[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a duck decoy with stabilizing sponsons and keel, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a duck decoy with stabilizing sponsons and keel, showing my new design; FIG. 2 is an elevational view of one side, the opposite side being a mirror image thereof; FIG. 3 is a top plan view; FIG. 4 is a bottom plan view; FIG. 5 is a front elevational view; and, FIG. 6 is a rear elevational view.

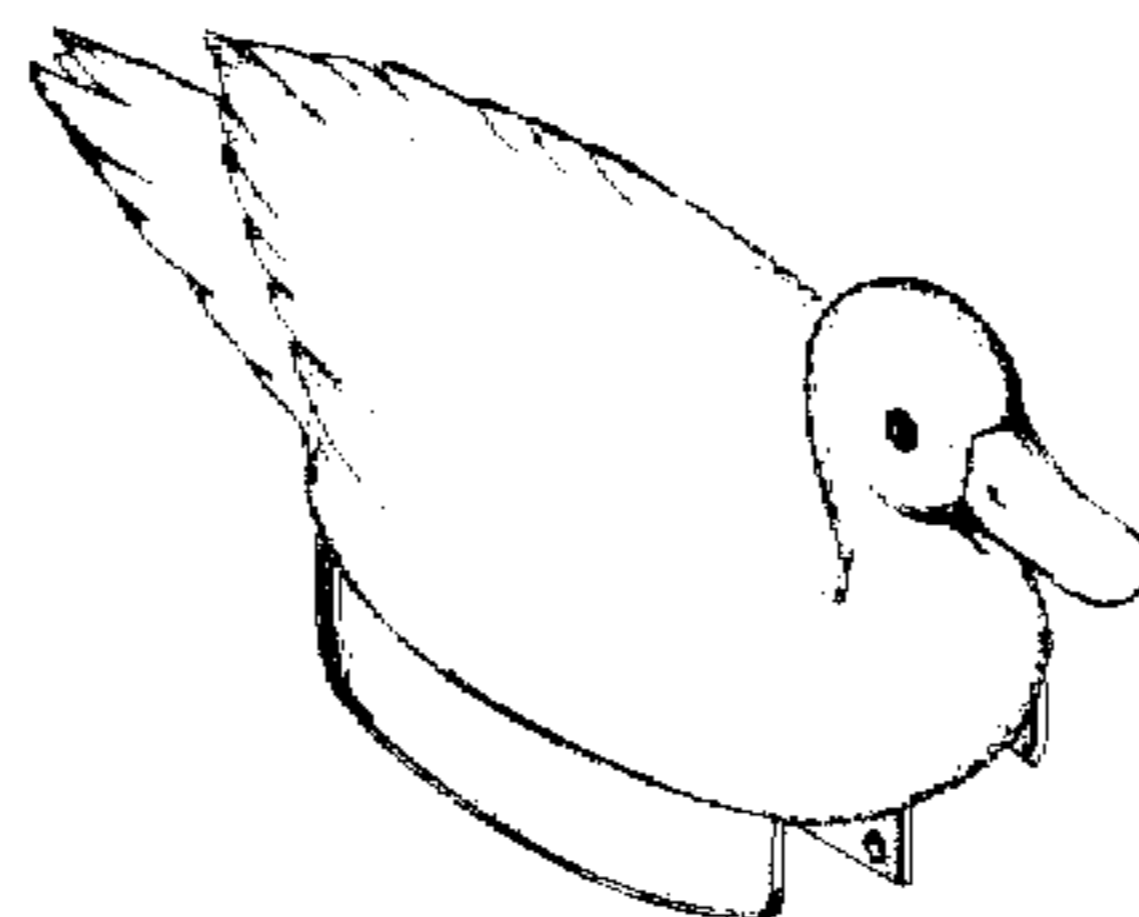

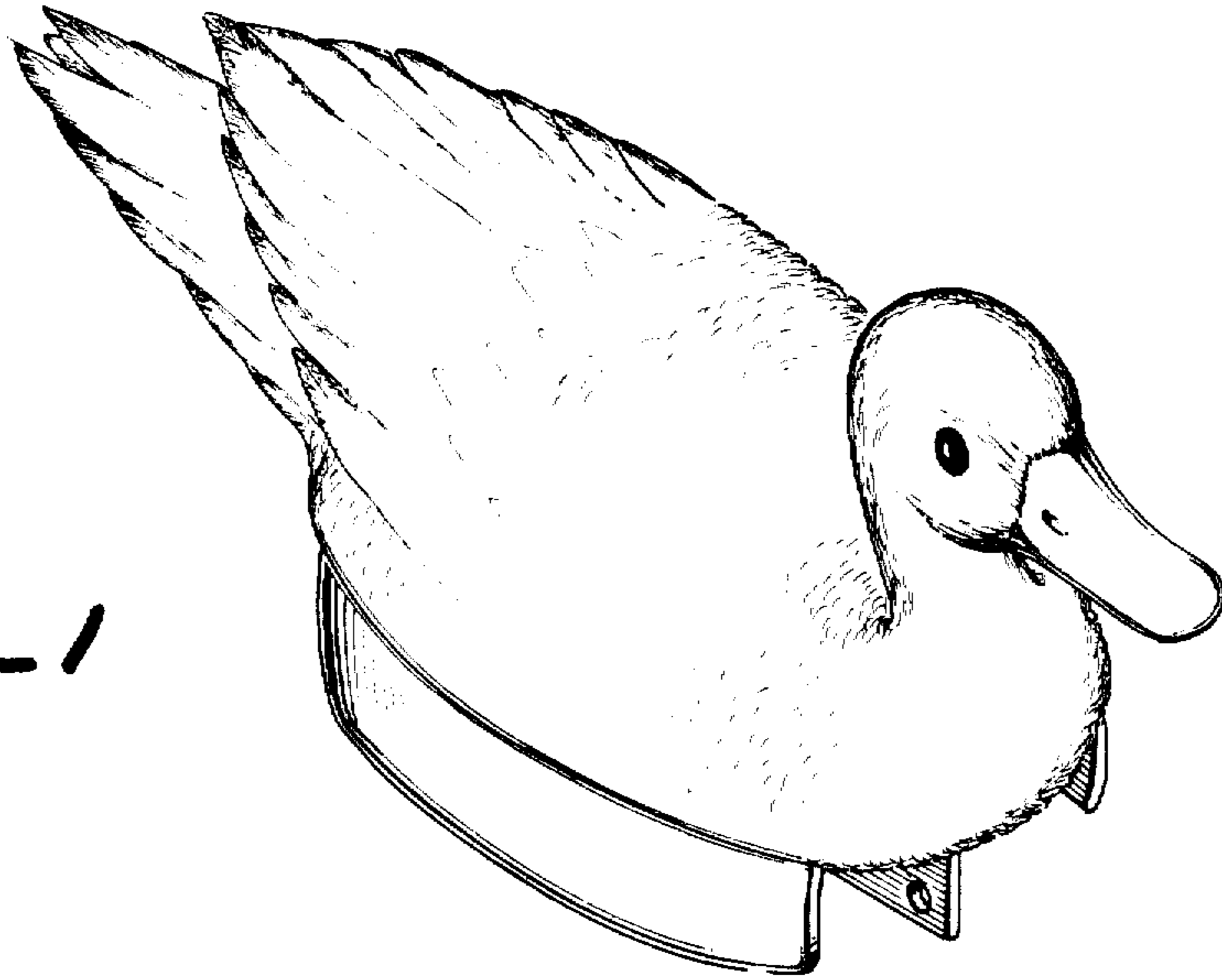

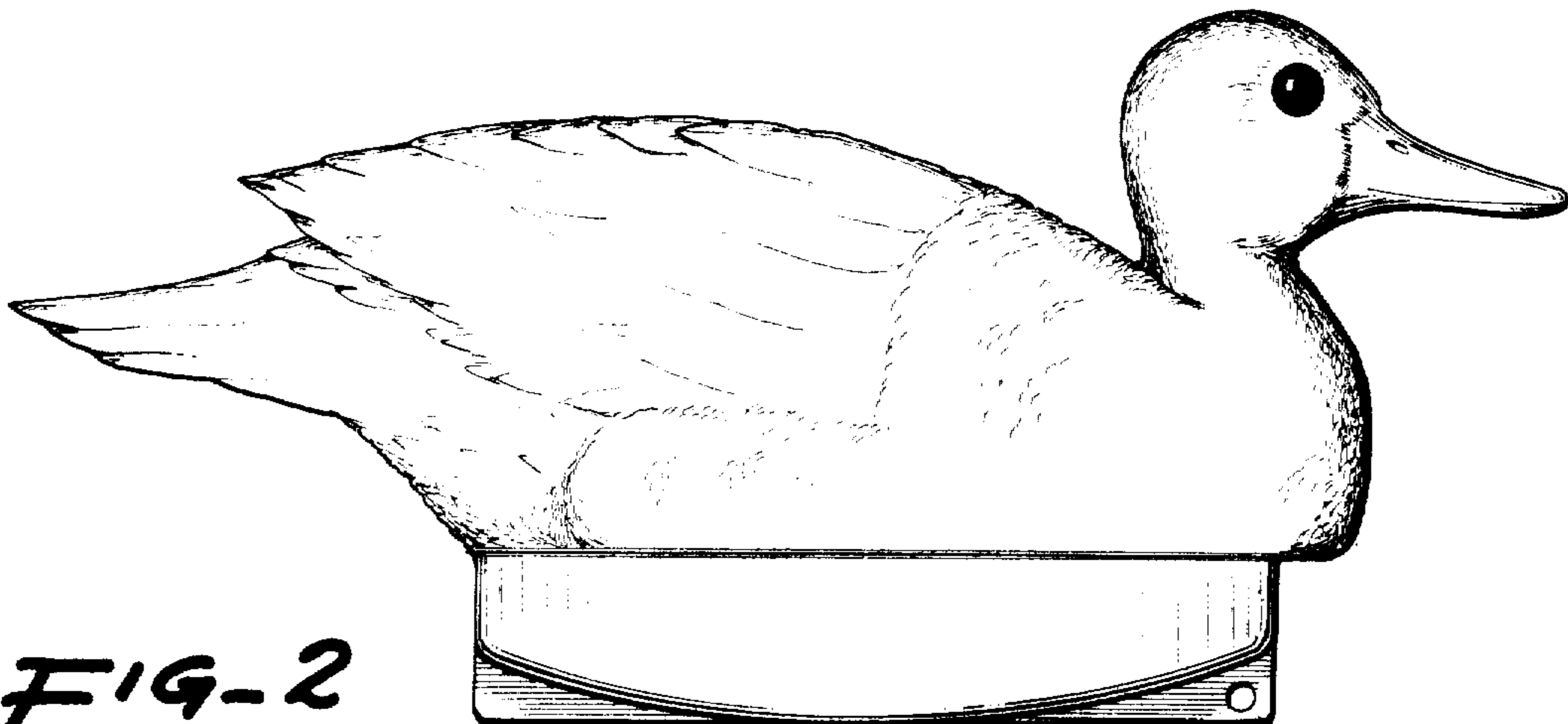

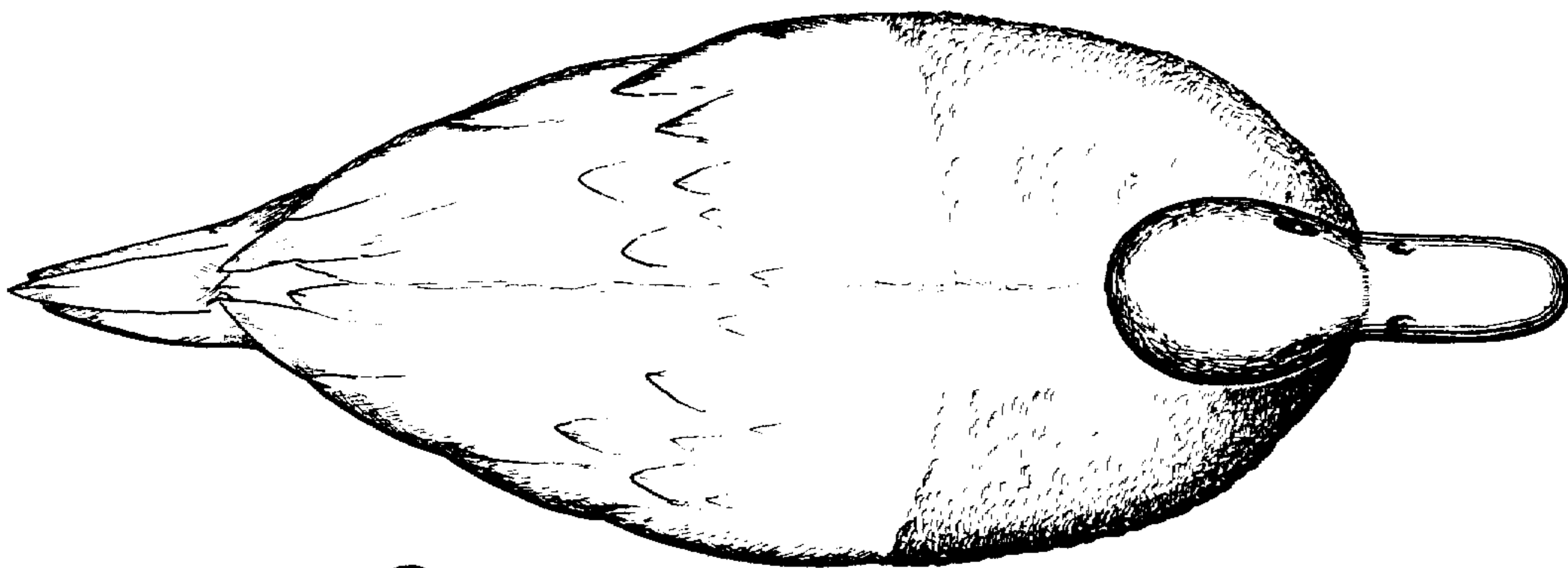

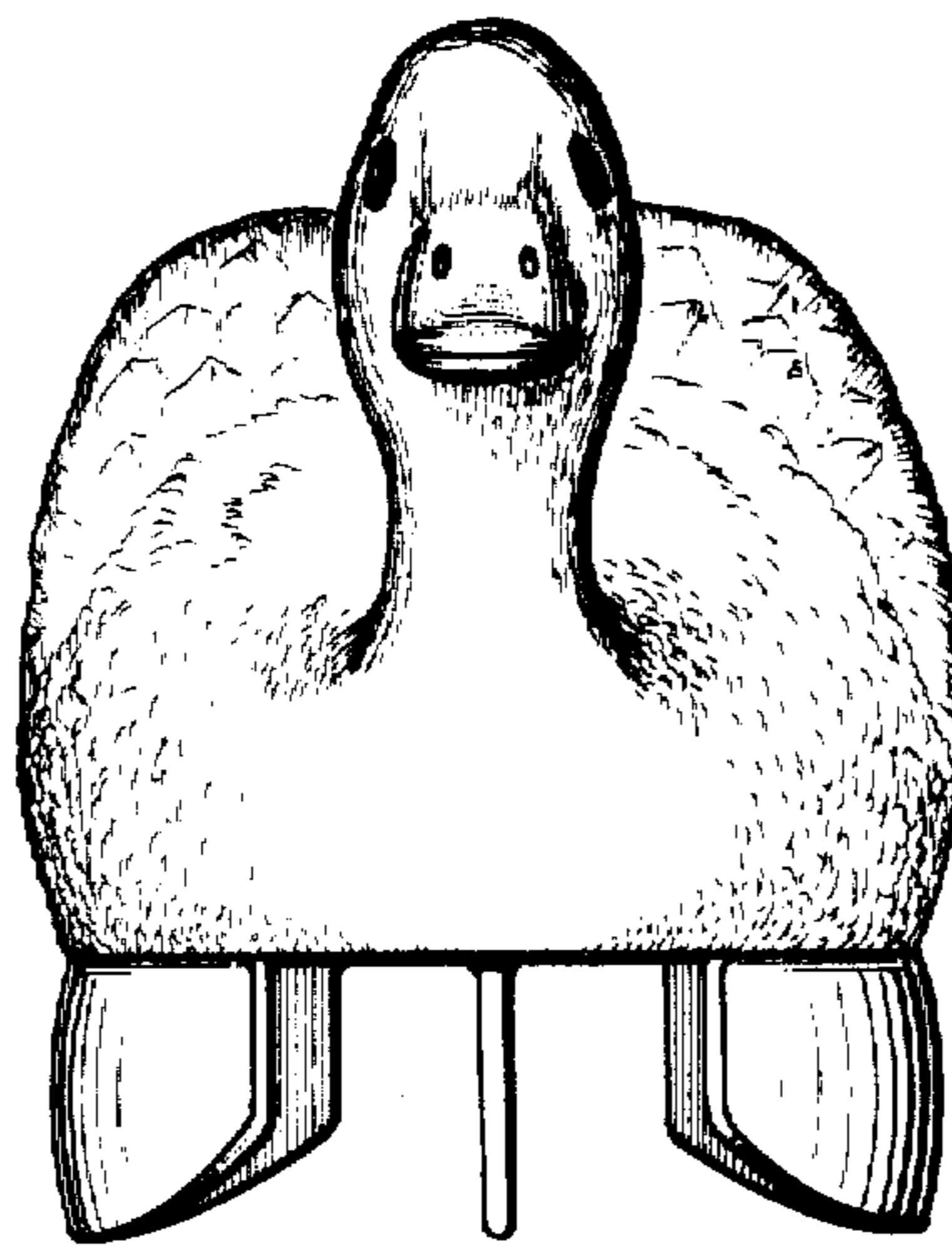
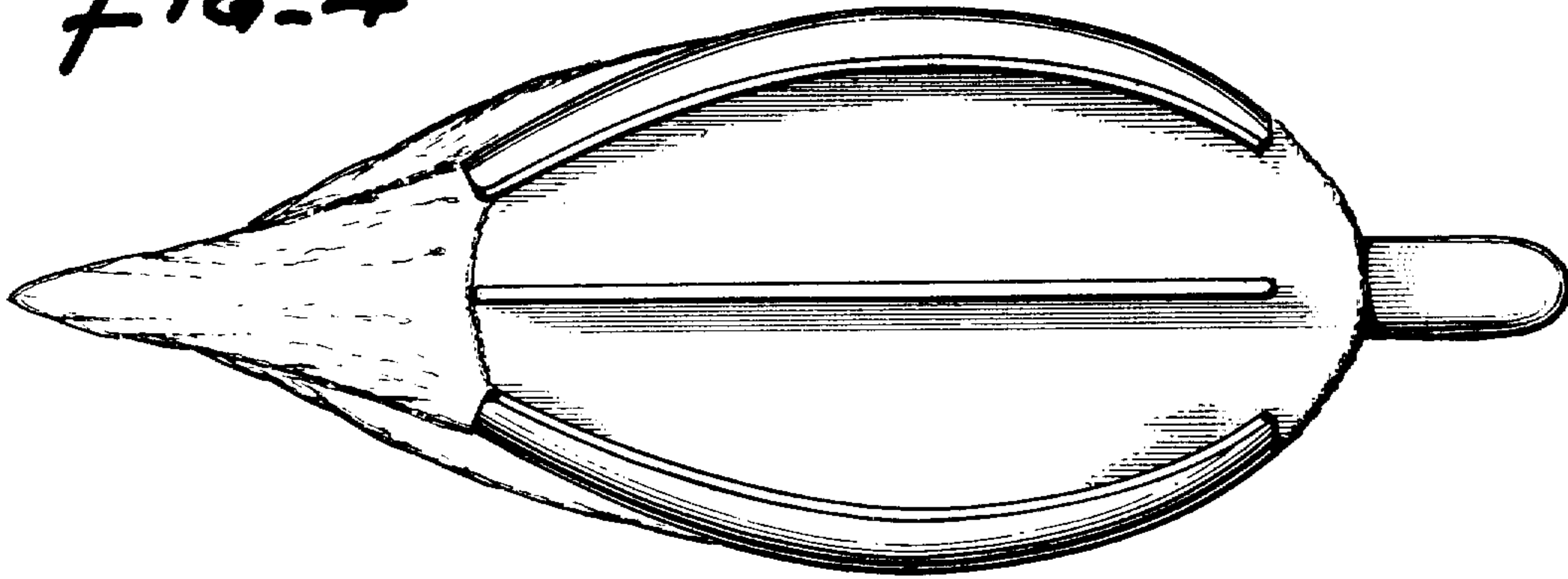
