FIG. 5 is an end elevational view thereof.

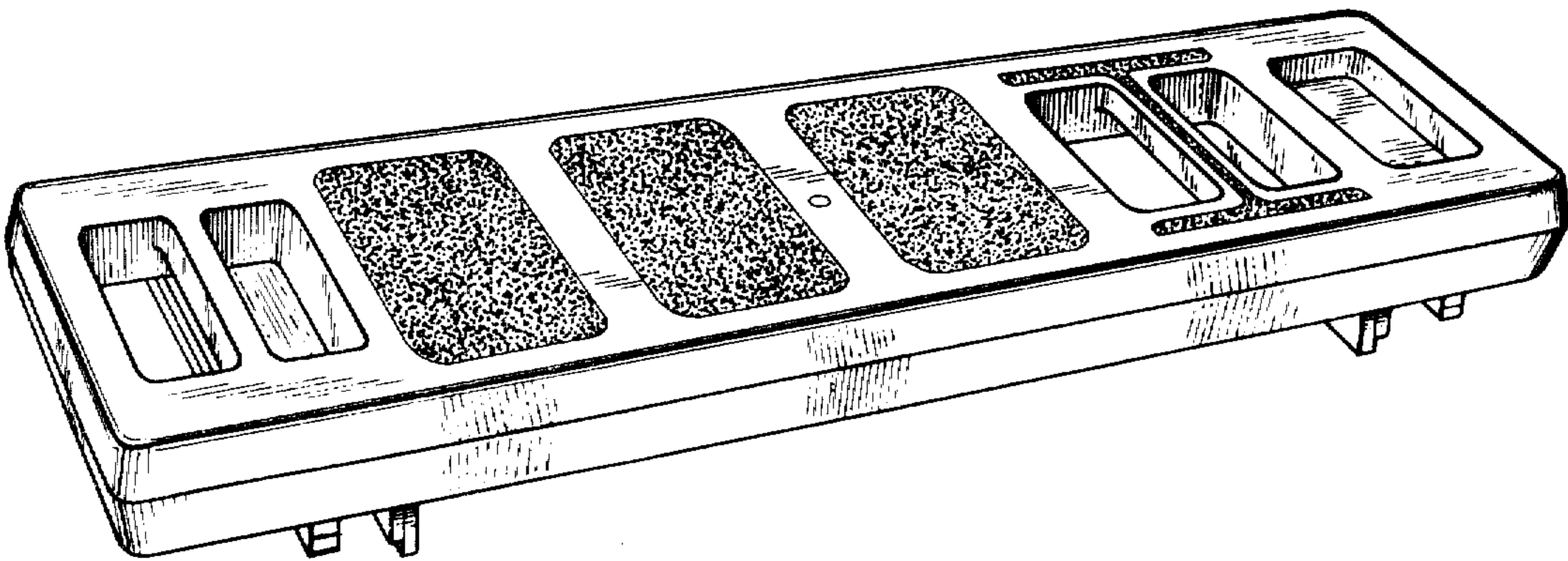

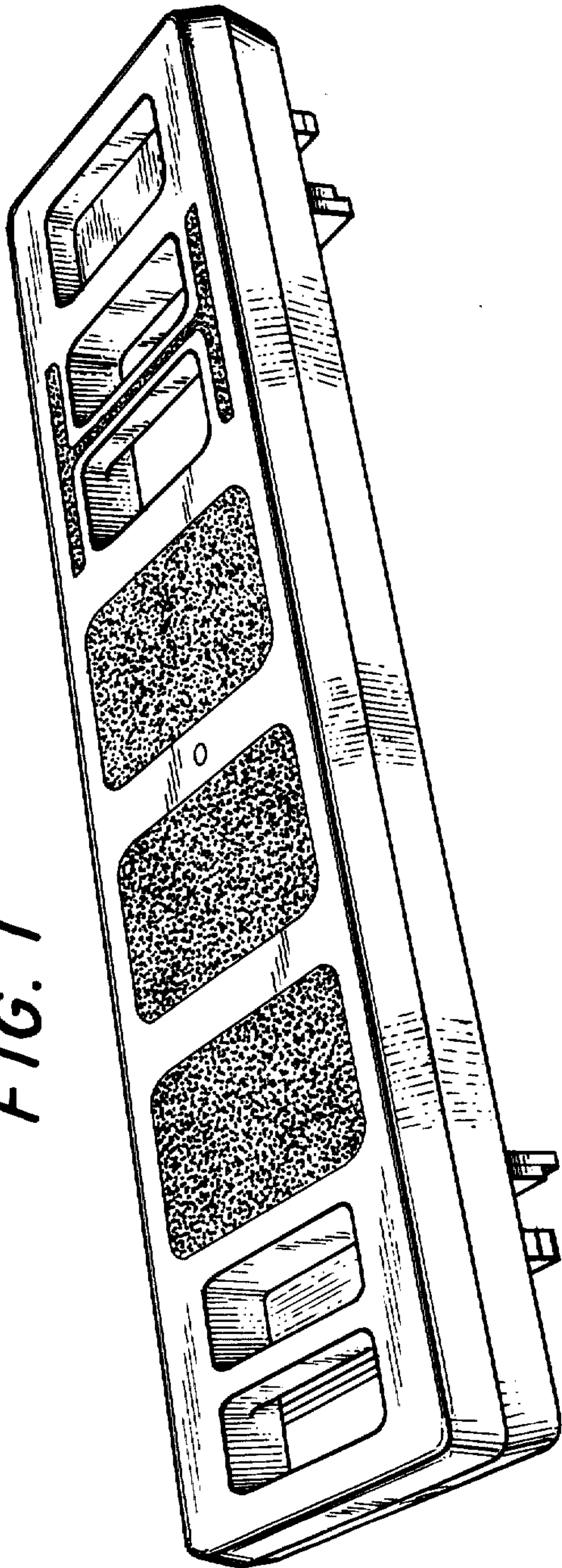

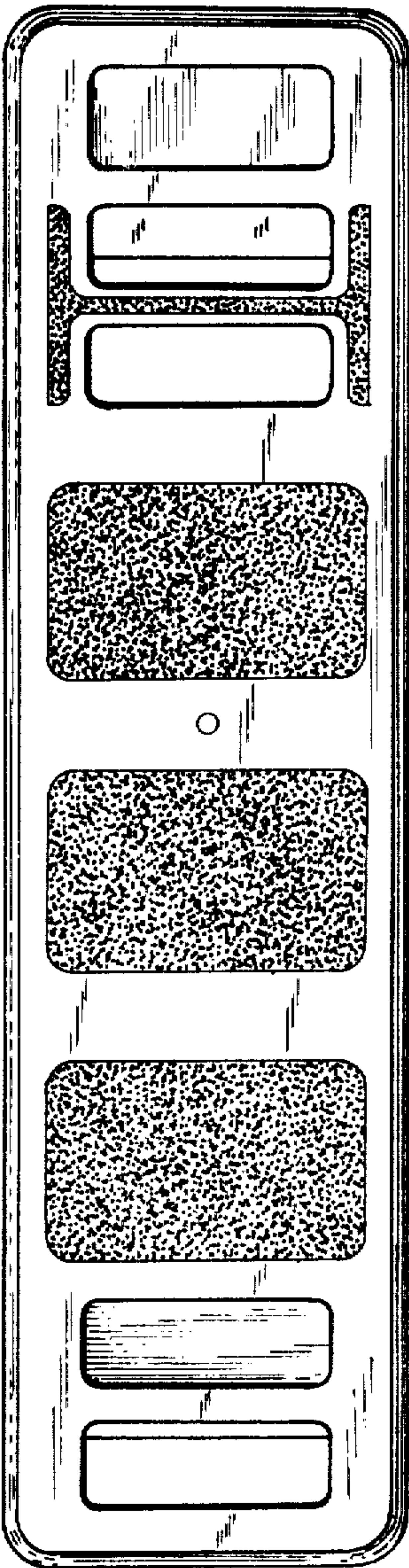

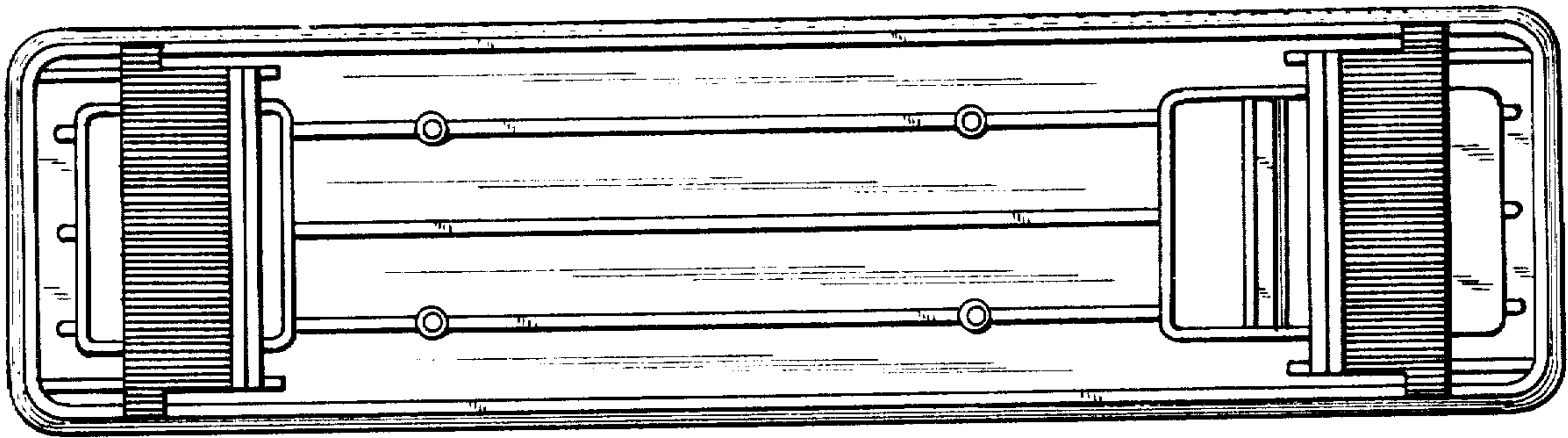

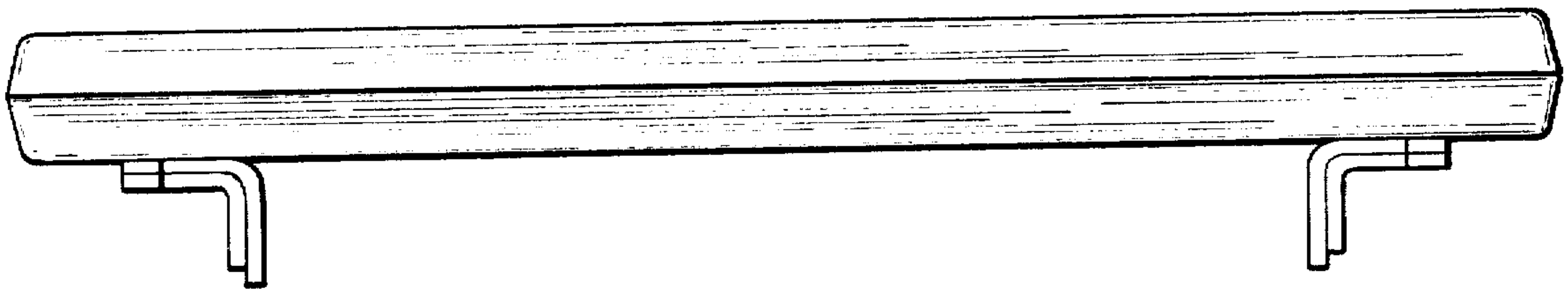
