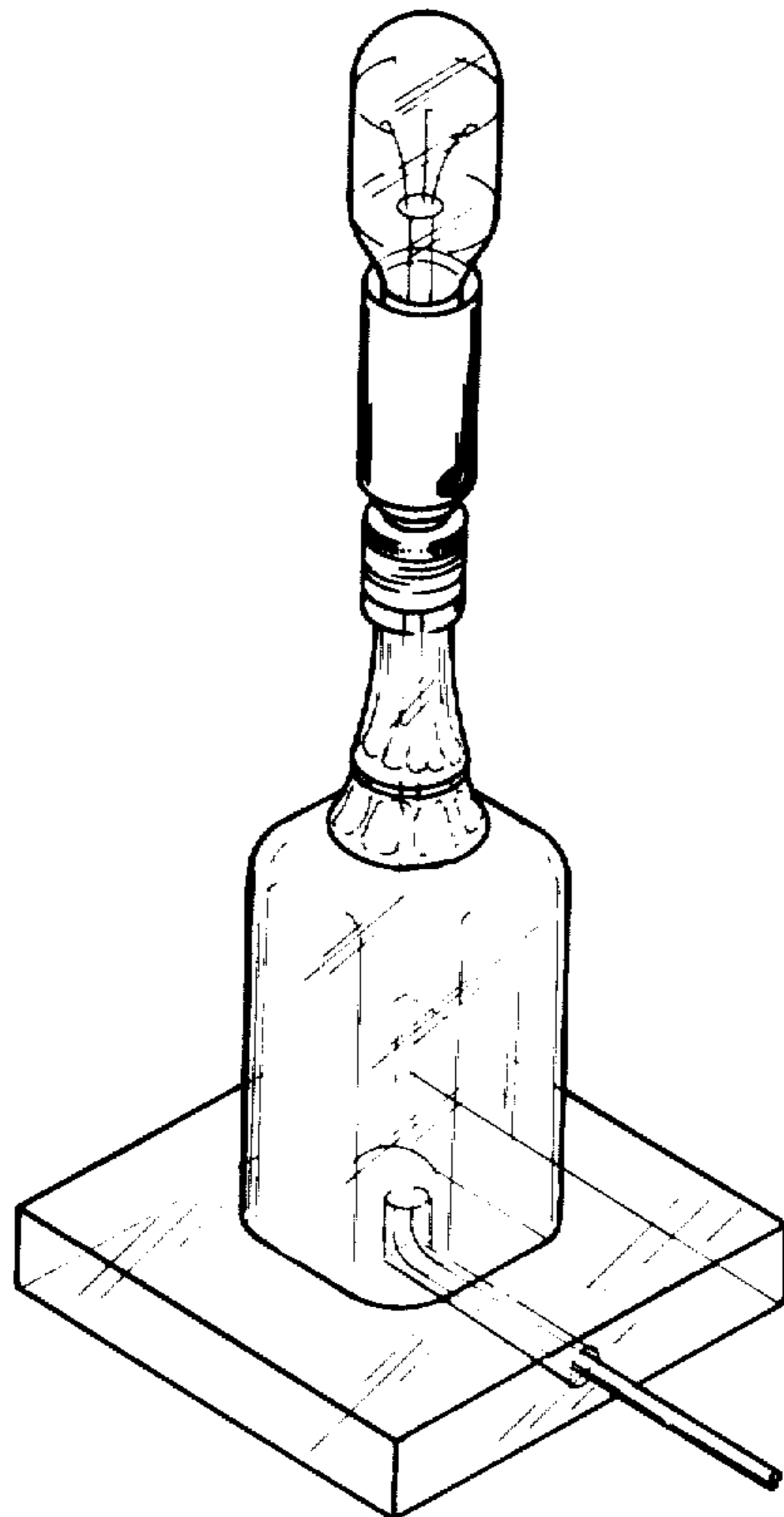

FIGS. 4, 5 and 6 are respectively side elevational views of the first, second and third embodiments of my design.



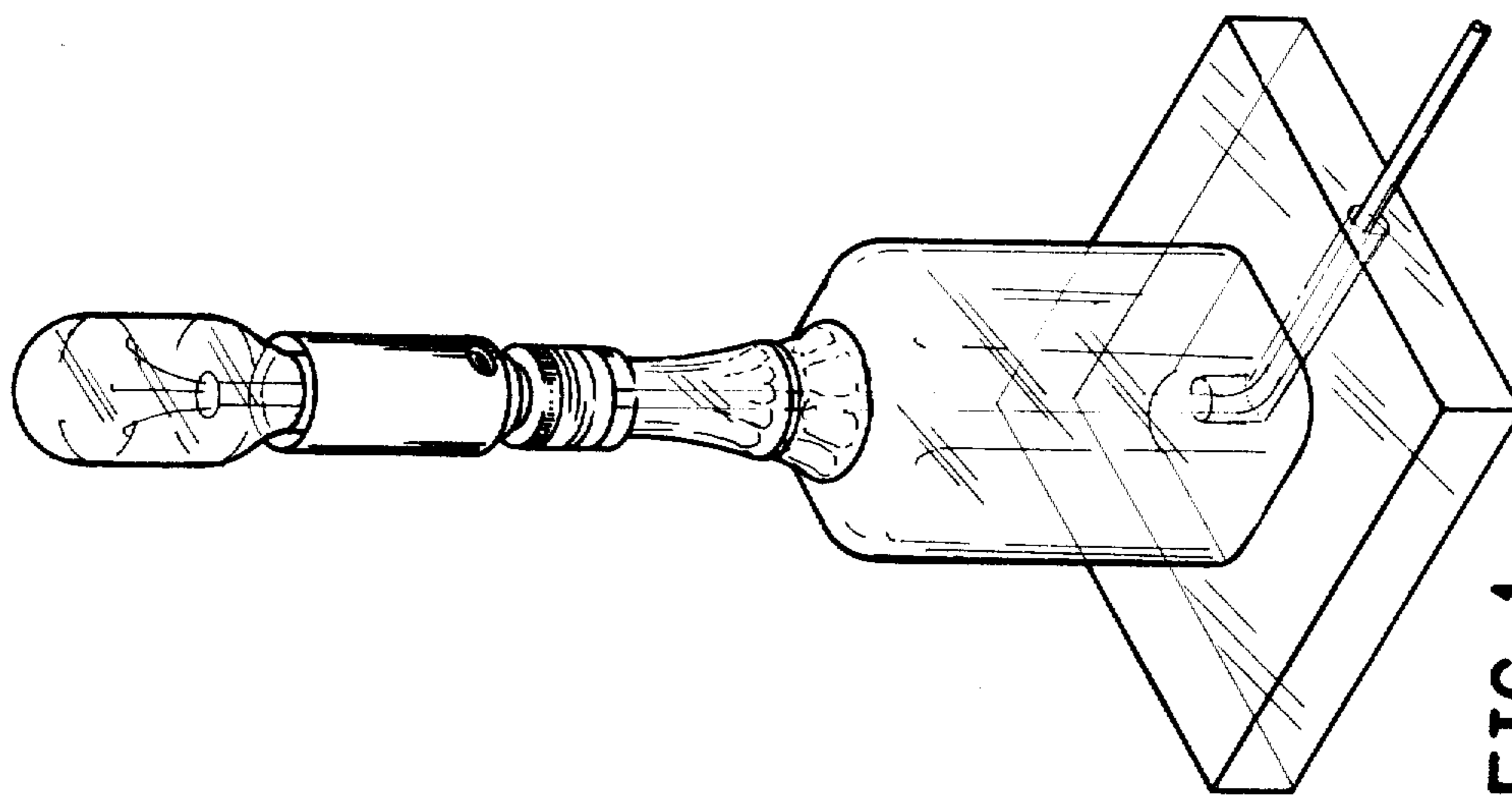

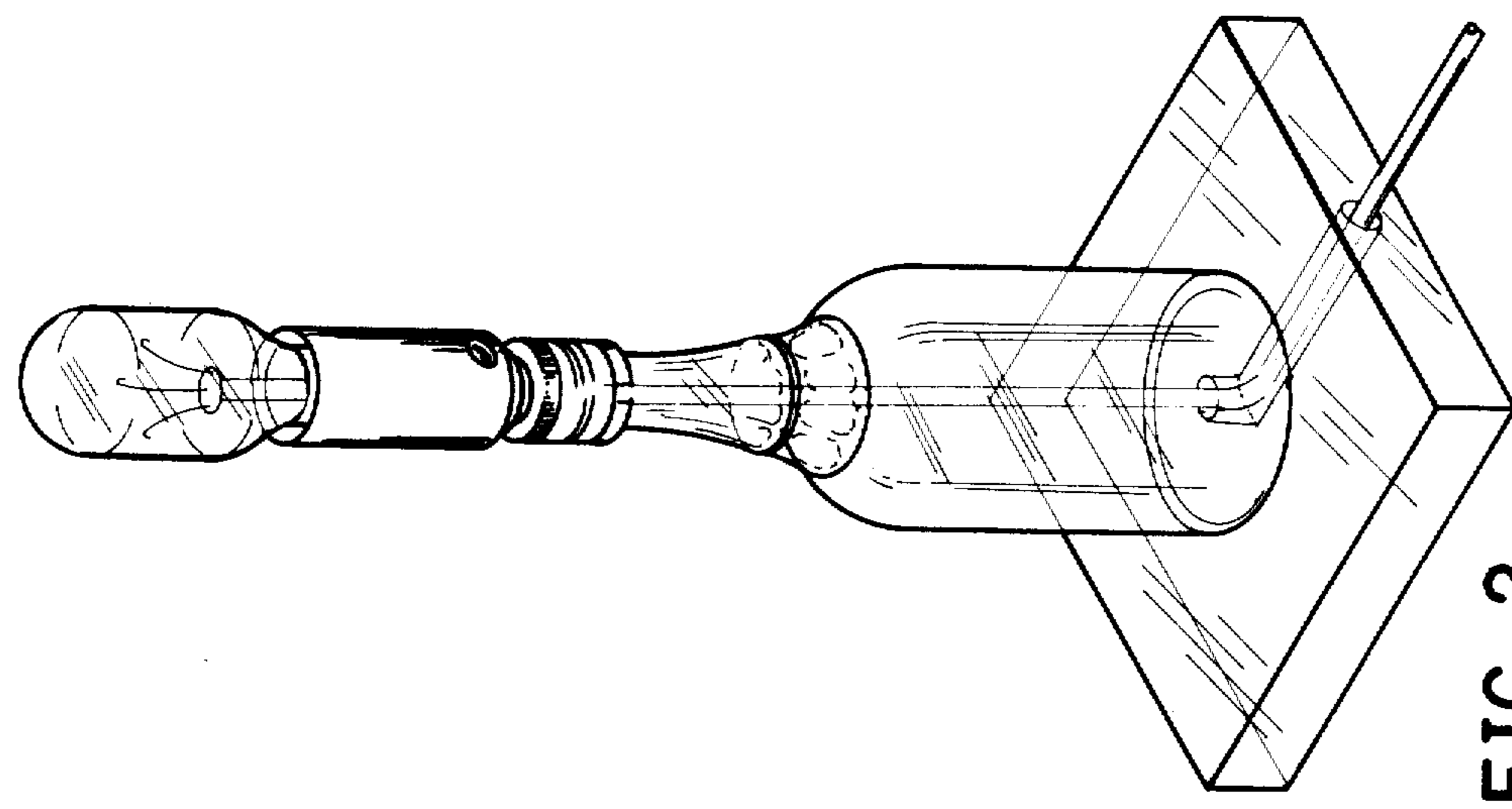

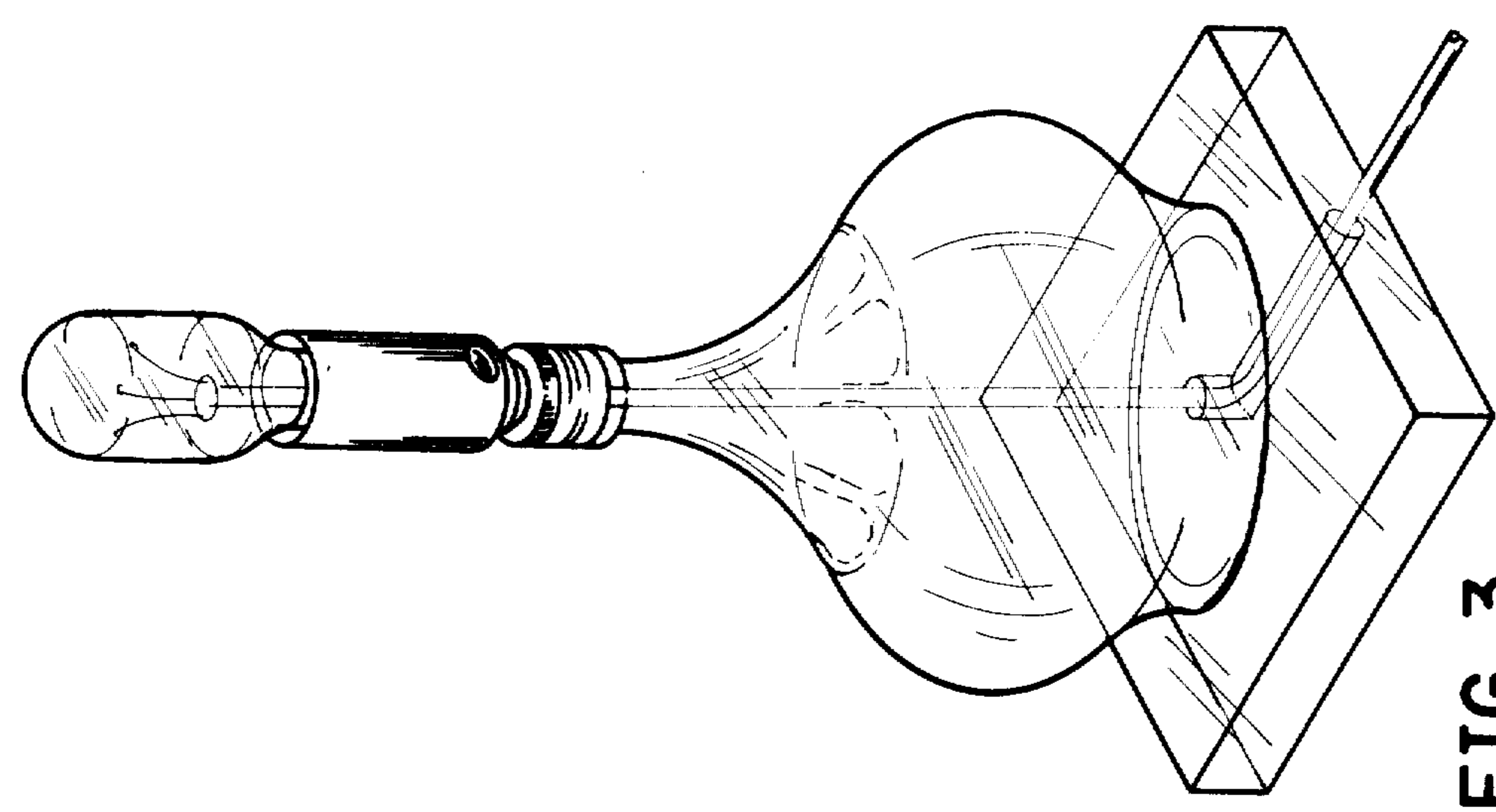

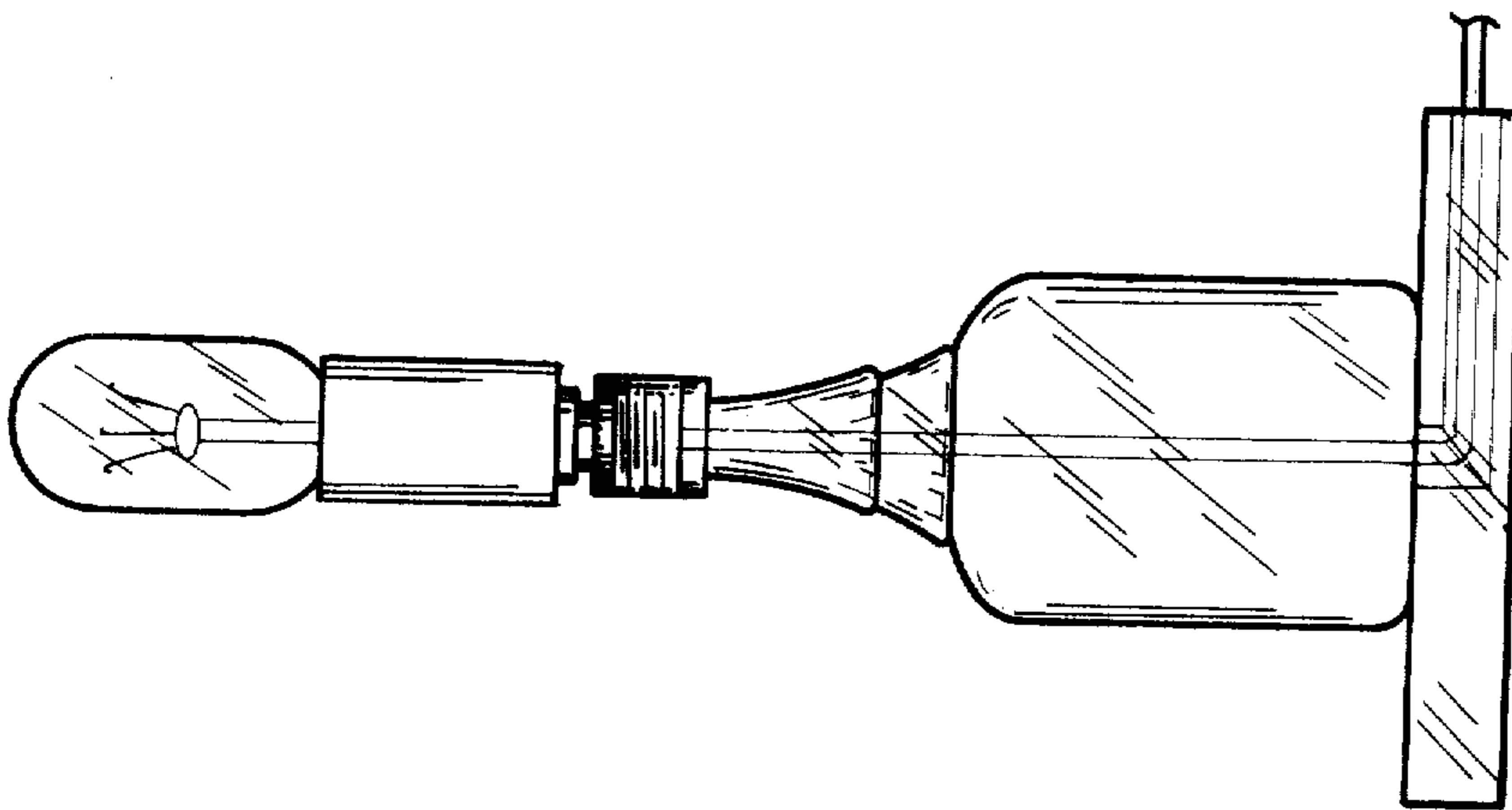

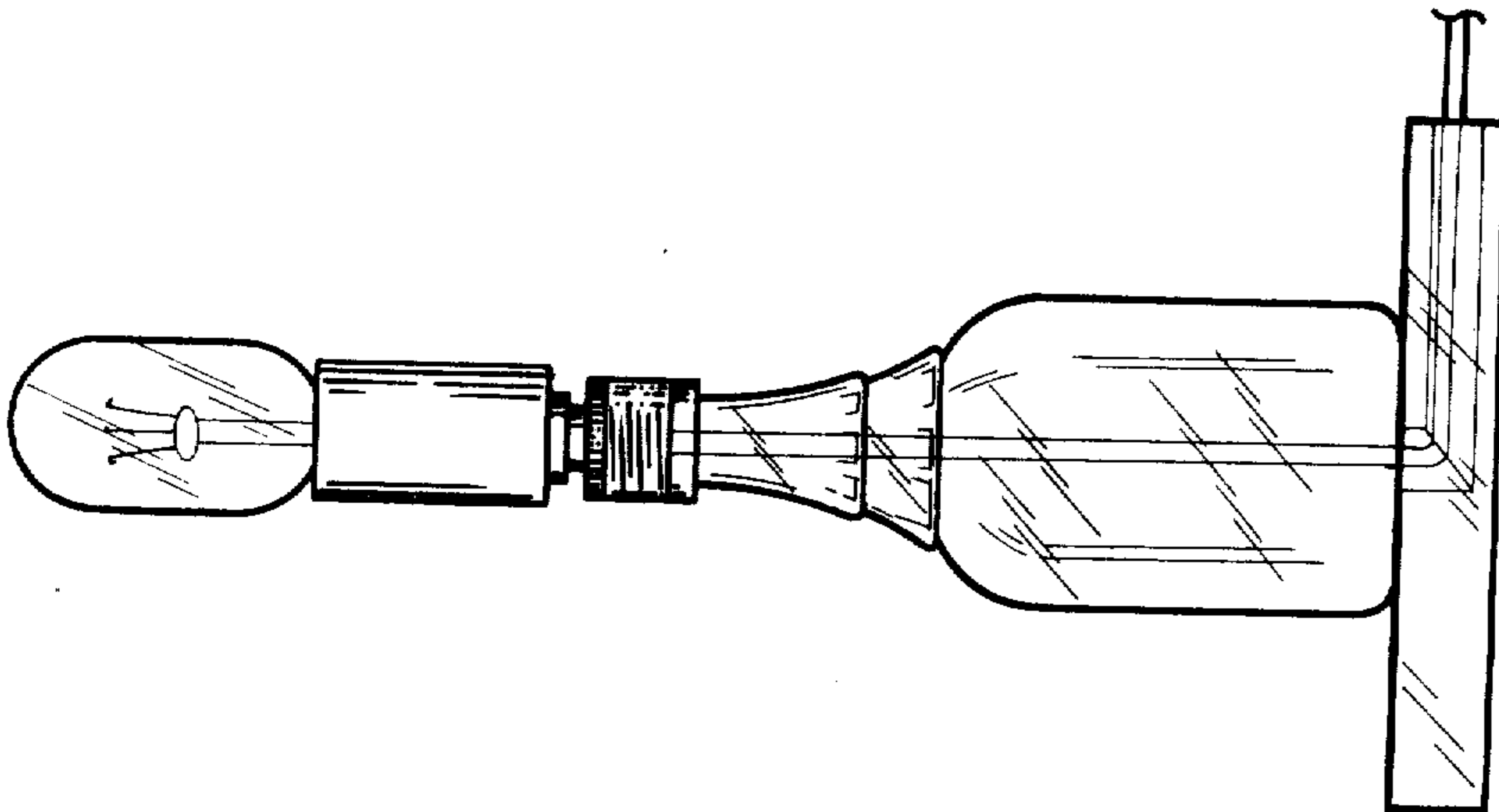

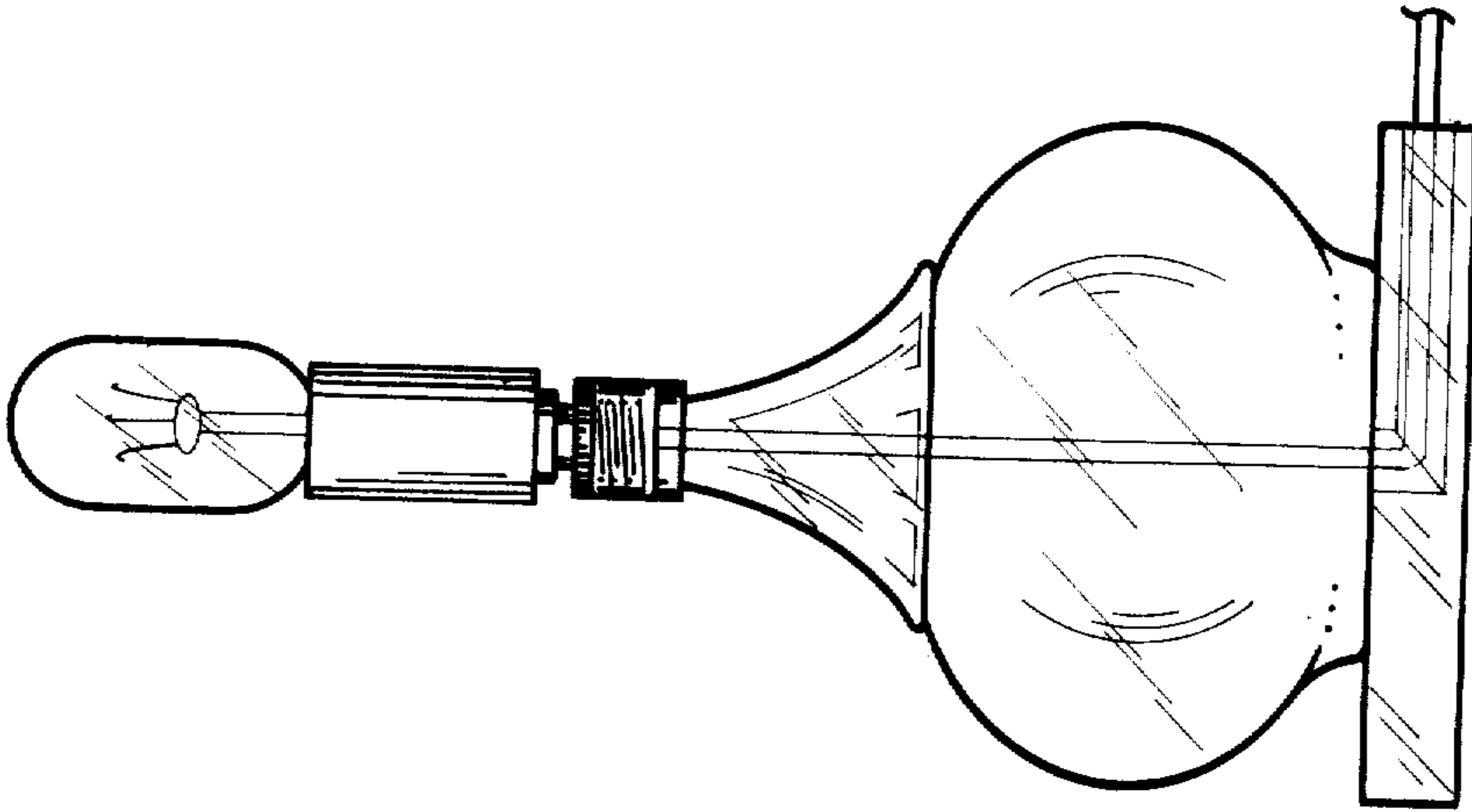
