The ornamental design for a treatment chair, as shown and described.

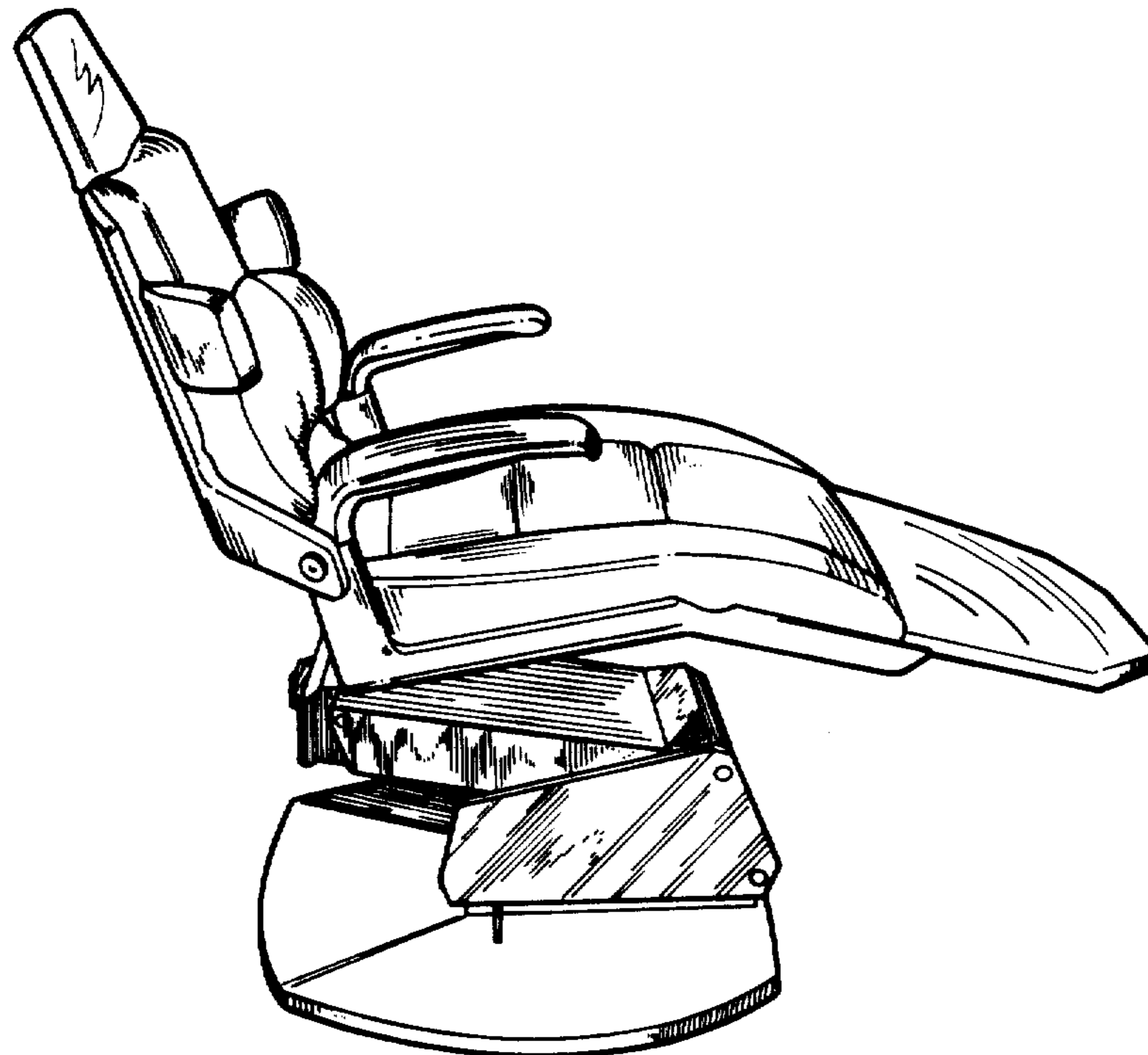
DESCRIPTION

The side of the chair not shown is substantially a mirror image of the side shown in FIG. 1.



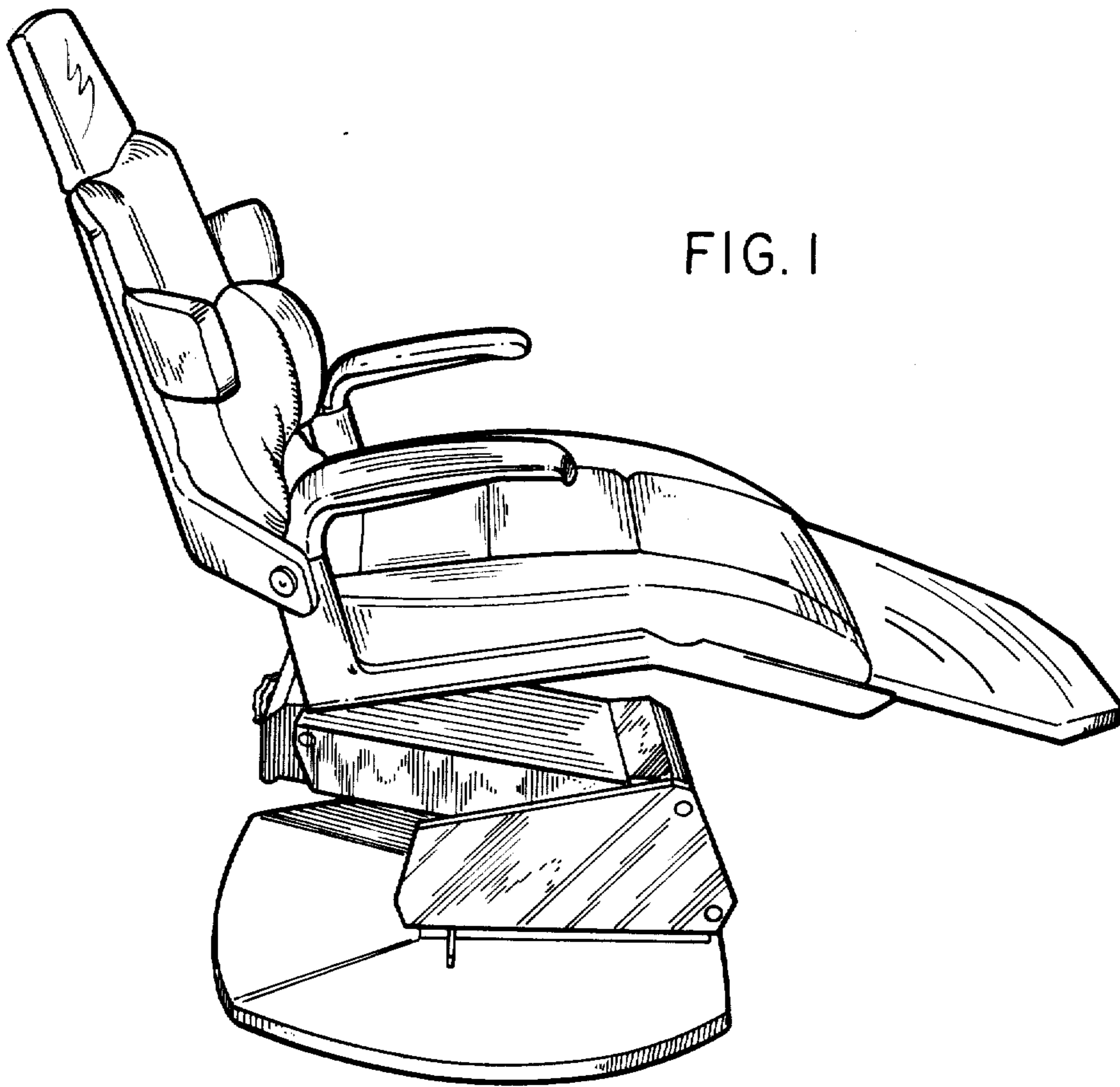

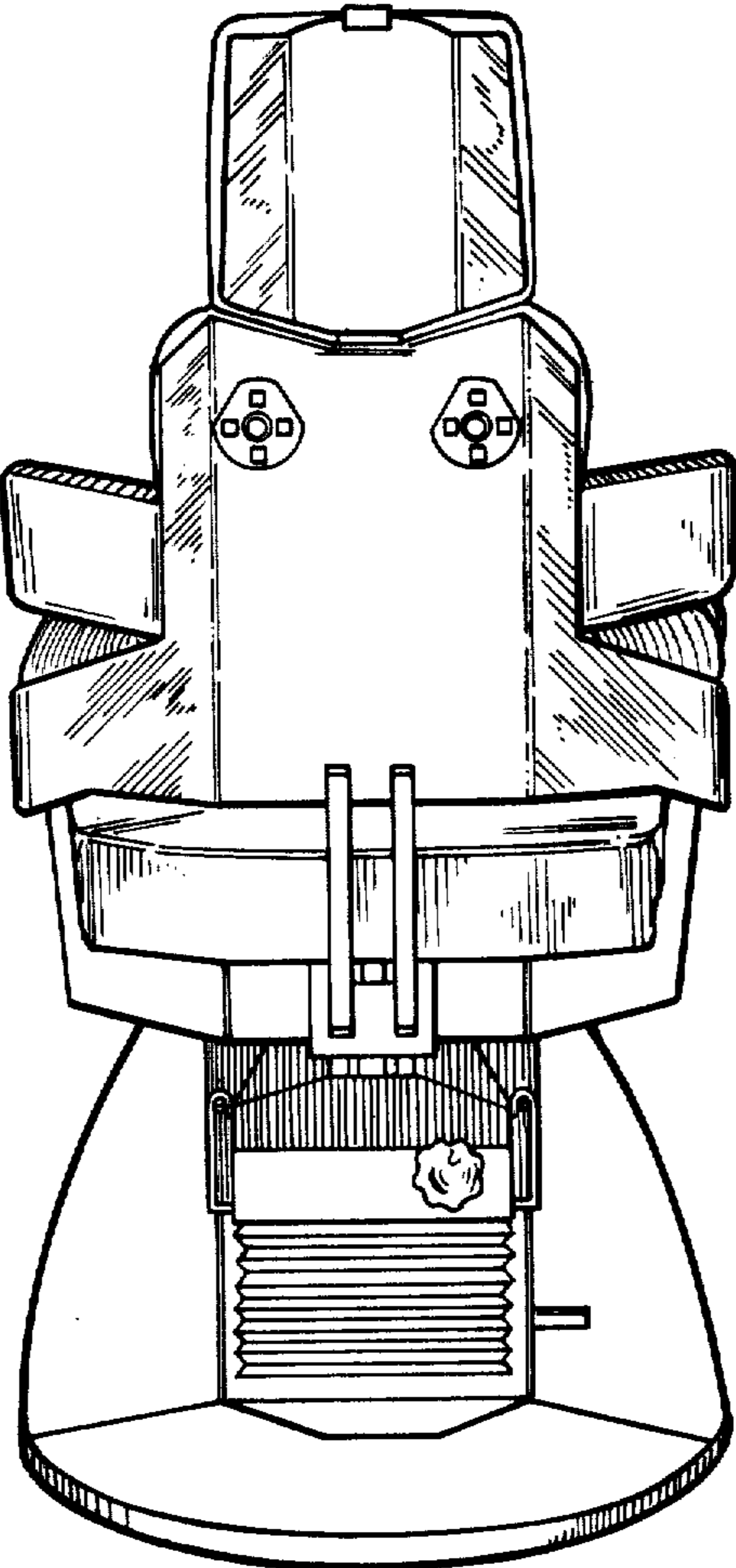

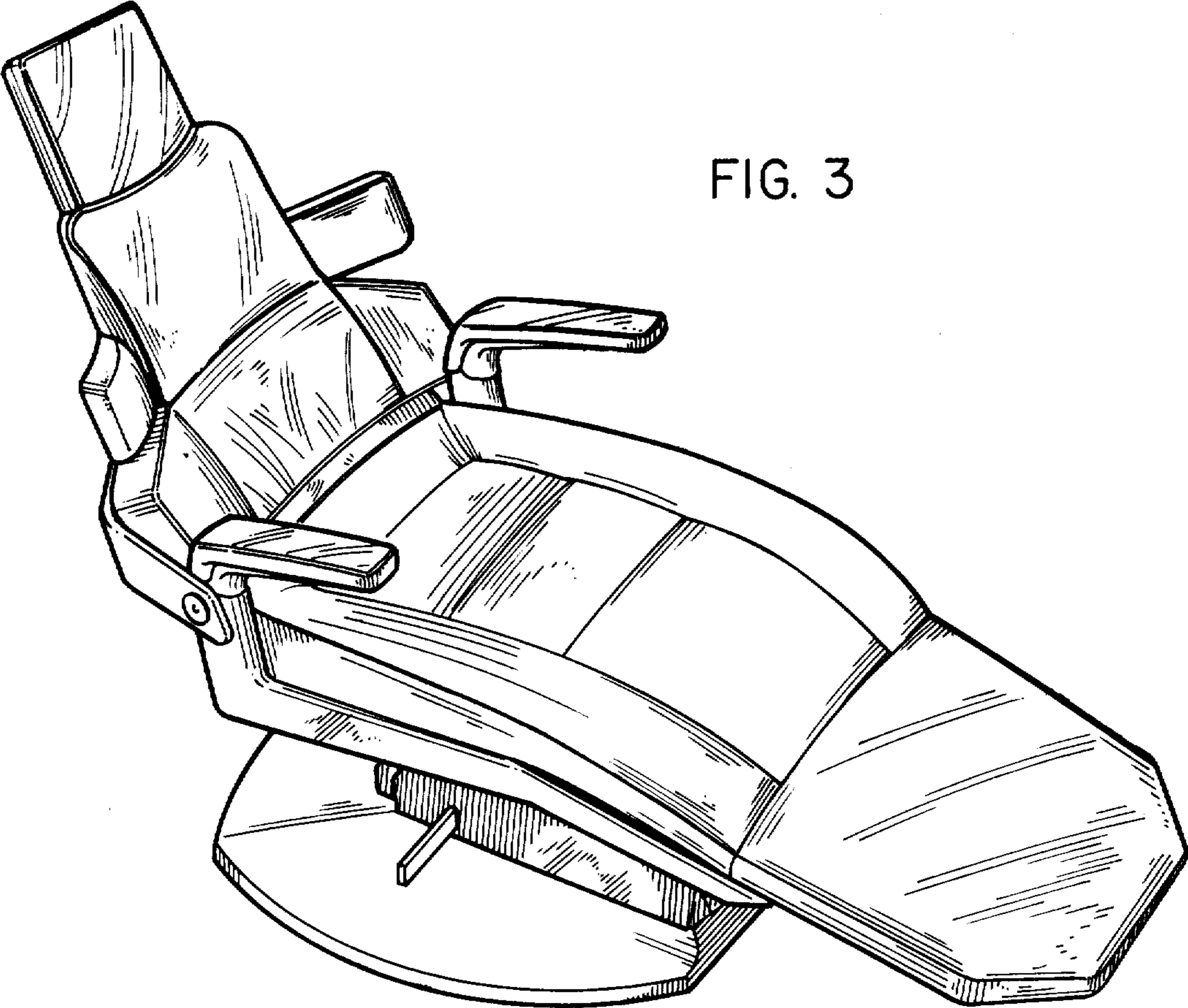
