The ornamental design for an escutcheon, as shown.

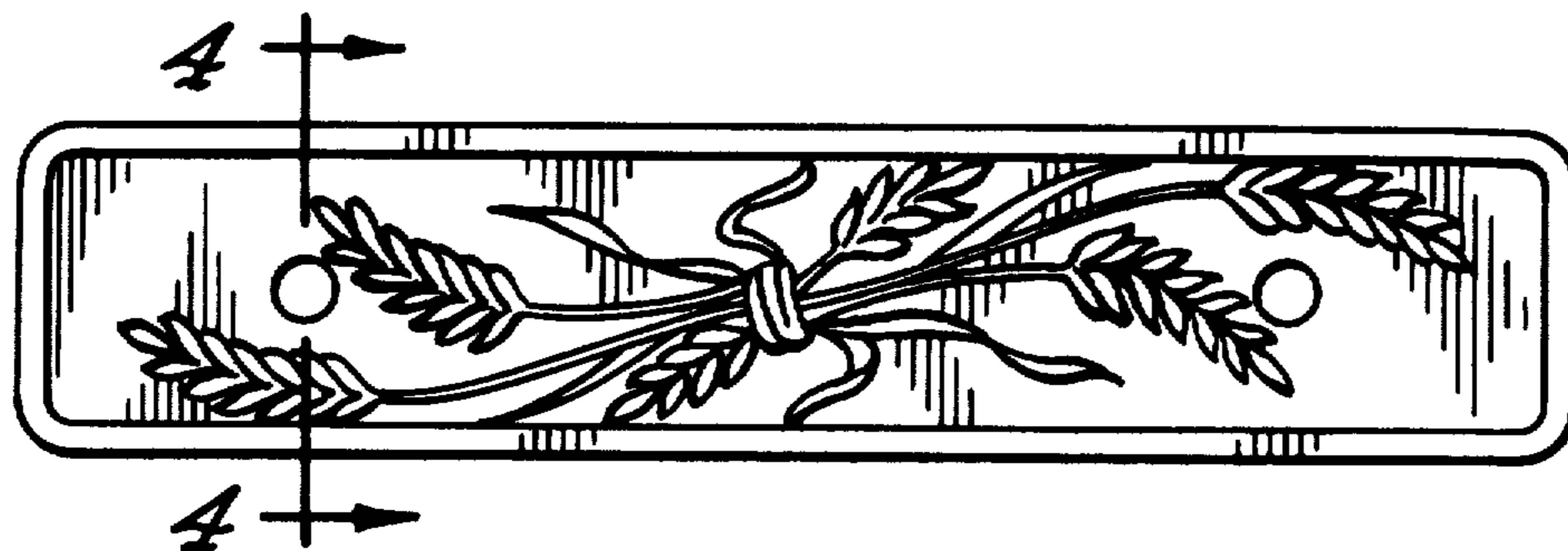
DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of an escutcheon incorporating my new design, the rear being flat and unornamented;

FIG. 2 is a side elevational view thereof;

FIG. 3 is an end elevational view thereof;

FIG. 4 is an enlarged sectional view taken along the line 4-4 in FIG. 1.



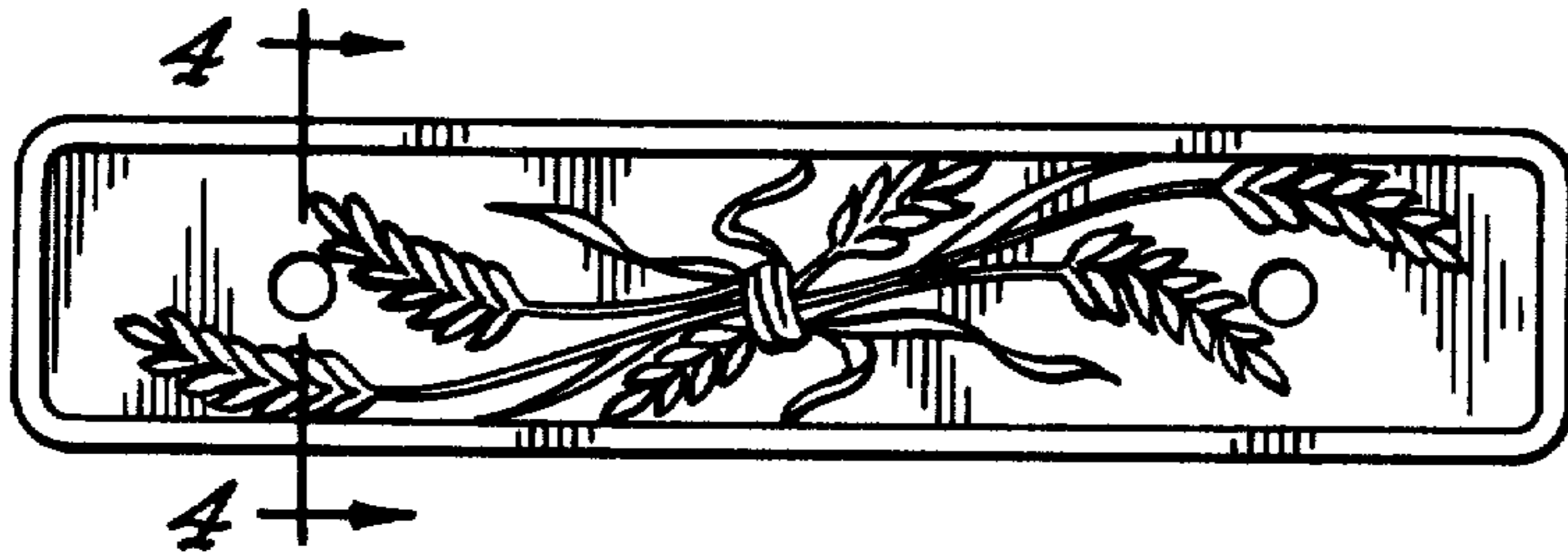

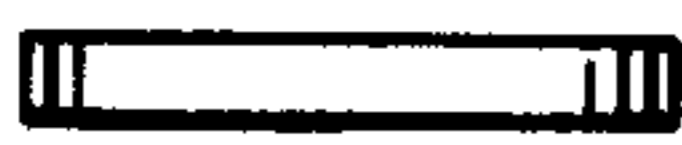
