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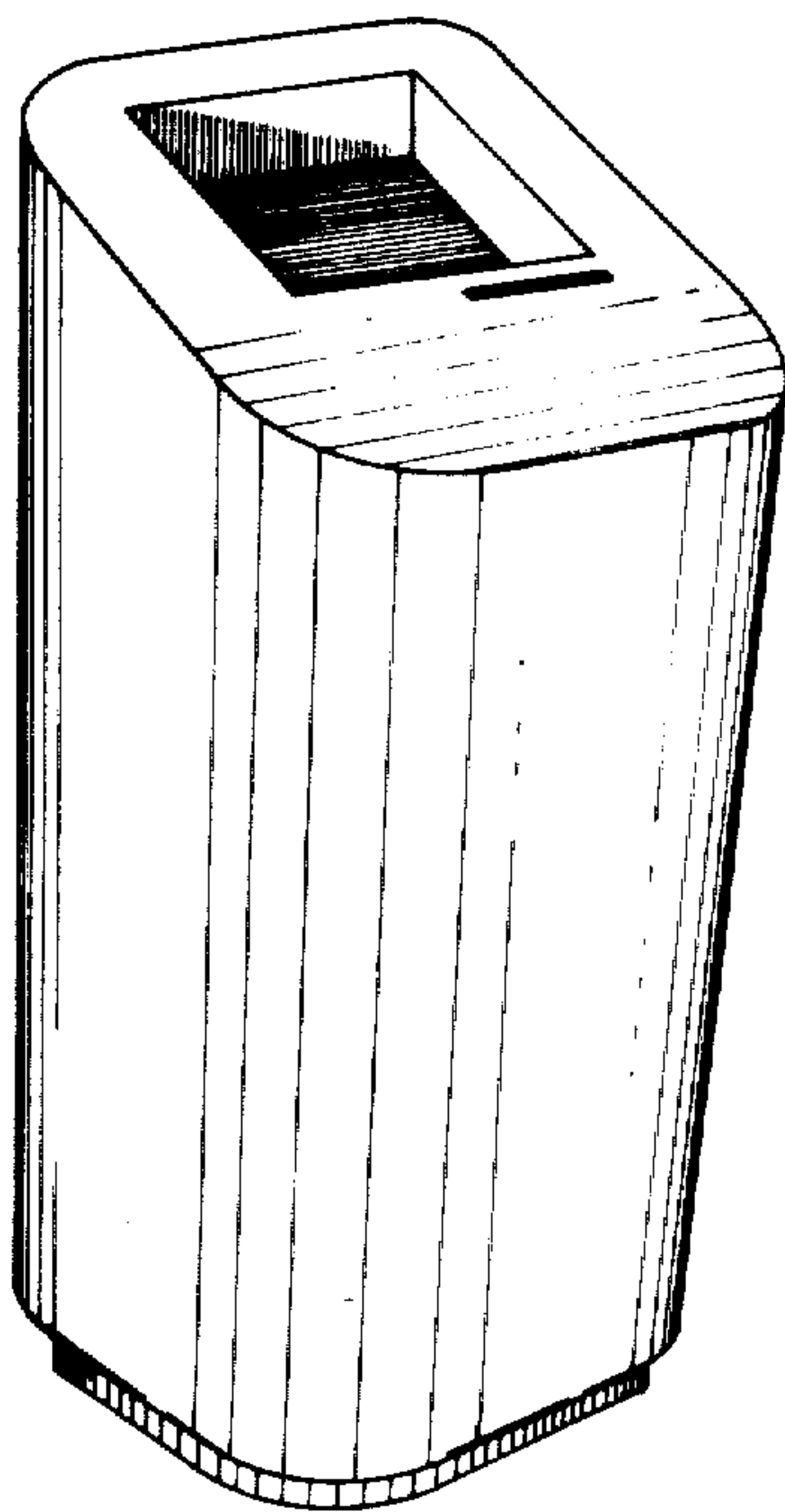

The ornamental design for a support stand for electronic equipment, substantially as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of a support stand for electronic equipment showing our new design;
FIG. 2 is a front elevational view;
FIG. 3 is a left side elevational view the right side elevational view being identical thereto;
FIG. 4 is a rear elevational view;
FIG. 5 is a top plan view; and
FIG. 6 is a bottom plan view.



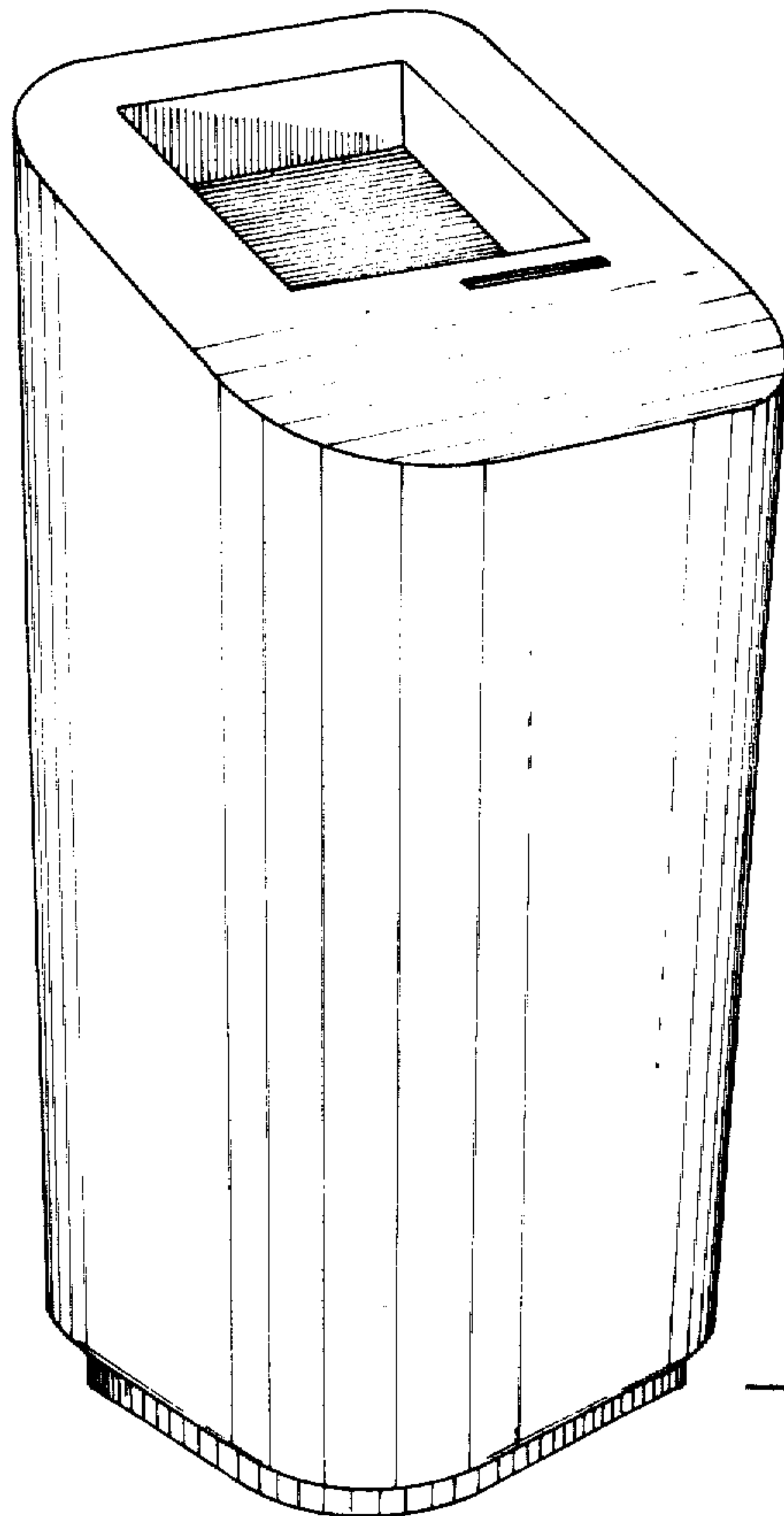

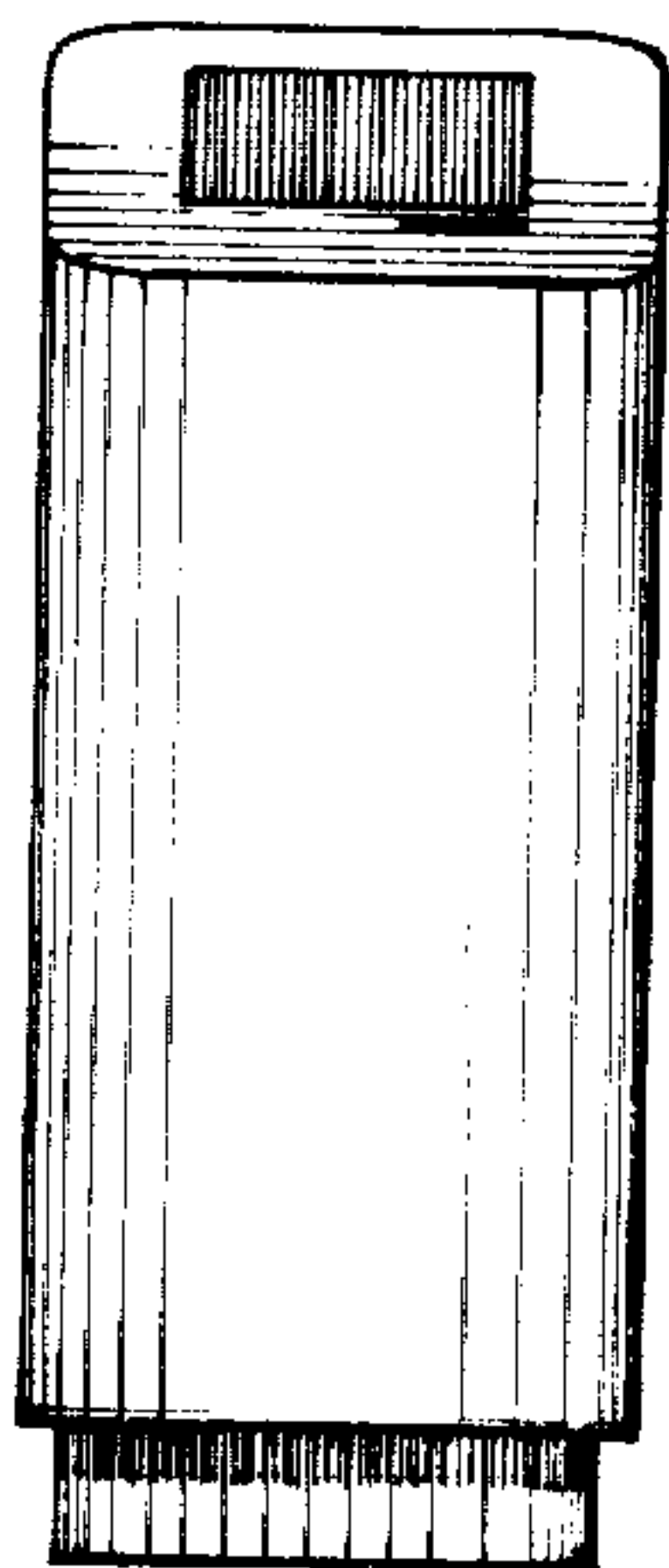

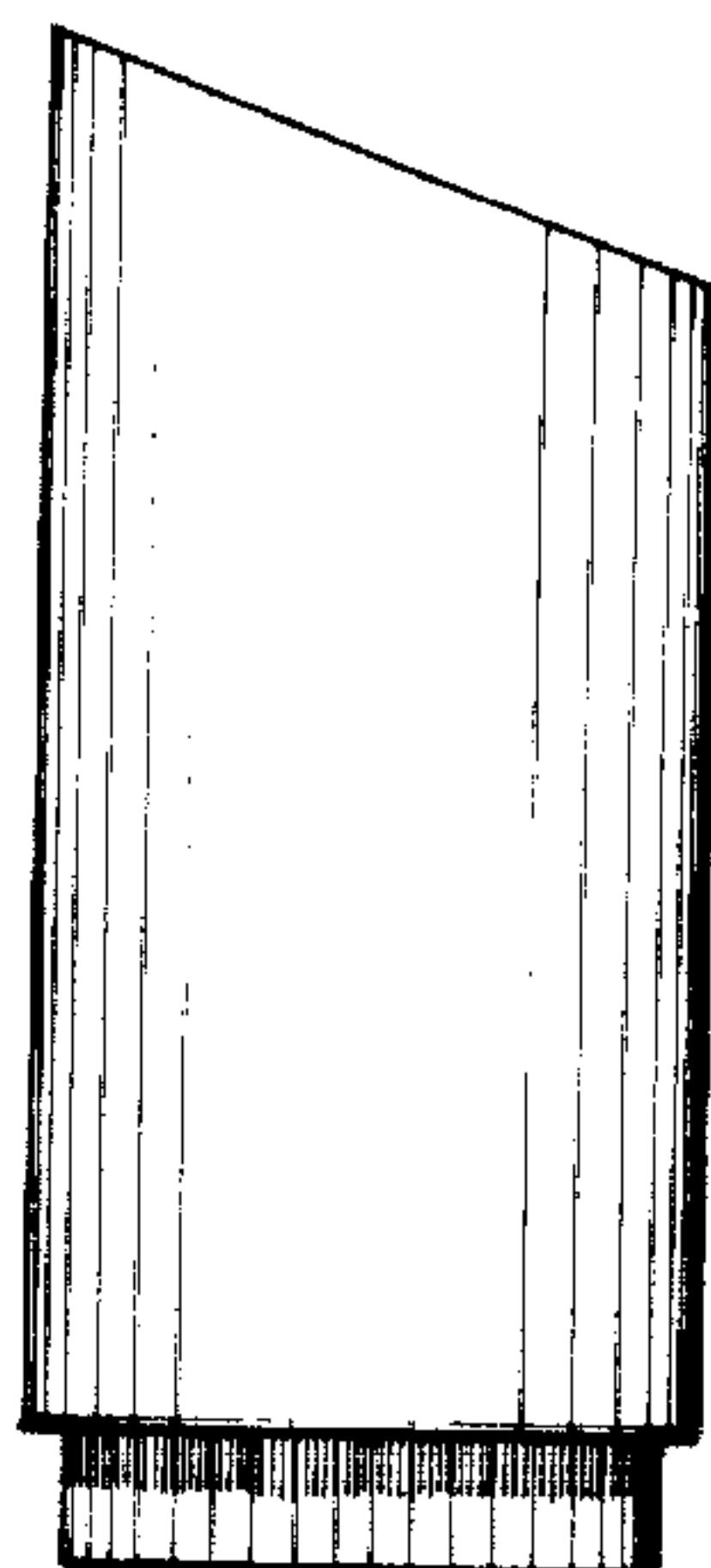

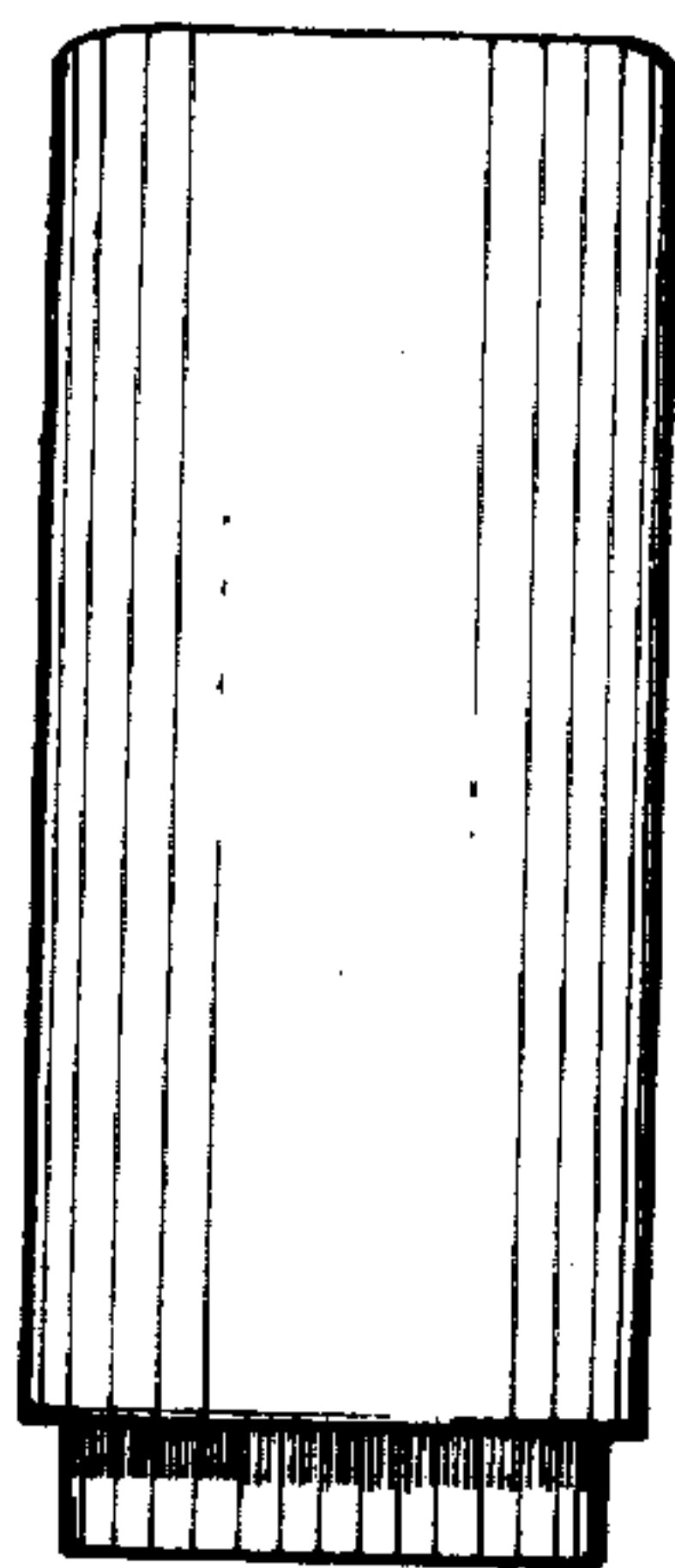

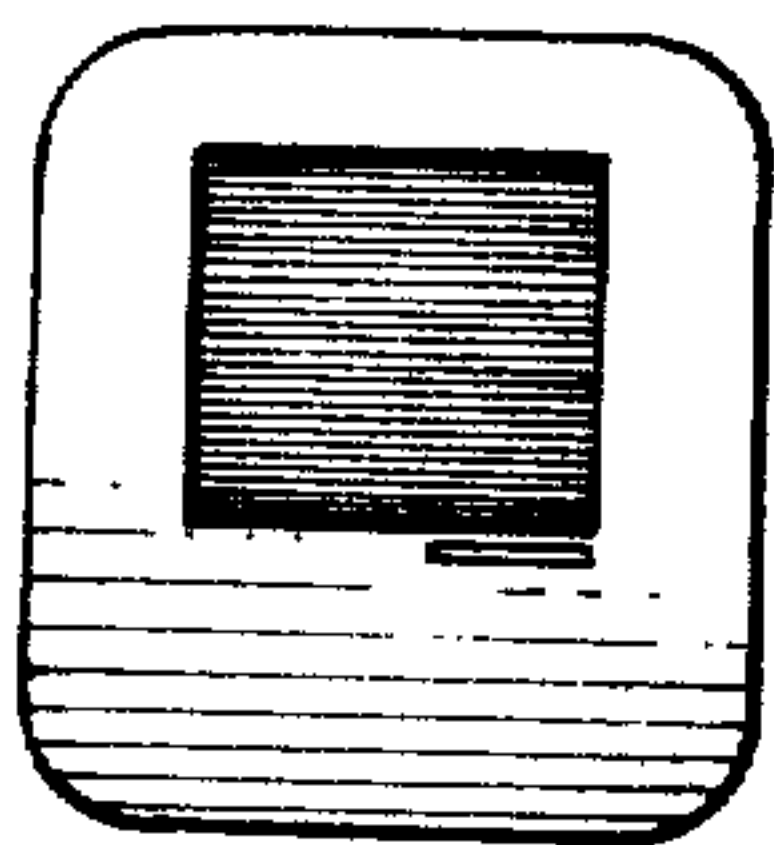

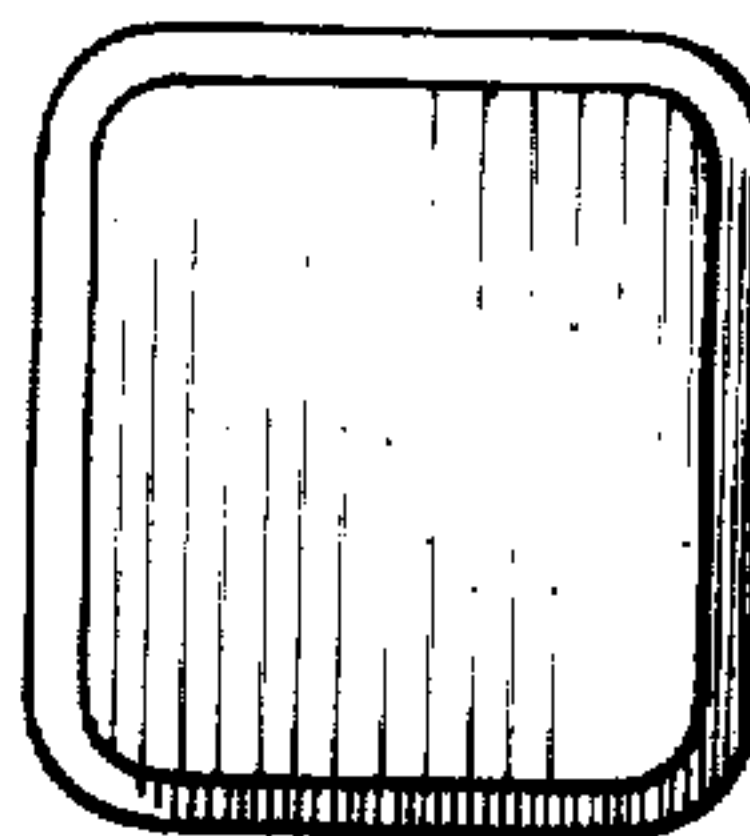
