FIG. 1 is a top plan view of a three-dimensional game board, showing my new design.

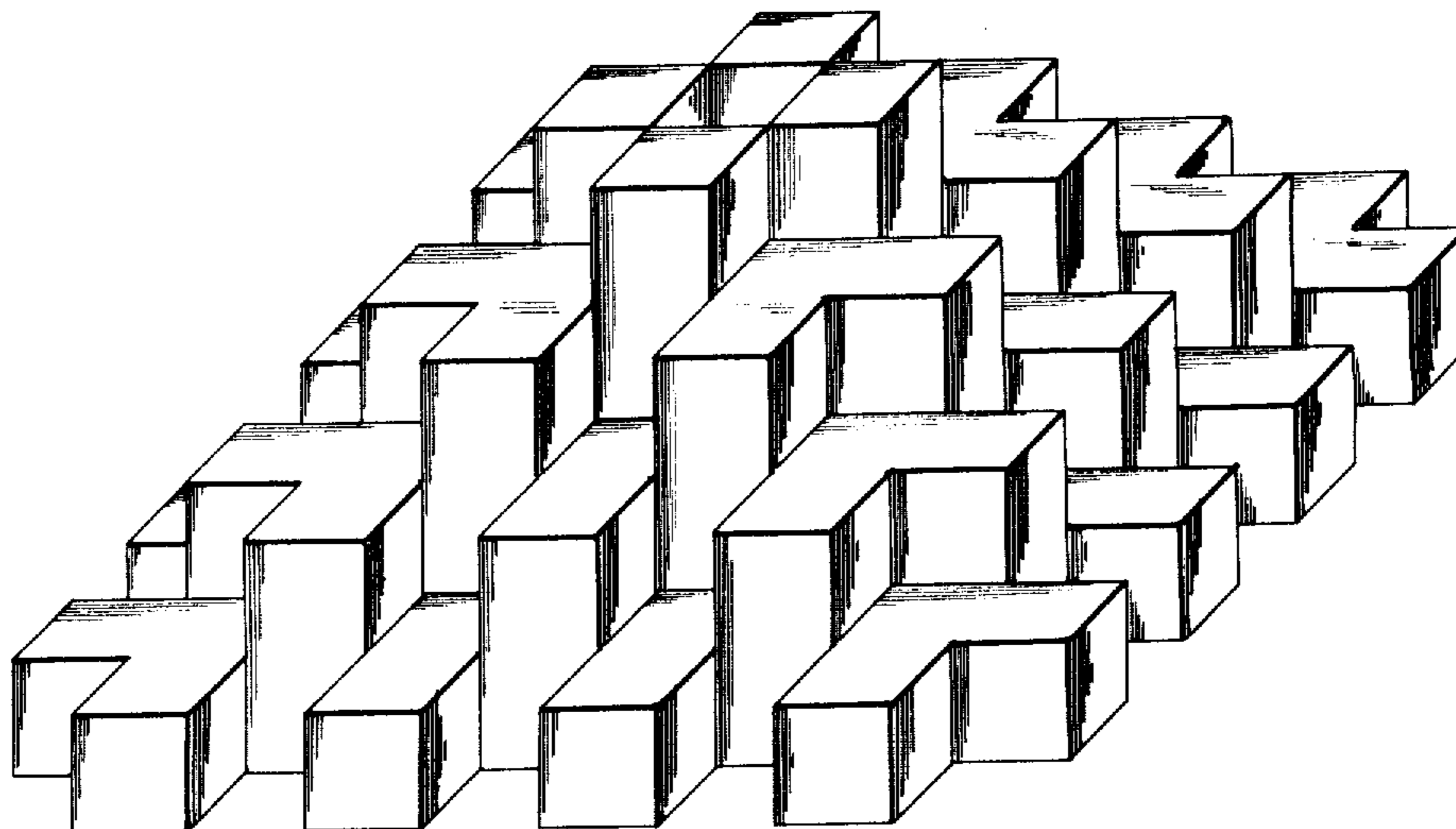

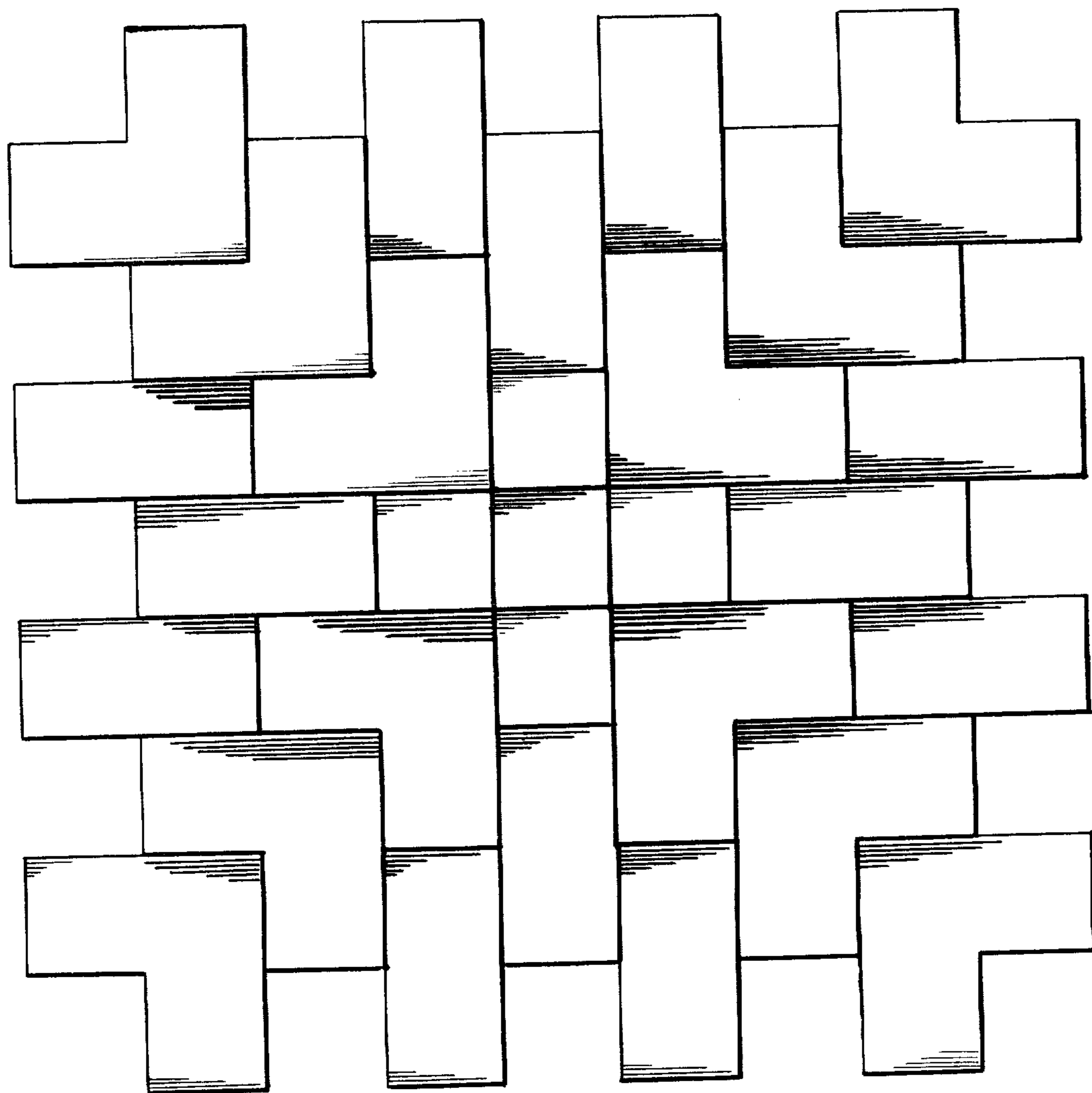

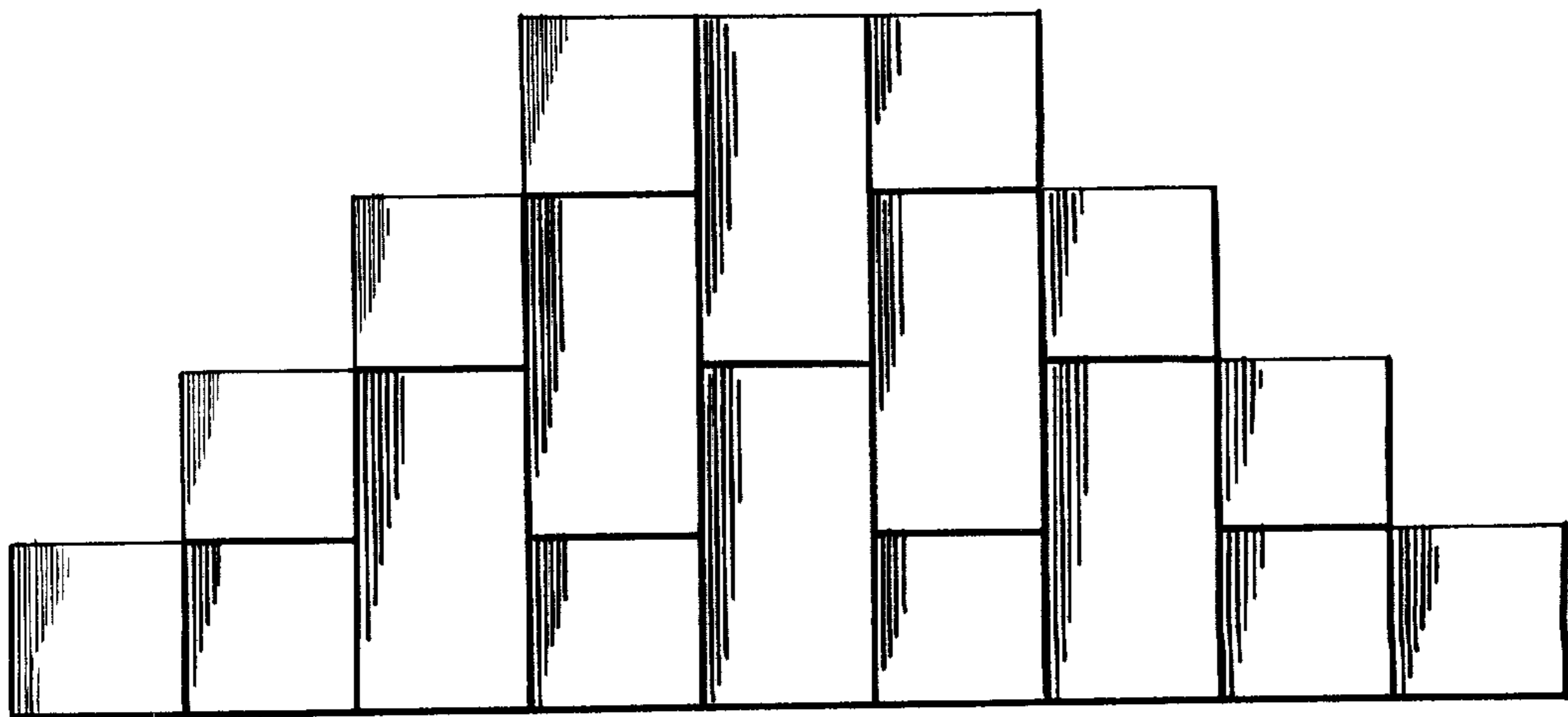

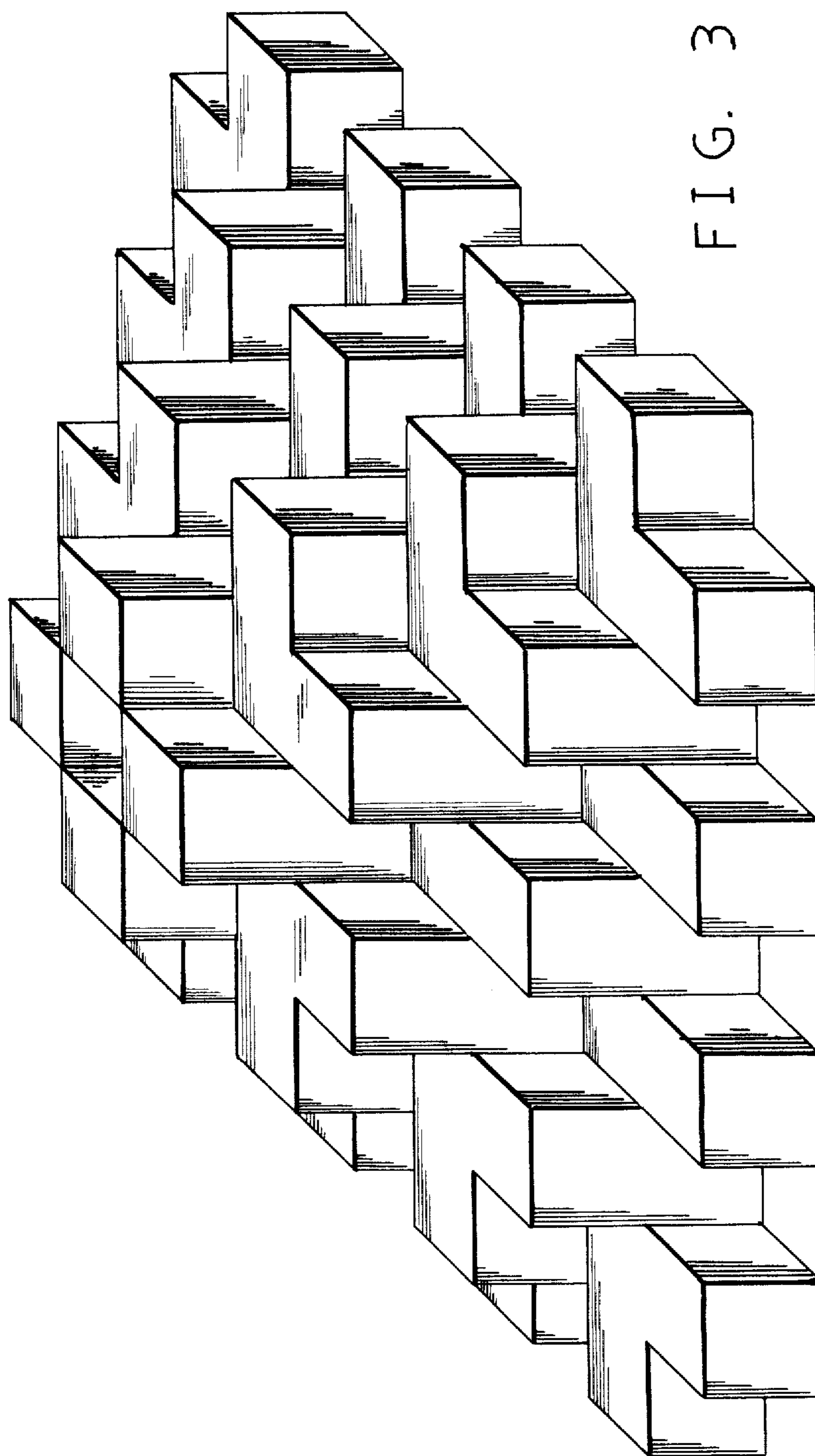
