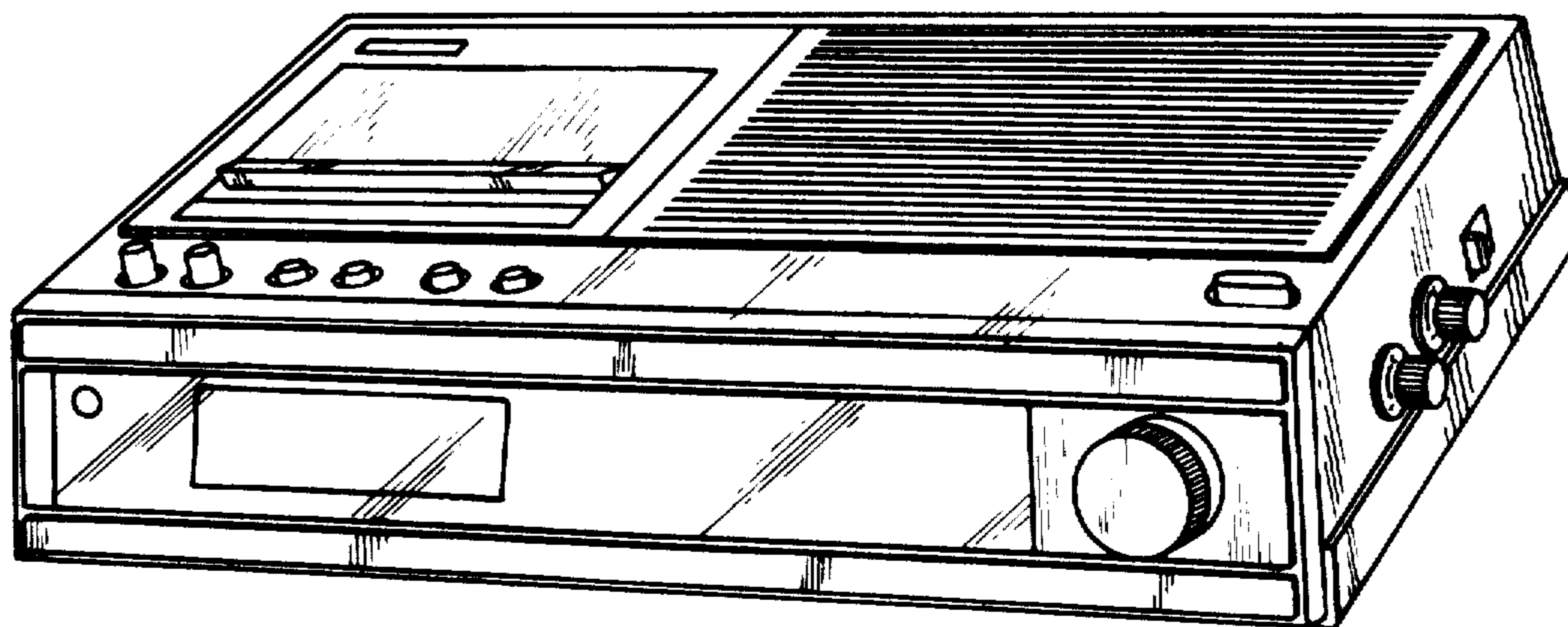

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front, top and right side perspective view of the clock radio receiver showing my new design;
FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof;

FIG. 7 is a bottom plan view.



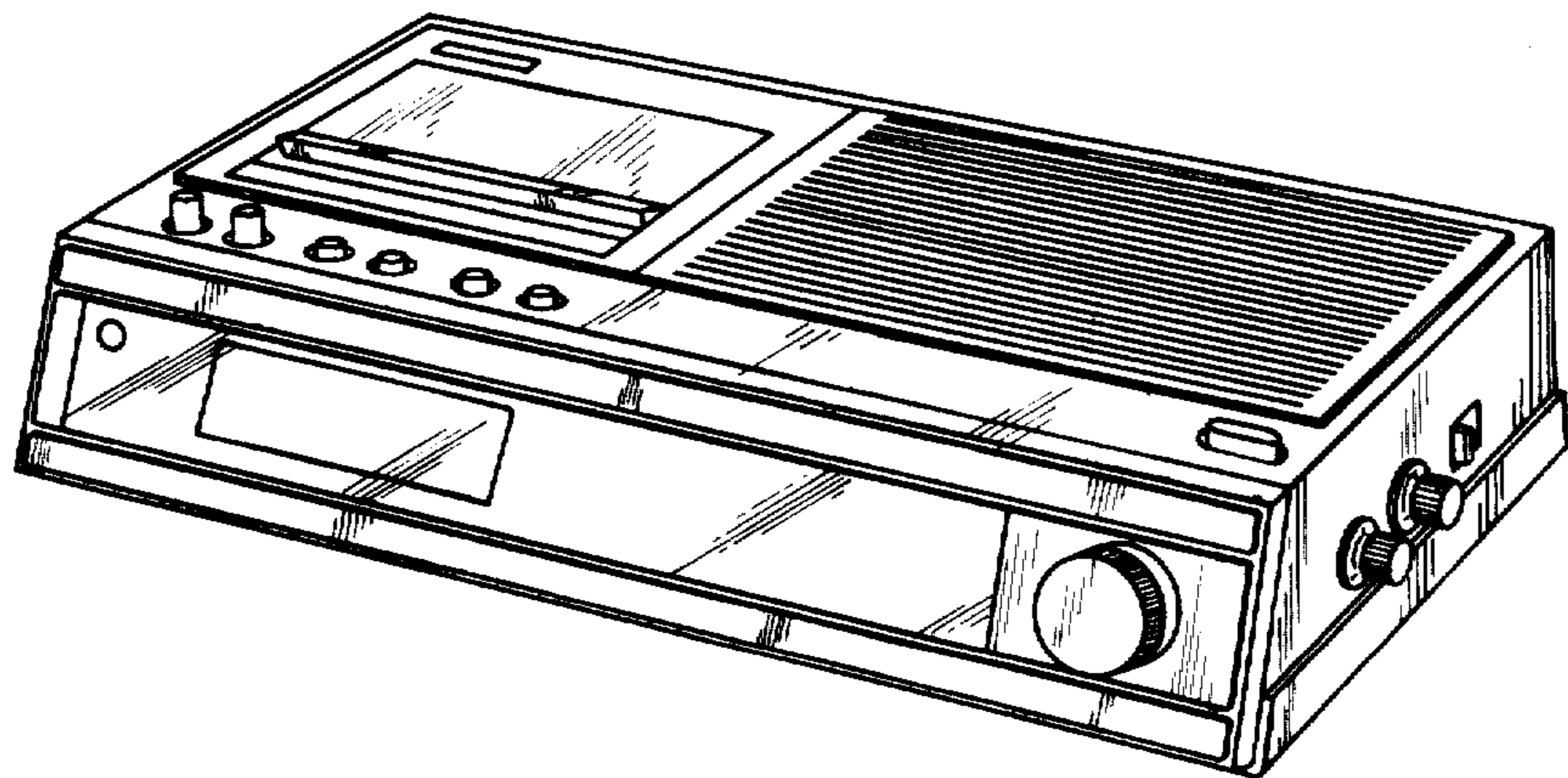

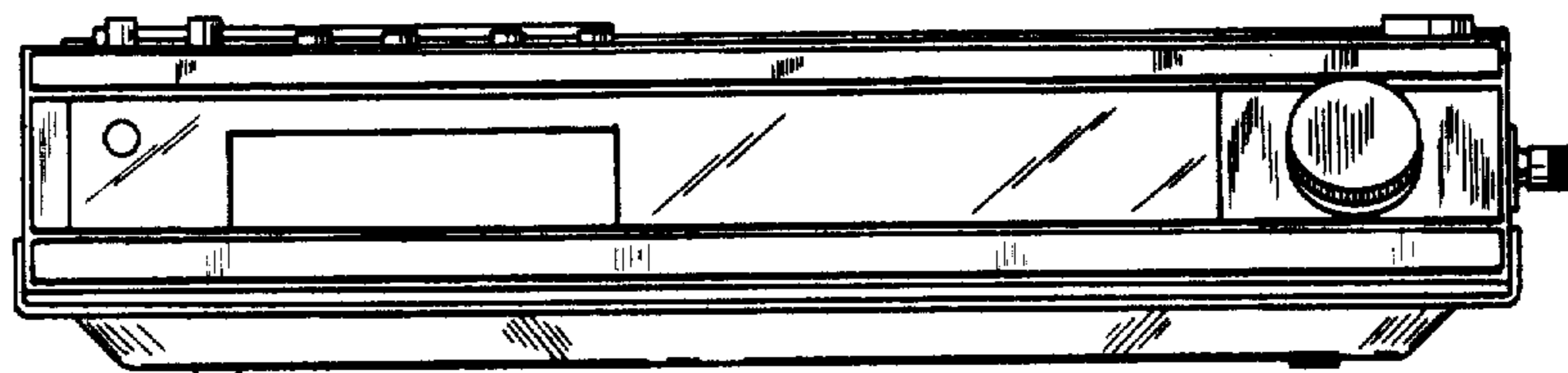

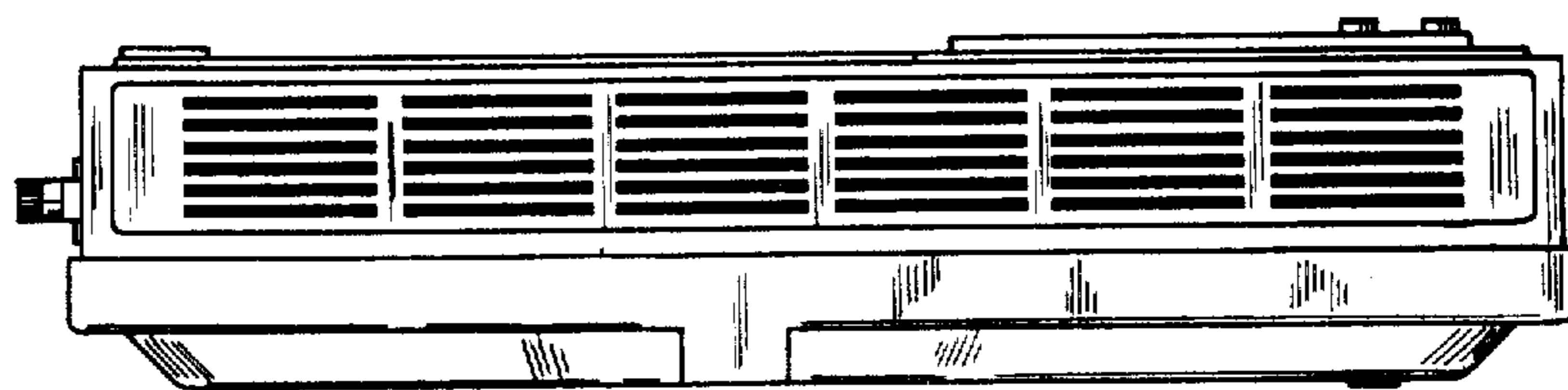

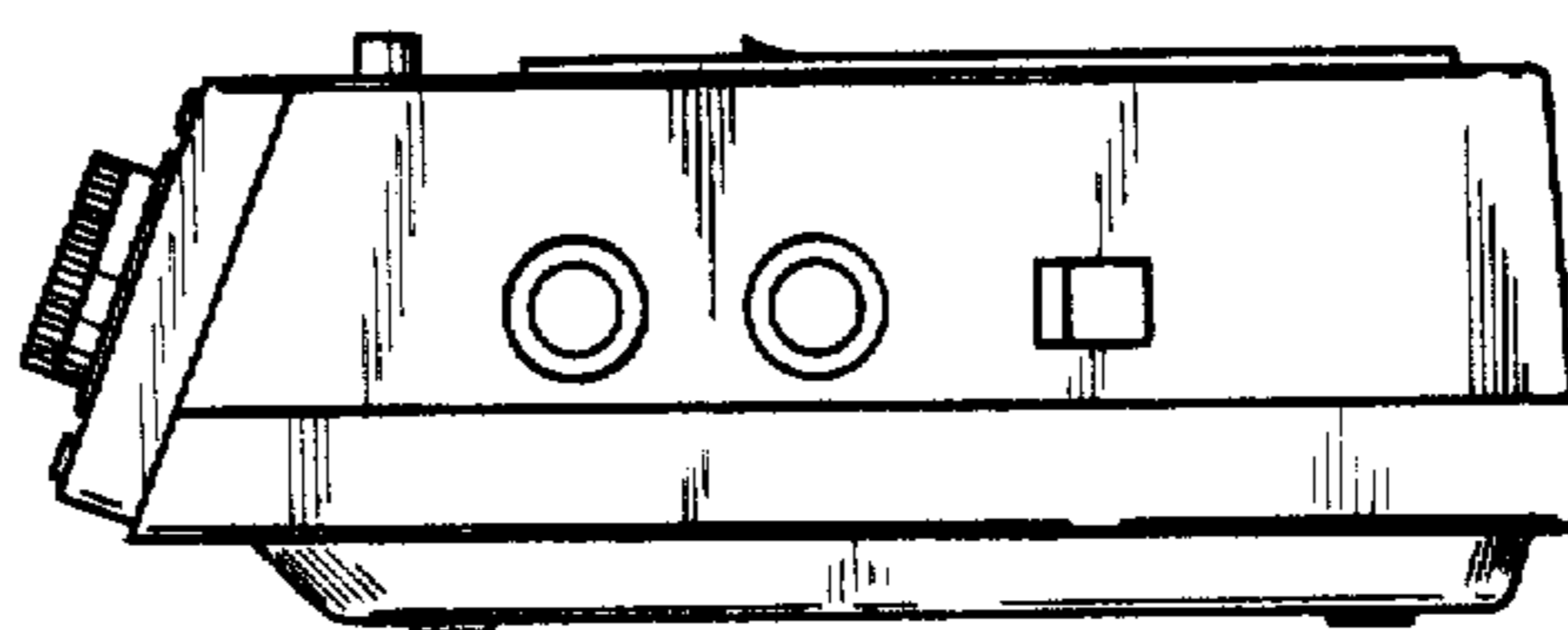

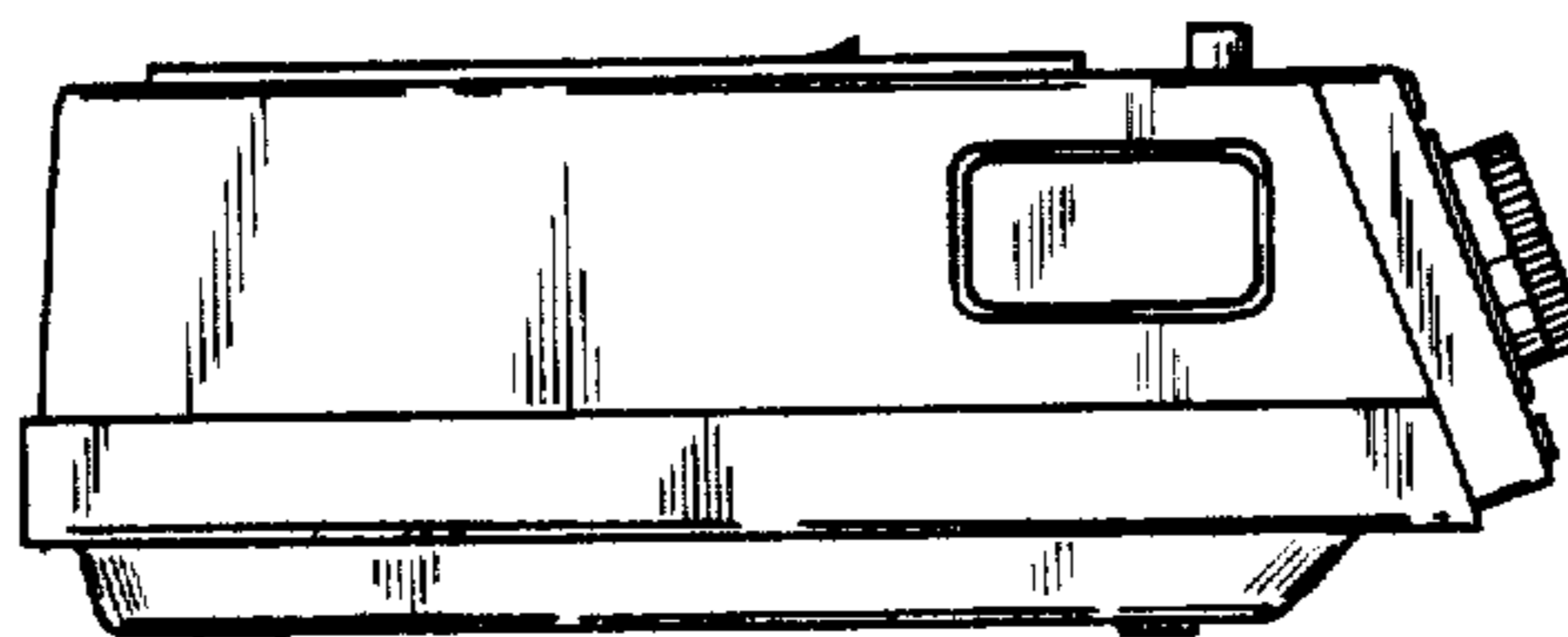

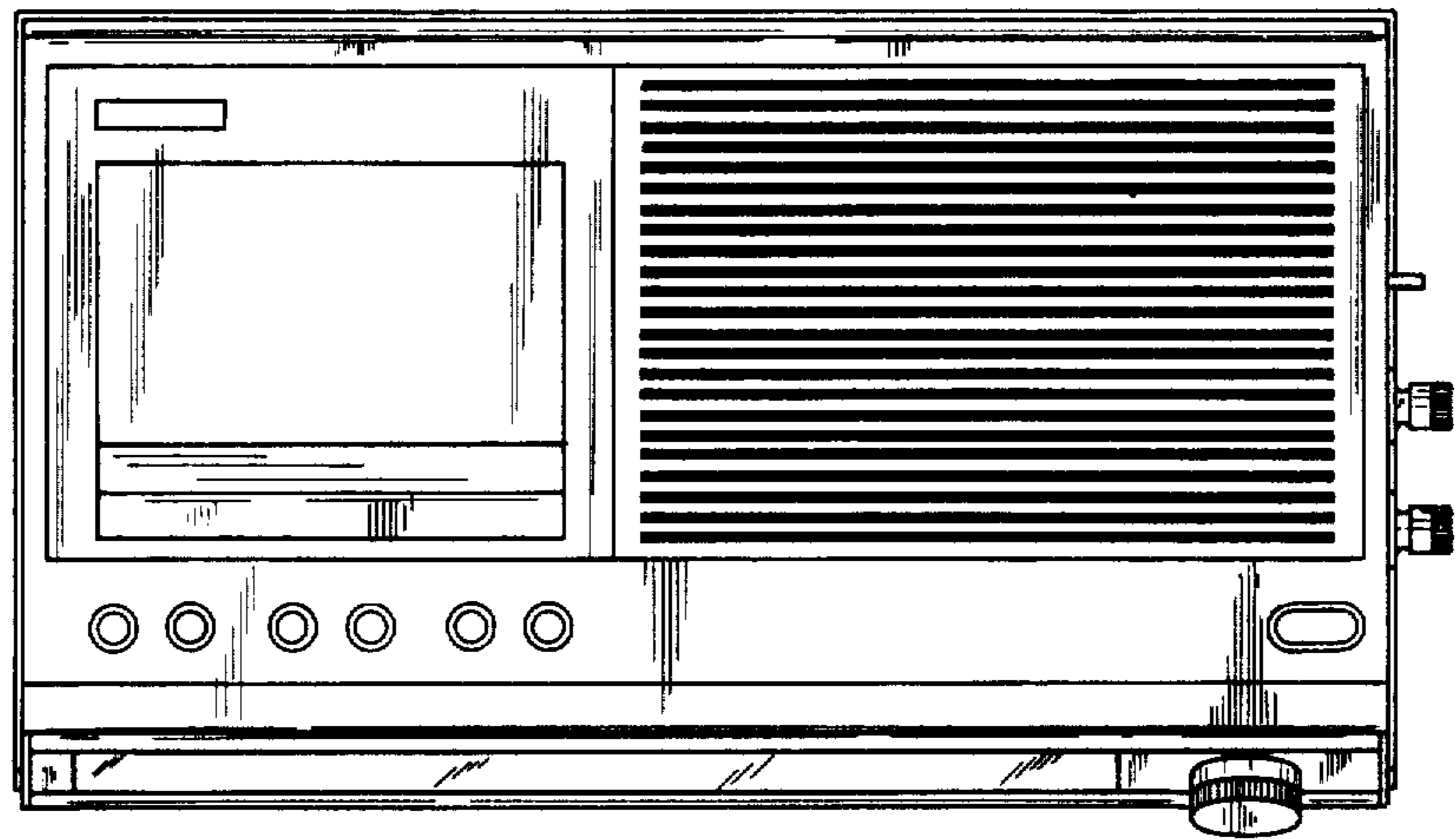

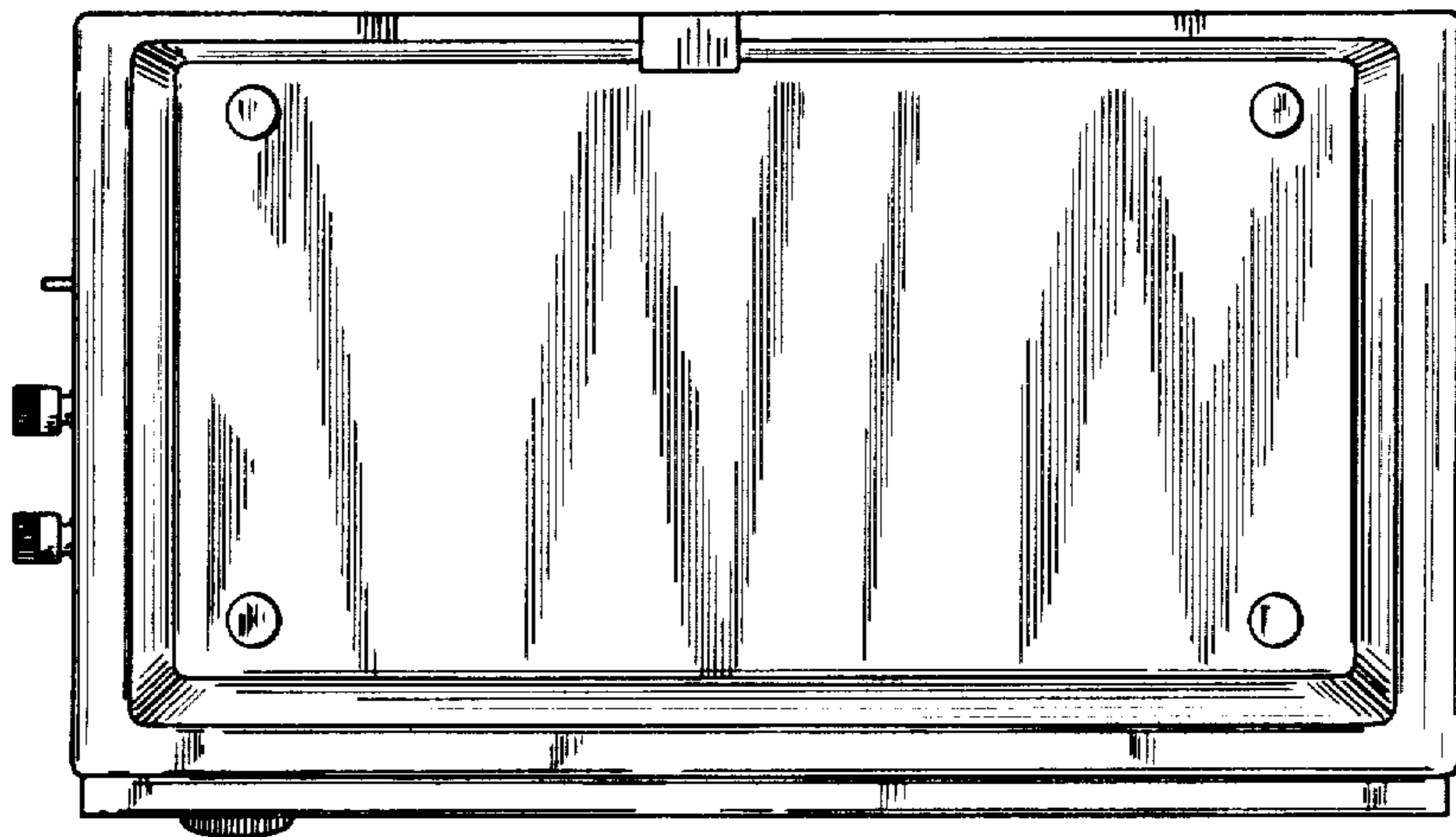
