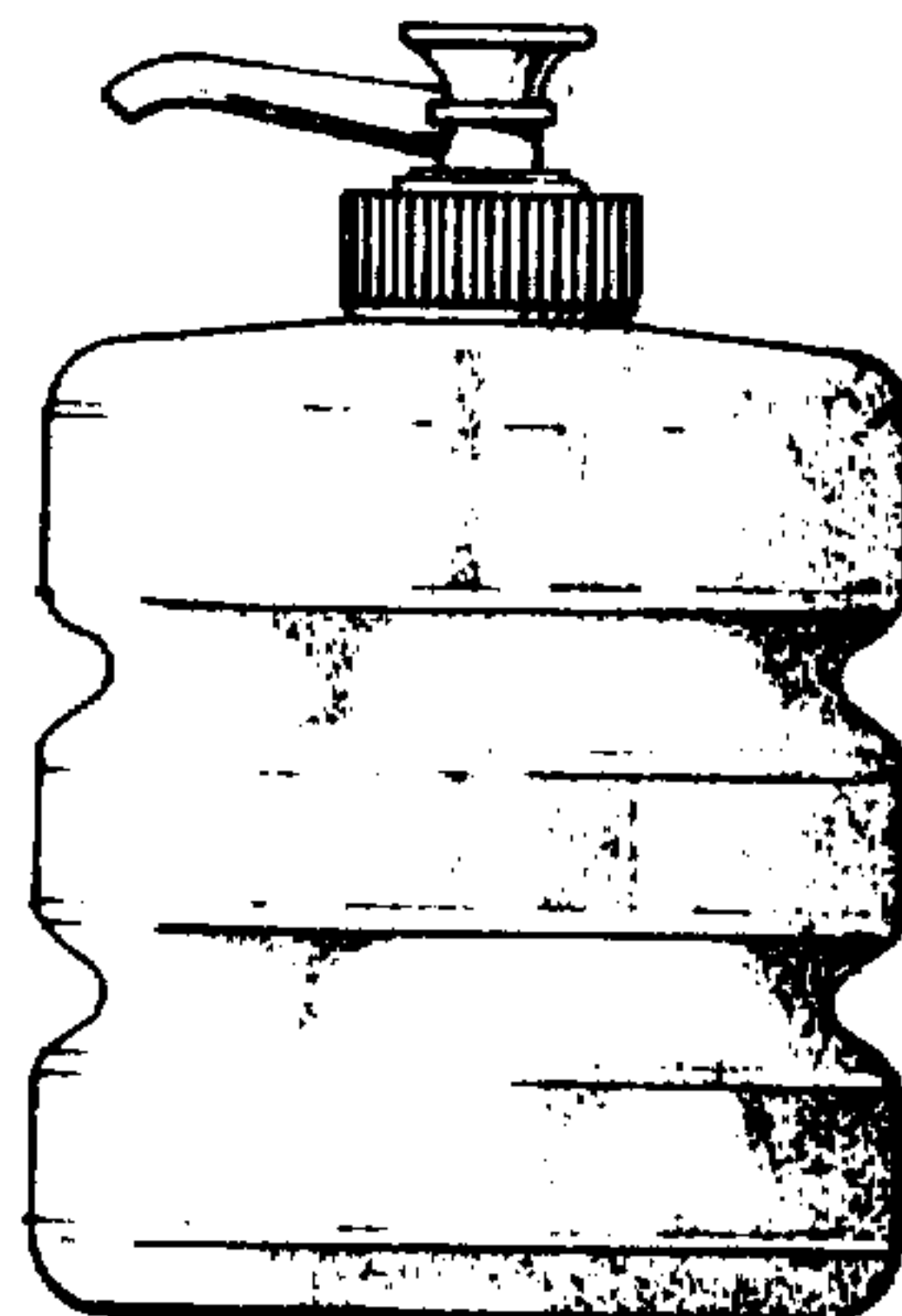

[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a bottle, substantially as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a bottle showing my new design;
 FIG. 2 is a rear elevational view;
 FIG. 3 is an elevational view looking from the right of FIG. 1 with the dispensing spout turned 180 degrees from the position in FIG. 1;
 FIG. 4 is an elevational view showing the side opposite that seen in FIG. 3;
 FIG. 5 is a top plan view; and
 FIG. 6 is a bottom plan view thereof;
 FIG. 7 is a front elevational view showing another embodiment of my new design;
 FIG. 8 is a rear elevational view;
 FIG. 9 is an elevational view looking from the right of FIG. 1 with the dispensing spout turned 180 degrees from the position in FIG. 7;
 FIG. 10 is an elevational view showing the side opposite that seen in FIG. 9;
 FIG. 11 is a top plan view; and
 FIG. 12 is a bottom plan view thereof.



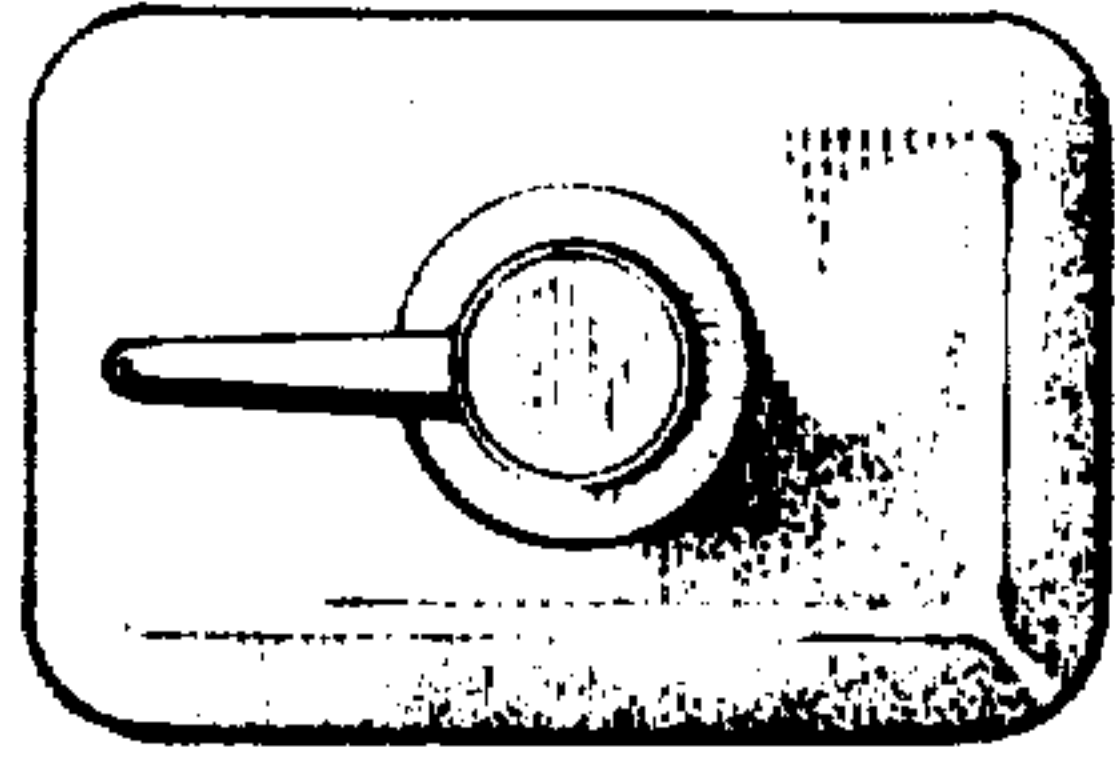

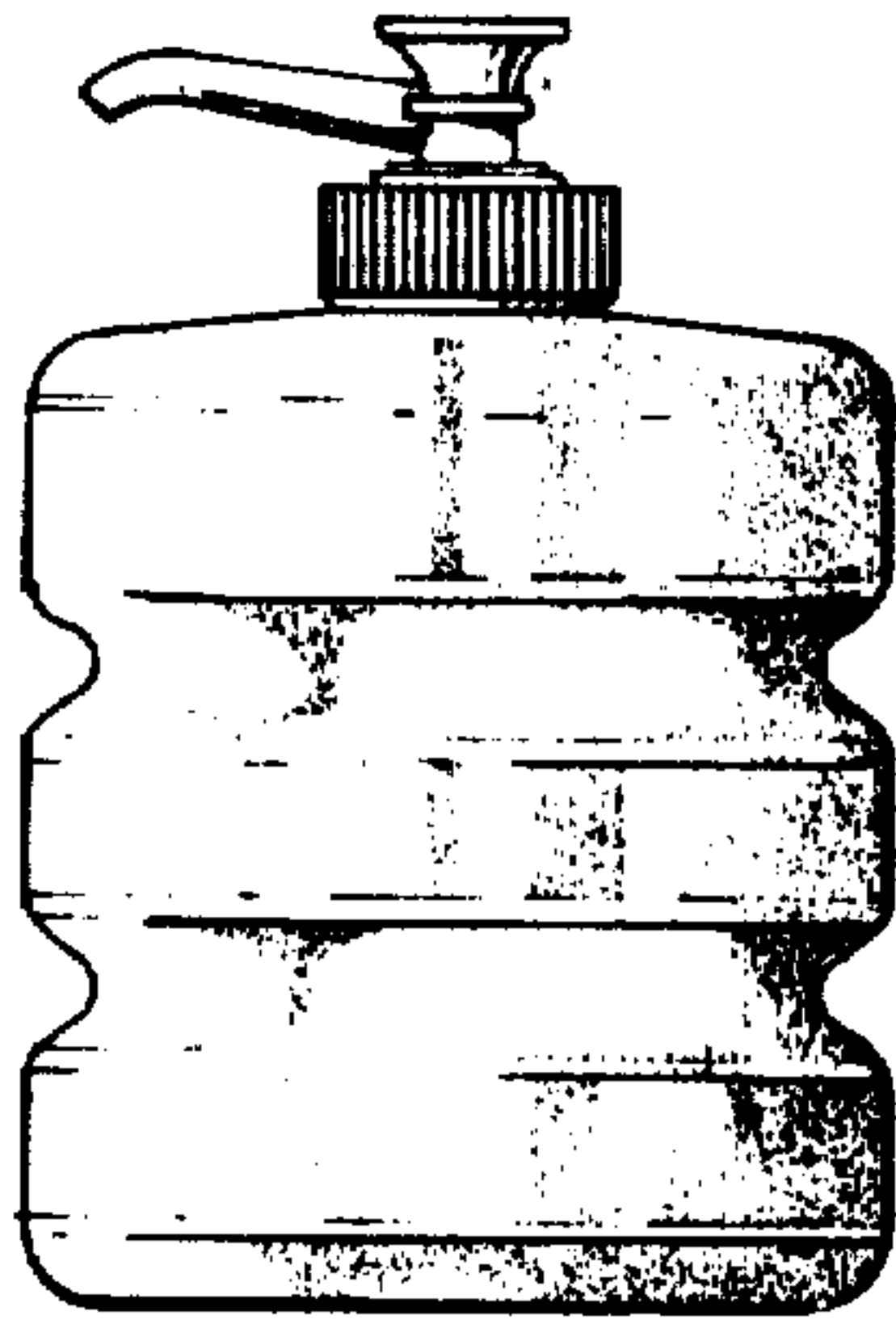

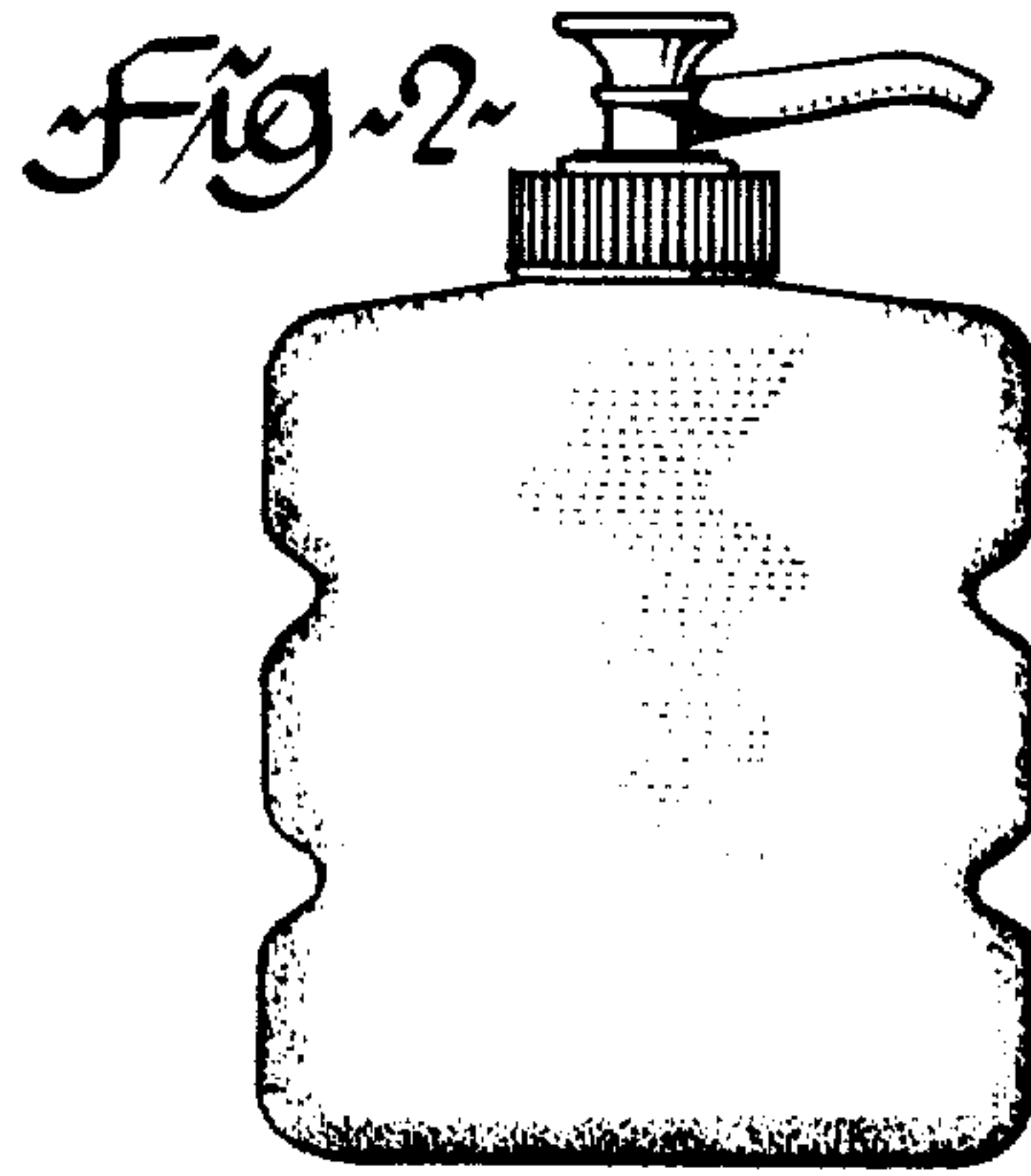

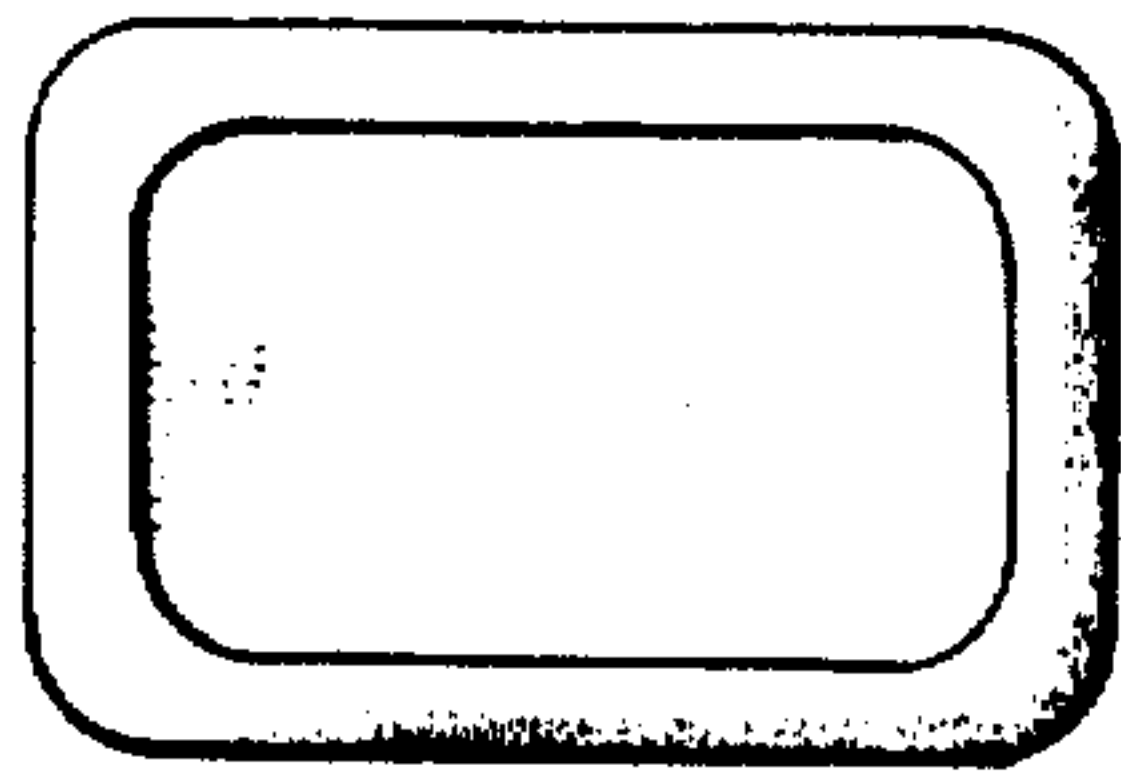

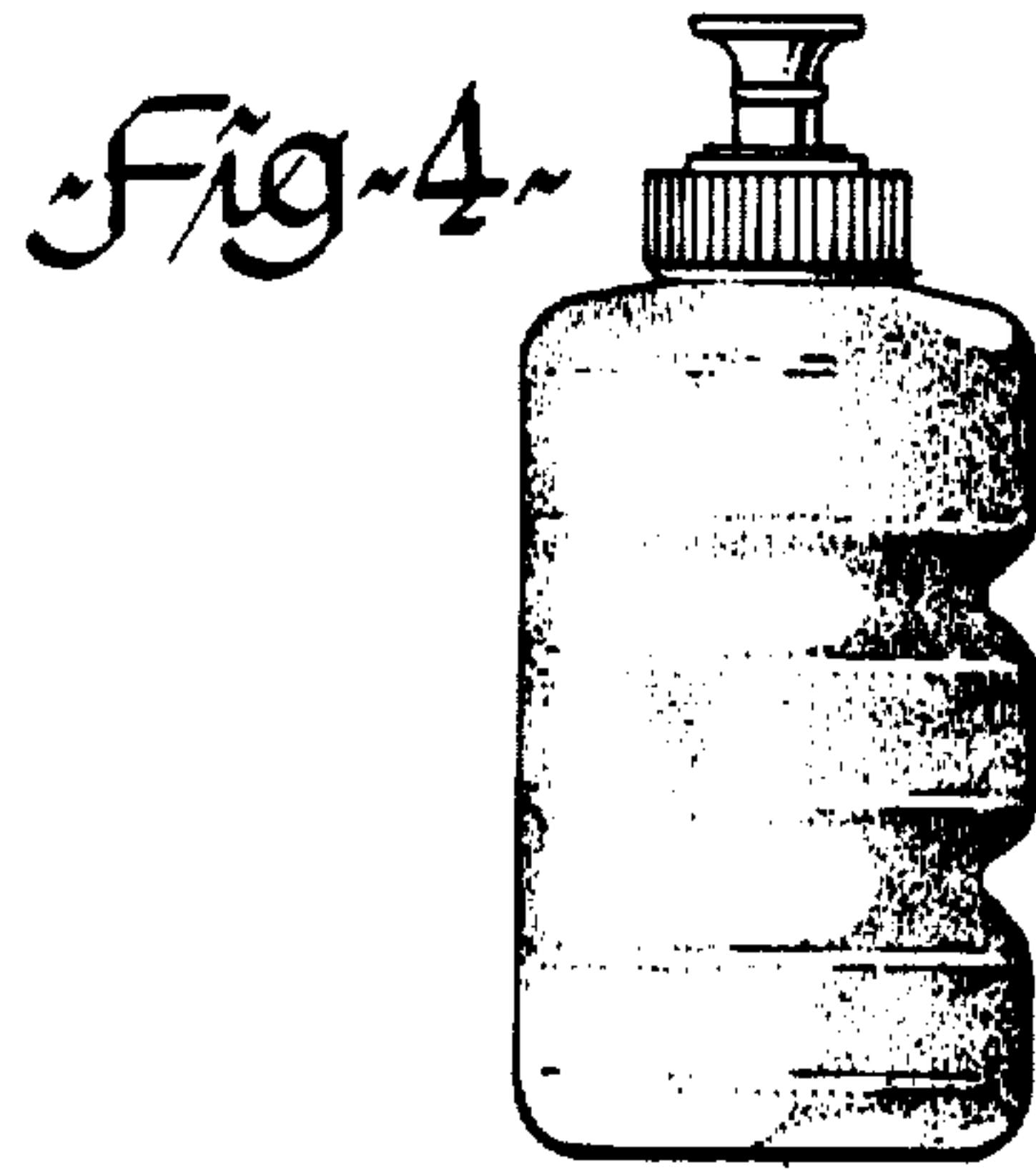

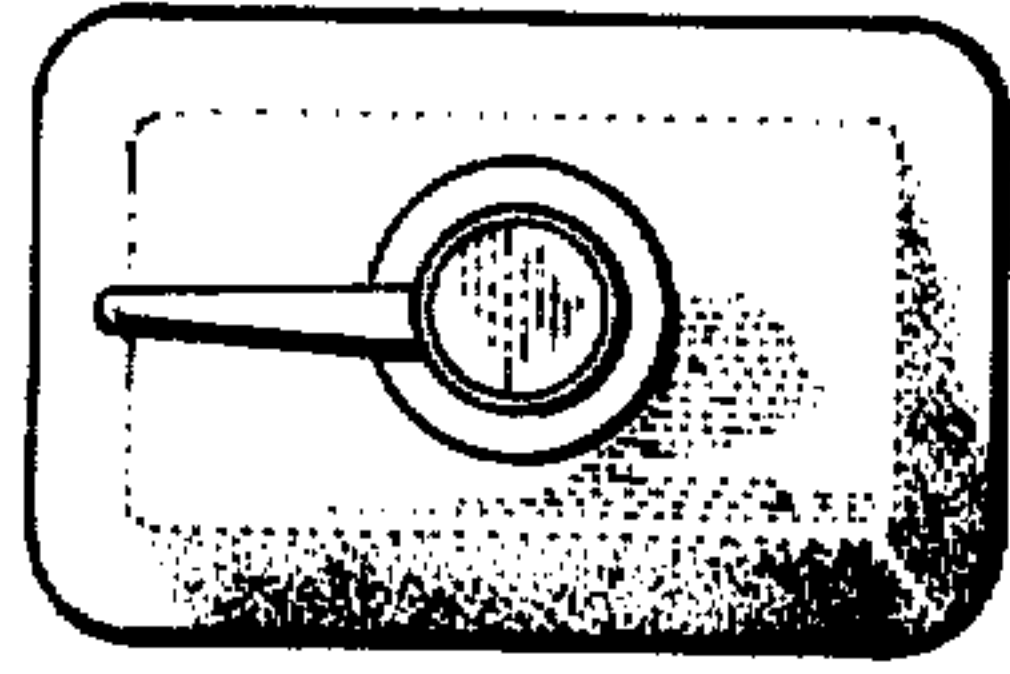

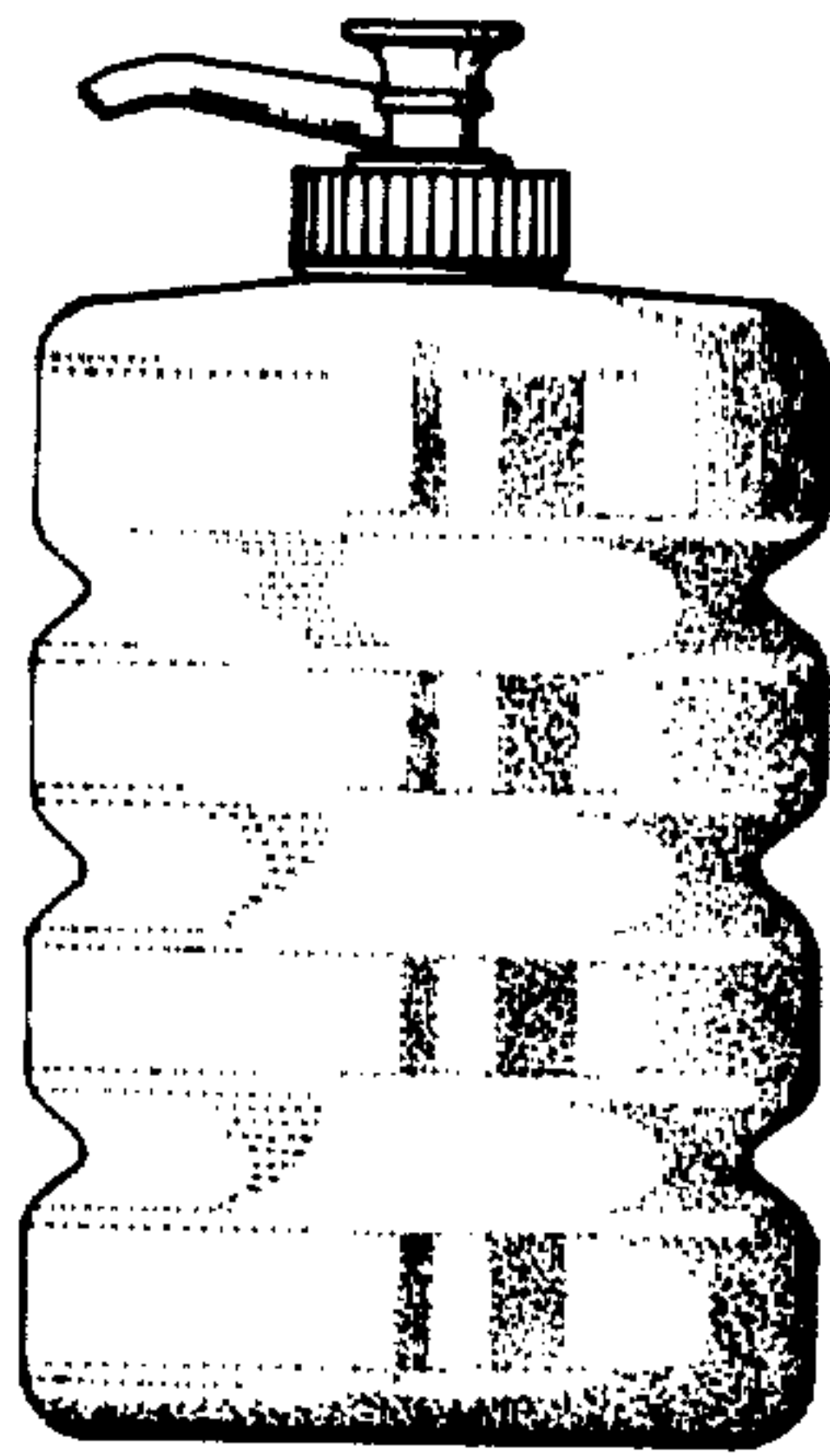

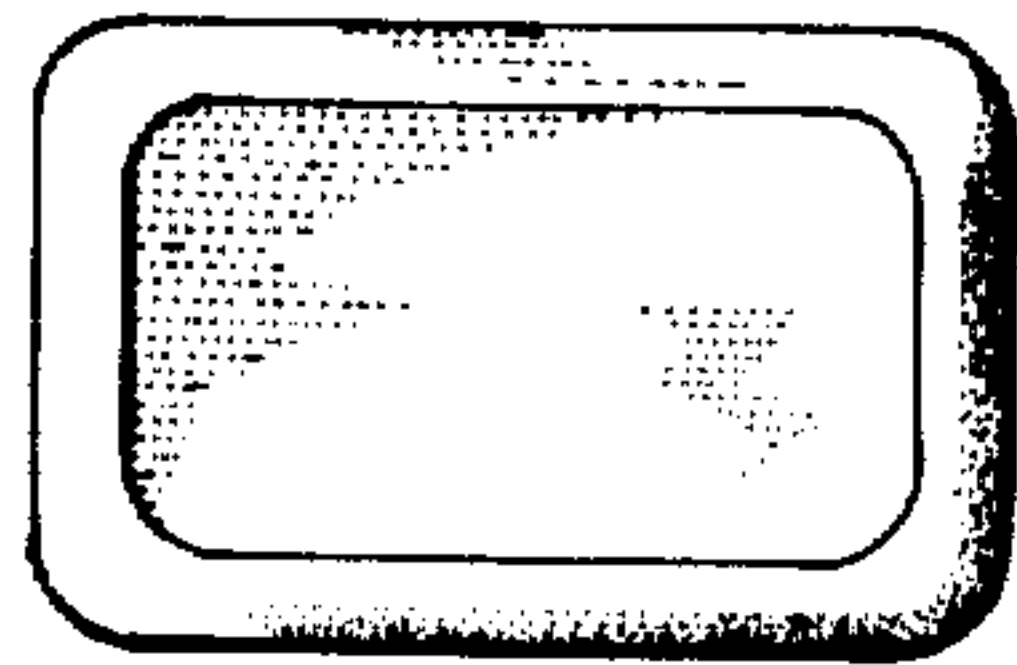
