 FIG. 4 is a plan view of the exterior of FIG. 3.

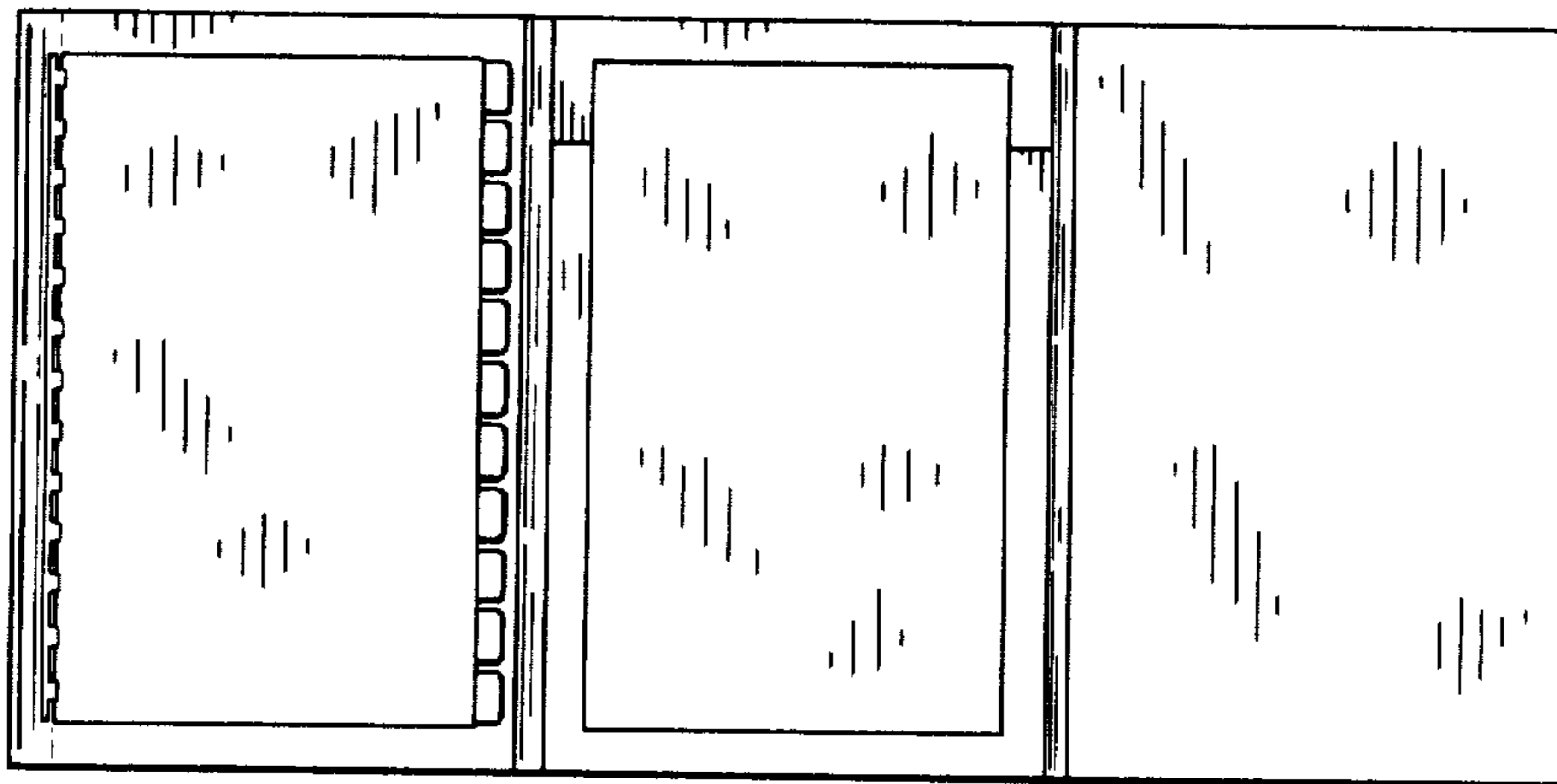
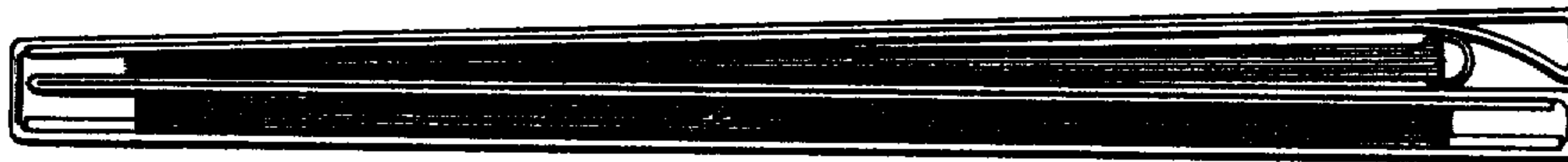

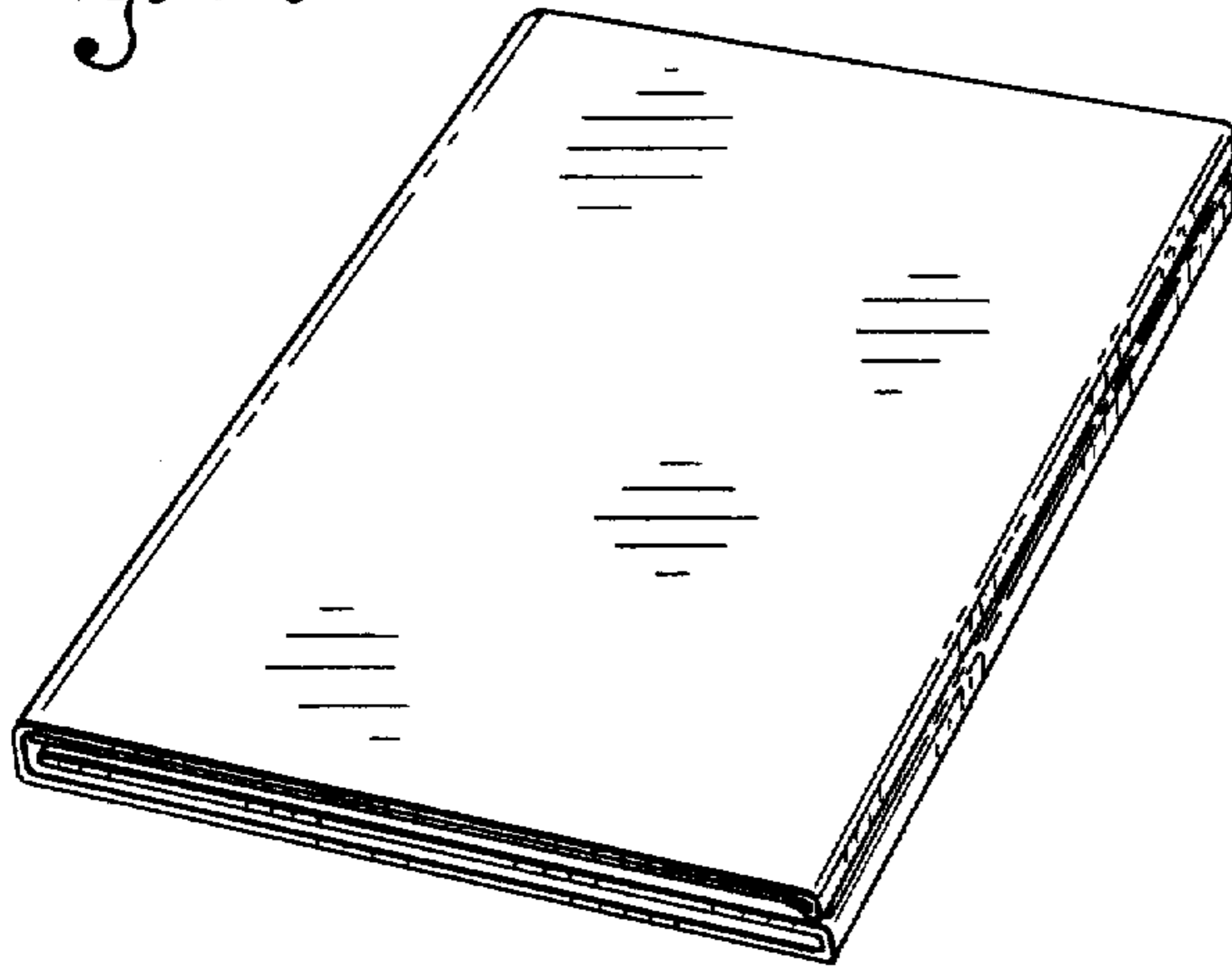

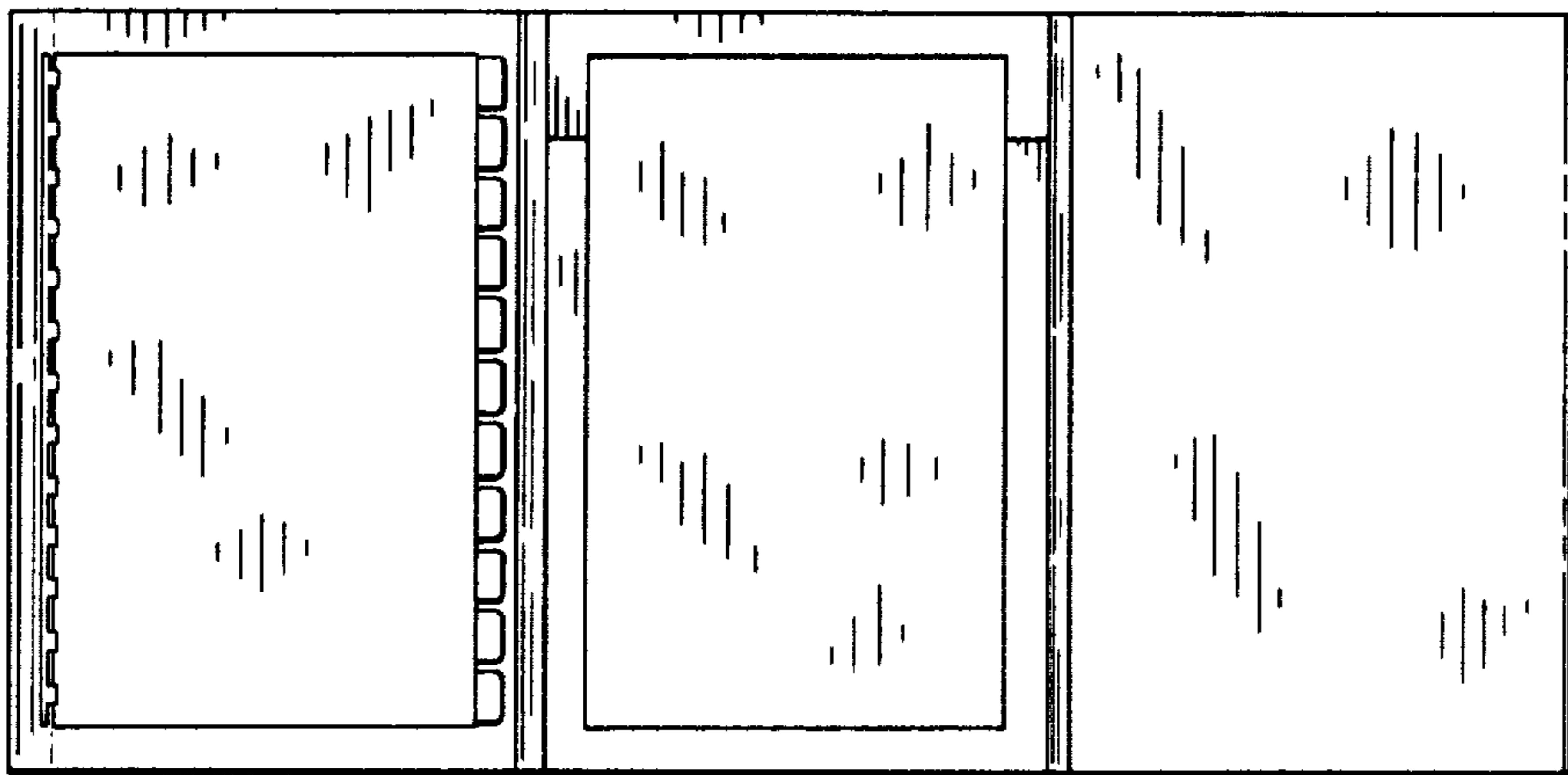
