The ornamental design for a carafe, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a left-side elevational view of a carafe showing our new design, the right-side elevational view being a mirror image;  
 FIG. 2 is a rear elevational view thereof;  
 FIG. 3 is a top plan view thereof;  
 FIG. 4 is a bottom plan view thereof; and  
 FIG. 5 is a cross-sectional view on an enlarged scale taken along the line 5-5 of FIG. 1.

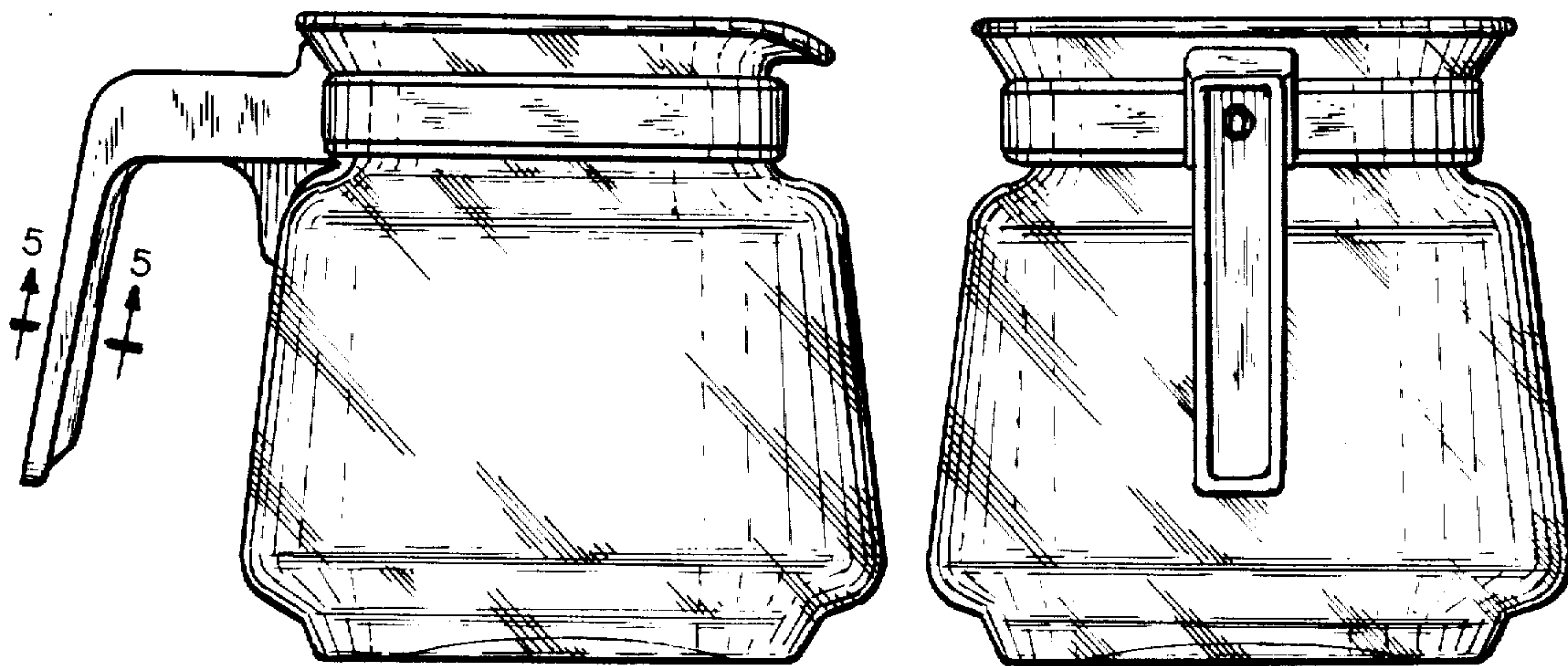

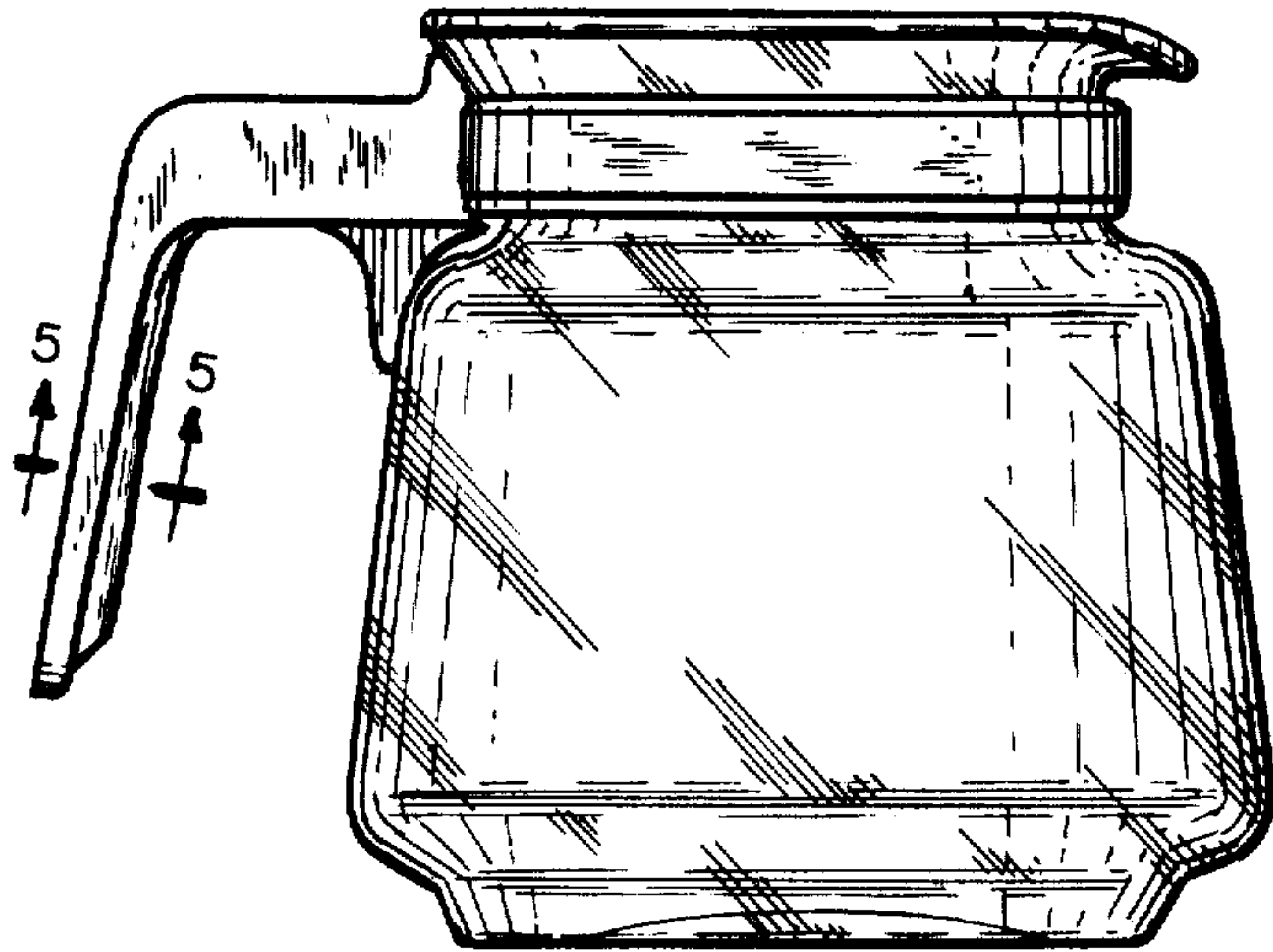

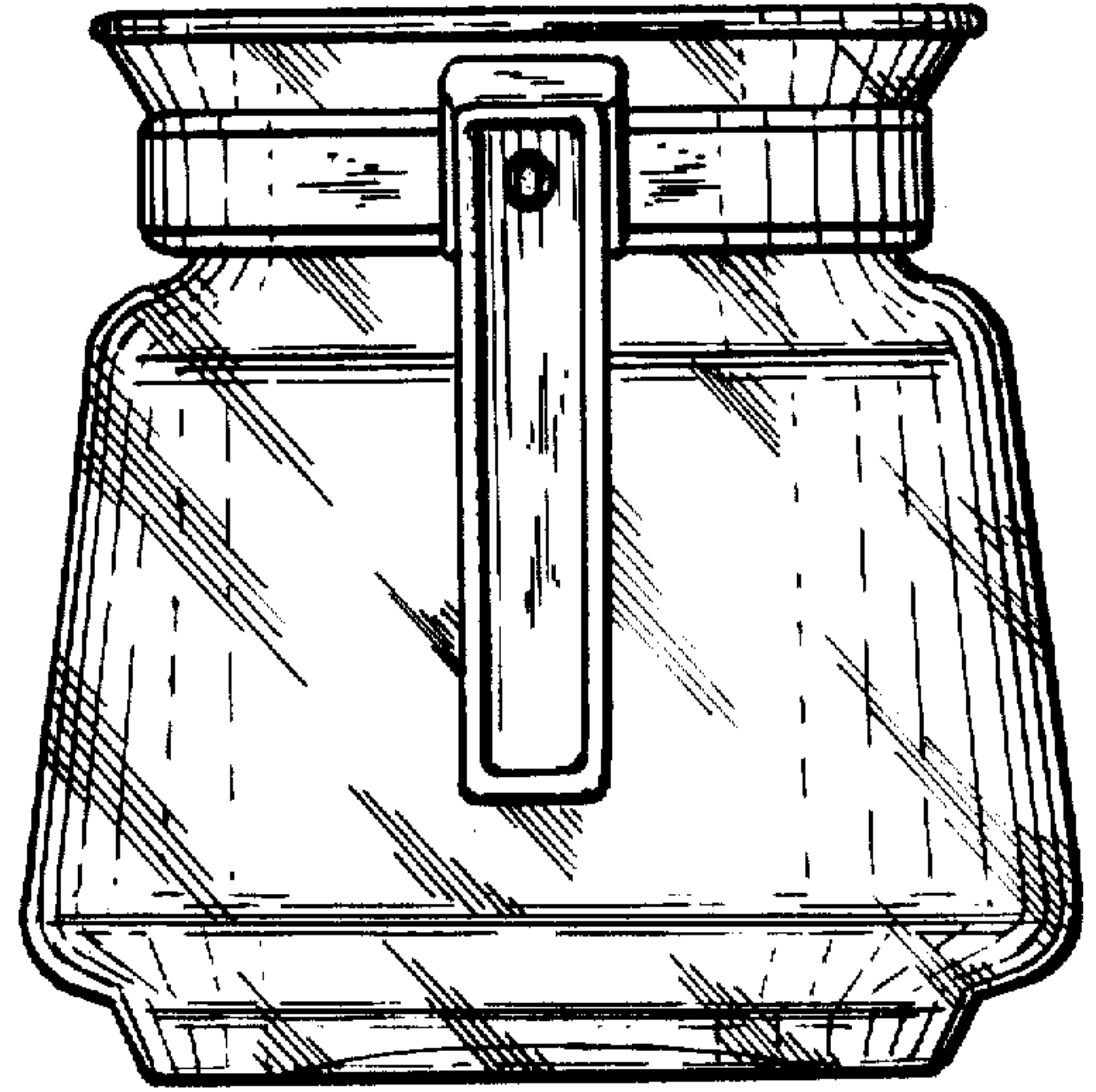

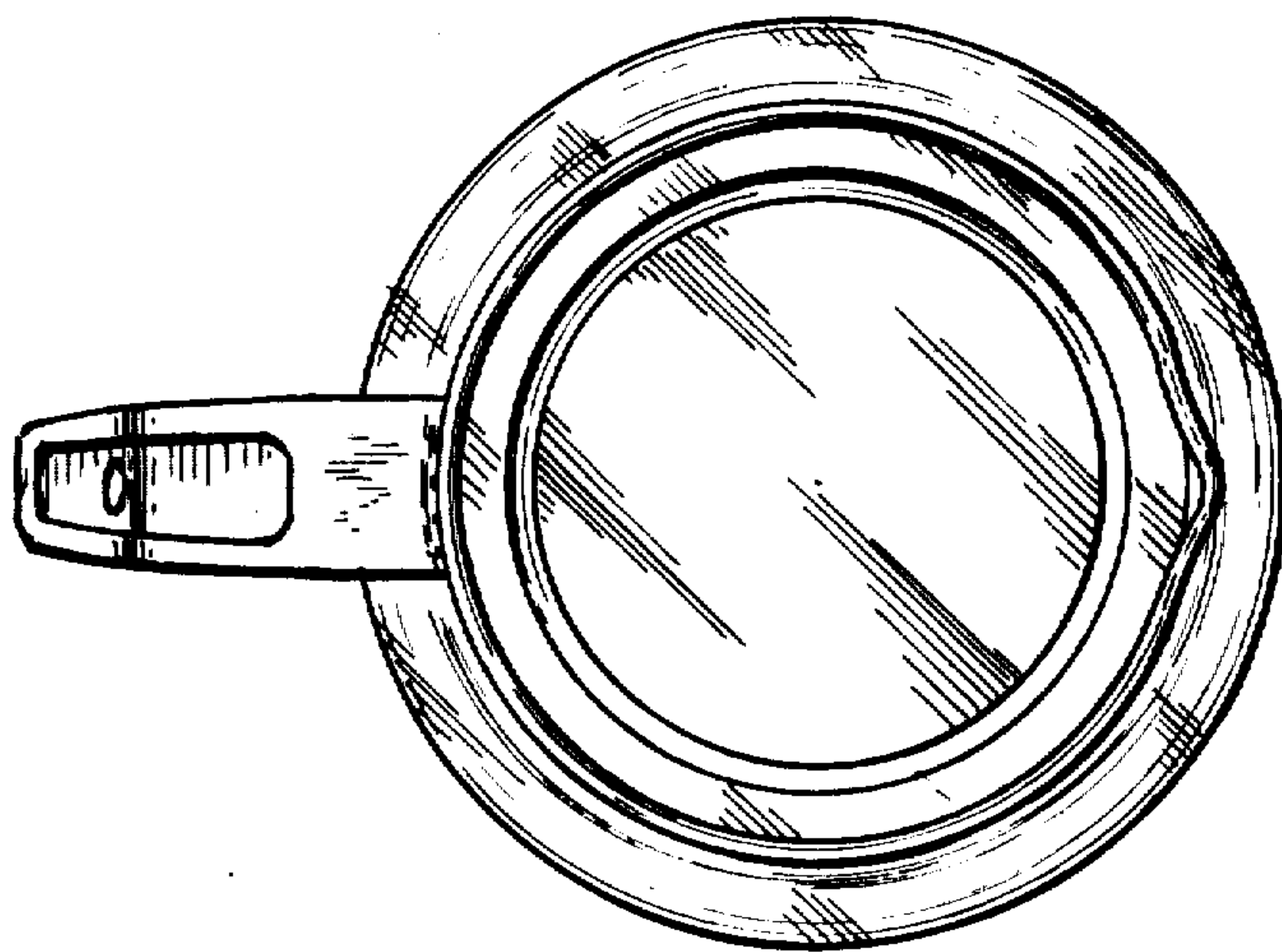

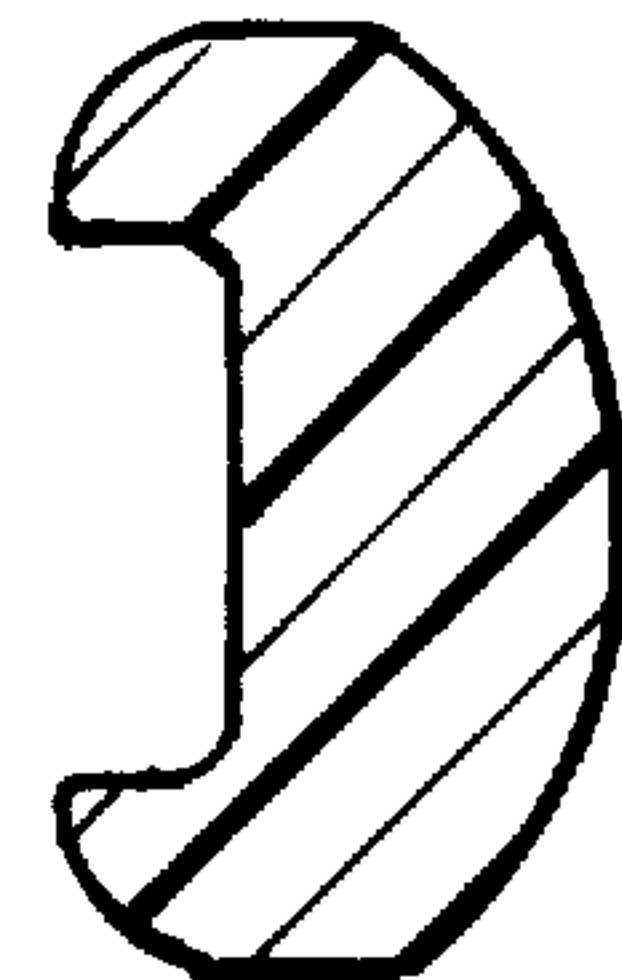
