[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a figurine of a Doberman Pinscher pup, substantially as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front end perspective view of the figurine of a Doberman Pinscher pup showing our new design; FIG. 2 is a side elevational view of FIG. 1; FIG. 3 is an opposite side perspective view showing the side opposite that shown in FIG. 2; FIG. 4 is a rear end perspective view of FIG. 1; and FIG. 5 is a top plan view of FIG. 1.

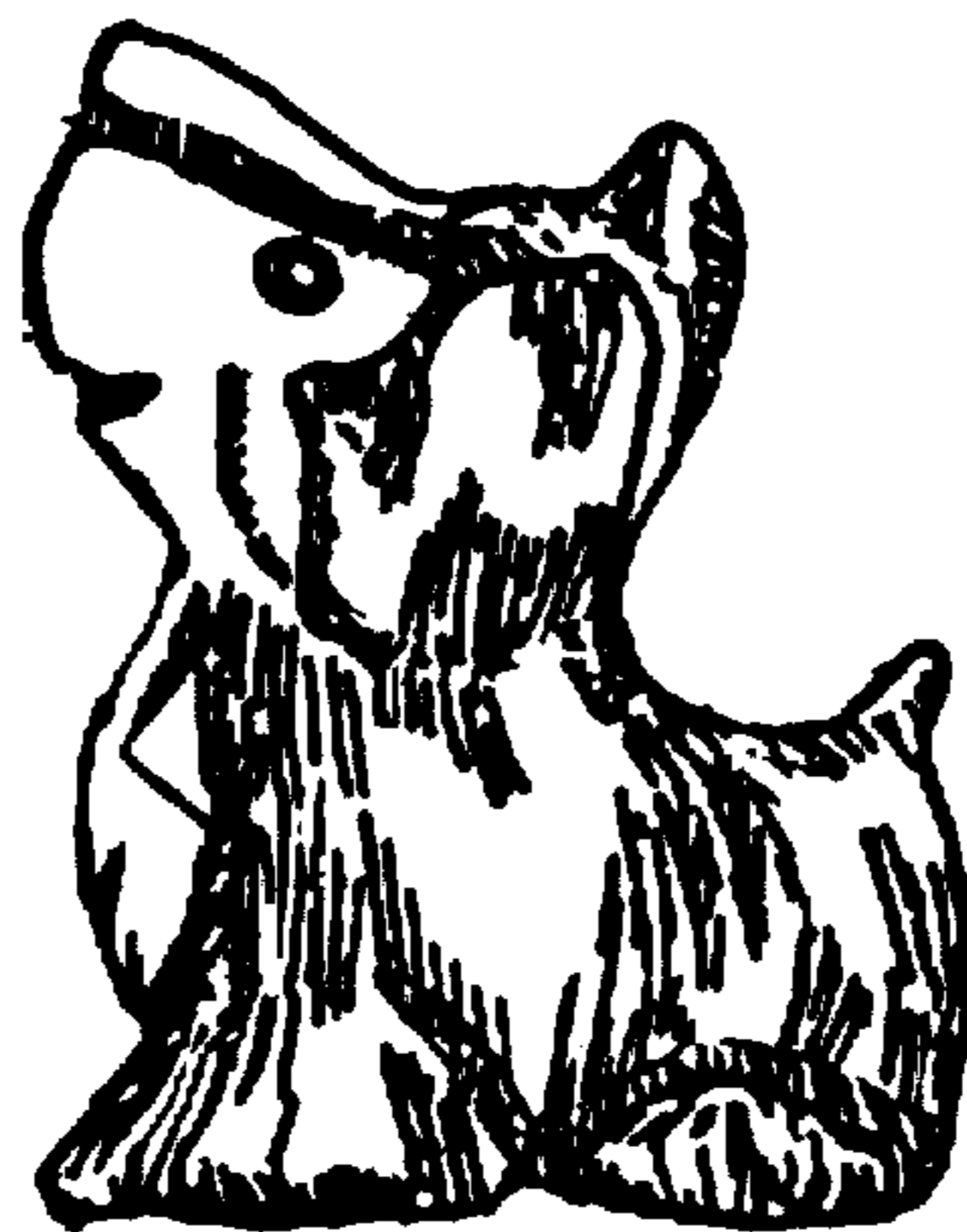
