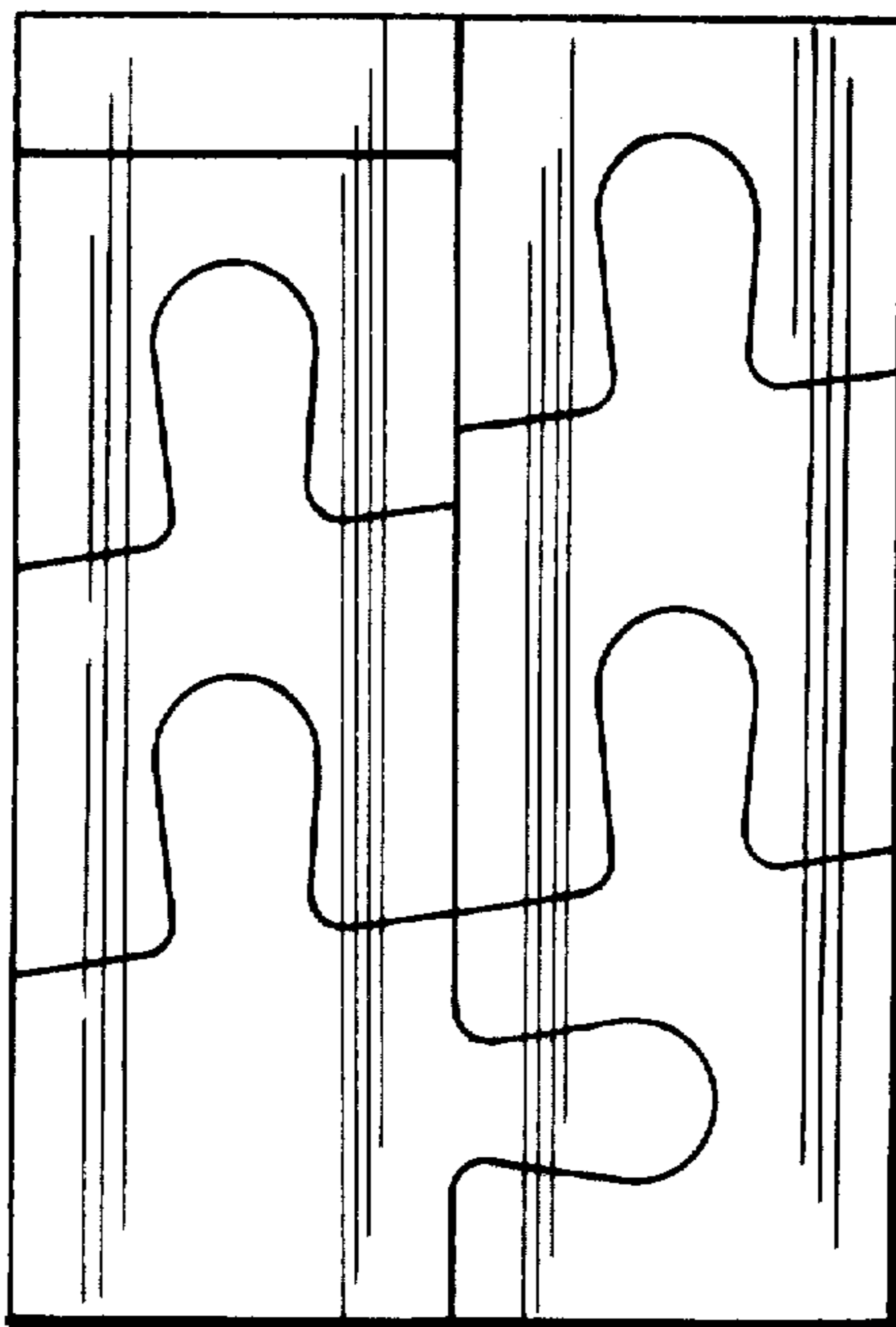

**DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 1 is a top plan view of a puzzle showing my new design;

FIG. 6 is a rear edge elevational view thereof.



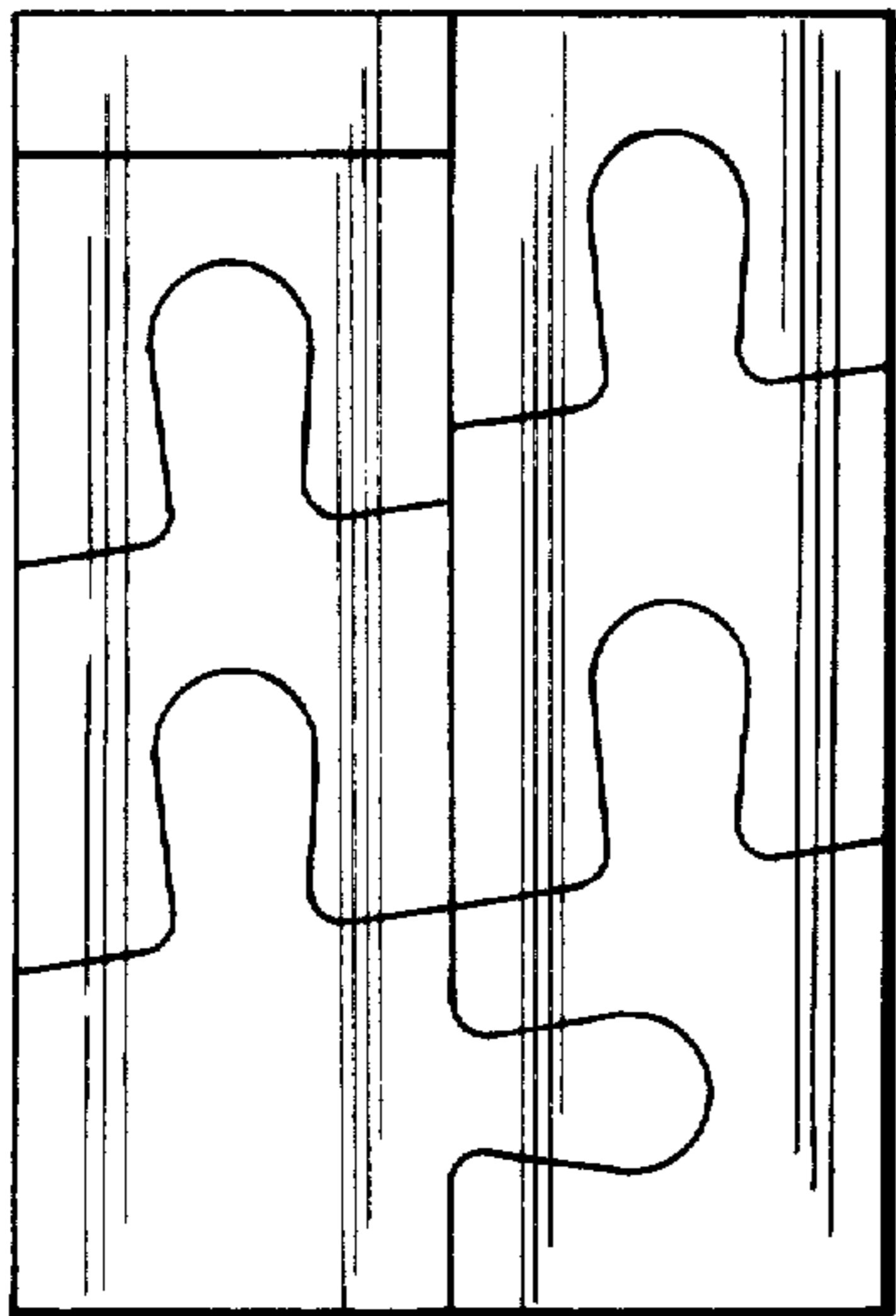

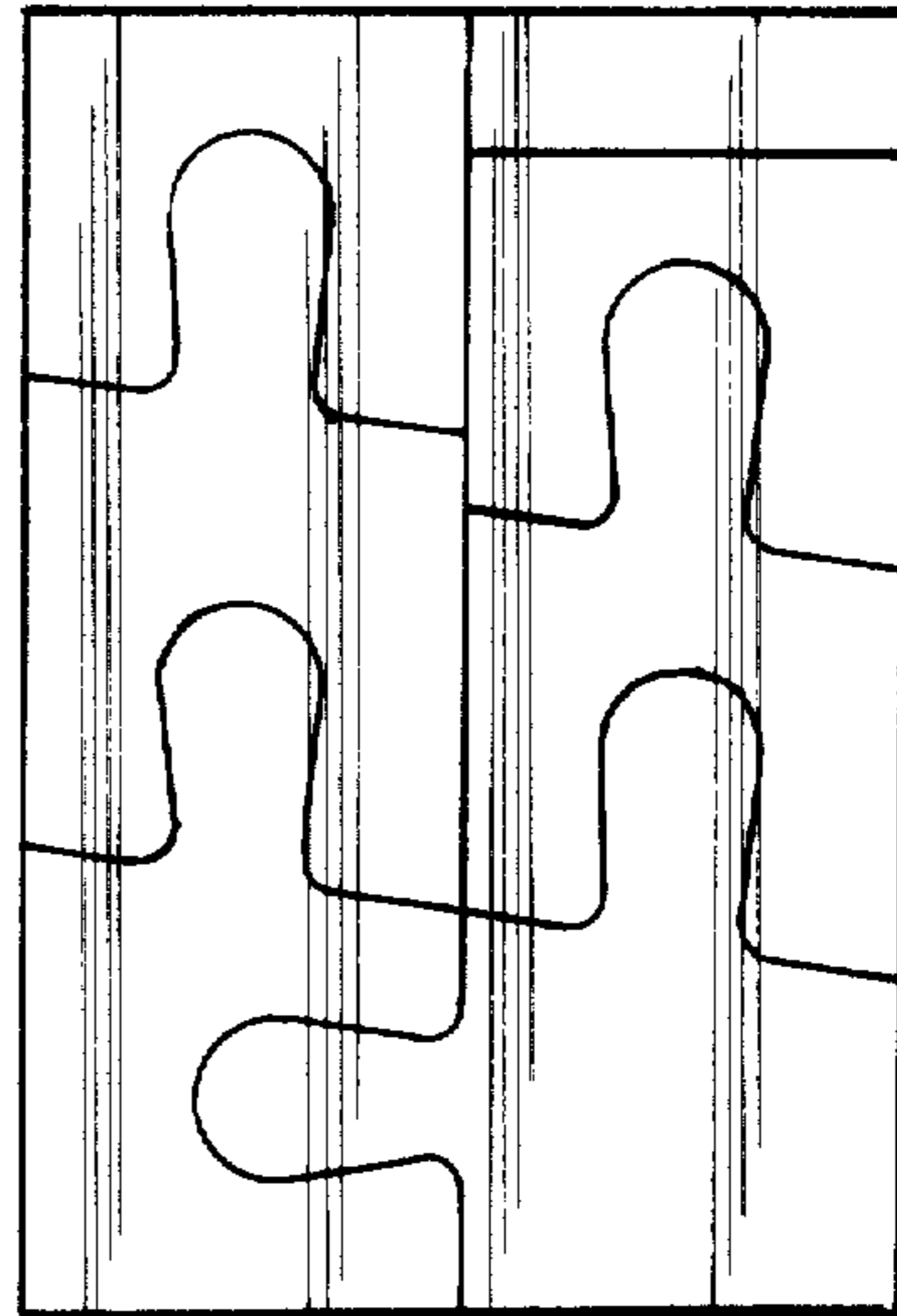
