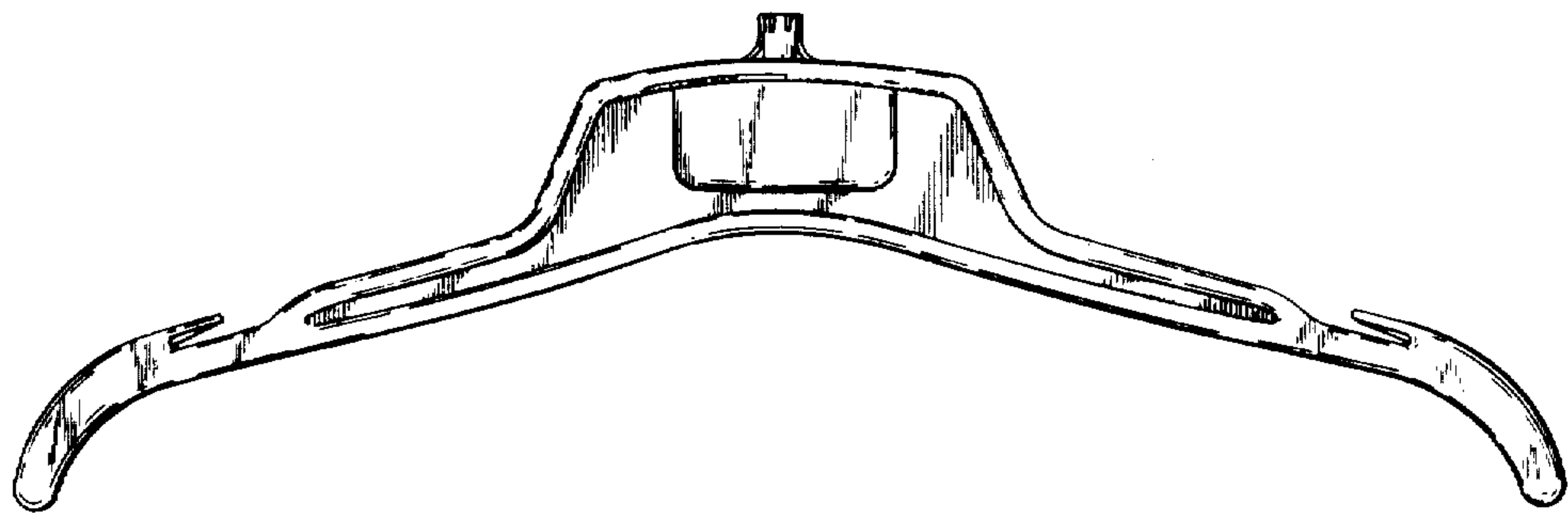
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[57] **CLAIM**

The rear is unornamented.



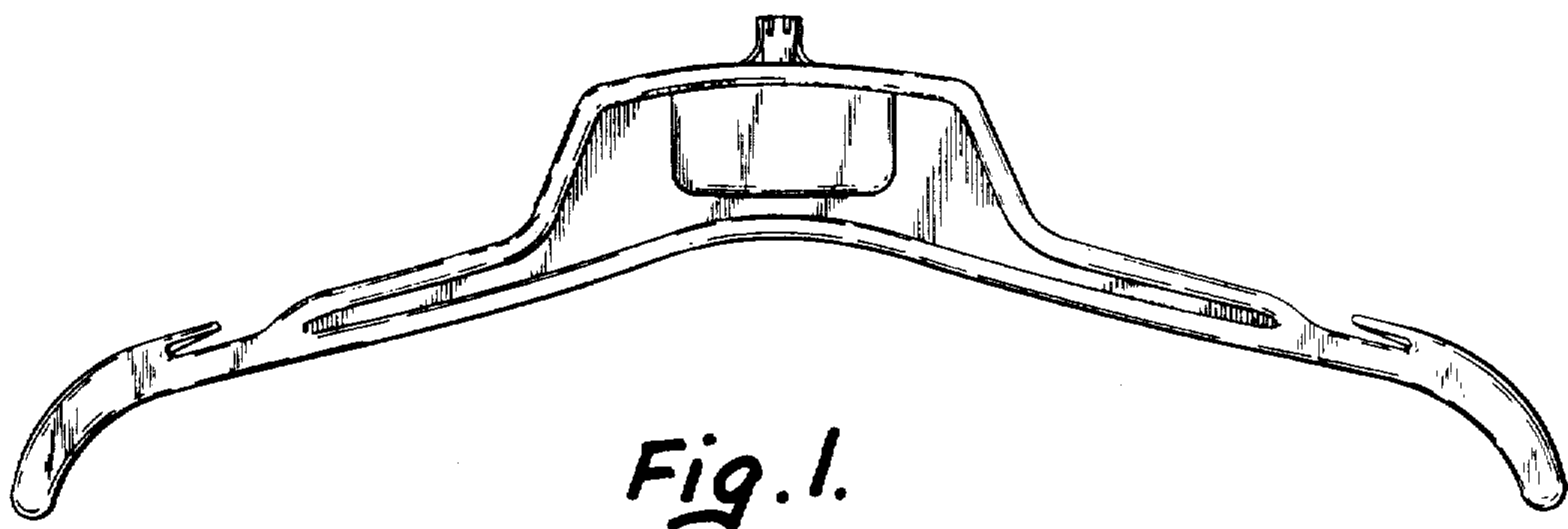

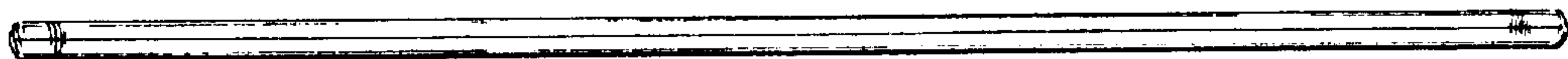
