The ornamental design for mirror reflex camera, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a mirror reflex camera showing our new design without an objective; FIG. 2 is a rear elevational view thereof; FIG. 3 is a right side elevational view thereof; FIG. 4 is a left side elevational view thereof; FIG. 5 is a top plan view of FIG. 2; FIG. 6 is a bottom plan view of FIG. 1; FIG. 7 is a top and right front perspective view thereof with the objective engaged.

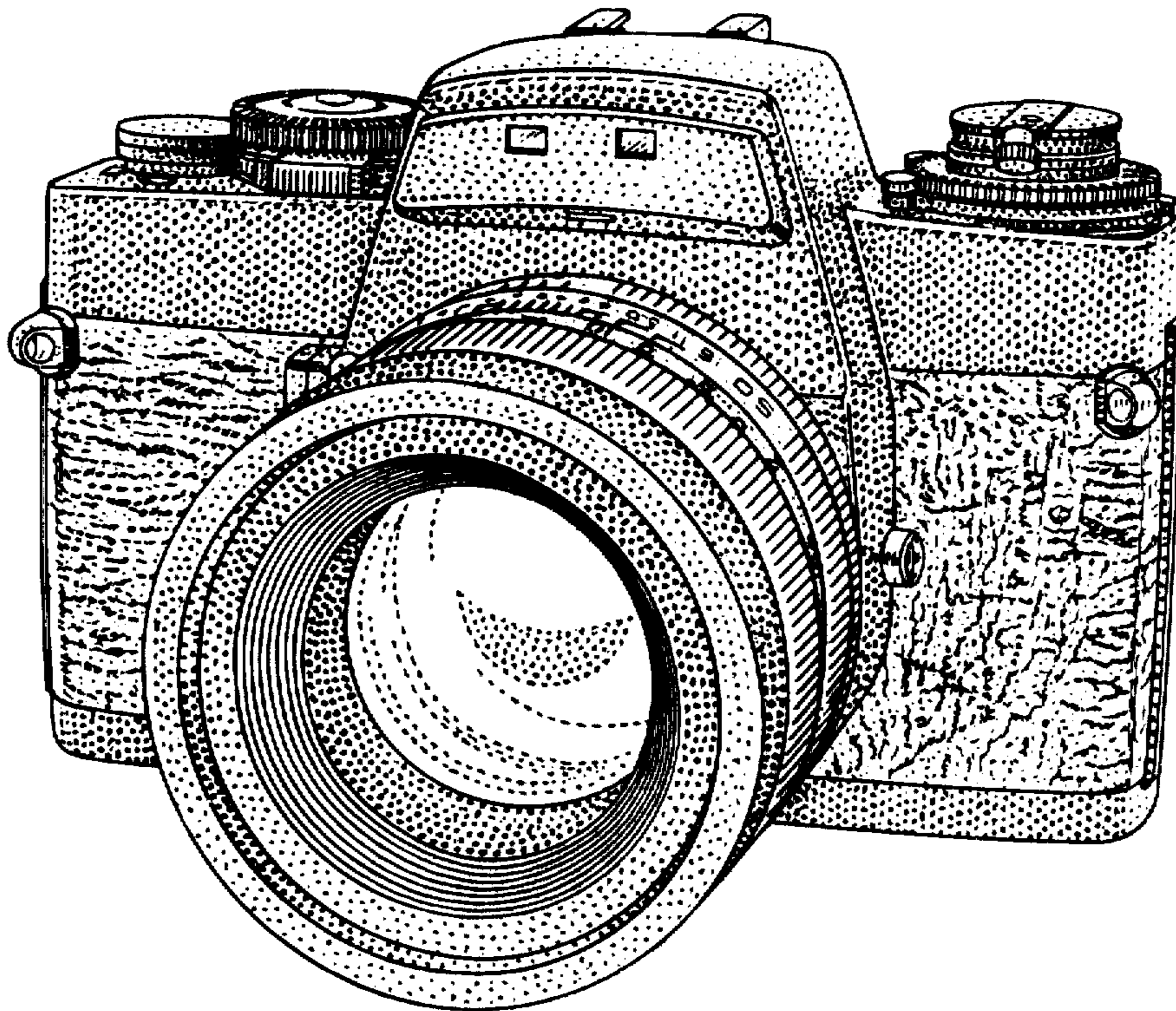

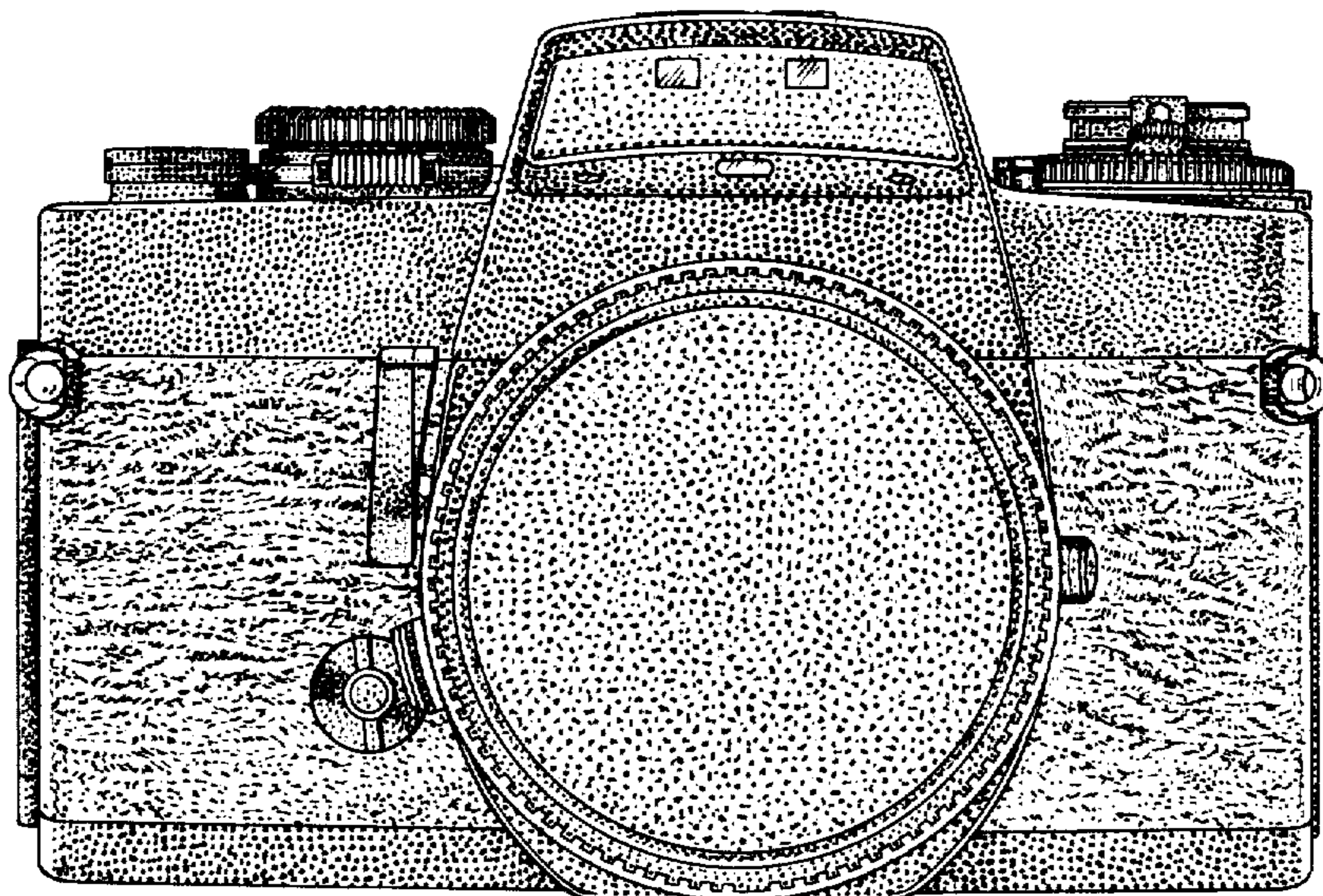

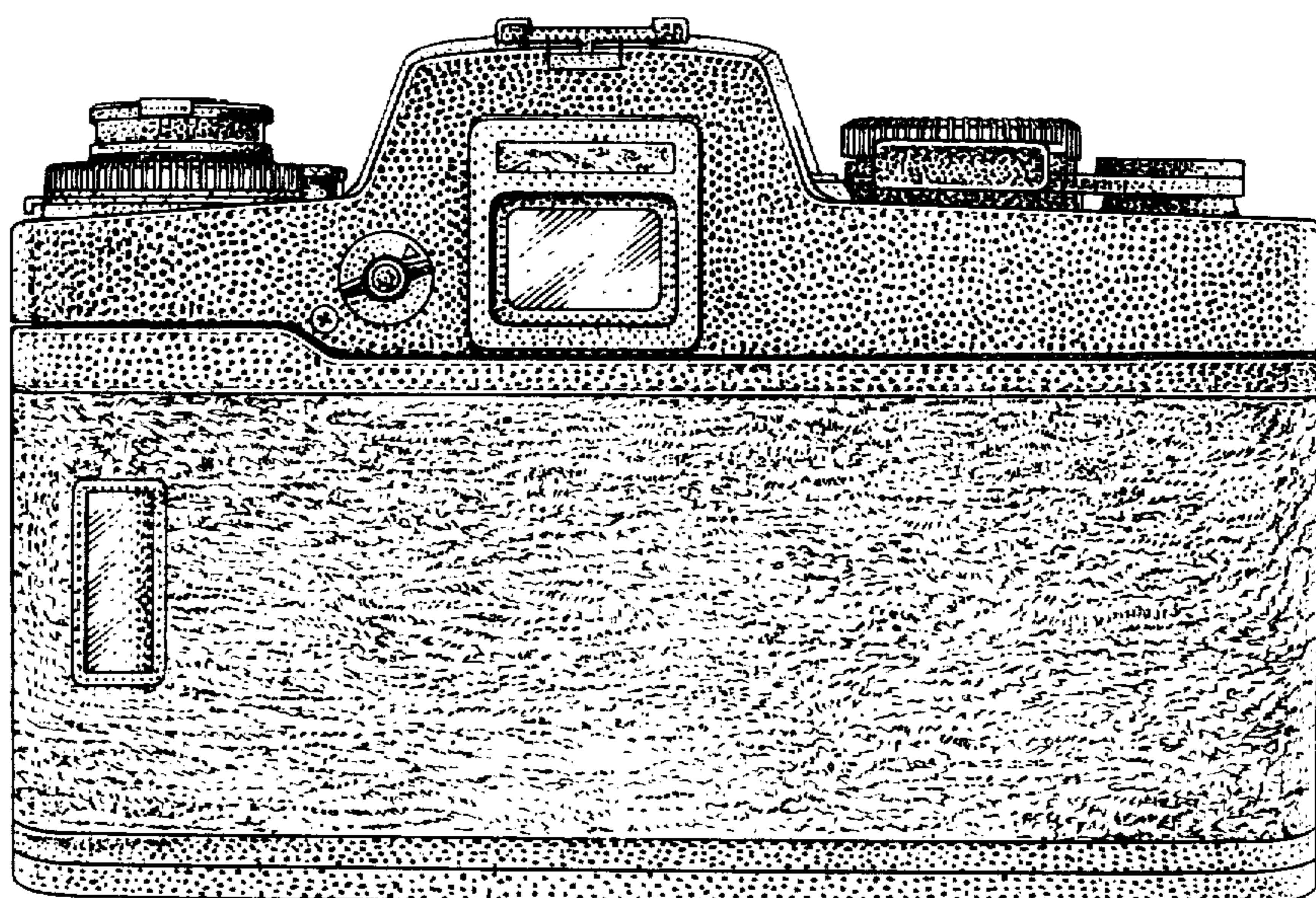

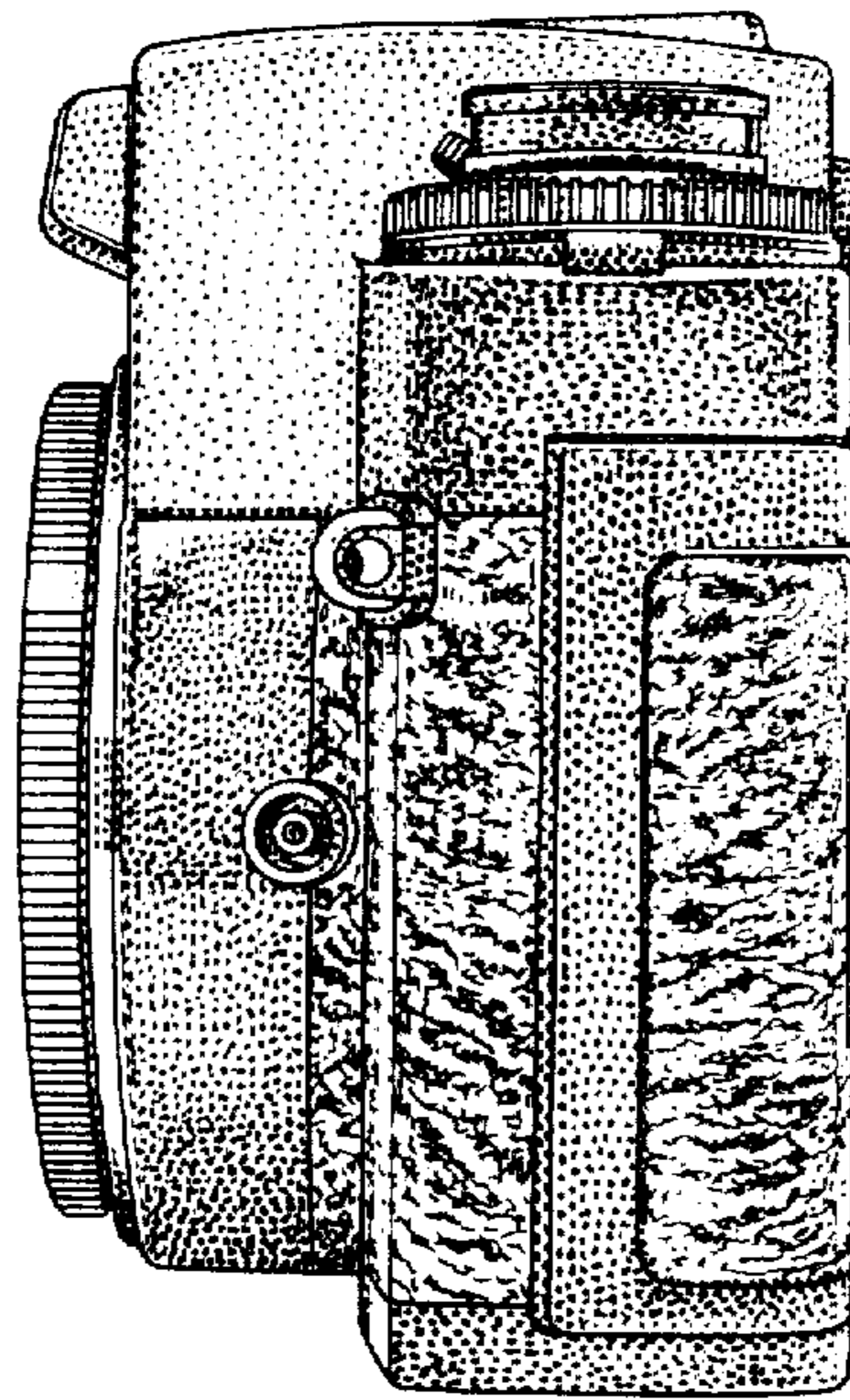

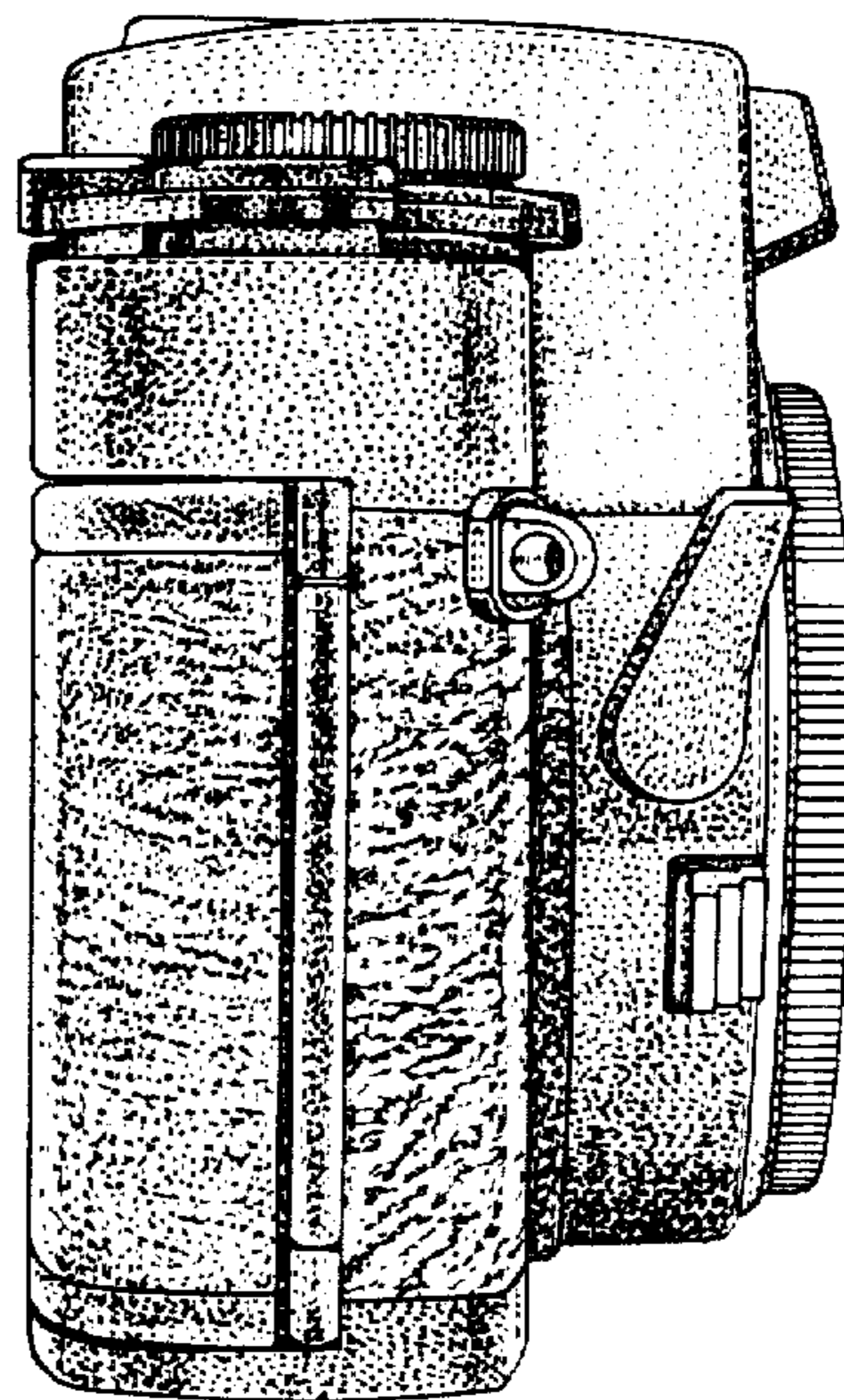

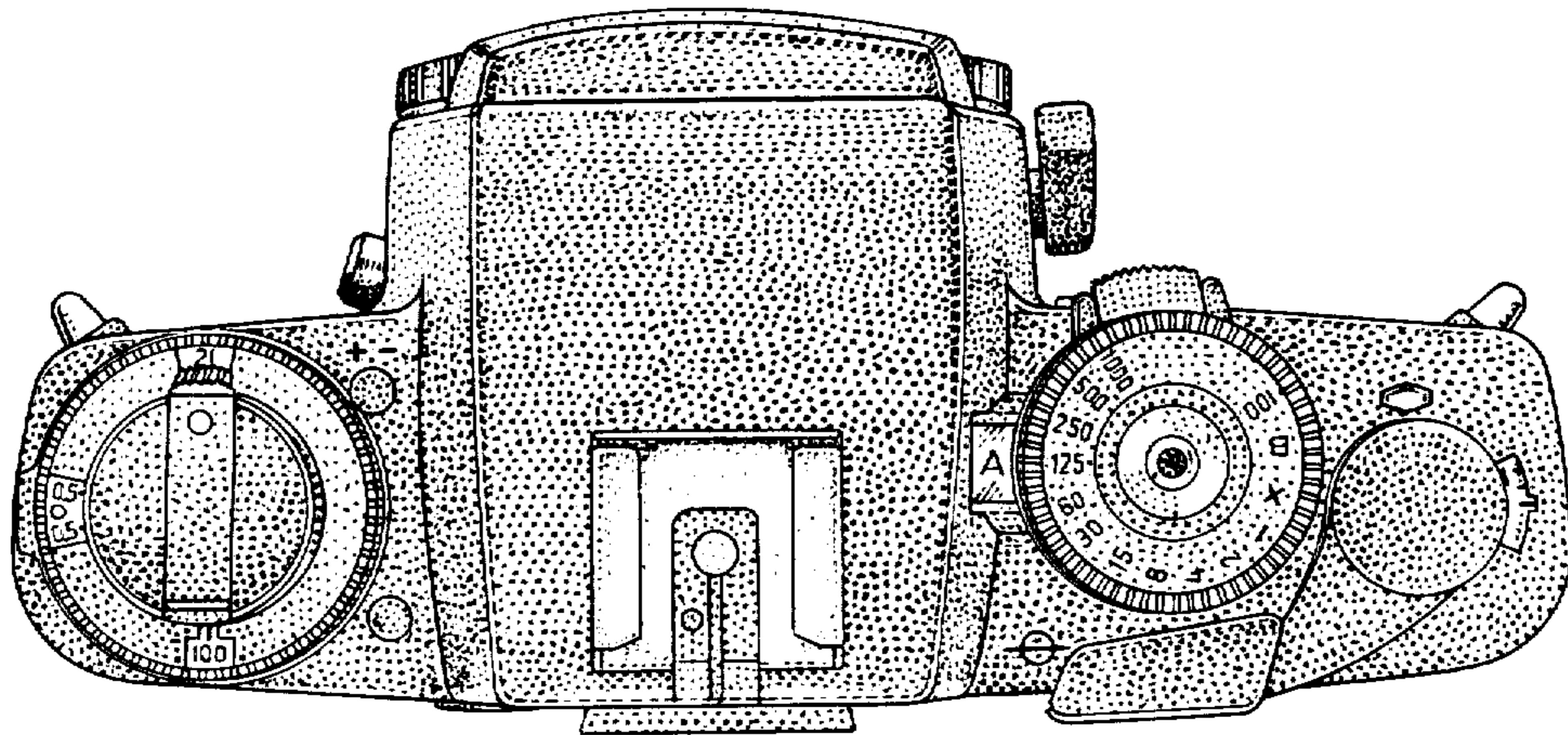

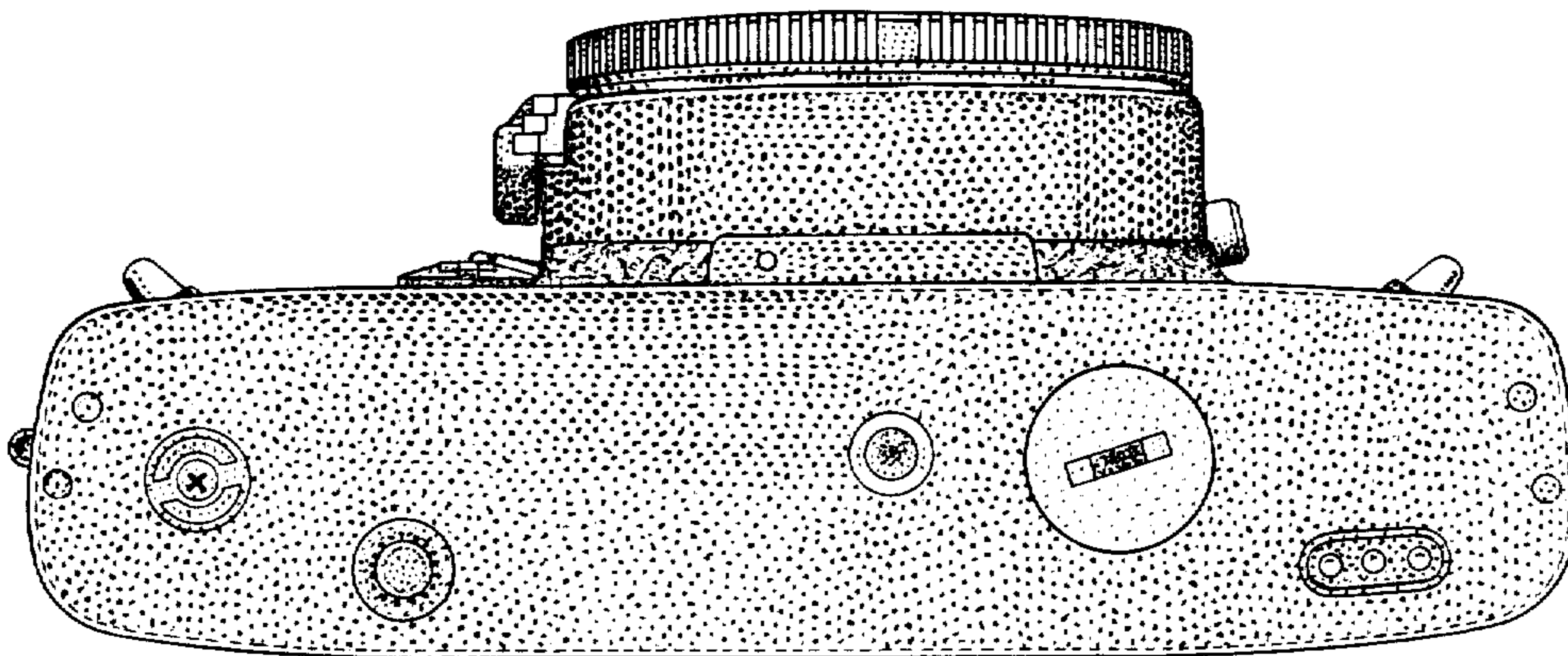
