FIG. 3 is a side elevation thereof.

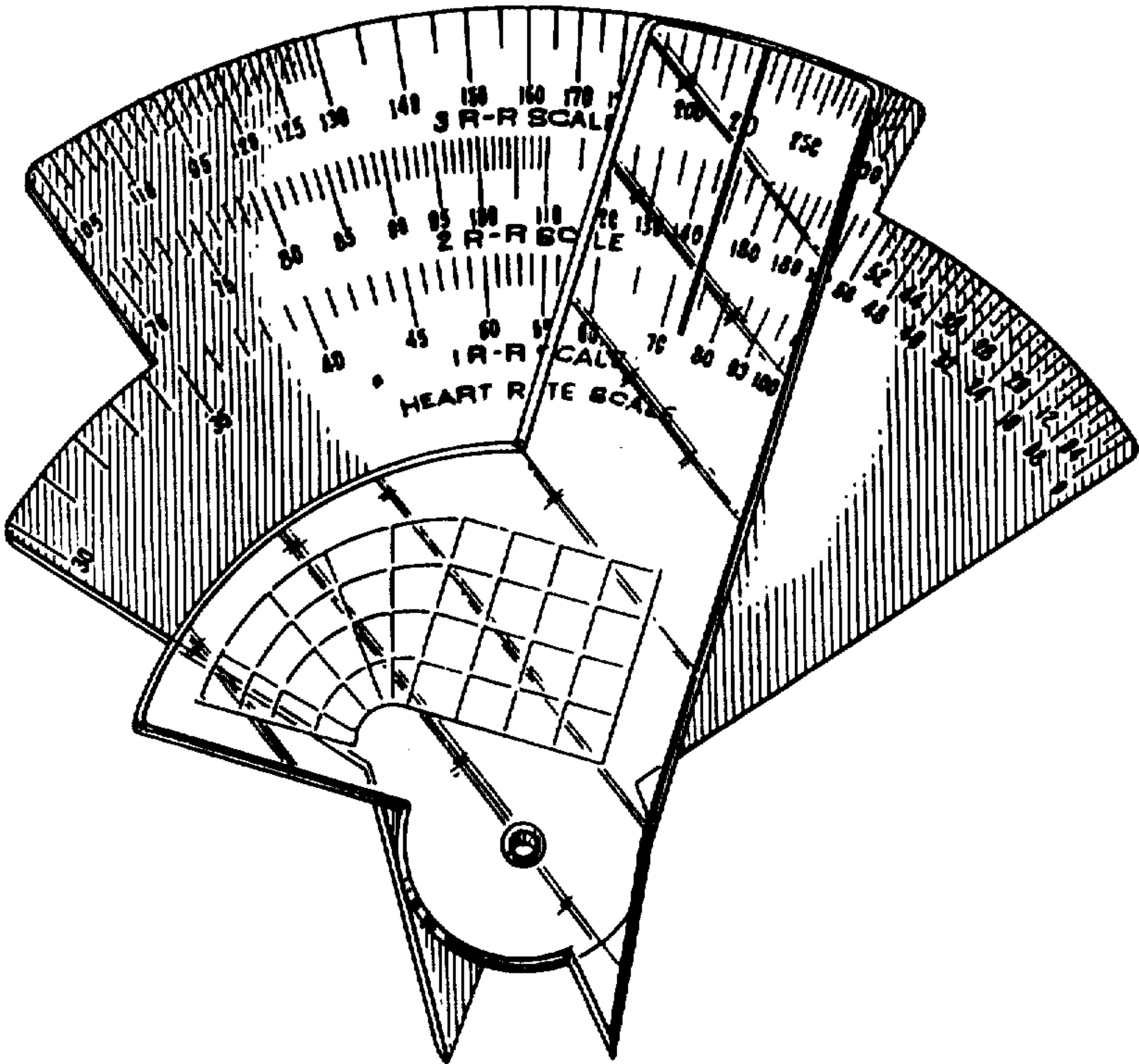

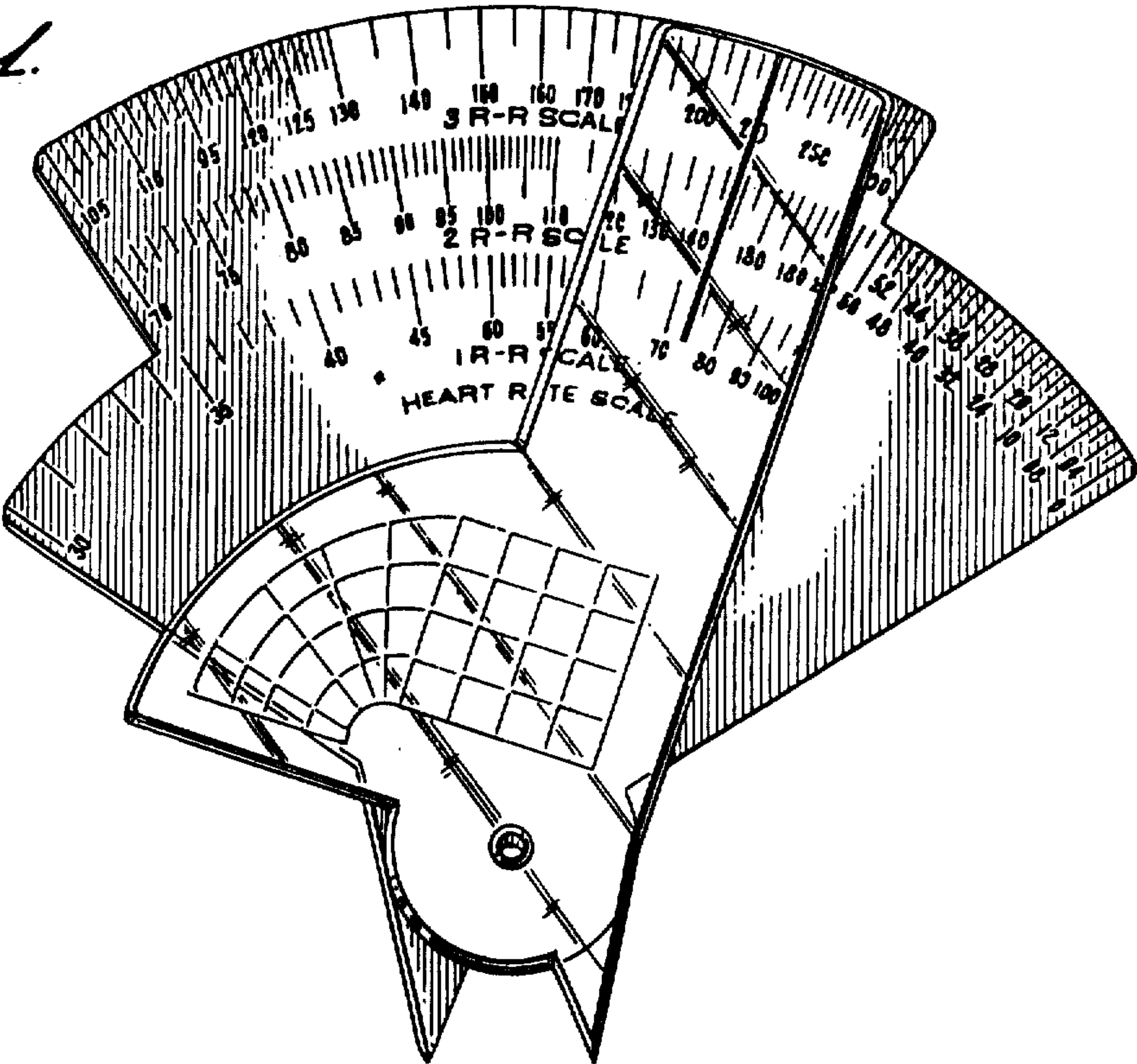

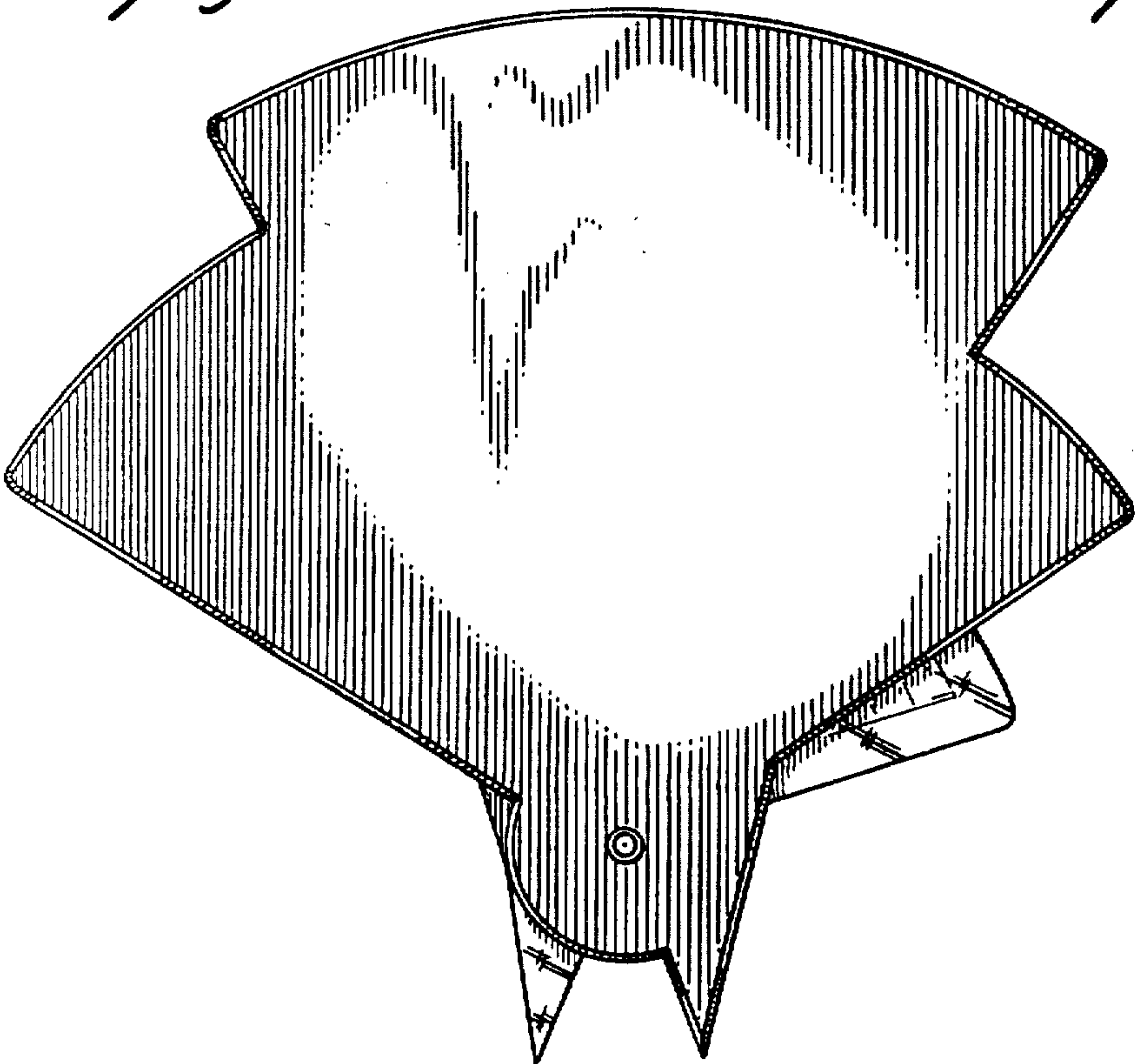
