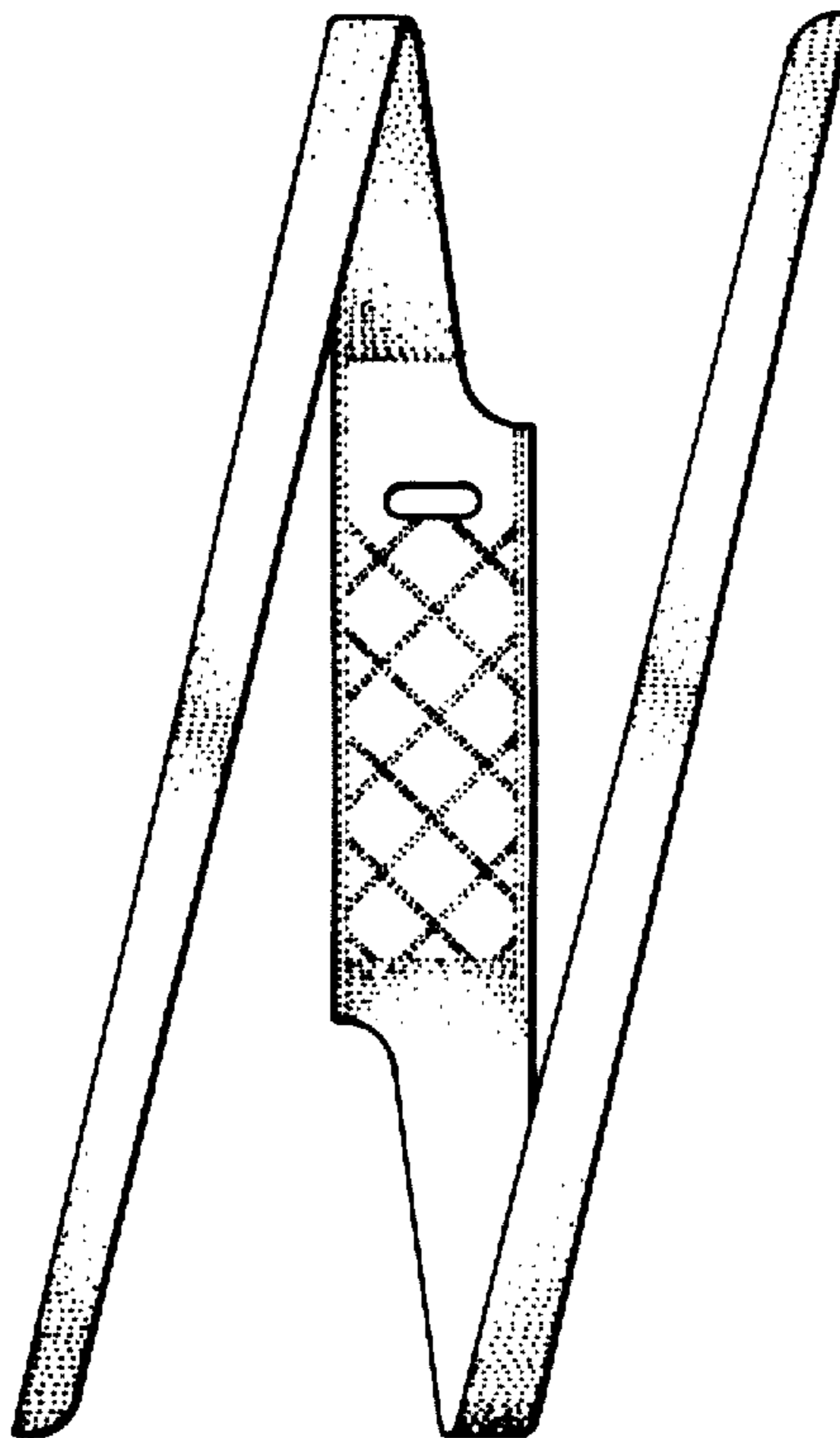

CLAIM

The ornamental design for a limb holder, as shown.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top plan view of the limb holder illustrating the undersides of the opposed straps;
FIG. 2 is a bottom plan view of the present limb holder illustrating the top portions of the opposed straps;
FIG. 3 is a side view of the present limb holder; and
FIG. 4 is an enlarged sectional view taken generally along the section lines 4—4.



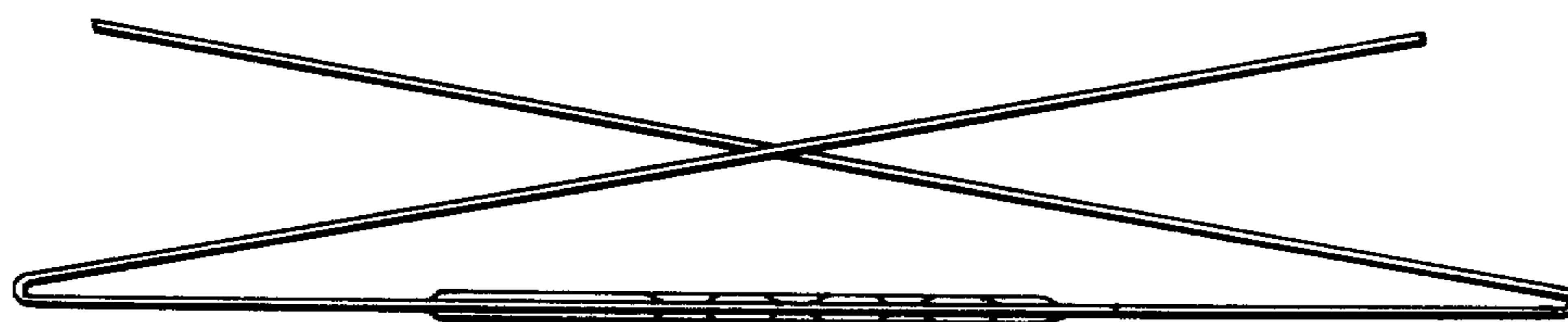
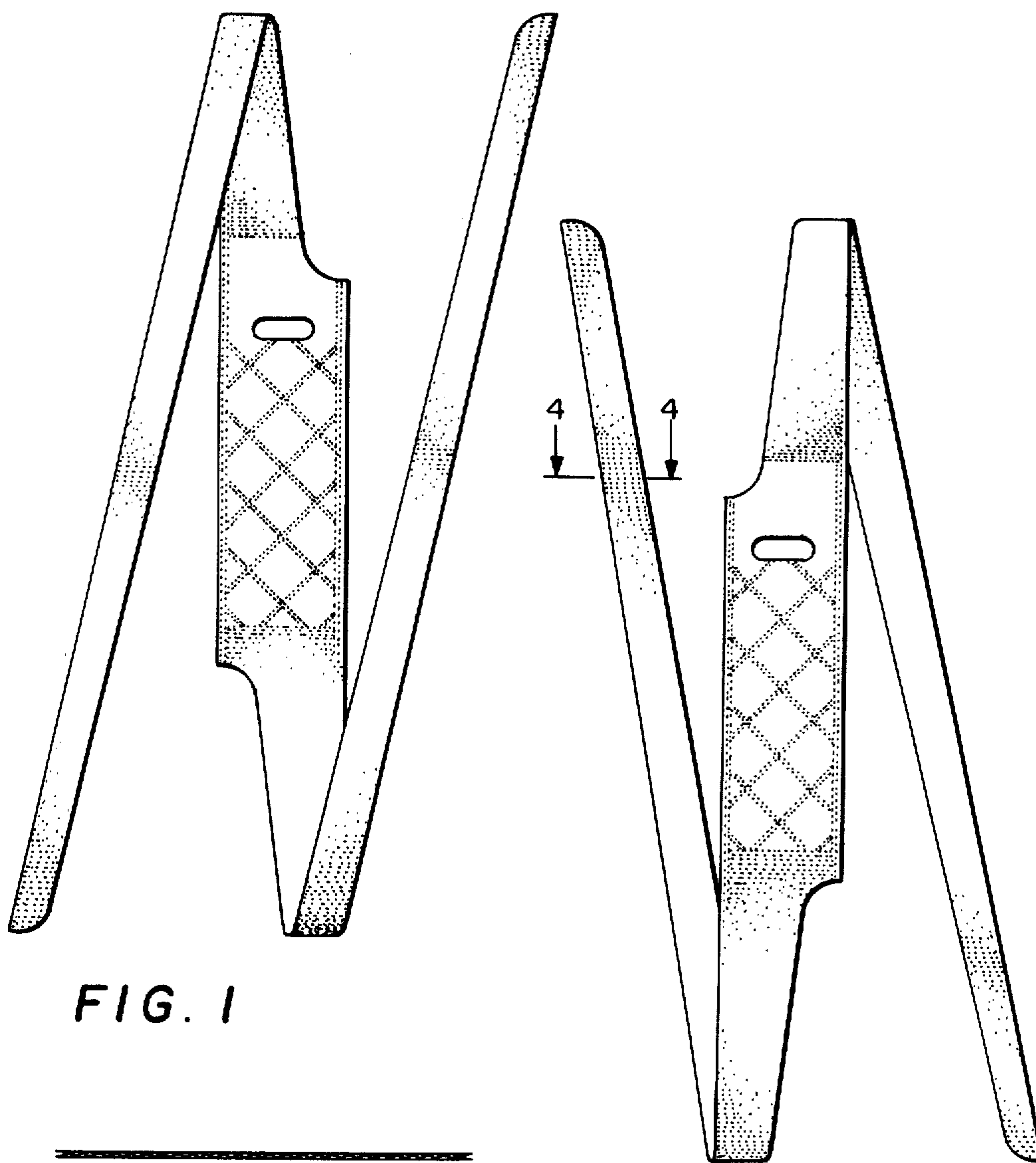
