DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a side elevational view of a fluorescent circular lamp adapter showing my new design, the opposite side being a mirror image;

FIG. 6 is a perspective view thereof.

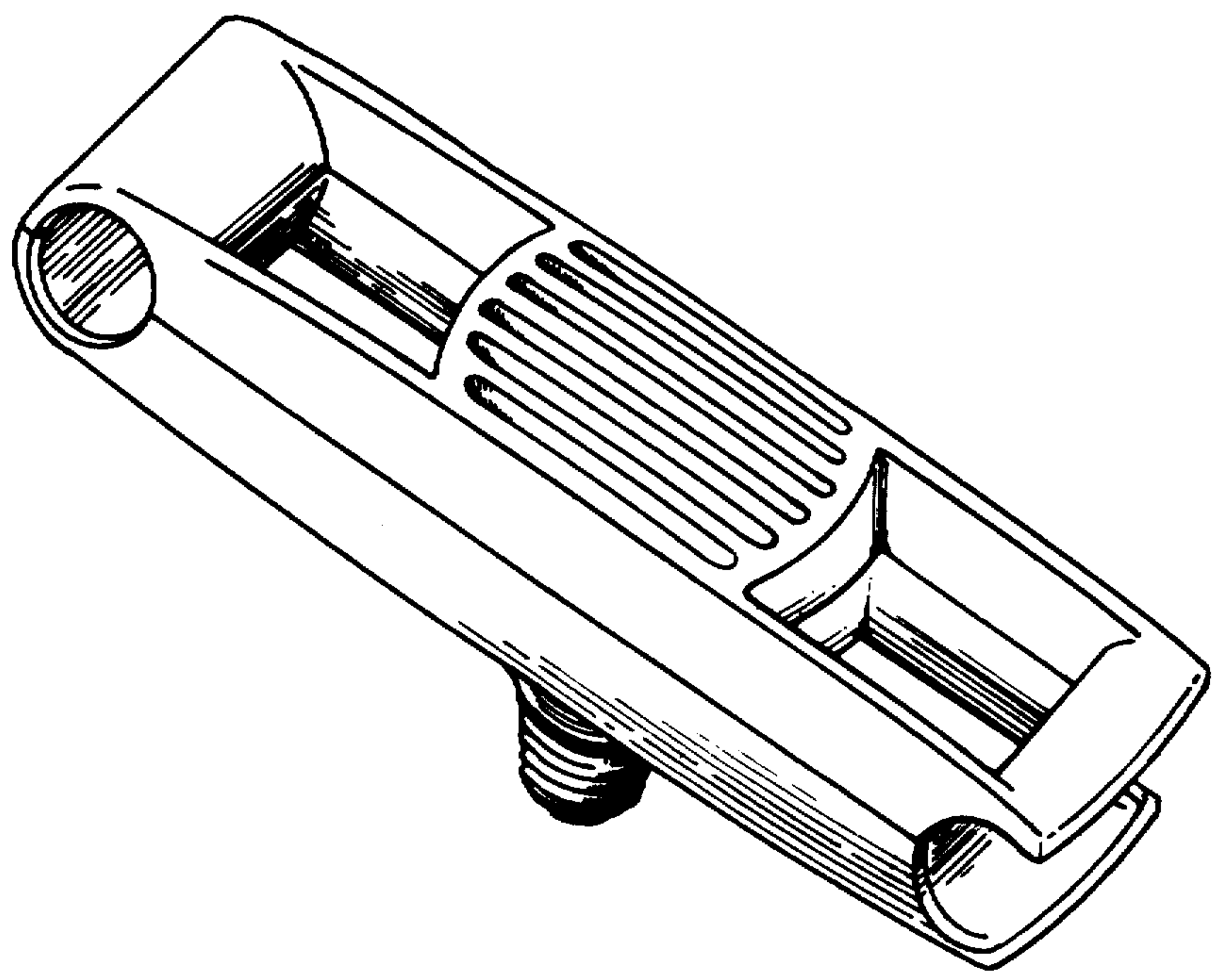

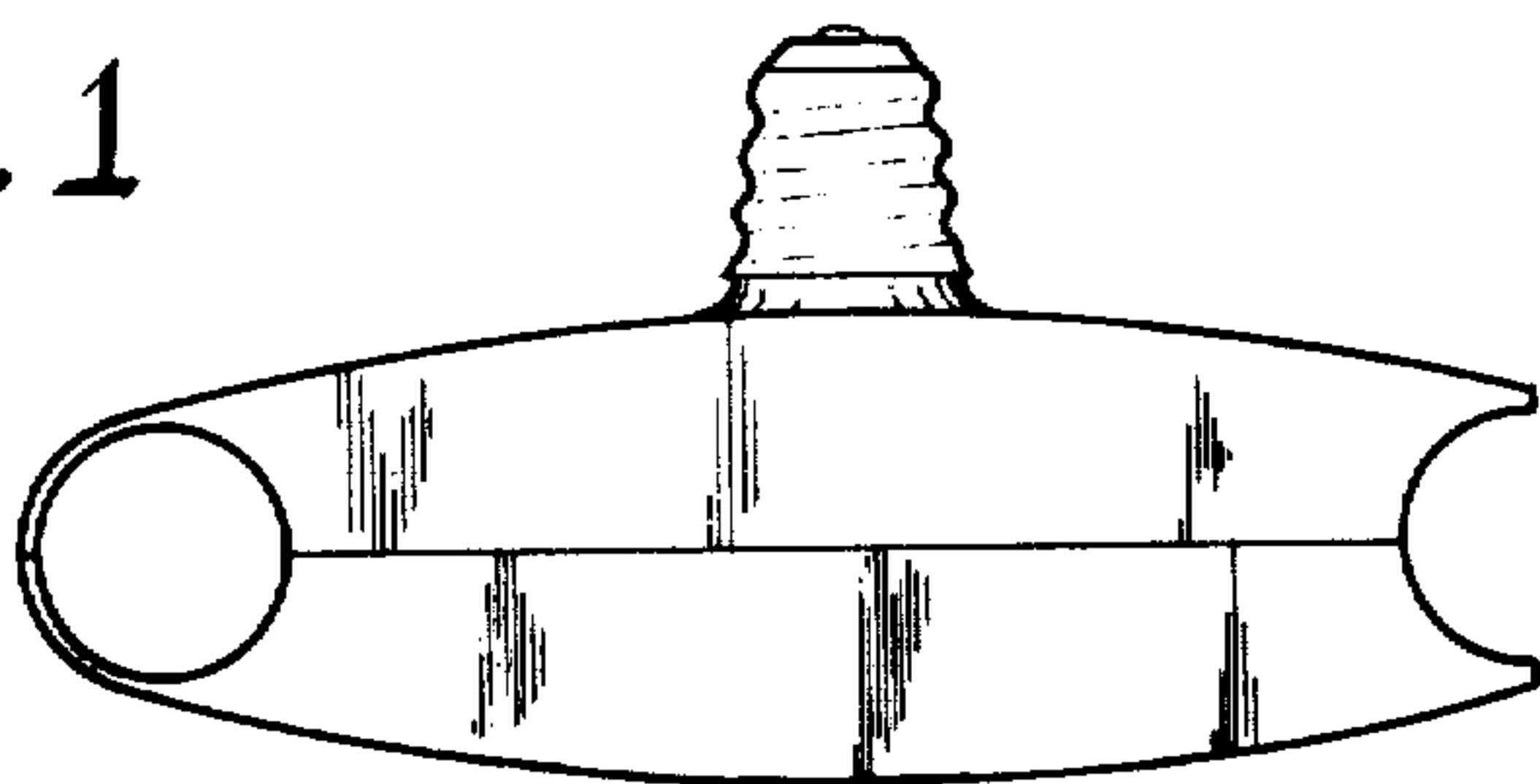

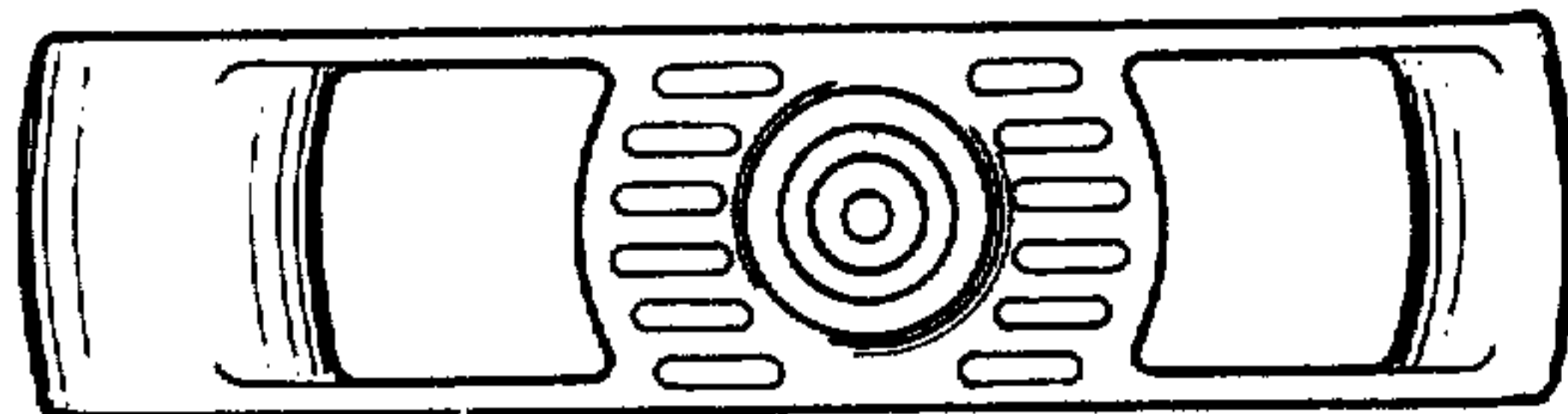

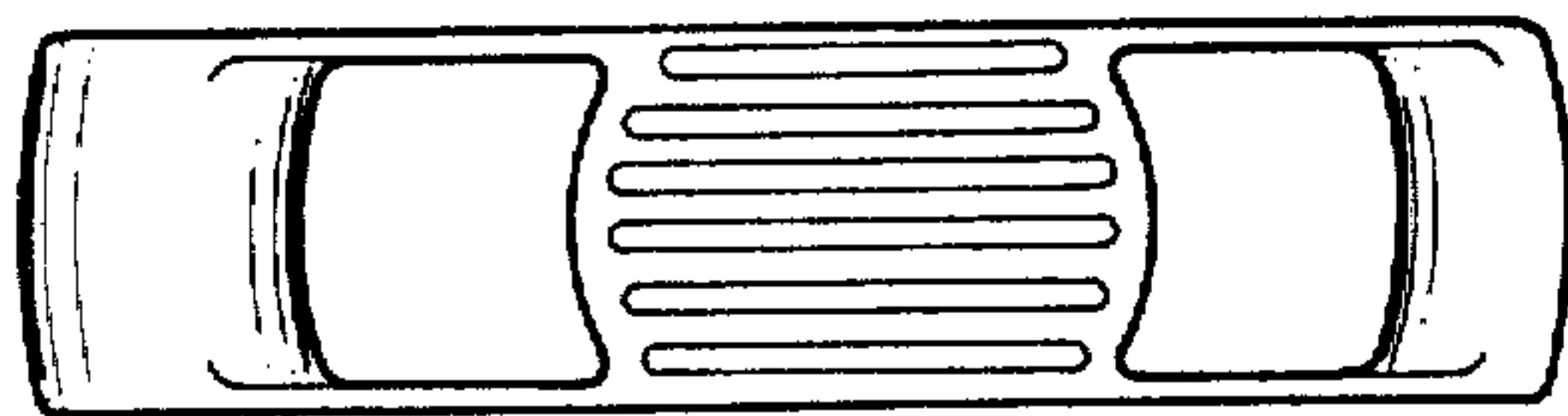

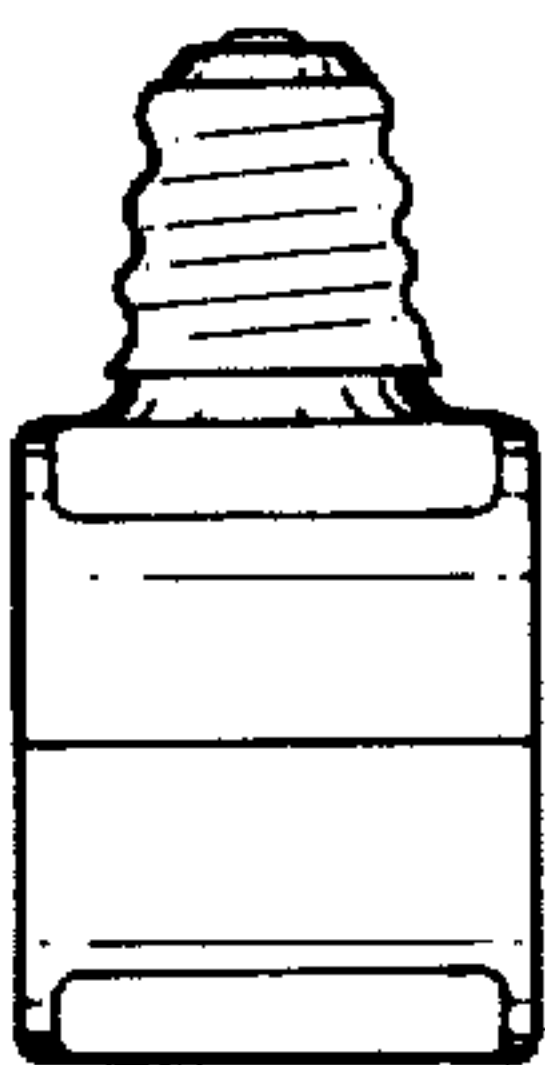

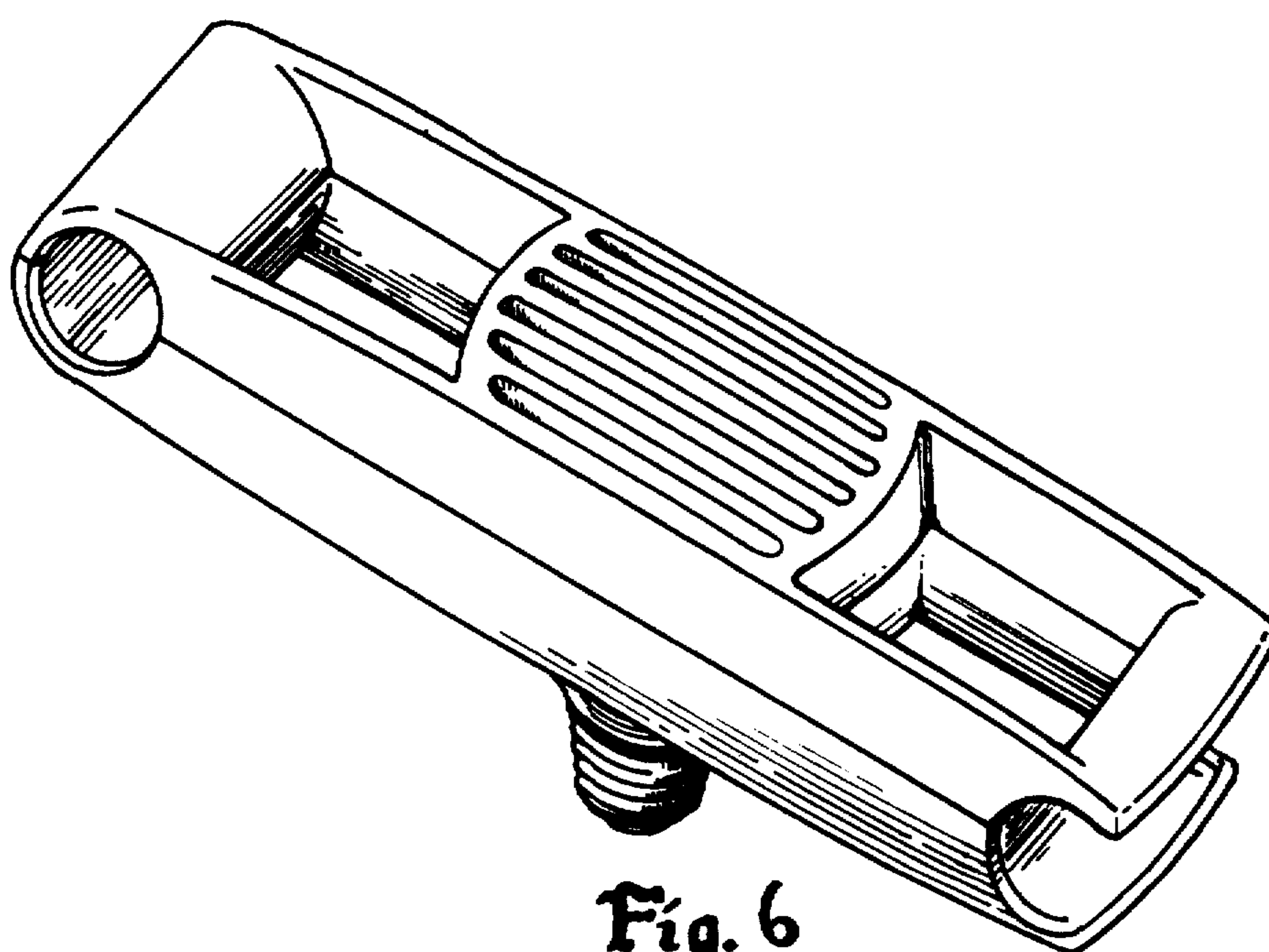
