The ornamental design for a tote tray, as shown and described.

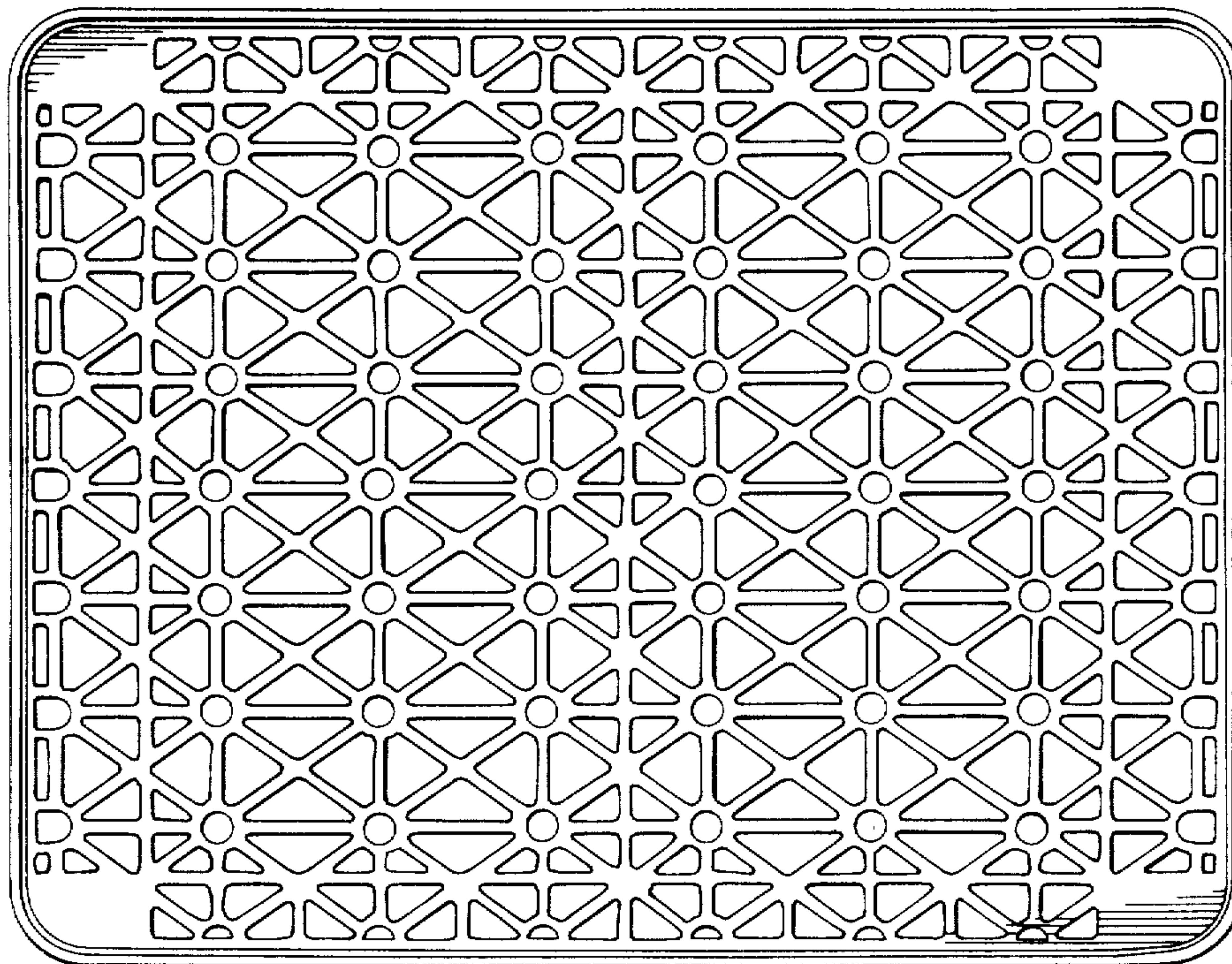
DESCRIPTION

FIG. 4 is an end elevation view thereof, the opposite end being the same in appearance.



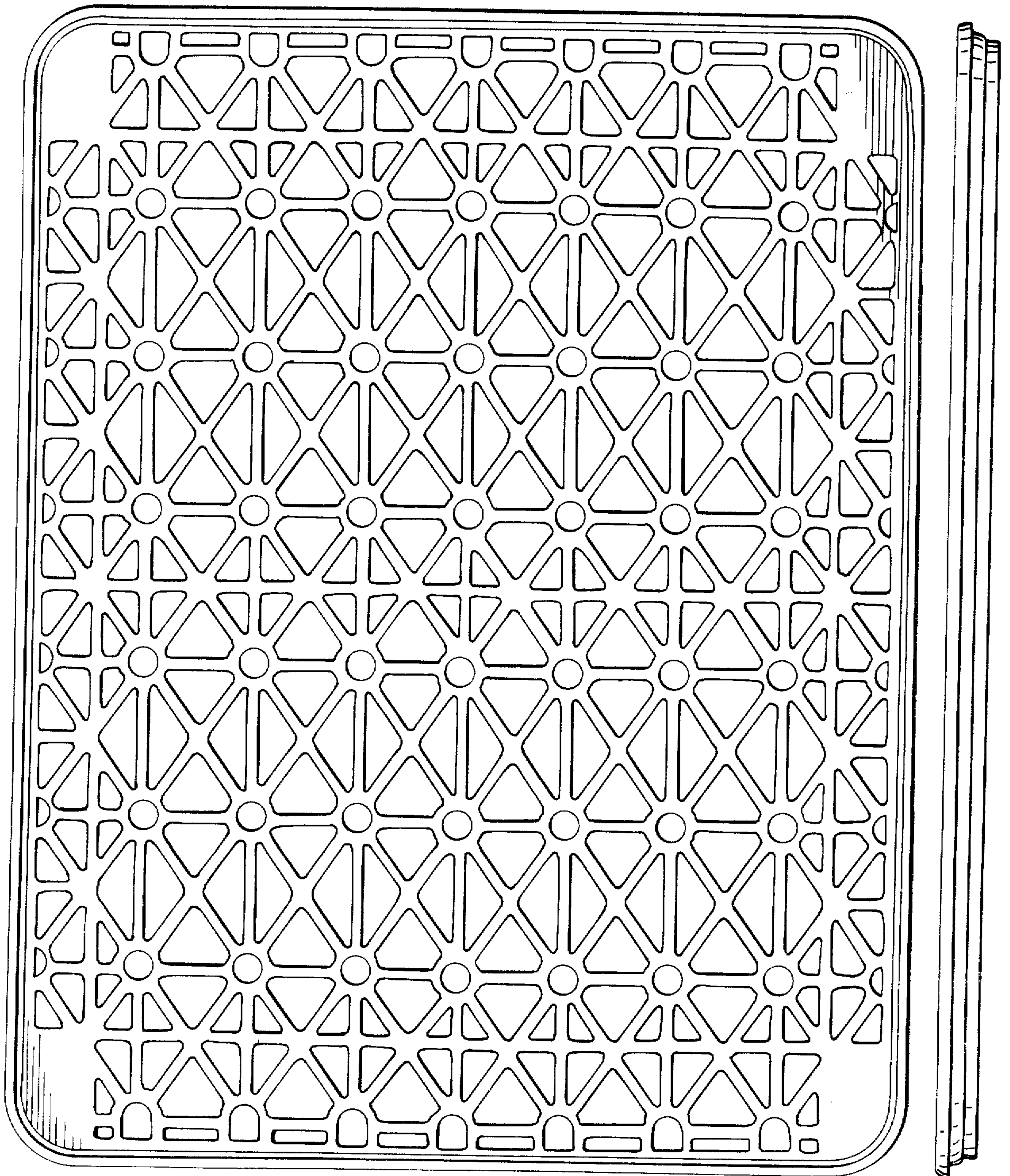

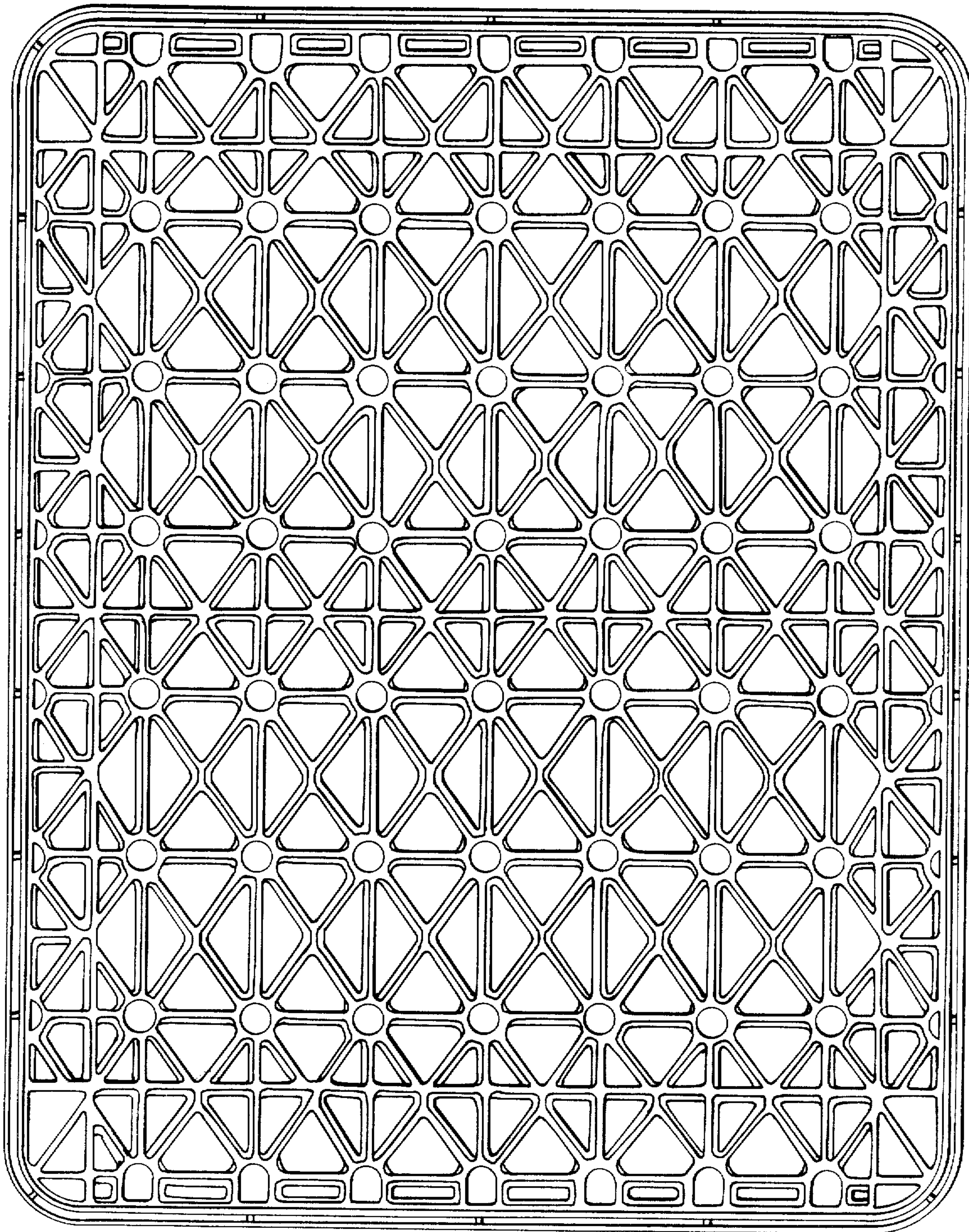

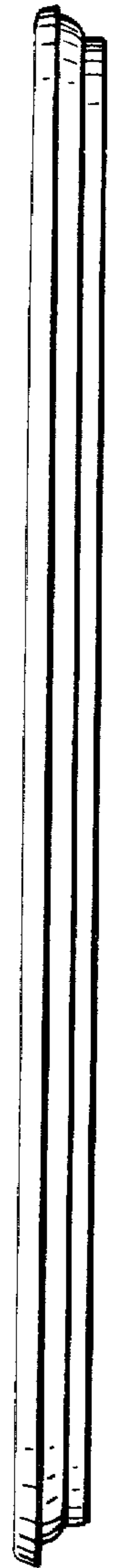
