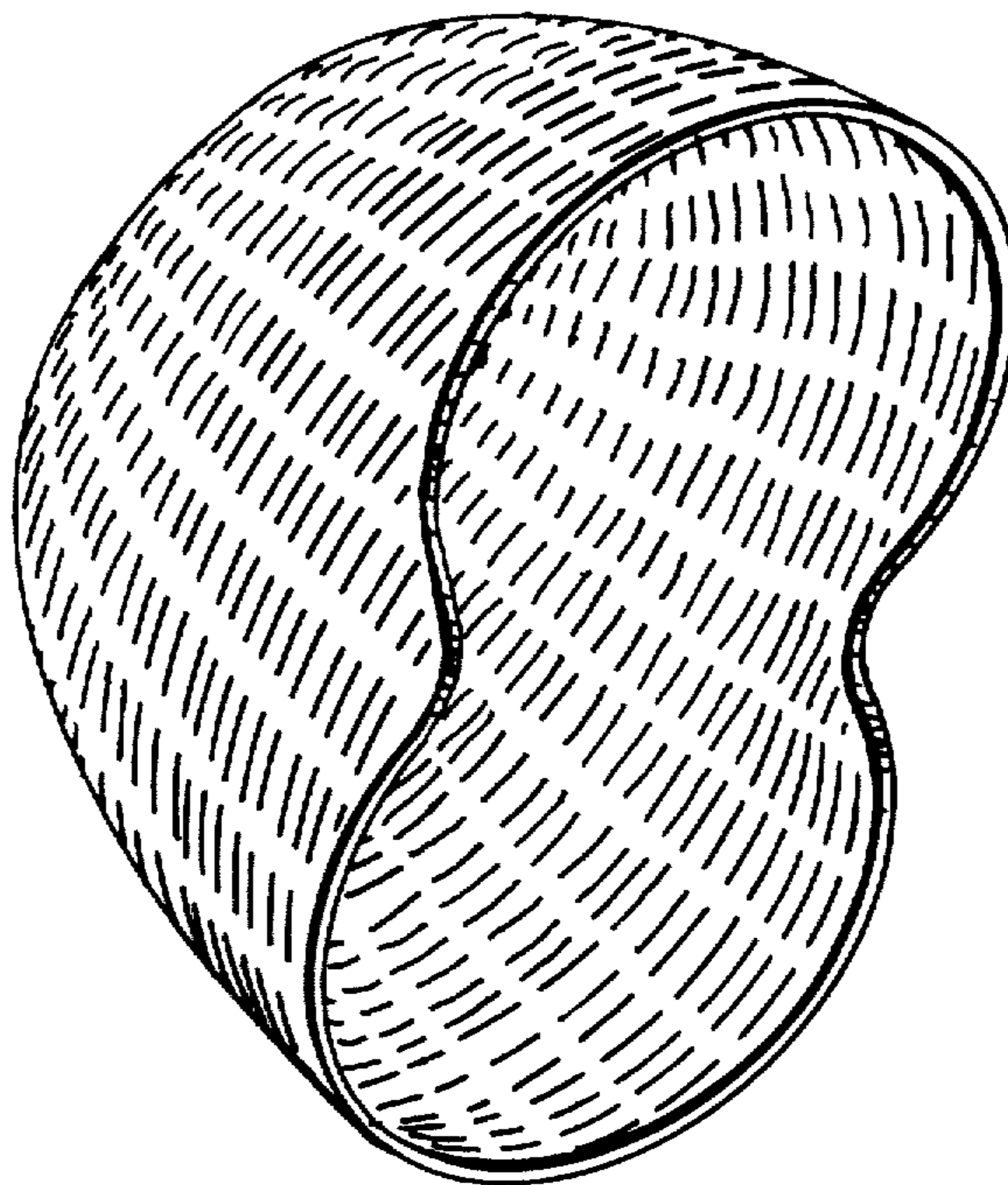

[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design head cap for holding electrical probes and medical dispensers, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front, bottom perspective view of a head cap for holding electrical probes and medical dispensers showing my new design;

FIG. 4 is a bottom plan view thereof.



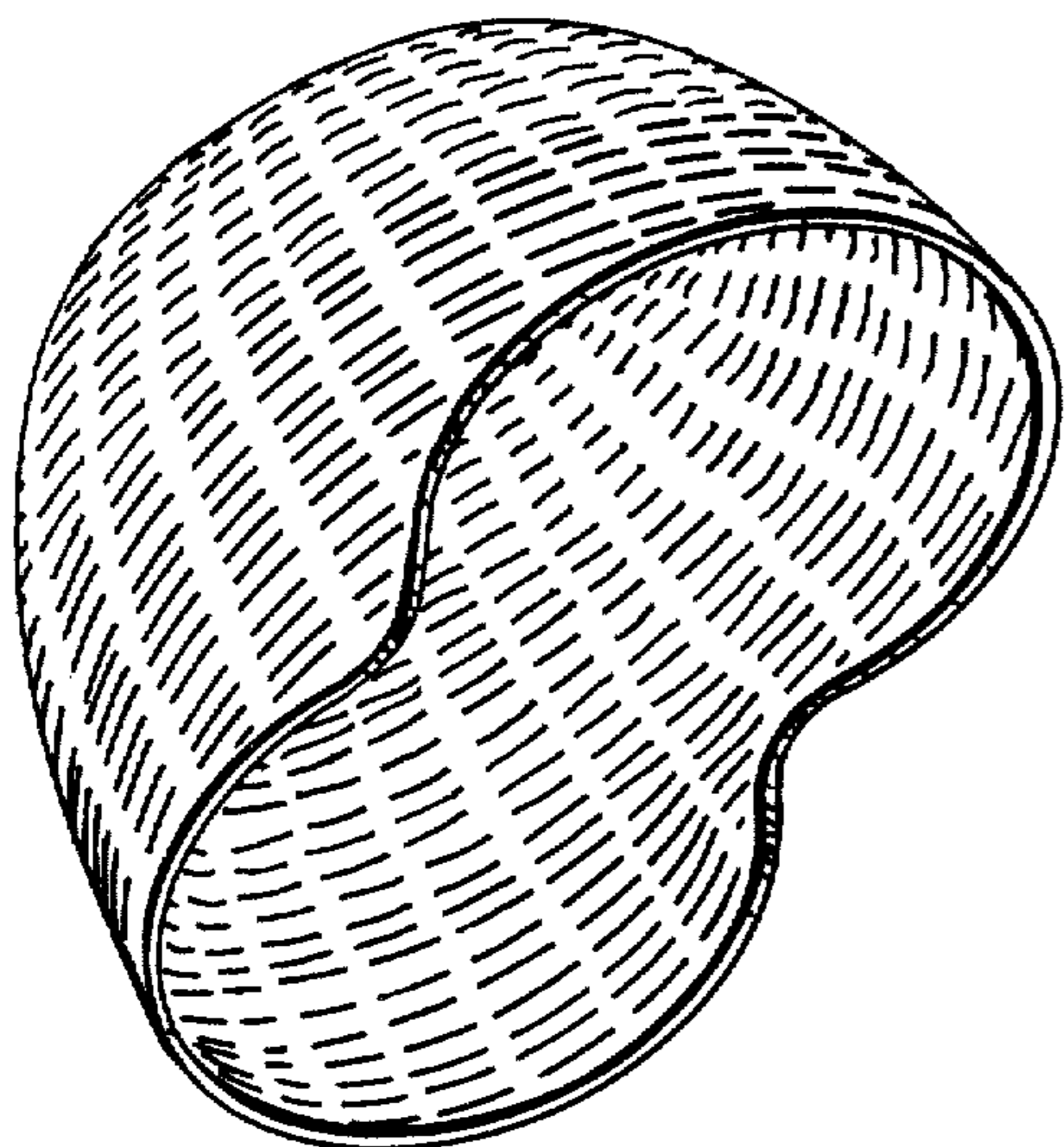

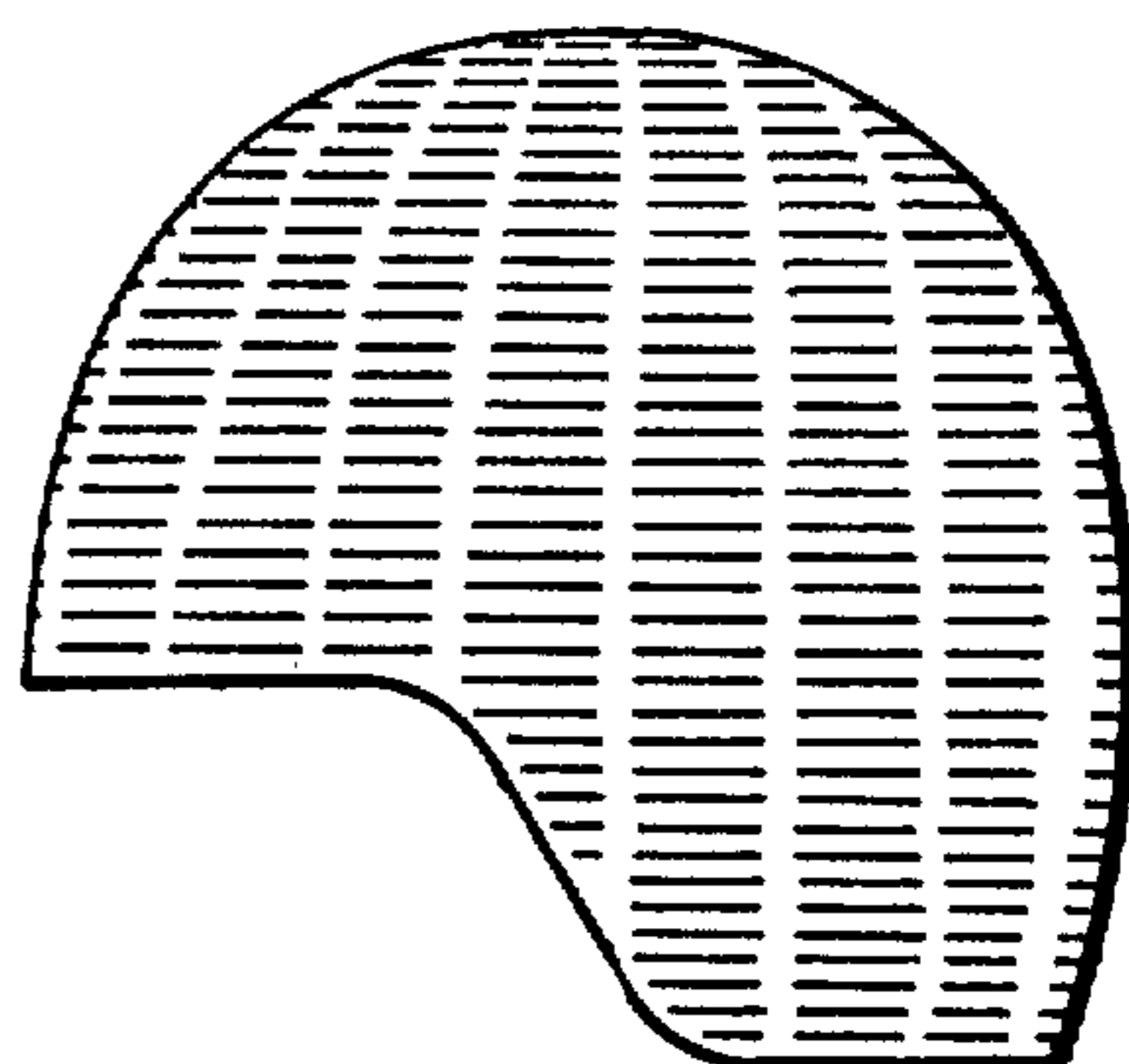

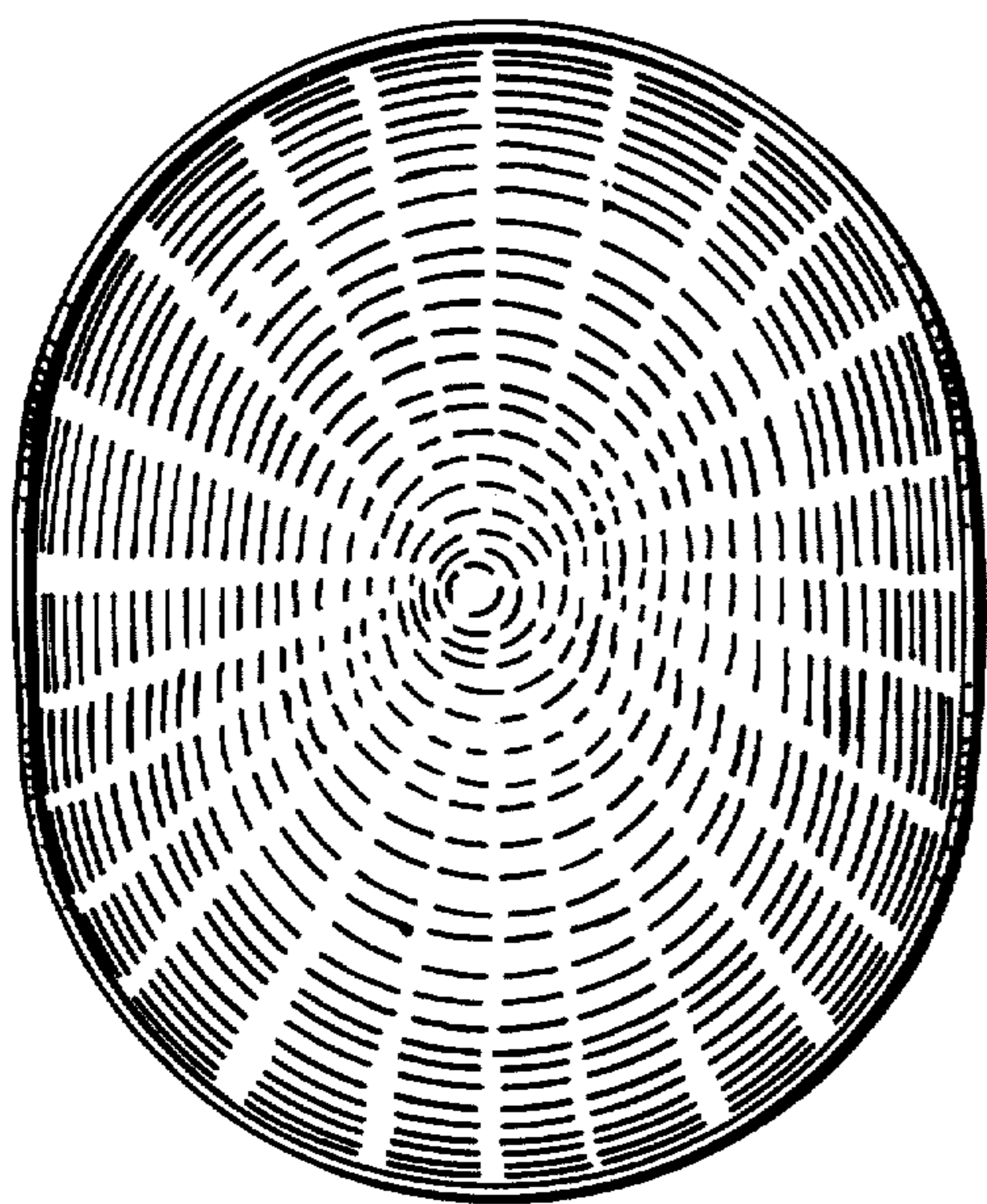

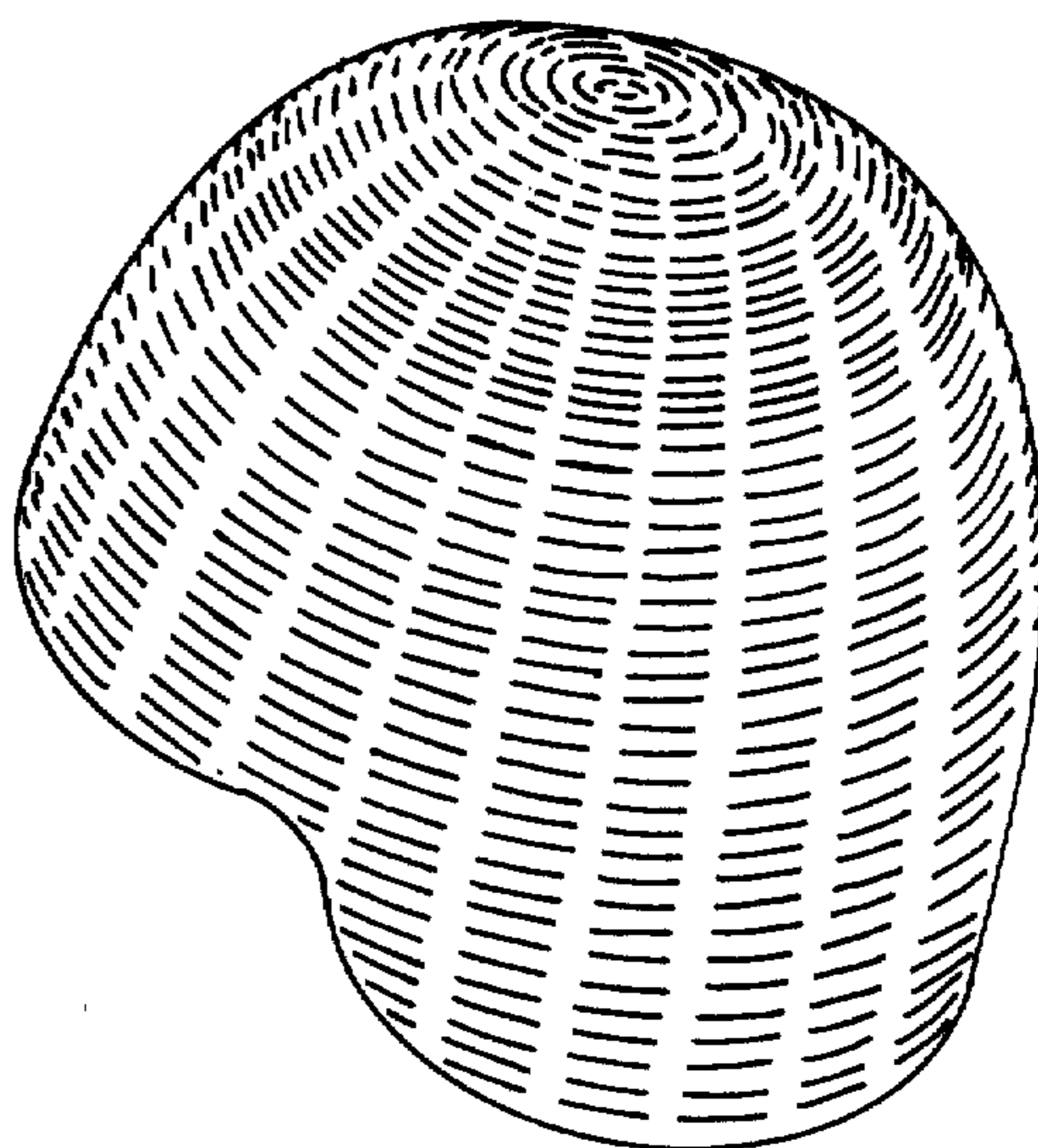
