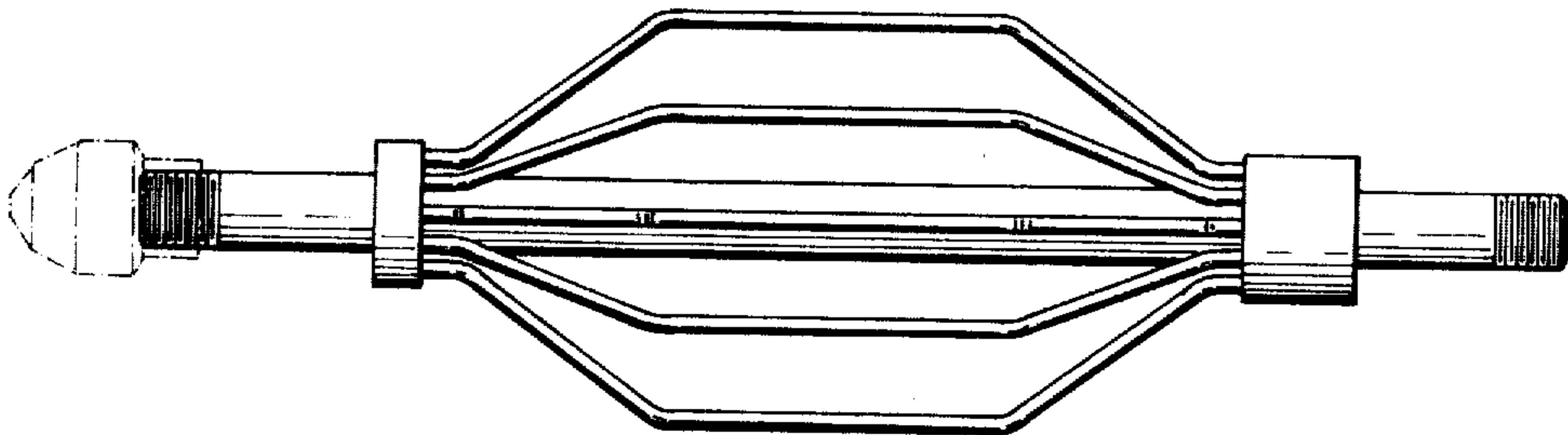

DESCRIPTION
FIG. 1 is a side elevational view of a sewer line proofer tool showing my new design;
FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof; and
FIG. 3 is a rear elevational view thereof.
The broken line representation of a nozzle in FIG. 1 is for purposes of illustration only.



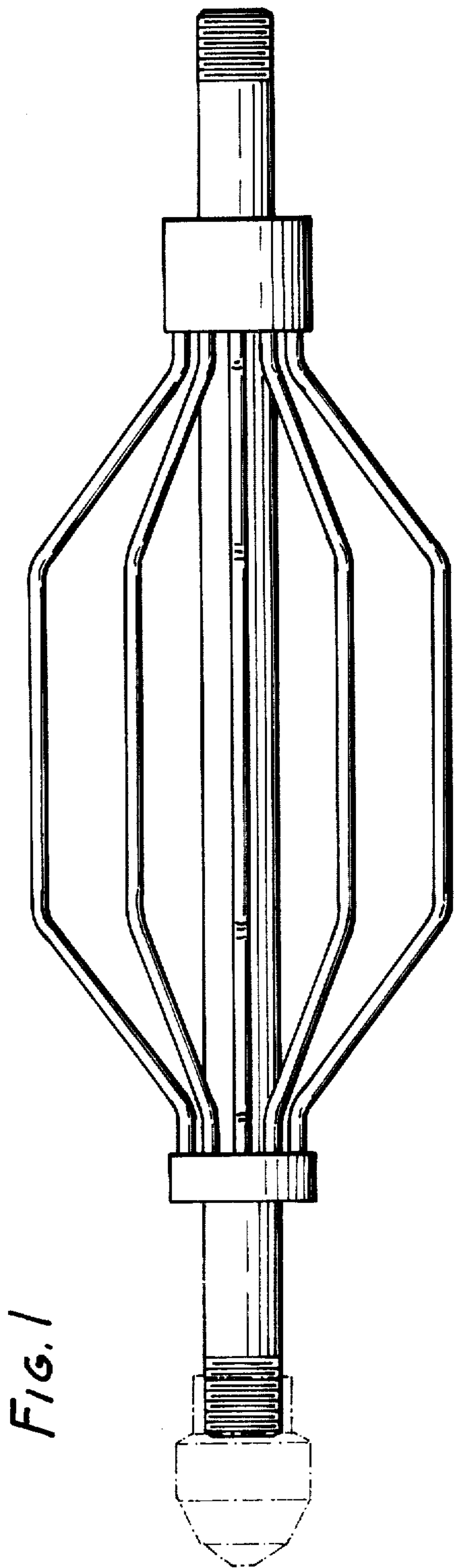

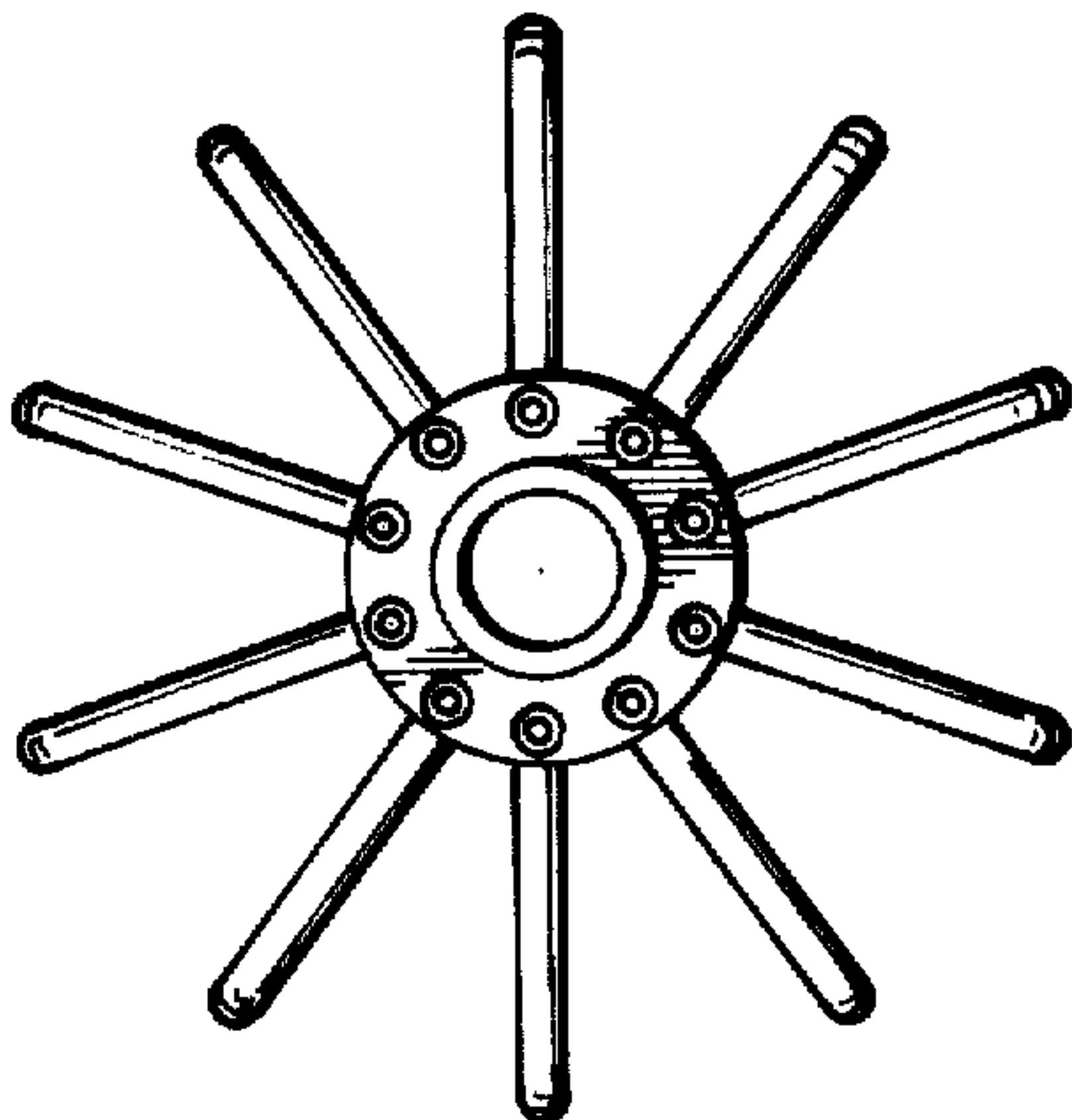
