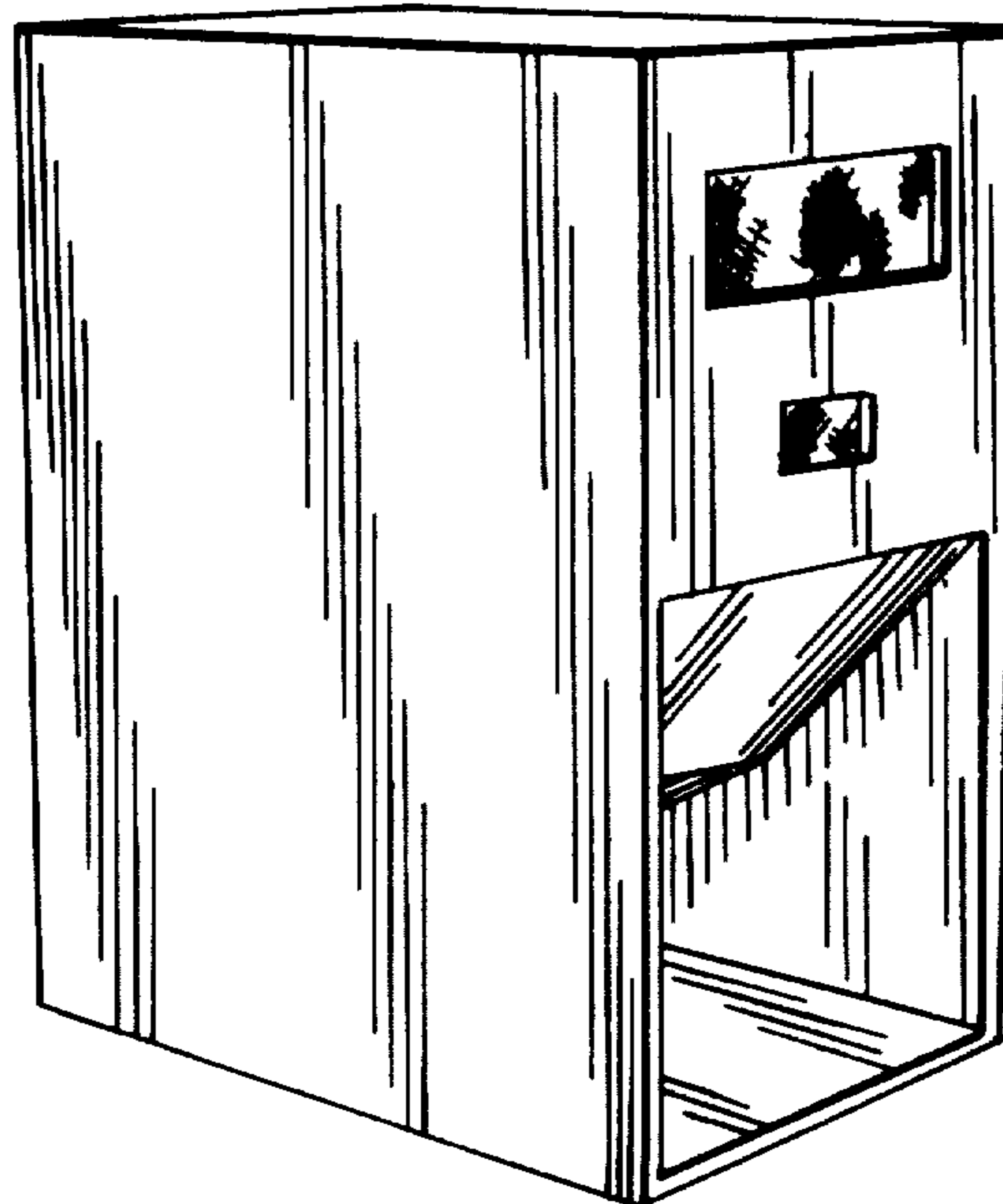

[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a loudspeaker cabinet, substantially as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of the loudspeaker cabinet, showing my new design;
FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof;
FIG. 3 is a side elevational view;
FIG. 4 is a rear elevational view;
FIG. 5 is a top plan view; and
FIG. 6 is a side elevational view in section on the line 6-6 of FIG. 2.



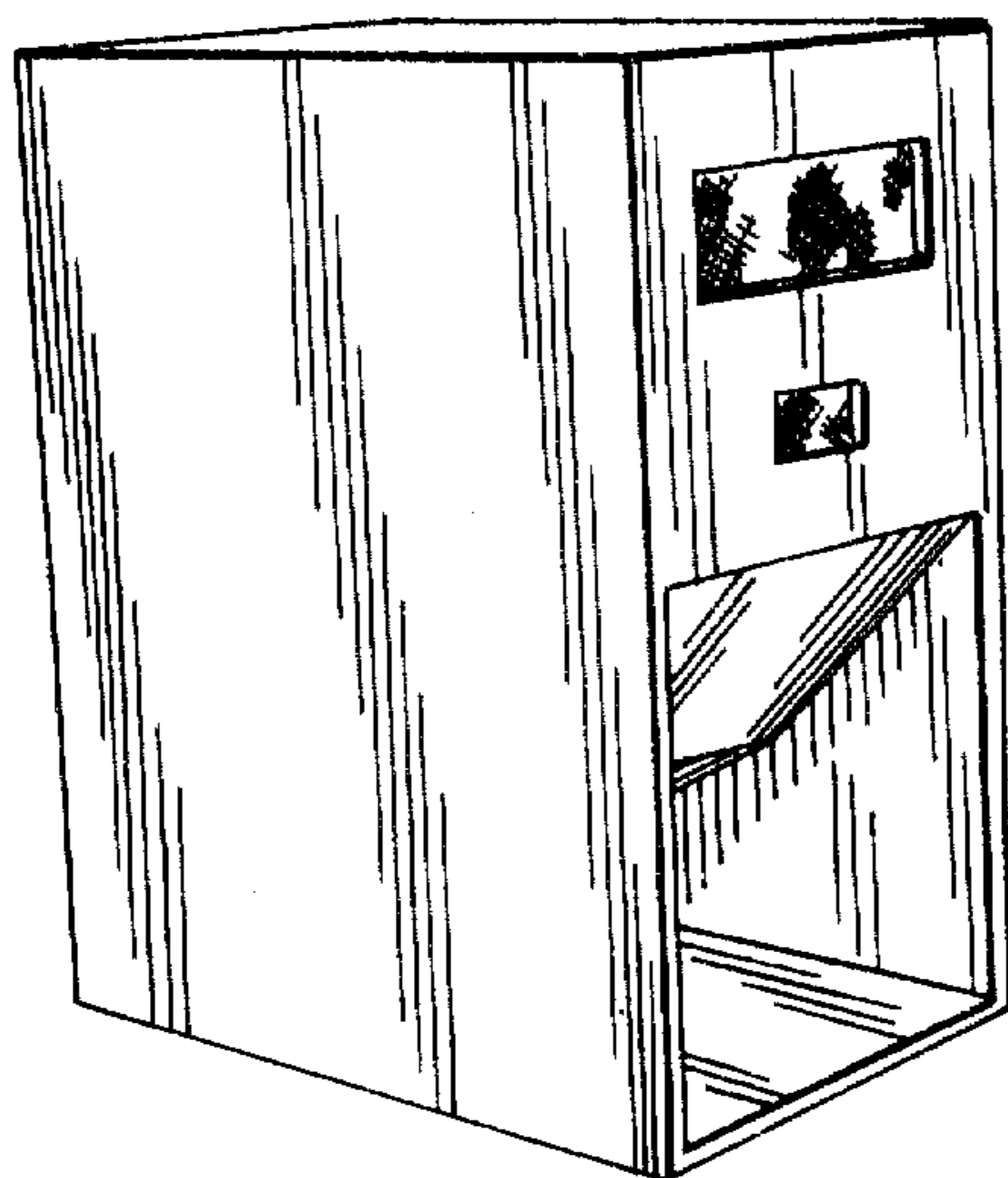

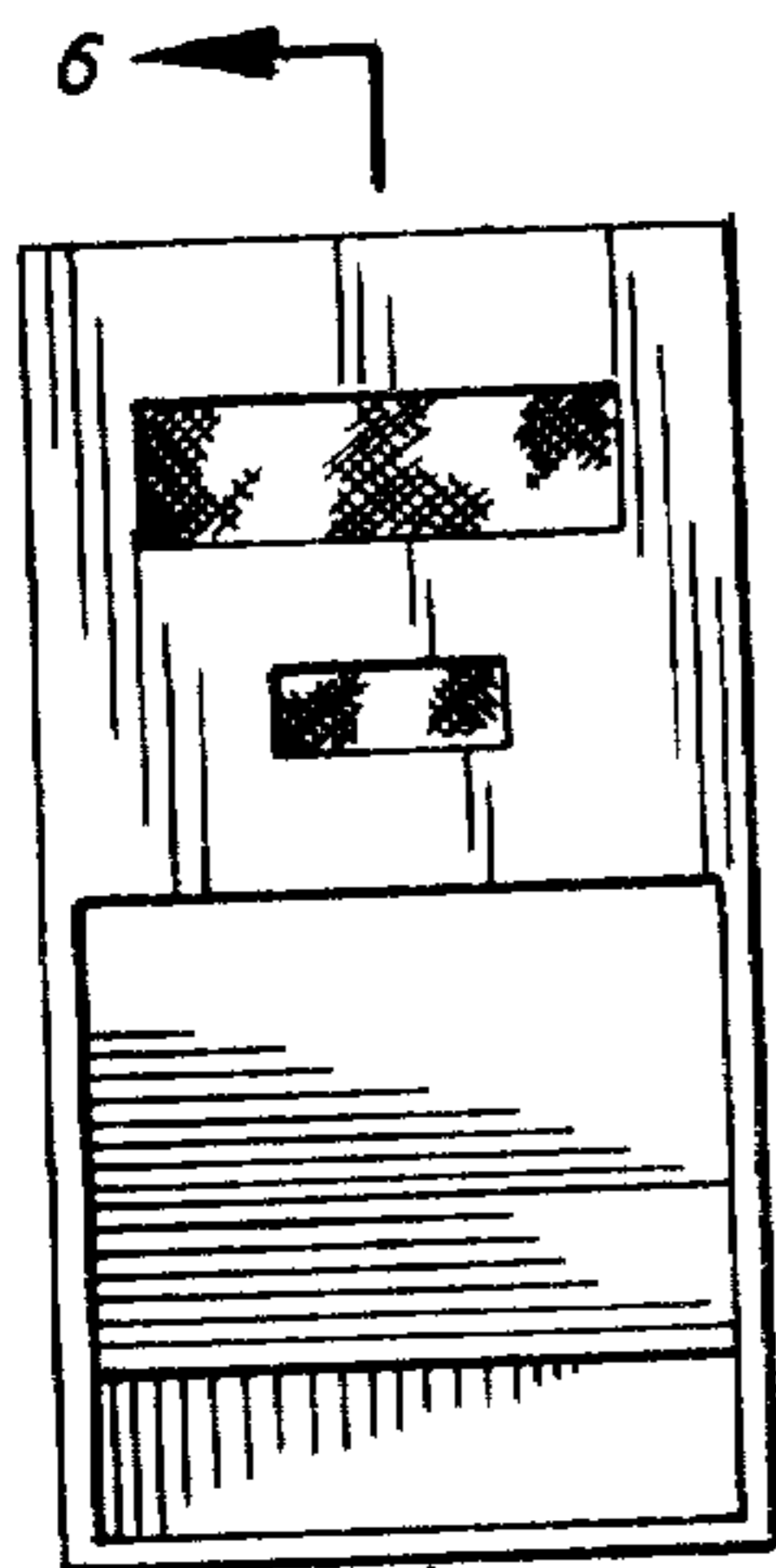

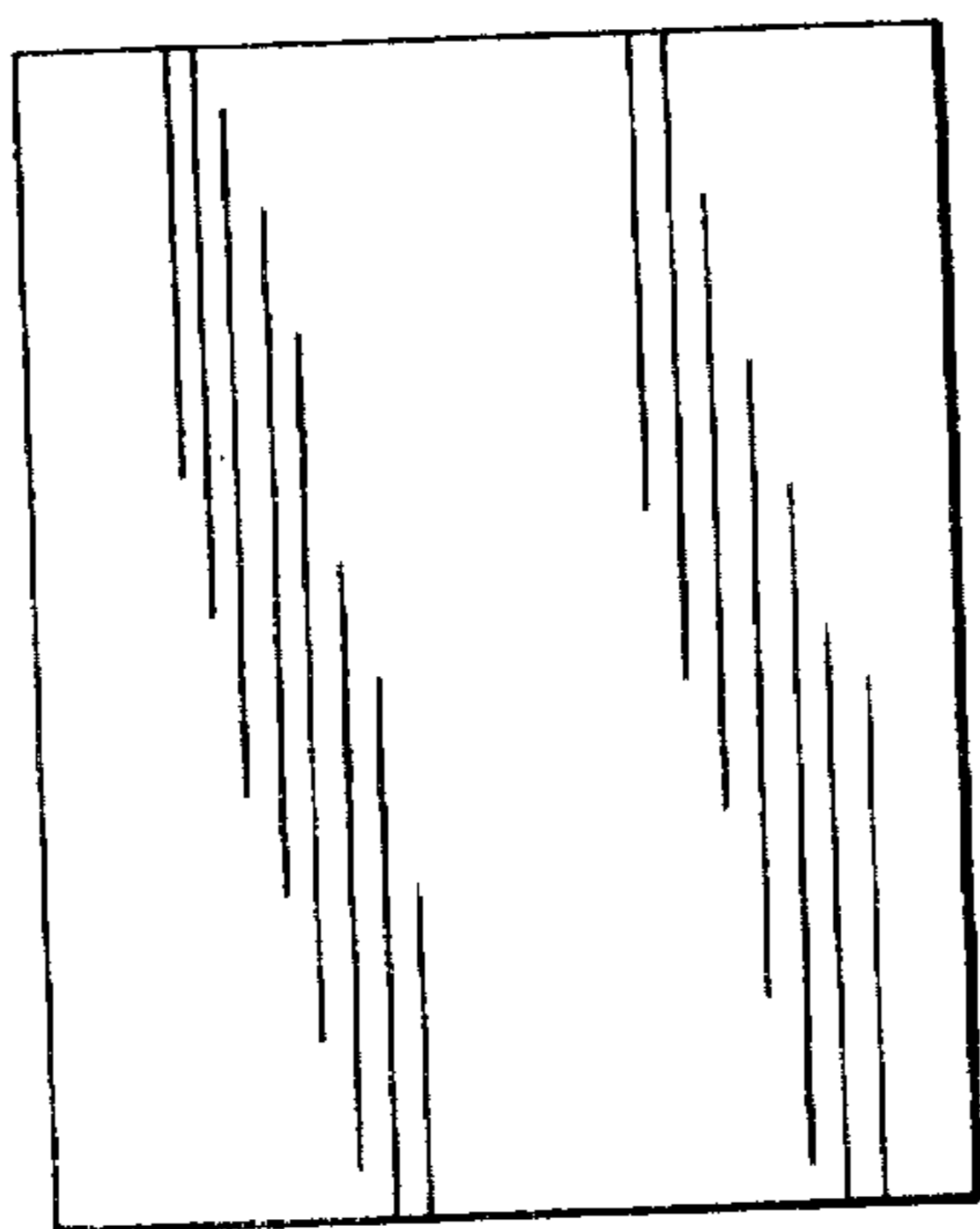

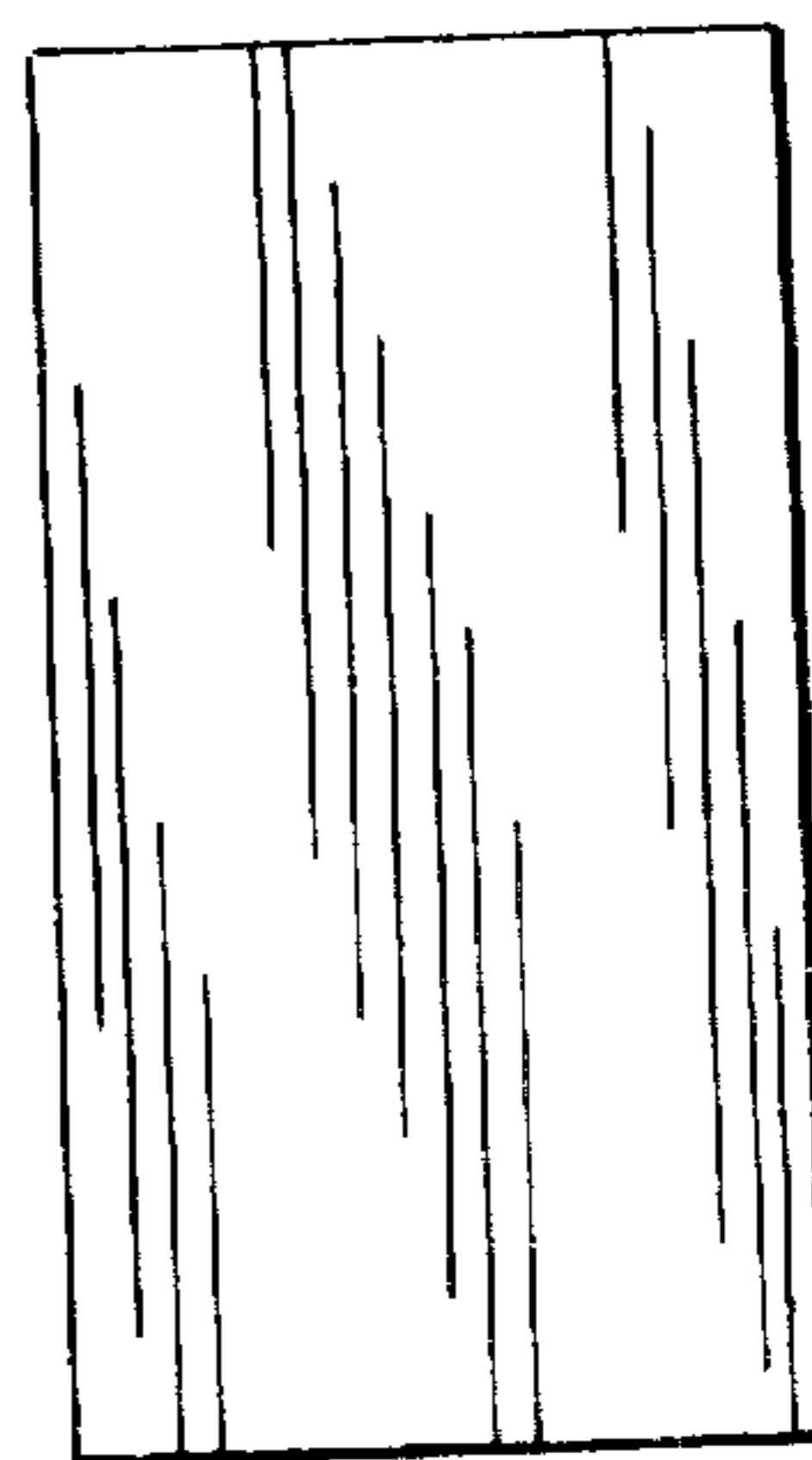

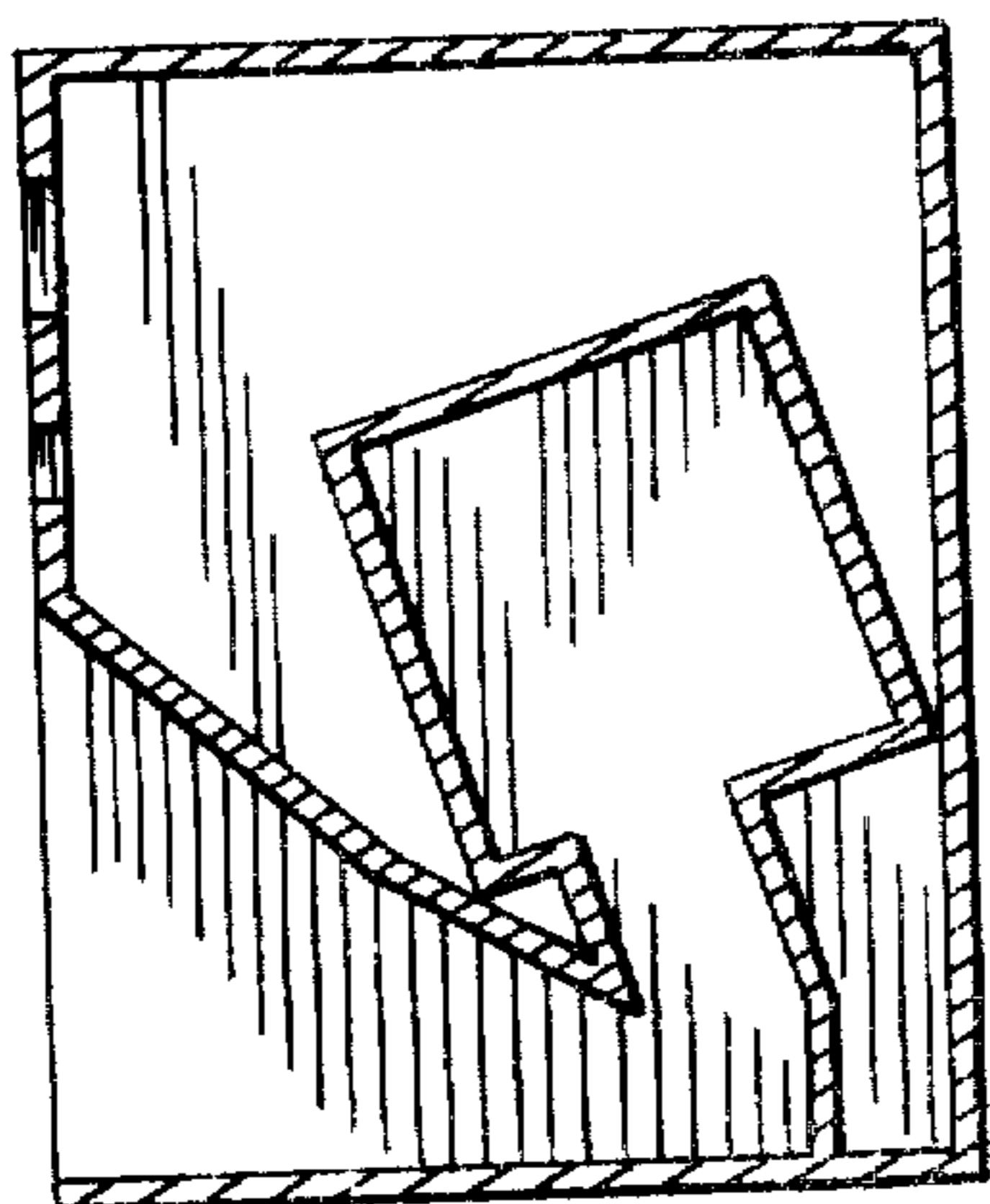

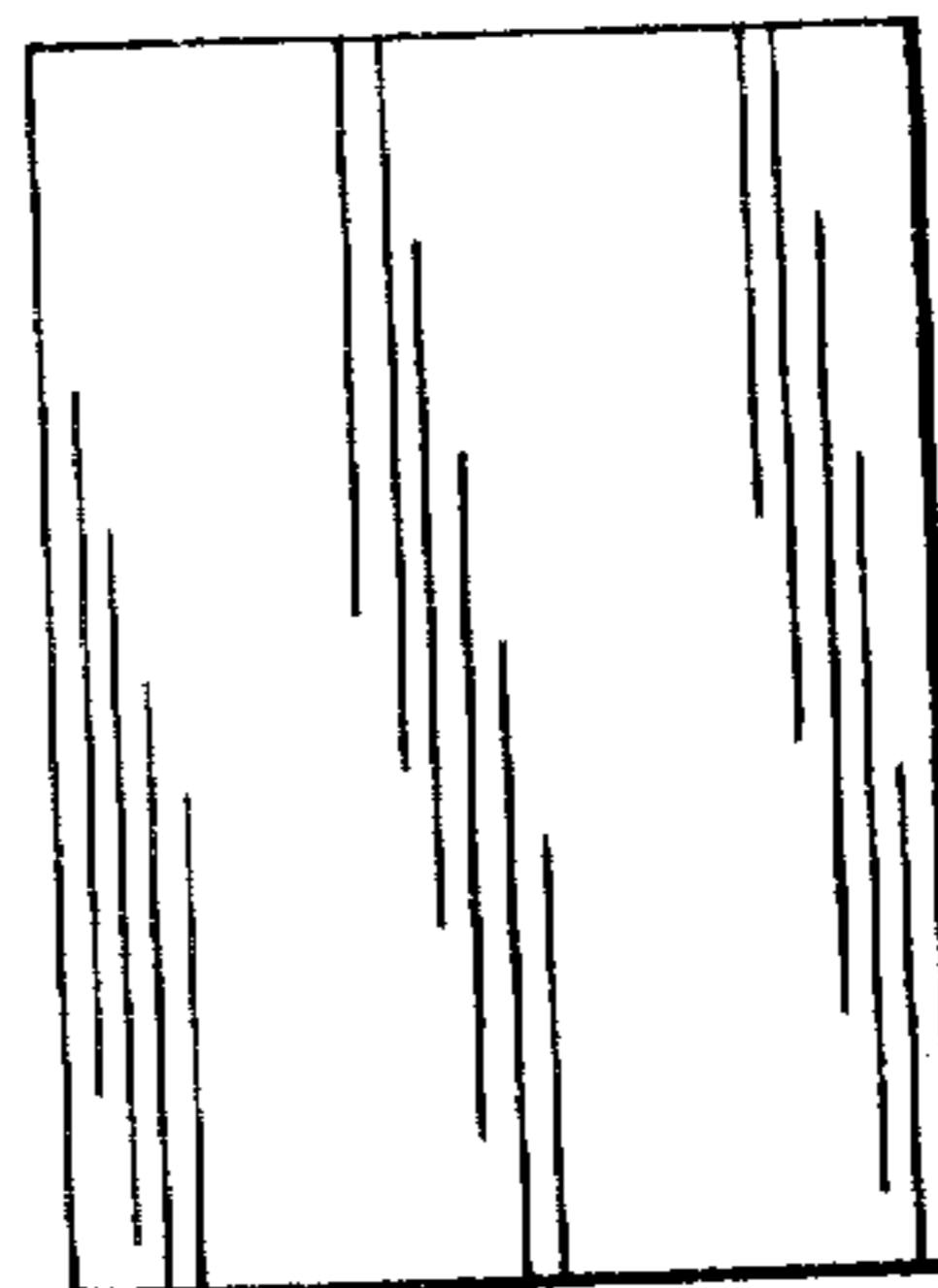
