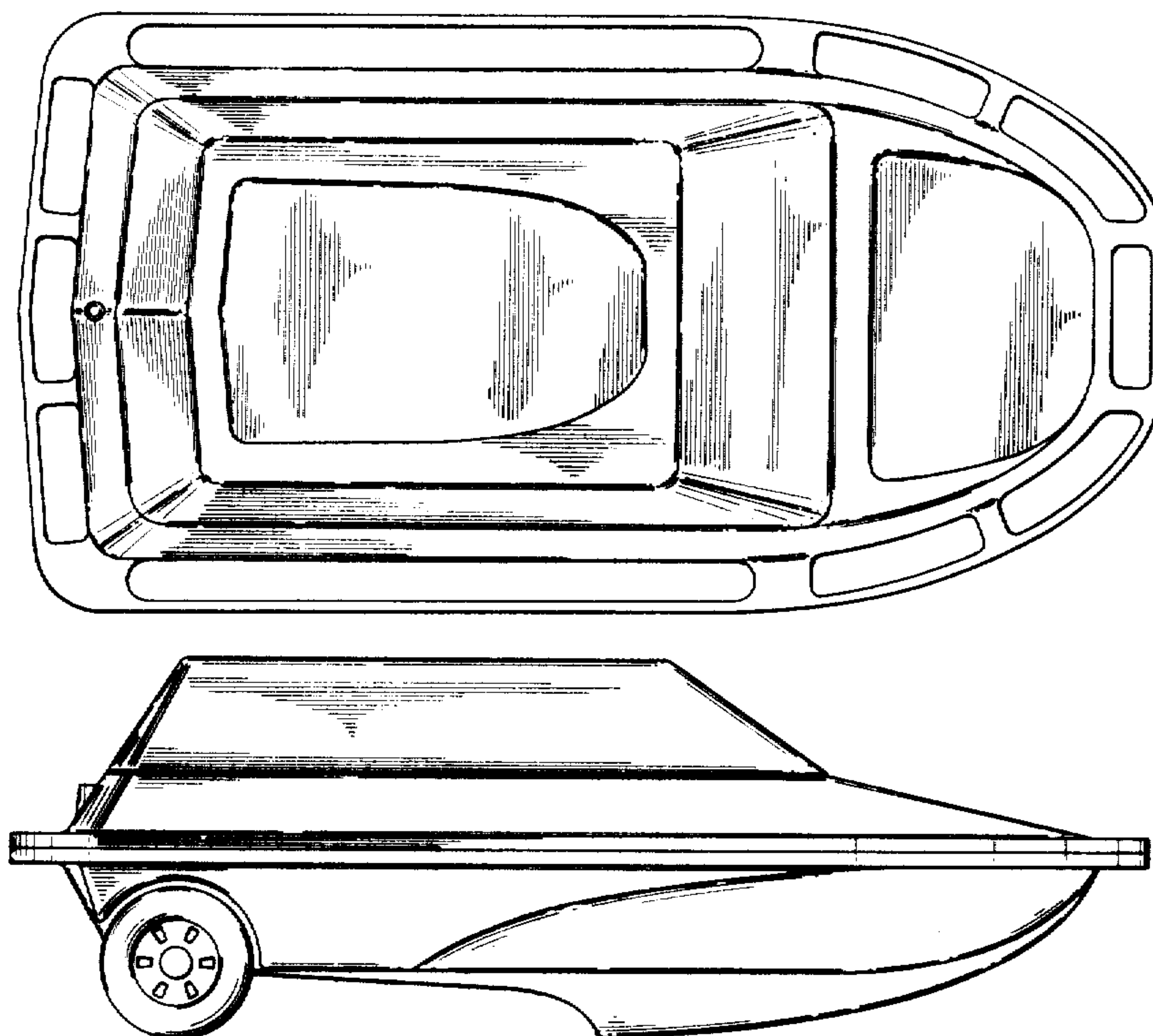

DESCRIPTION

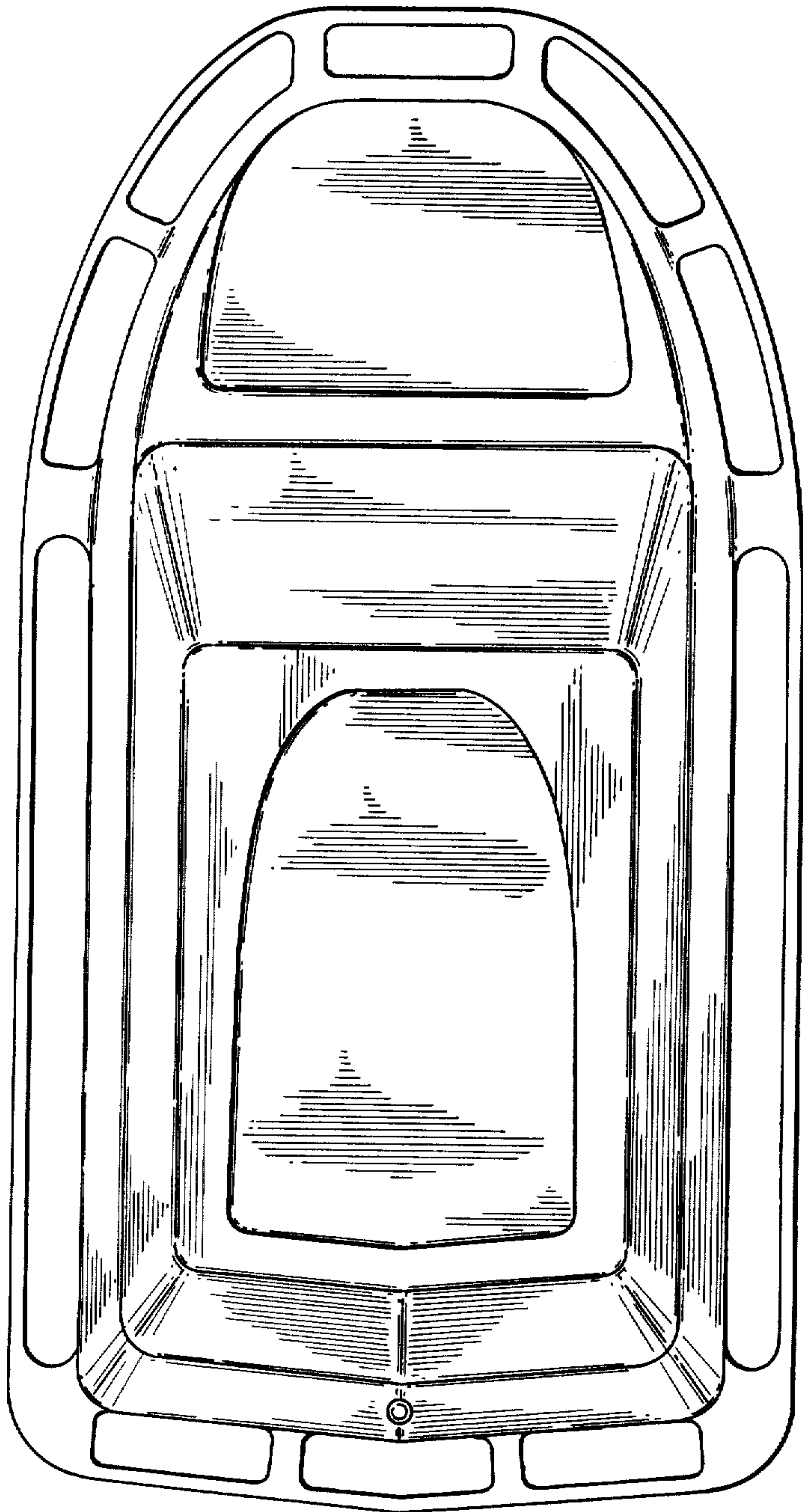

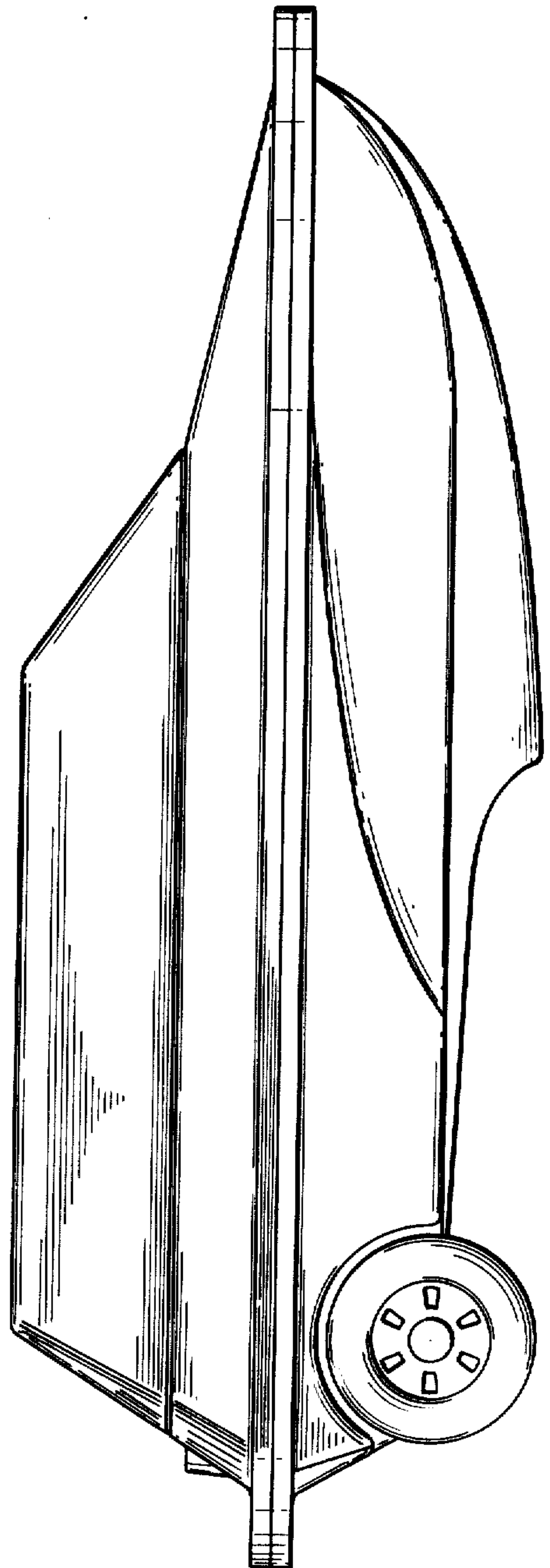

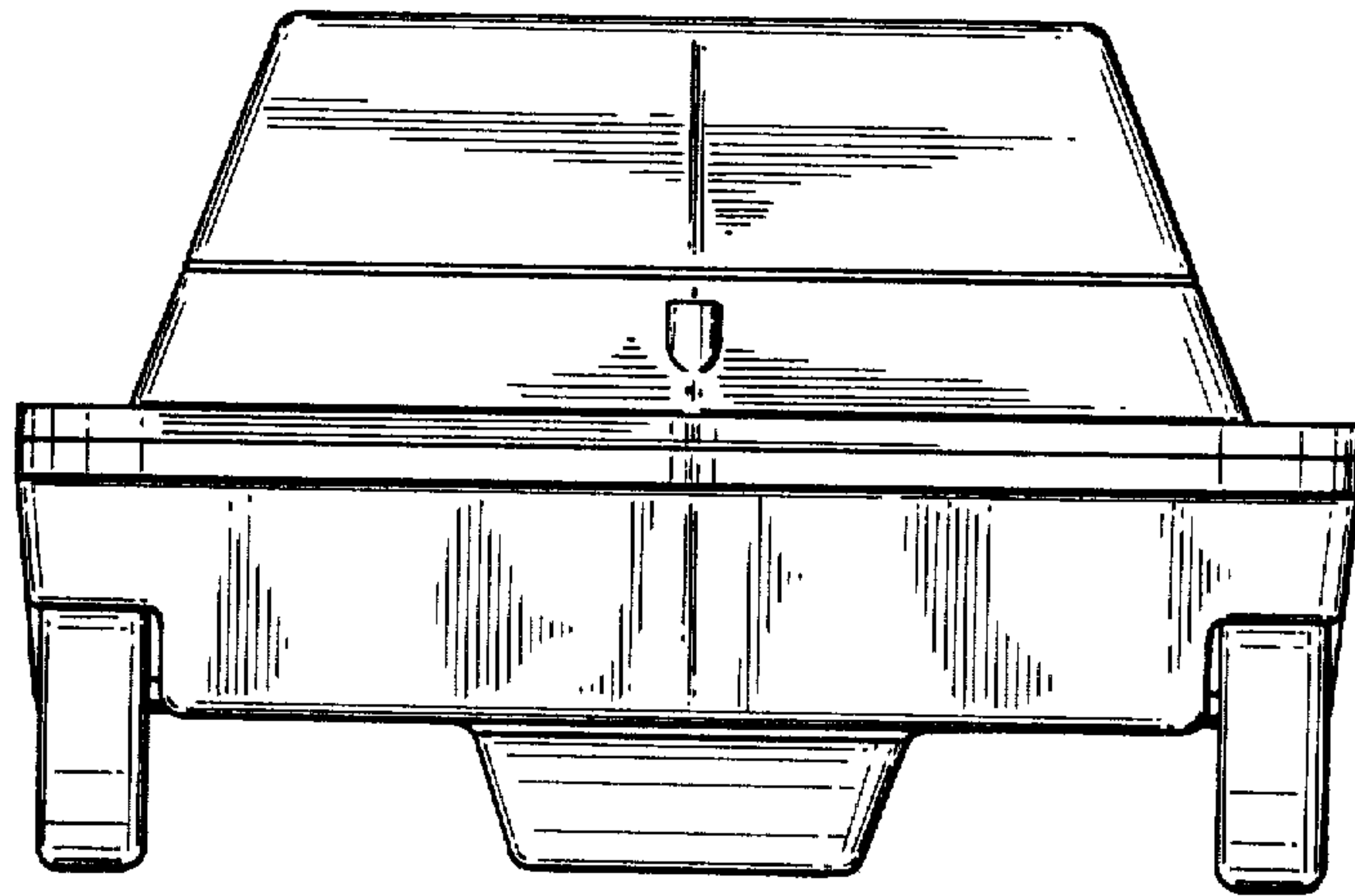

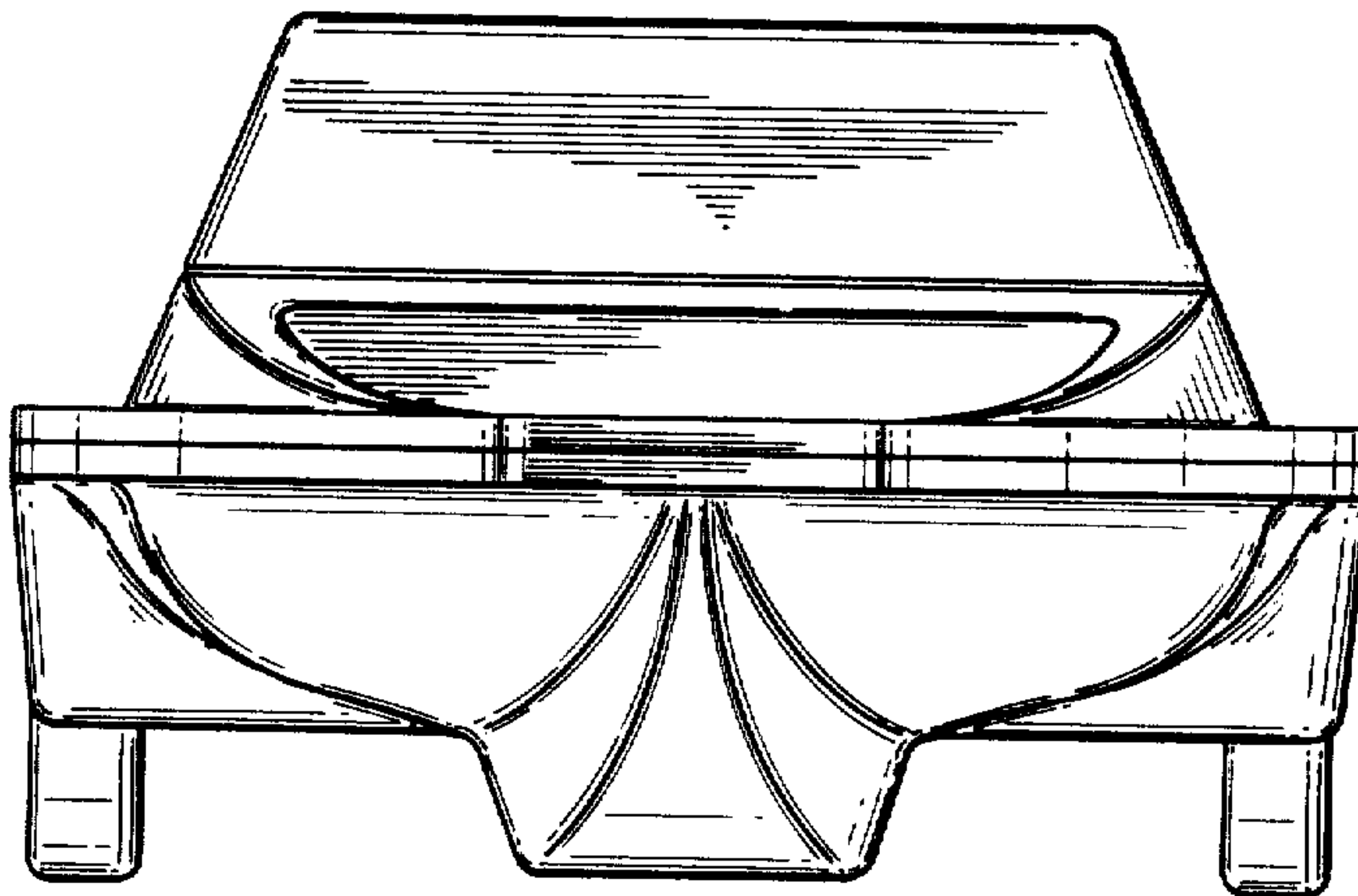
