FIG. 5 is a top plan view.

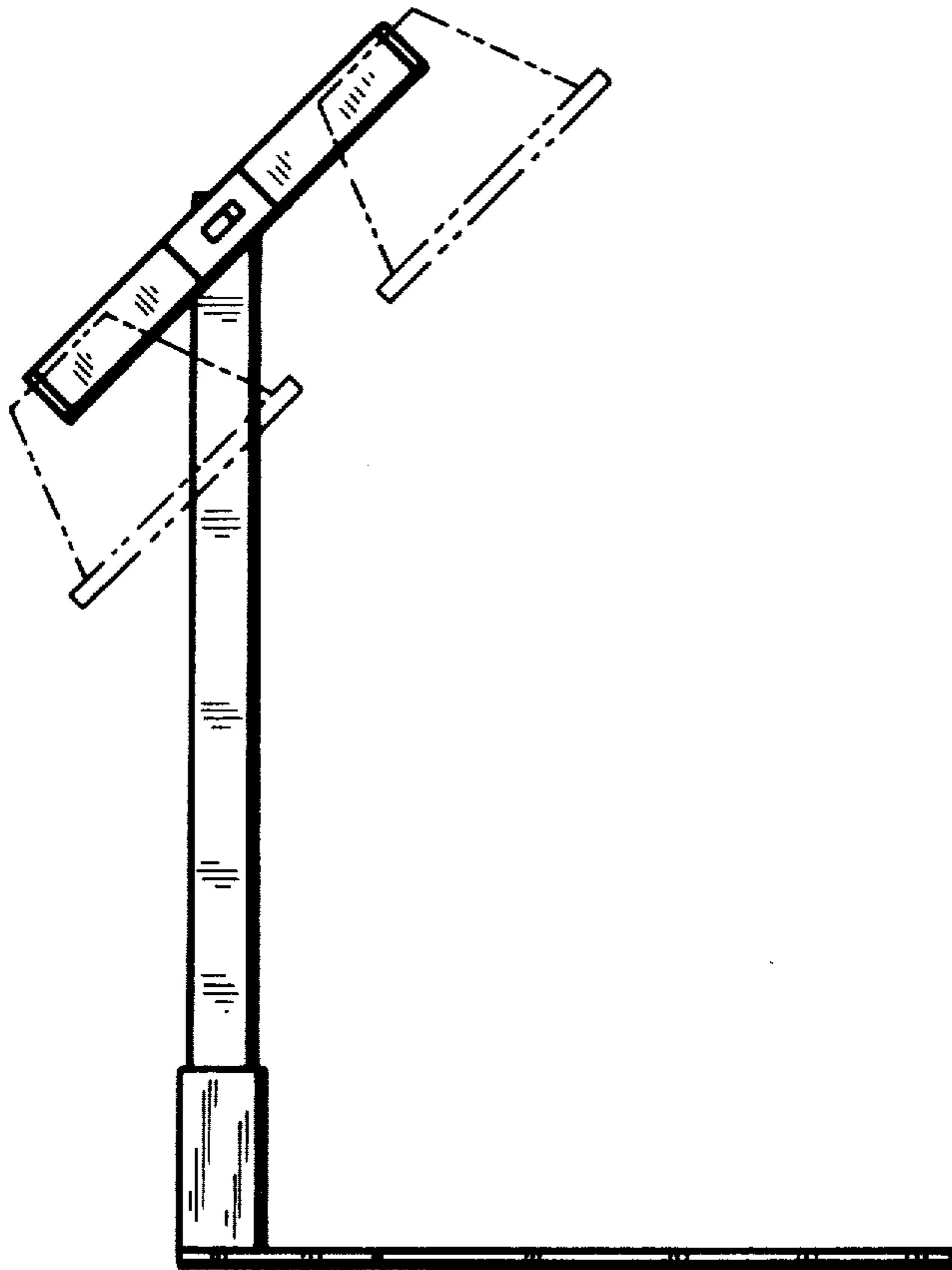
FIG. 6 is a bottom plan view.

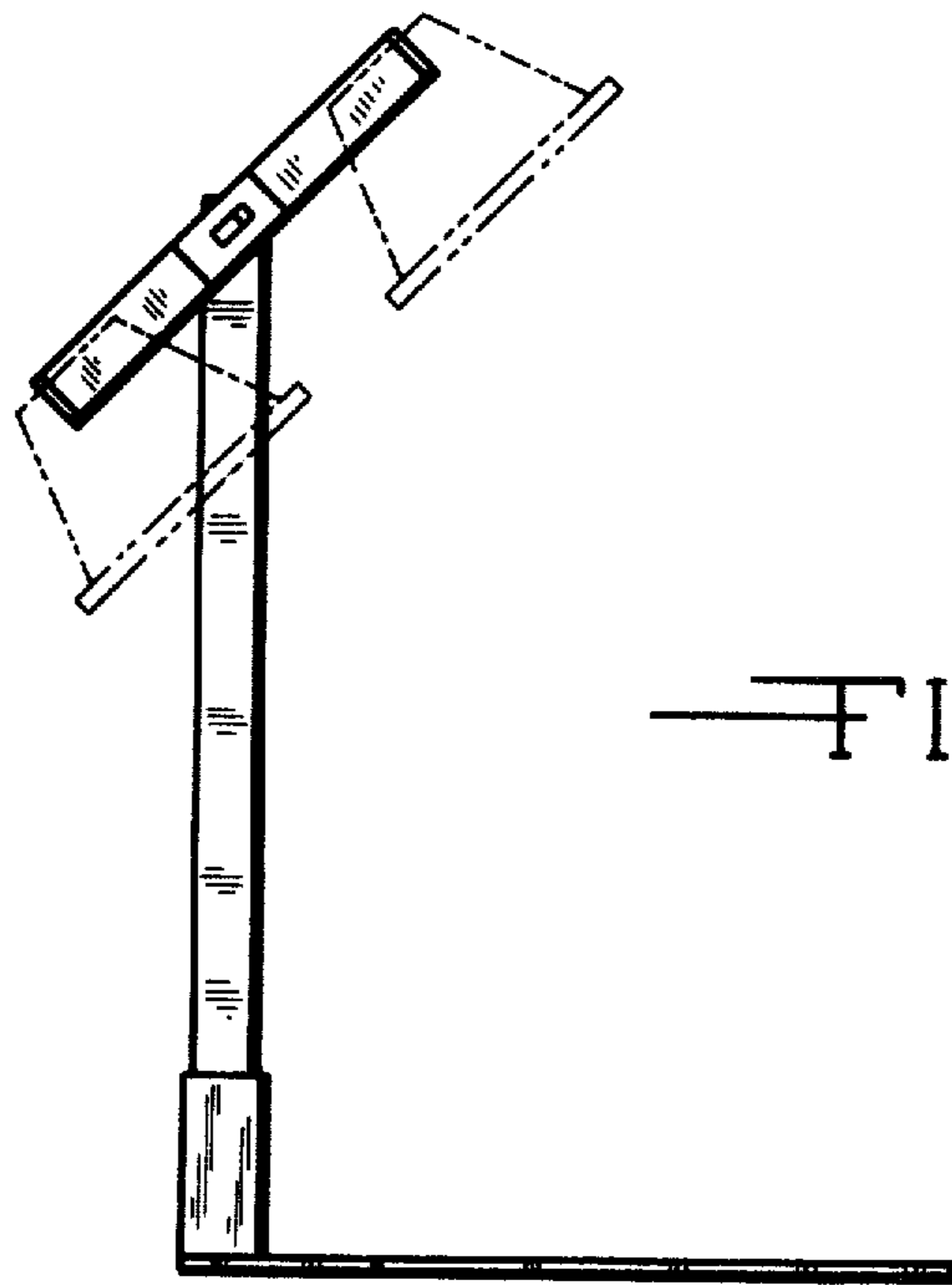

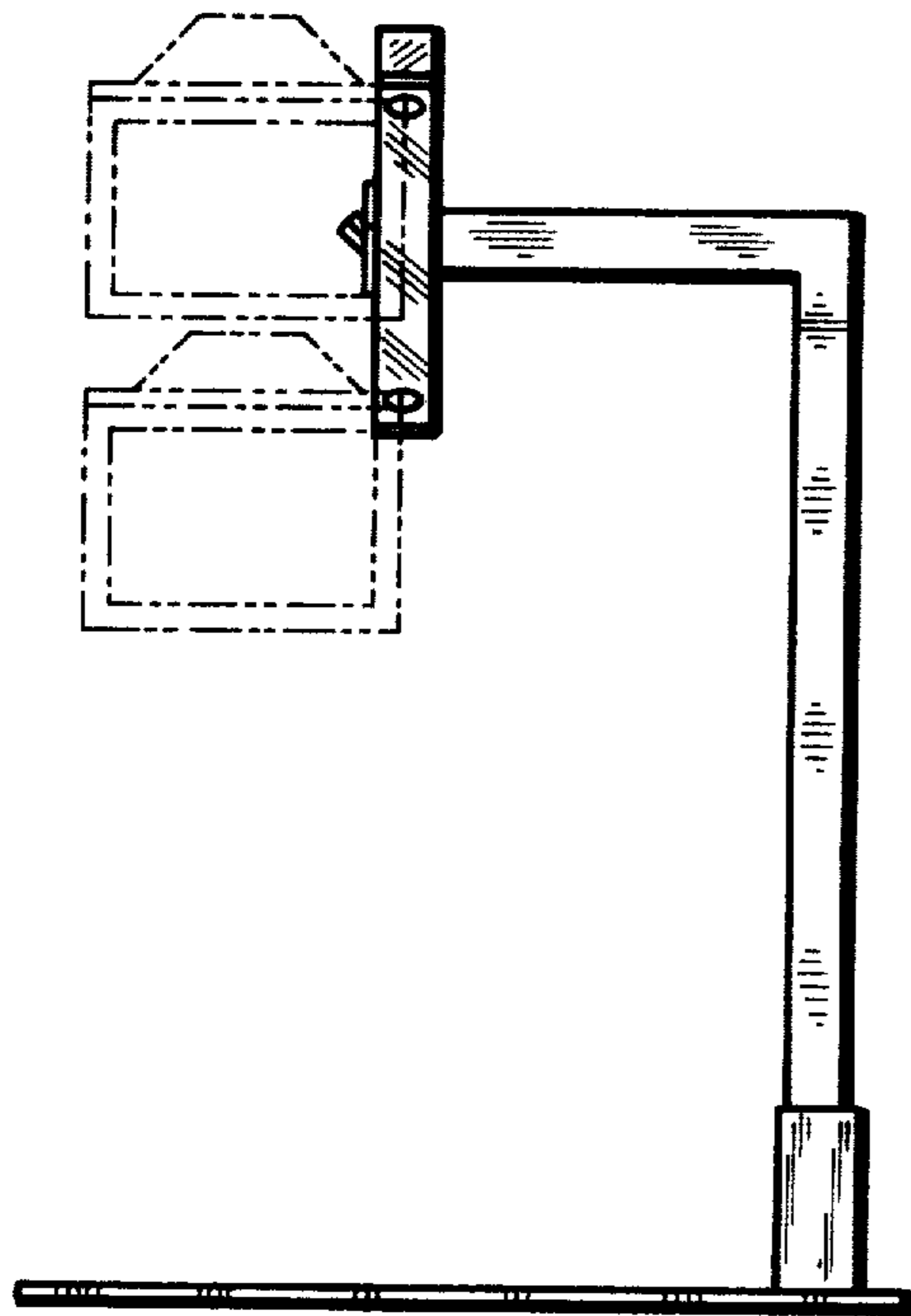

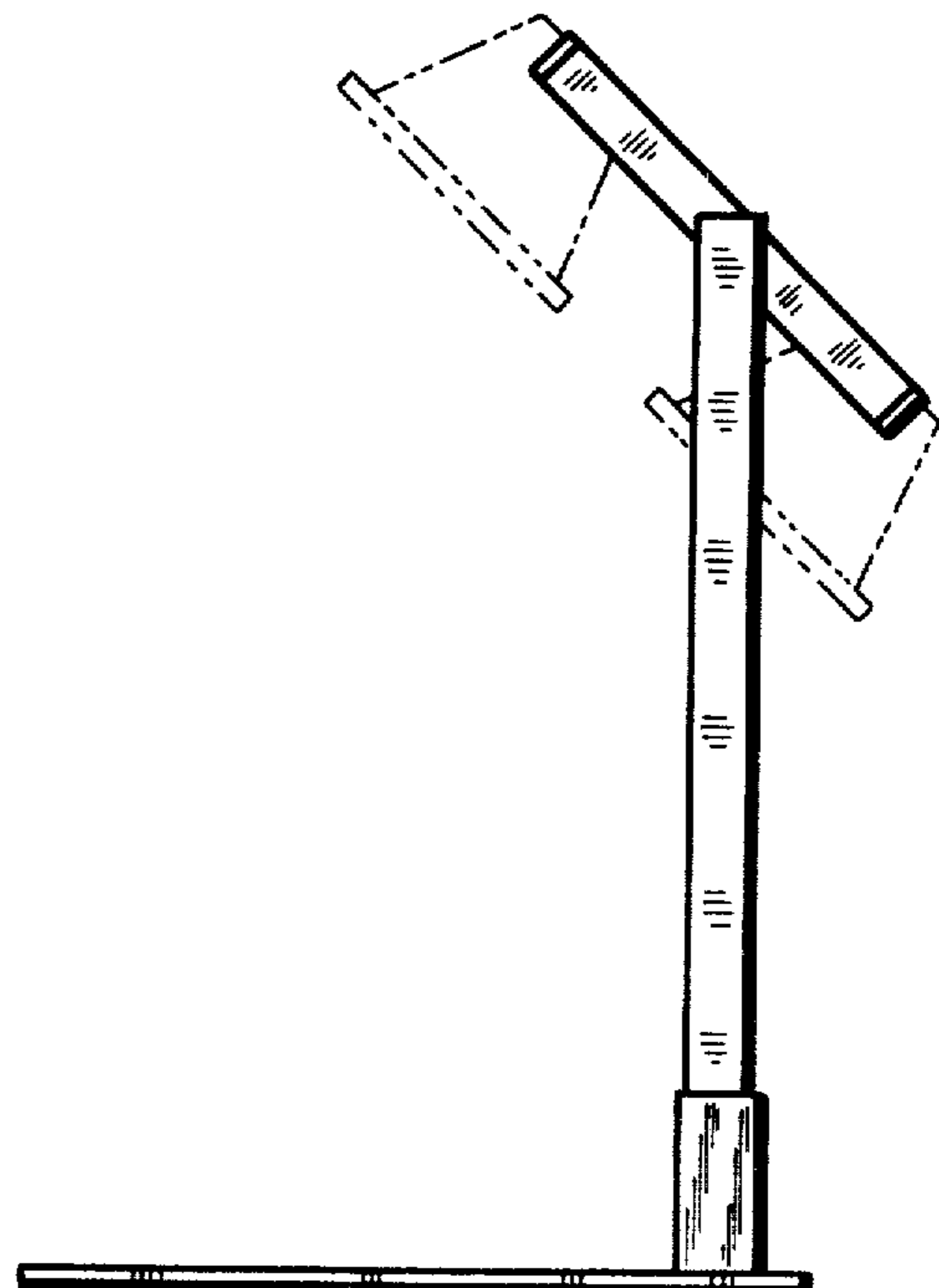




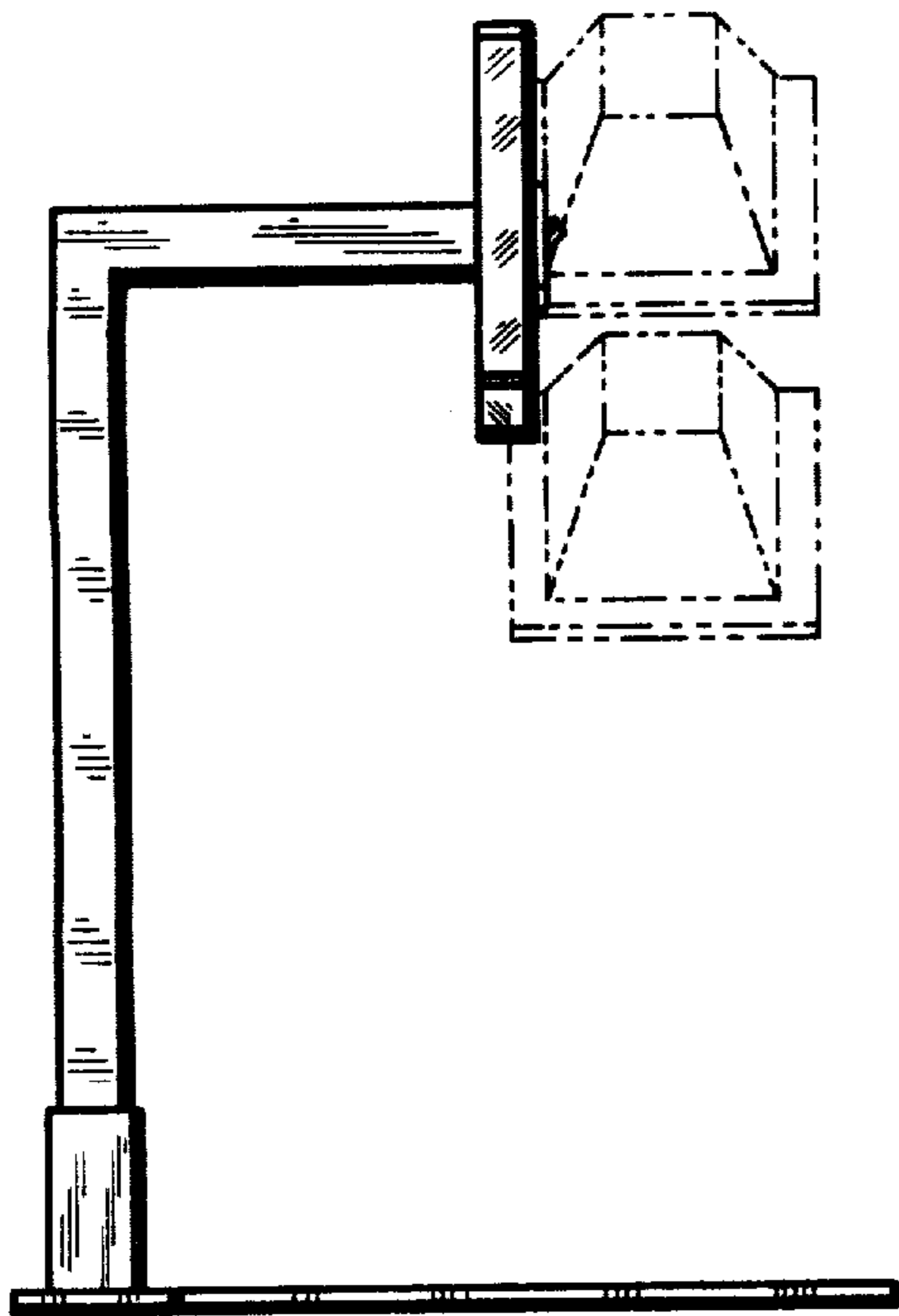

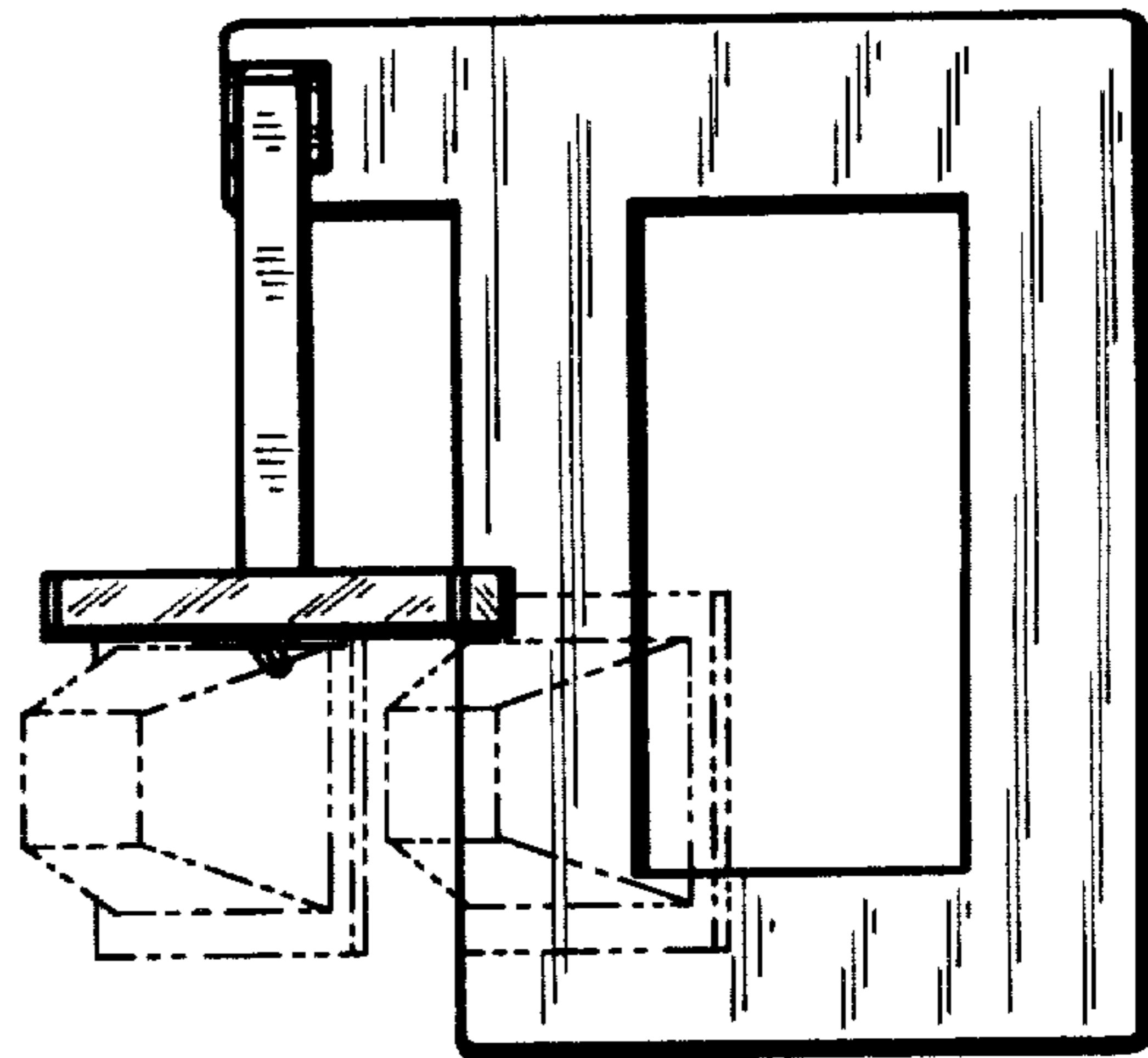

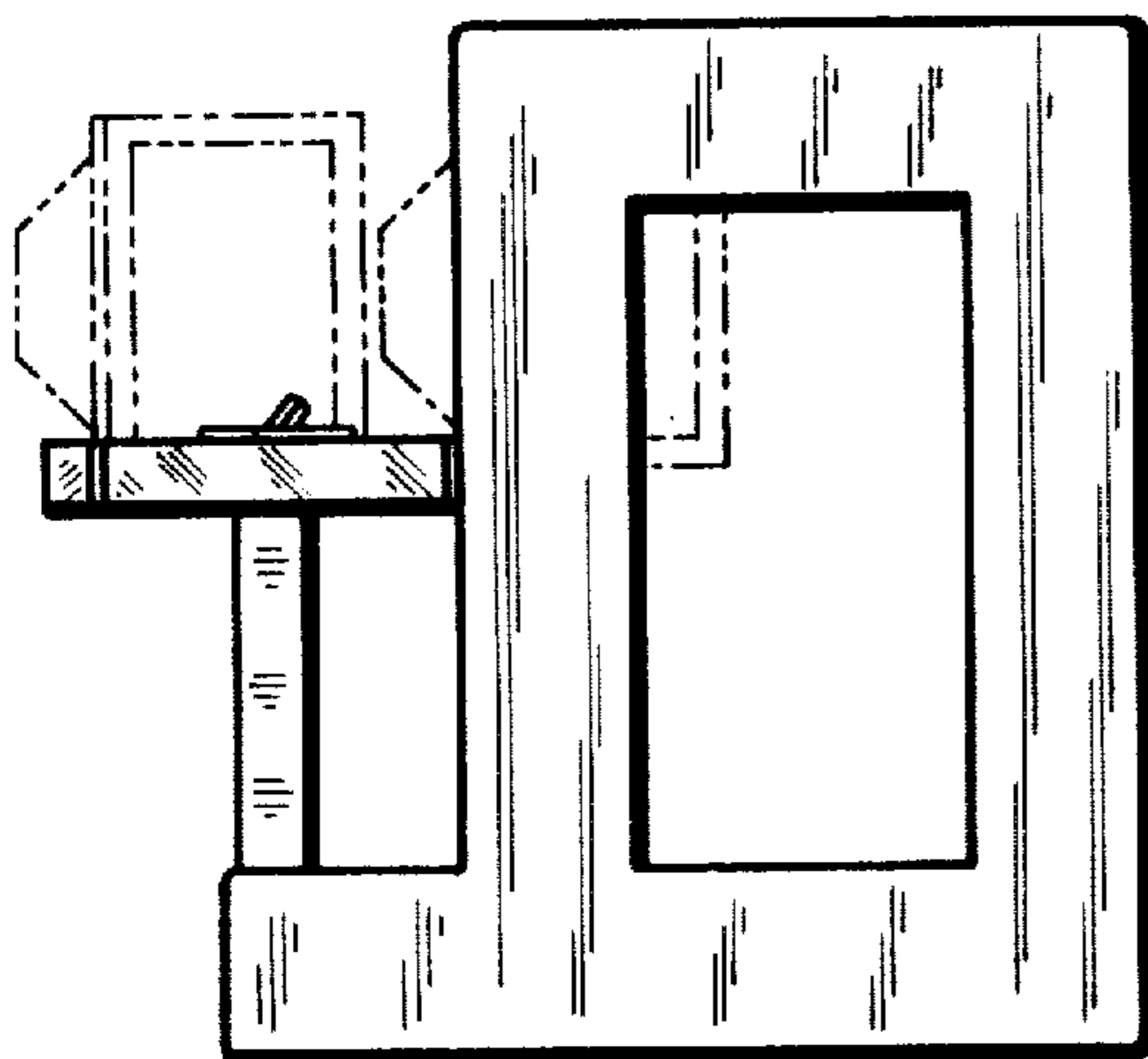
