FIG. 1 is a bottom plan view of a rack for holding stemware glasses showing my new design;

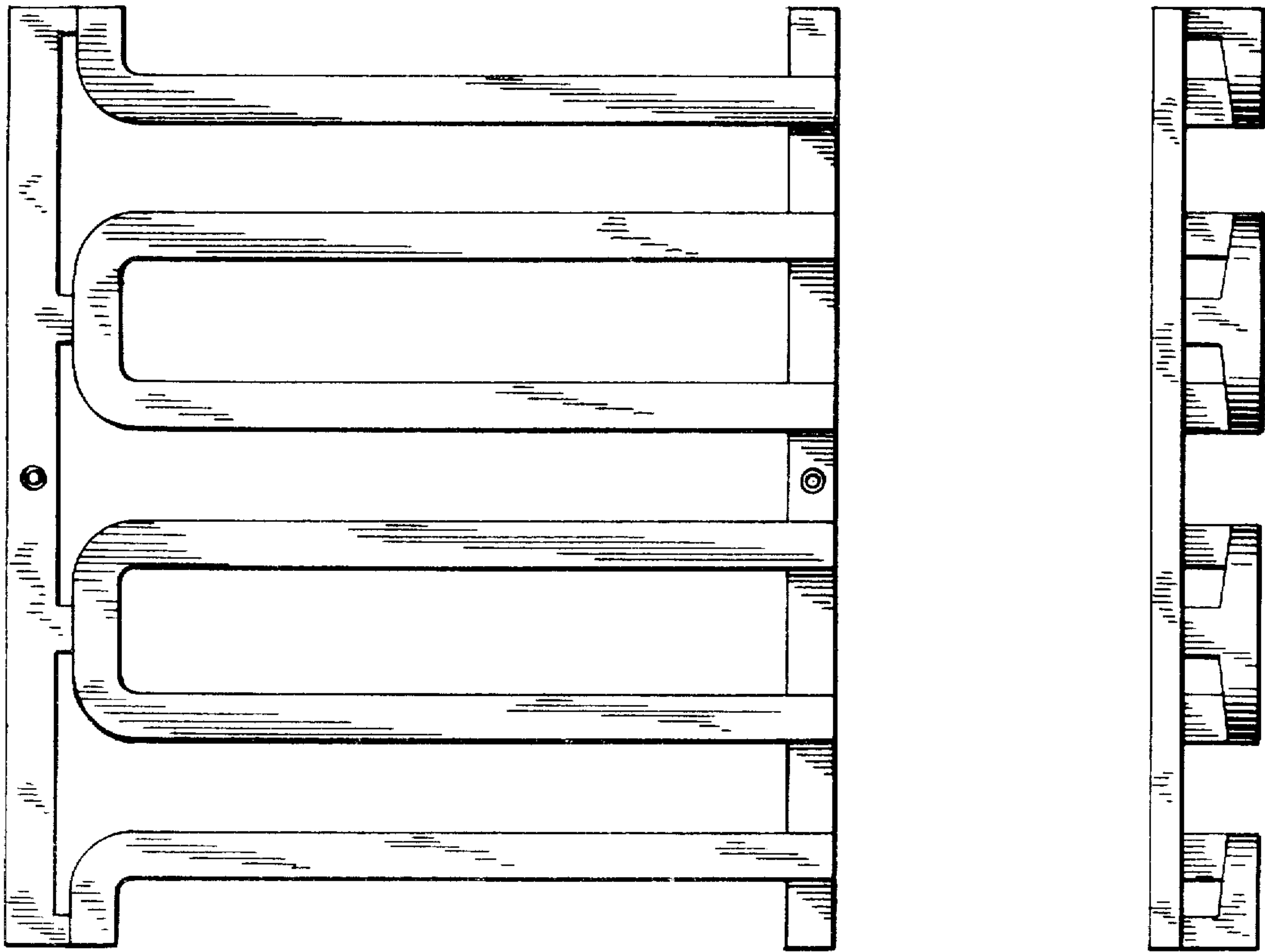
FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof;

FIG. 6 is an end elevational view taken from the bottom of FIG. 1.



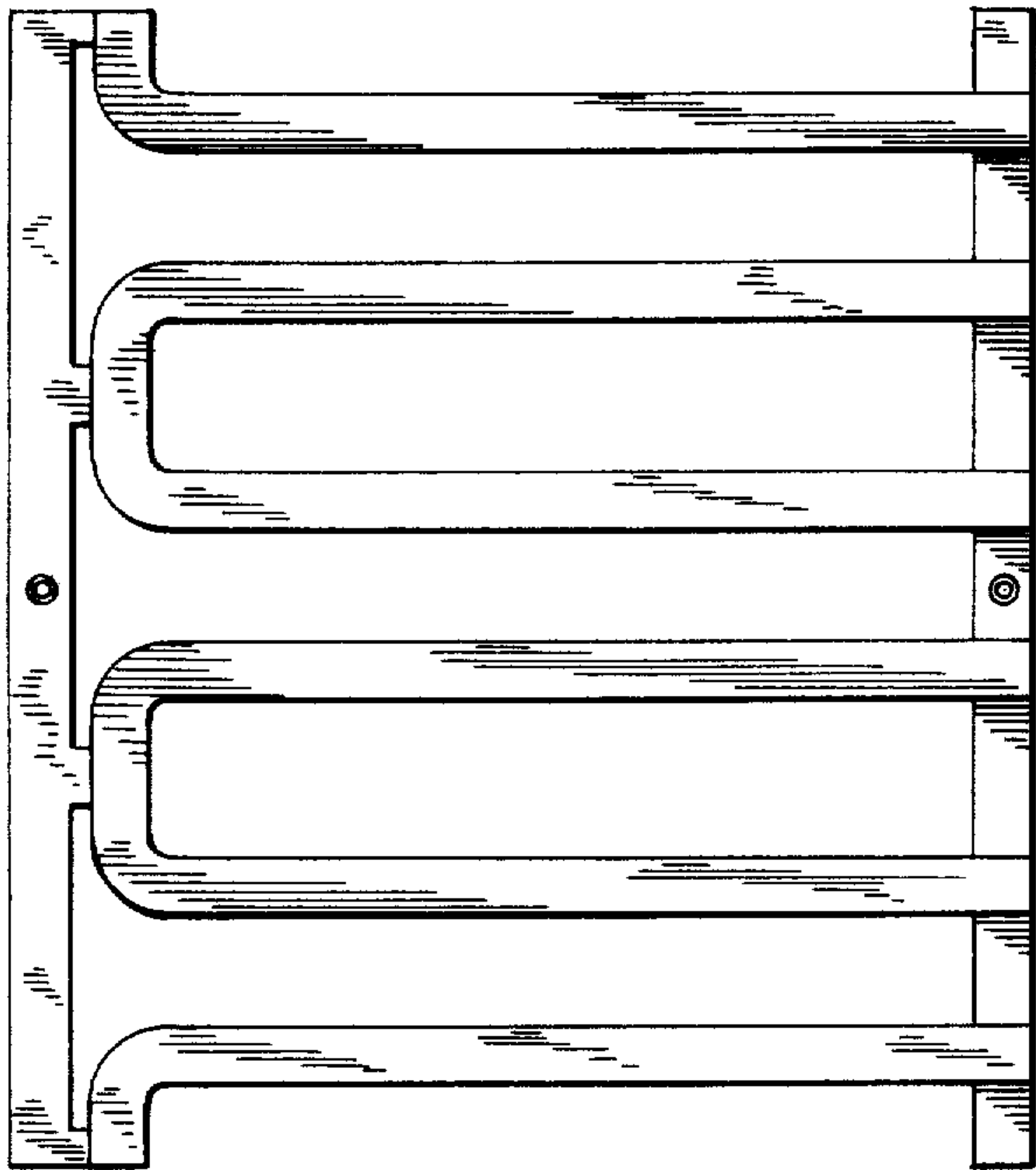

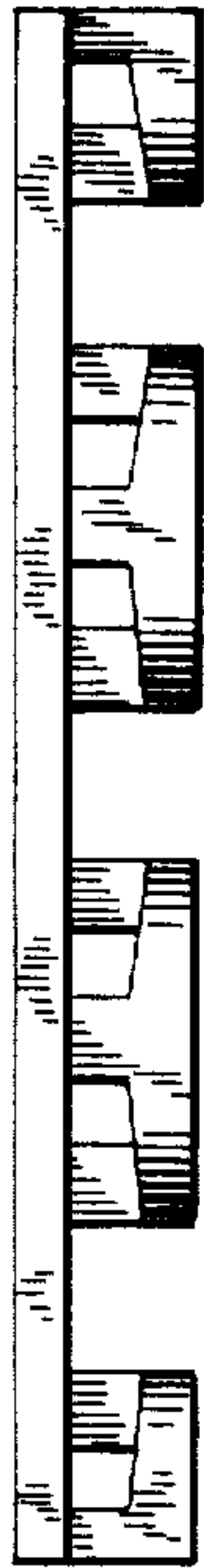

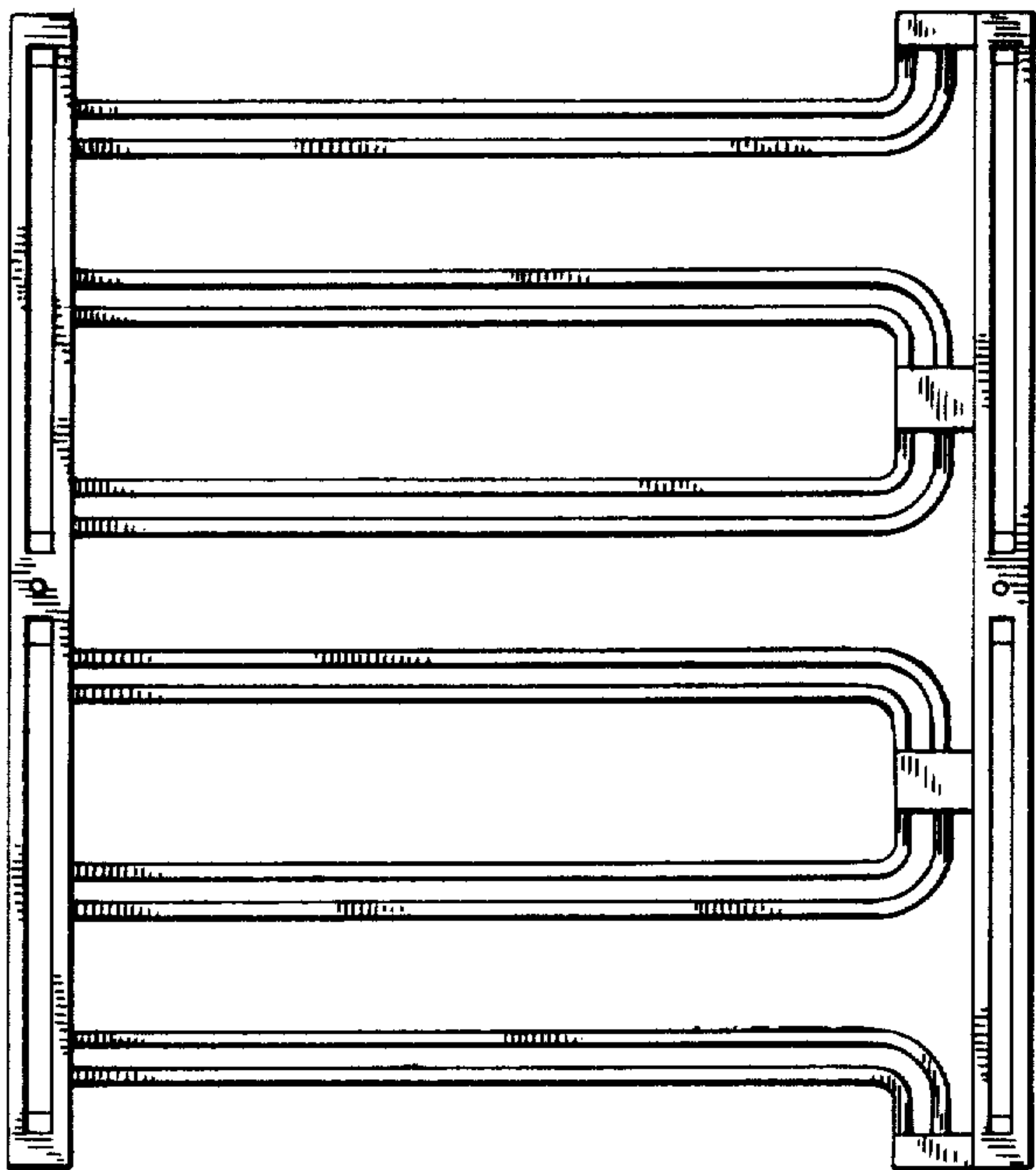

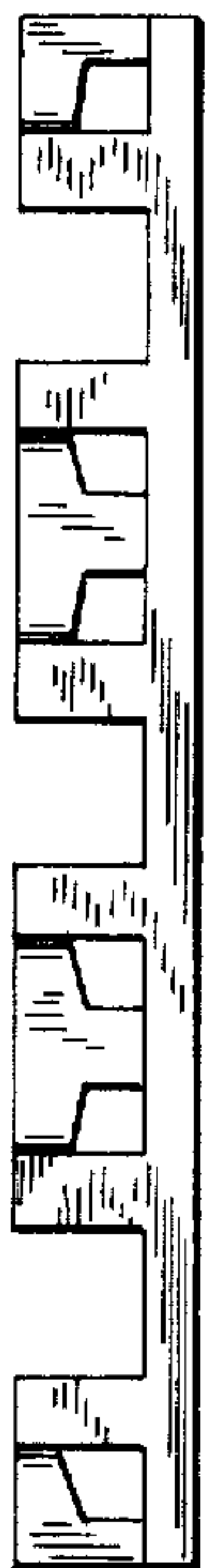

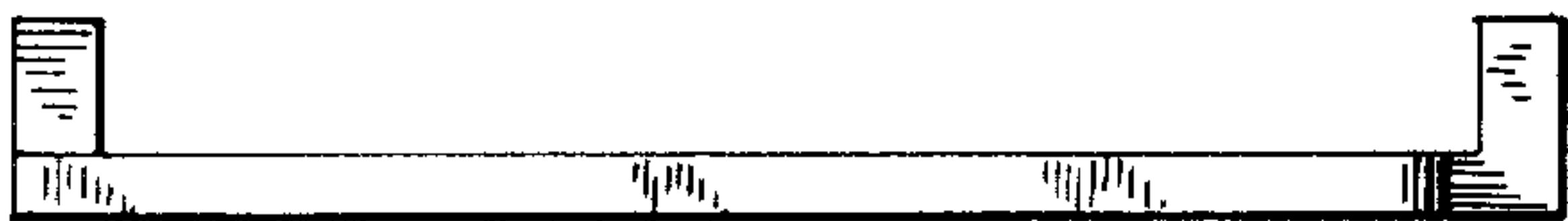
