FIG. 3 is a front elevational view thereof;

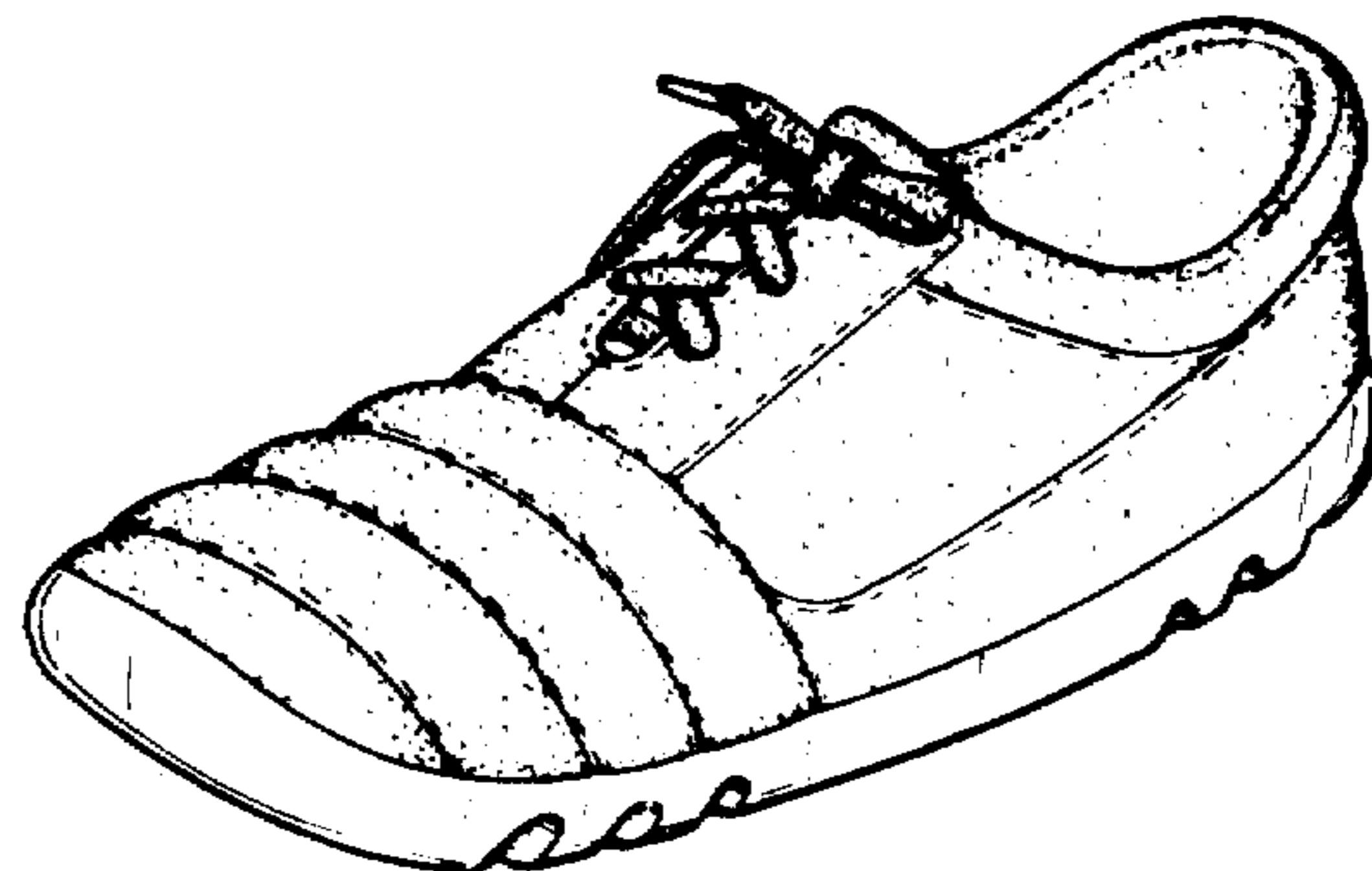
FIG. 4 is a rear elevational view thereof;

FIG. 8 is a right front perspective view thereof.



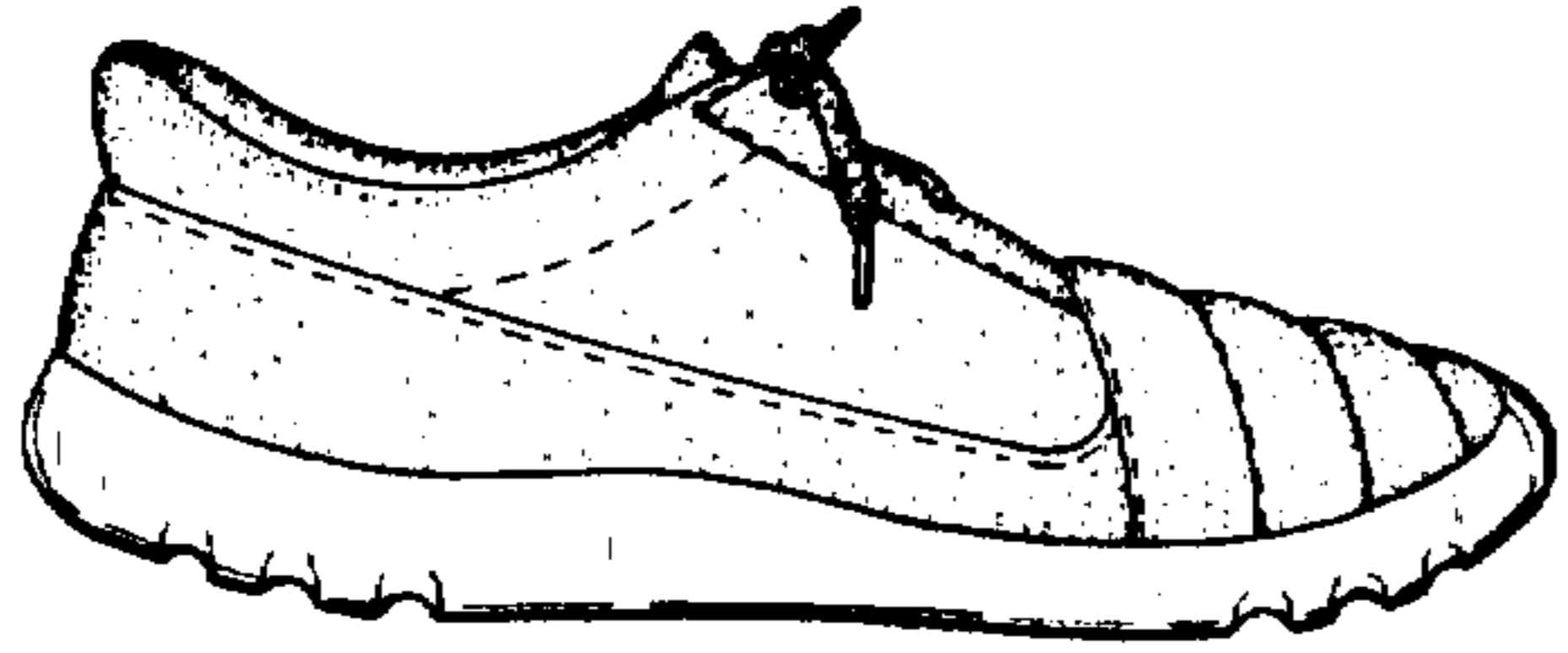

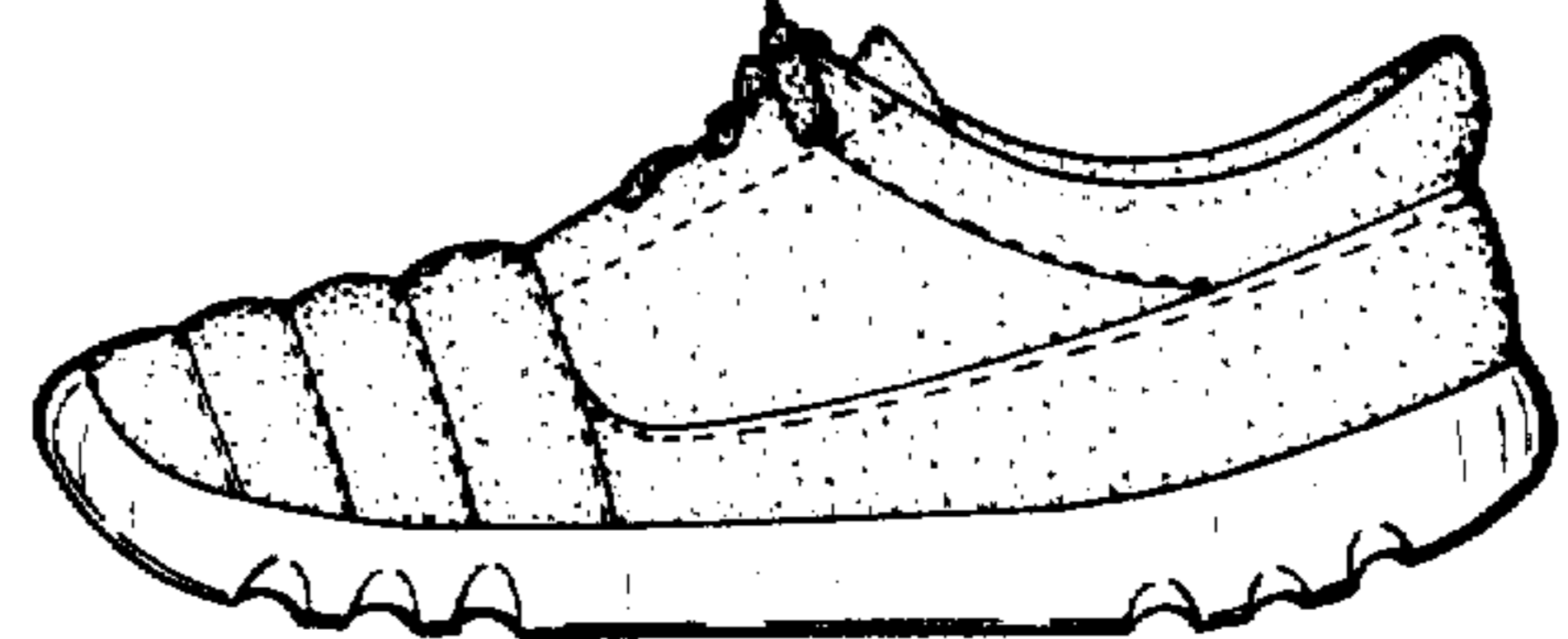

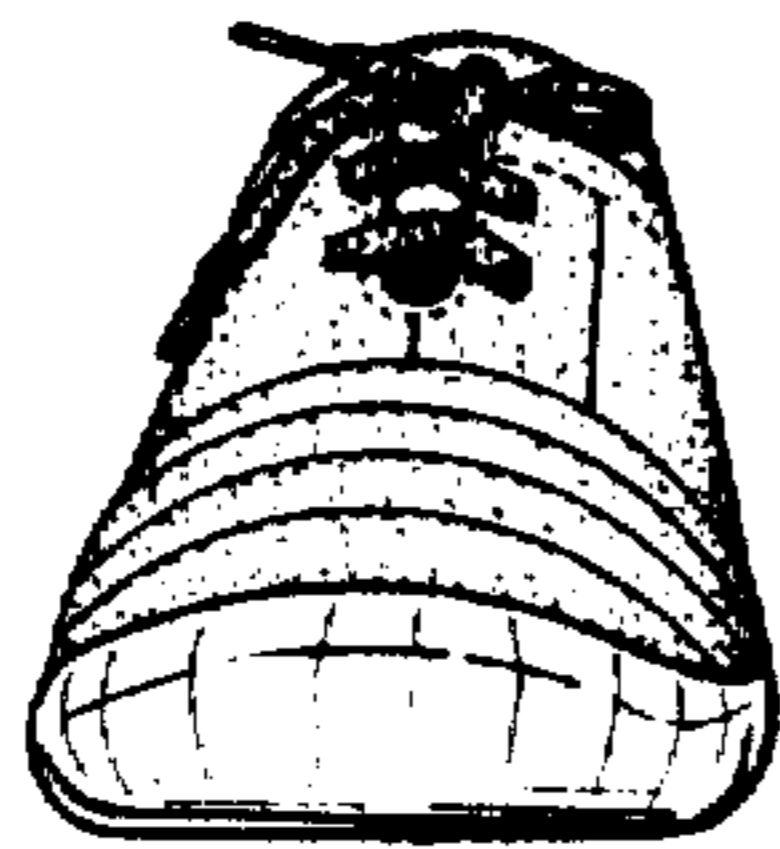

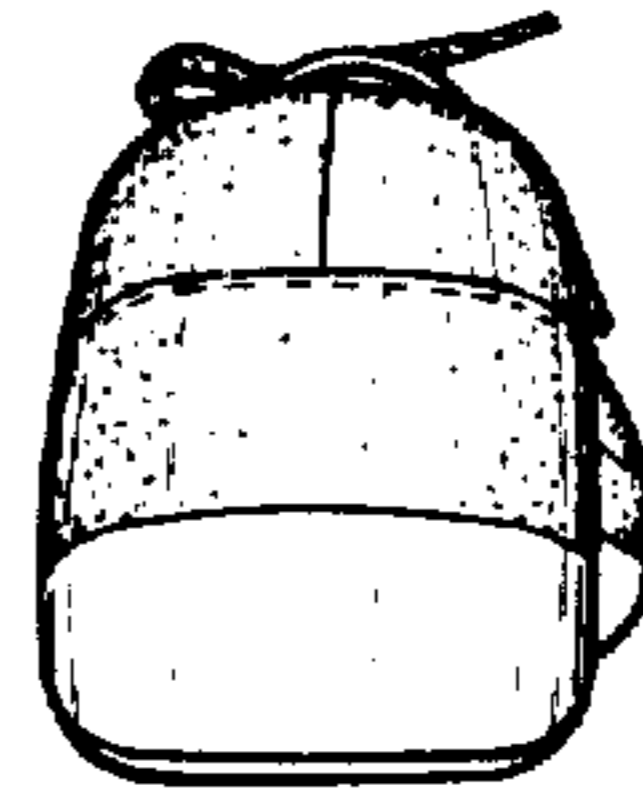

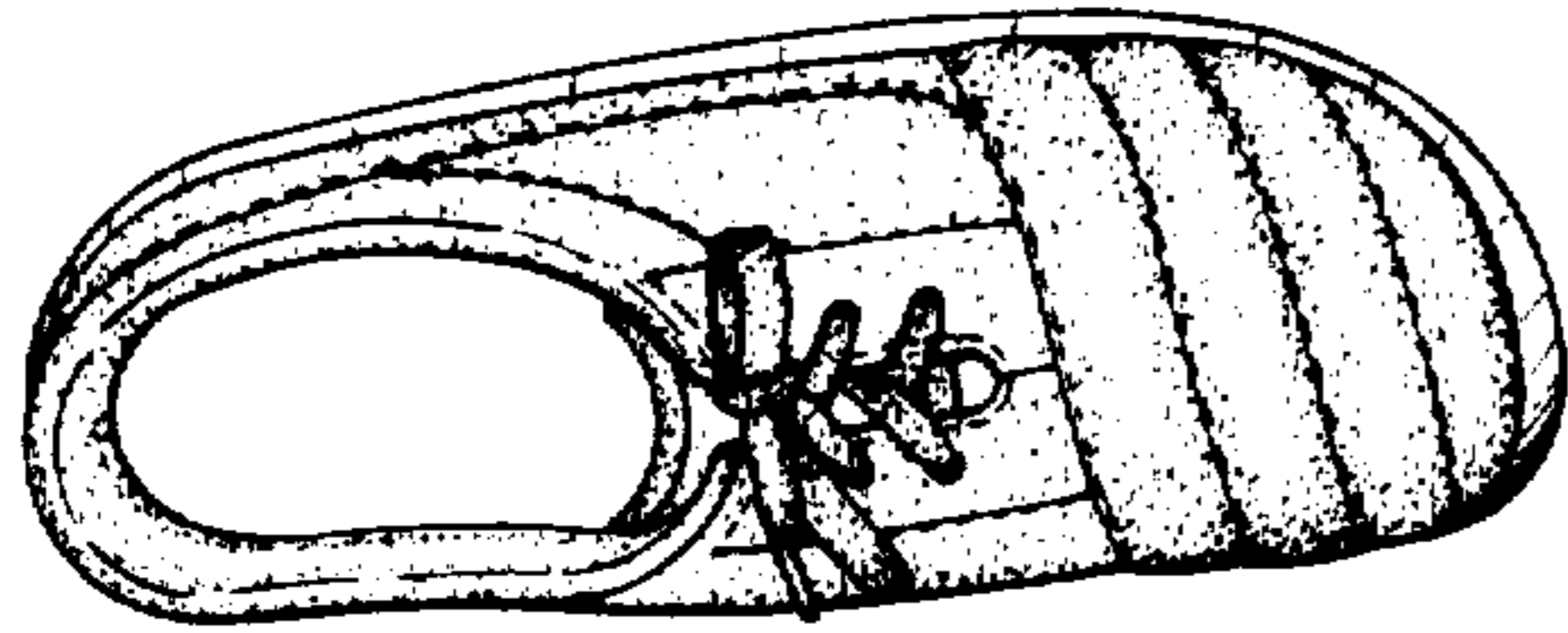

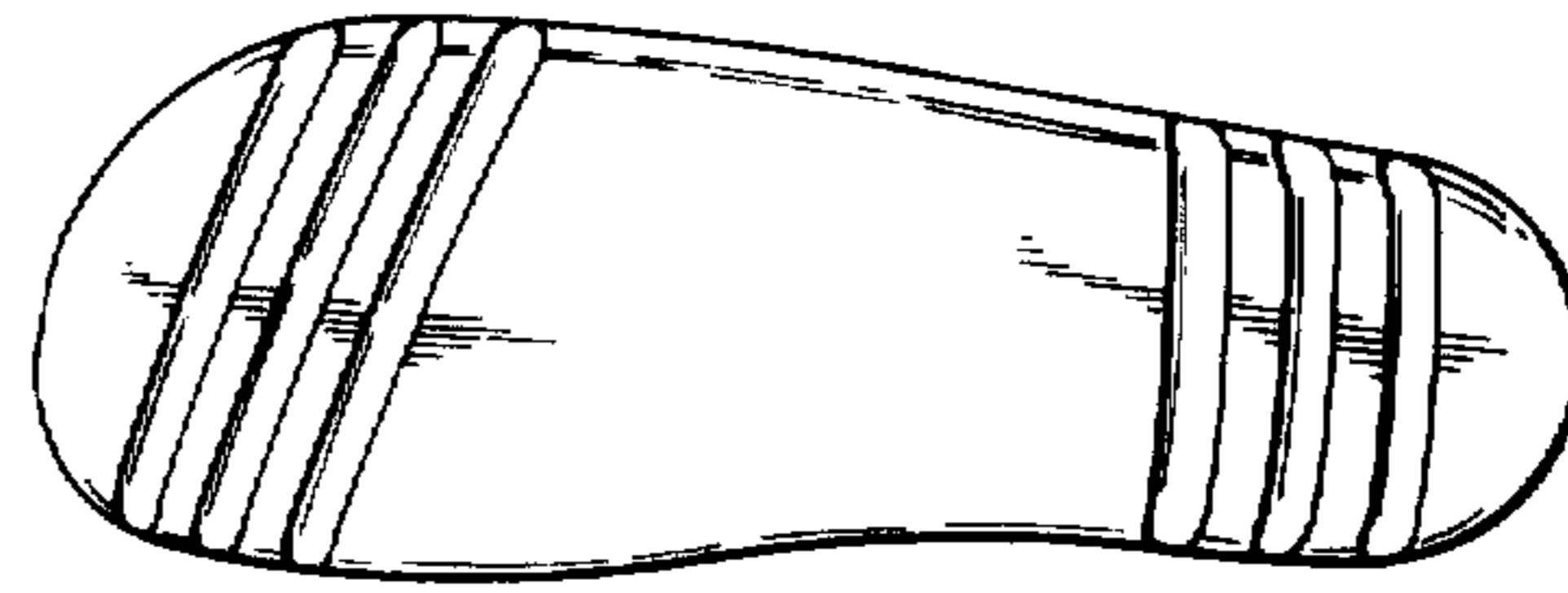

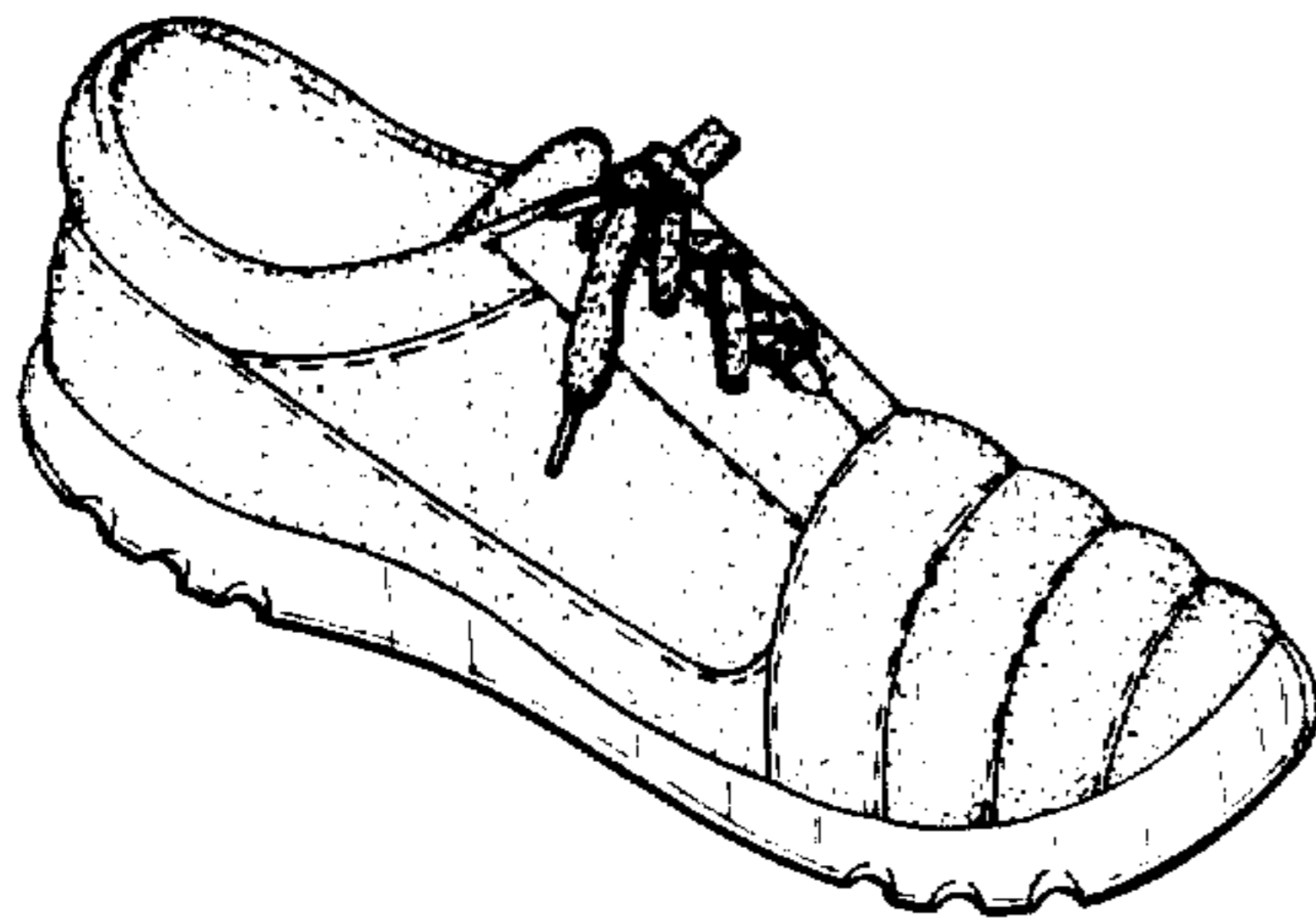

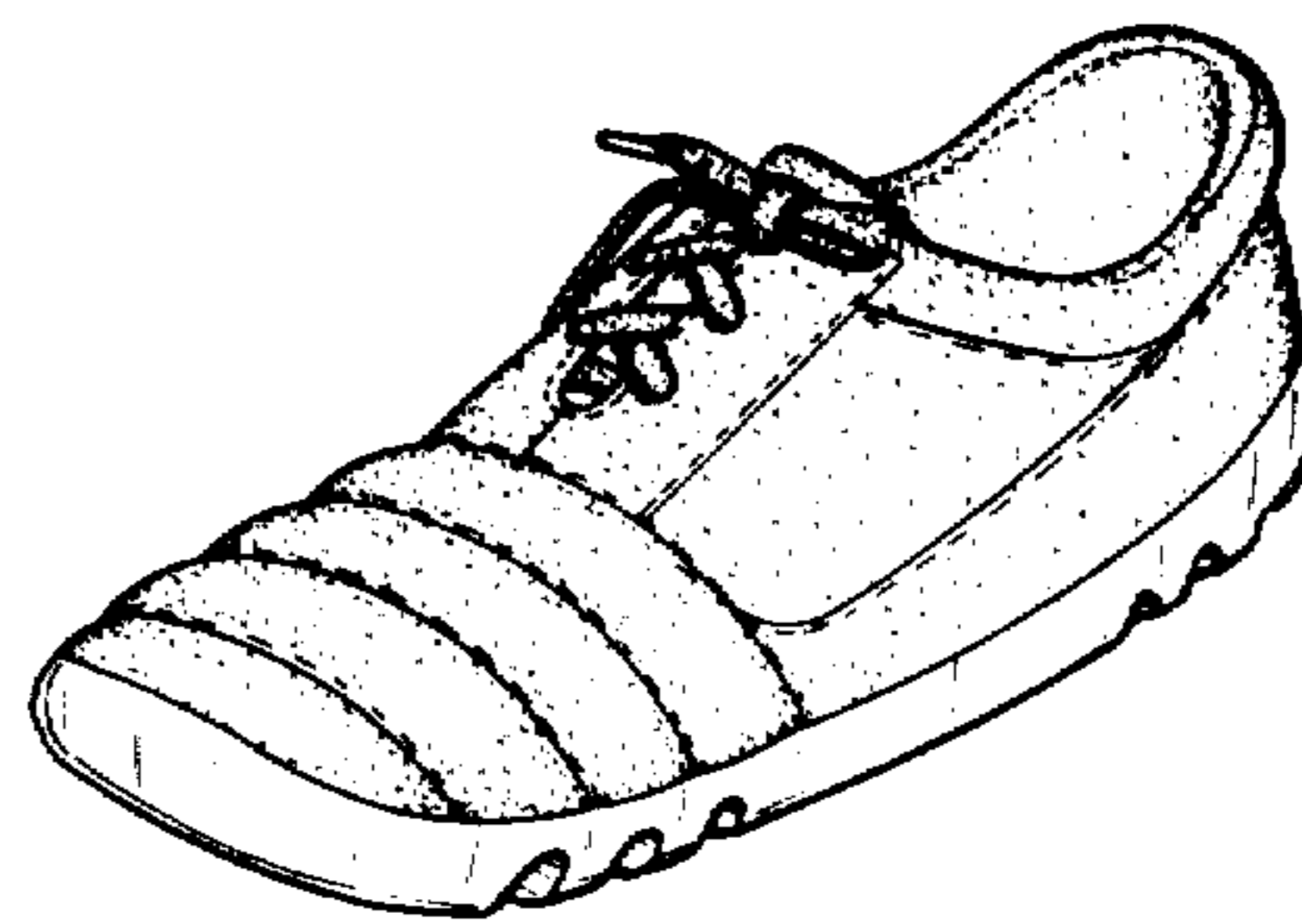
