DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top plan view of our design for a dental handpiece motor;
FIG. 2 is a front view along line 2—2 of FIG. 1;
FIG. 3 is a rear view along line 3—3 of FIG. 1;
FIG. 4 is a side view along line 4—4 of FIG. 3, the opposite side being essentially the same in appearance.
