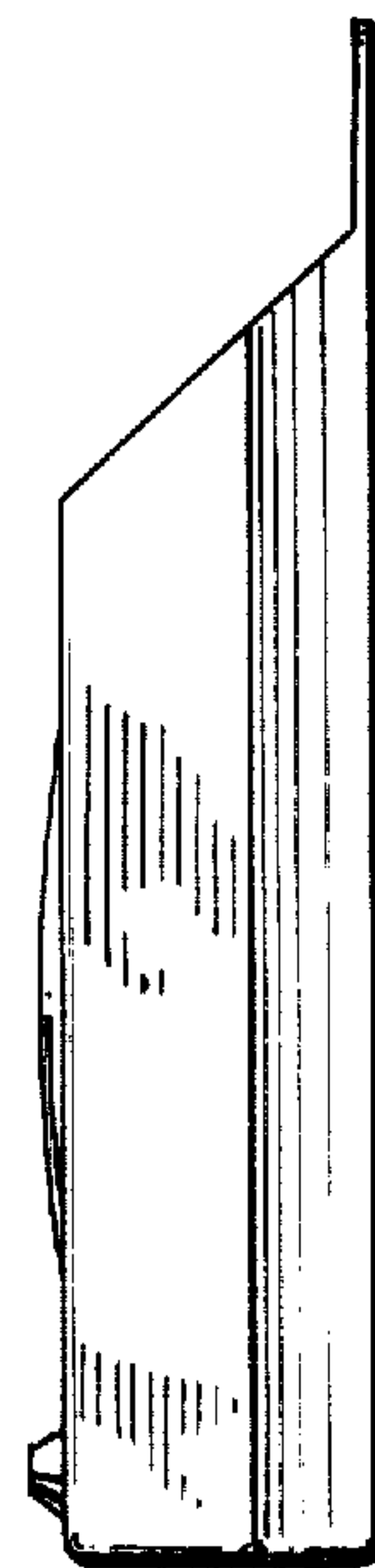

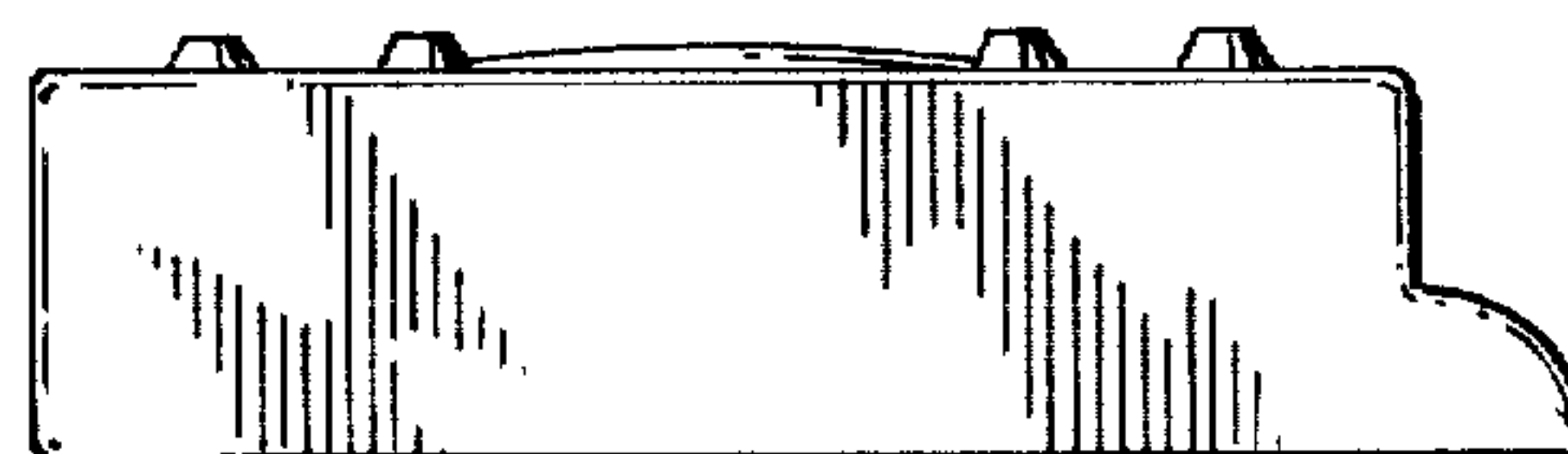
