[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a crystalline holder for smoking pipe, substantially as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of a crystalline holder for smoking pipe, showing my new design; FIG. 2 is a rear perspective view thereof; FIG. 3 is a front perspective view of a second embodiment of a crystalline holder for smoking pipe; FIG. 4 is a front perspective view of a third embodiment of a crystalline holder for smoking pipe; FIG. 5 is a front perspective view of a fourth embodiment of a crystalline holder for smoking pipe. The broken line disclosure of a smoking pipe in FIG. 1 is for illustrative purposes only and forms no part of the claimed design.

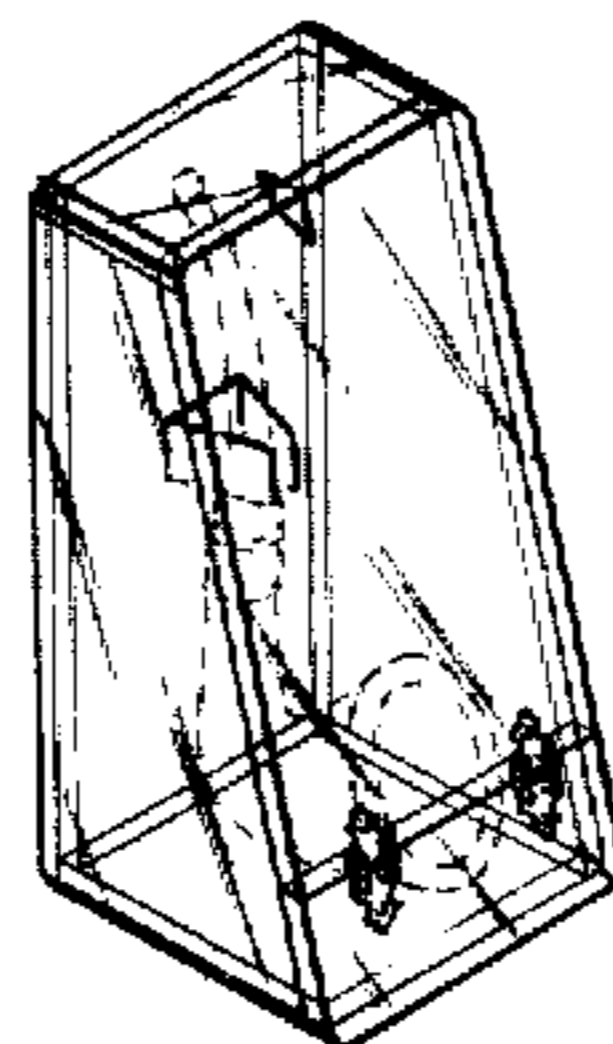

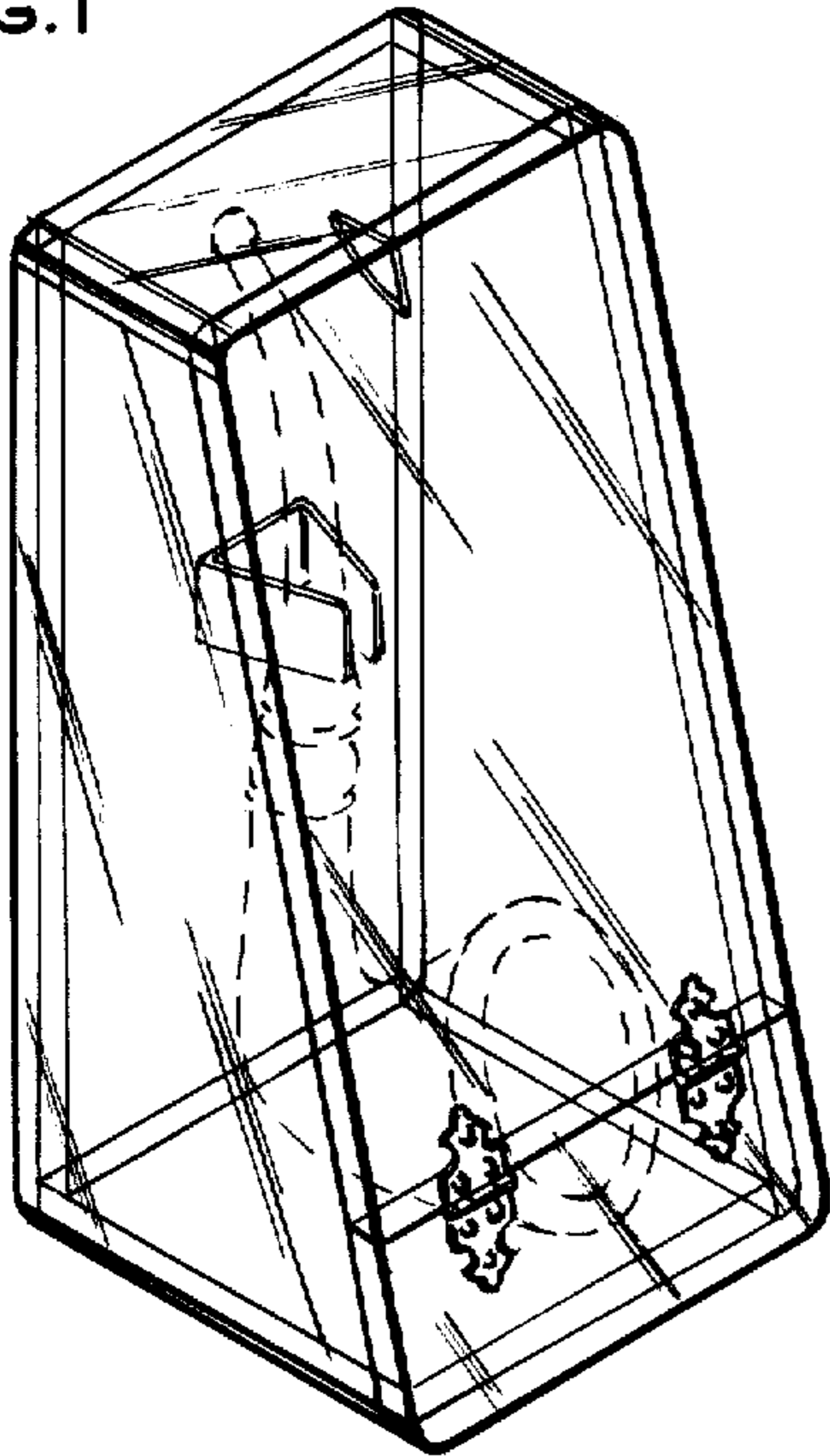

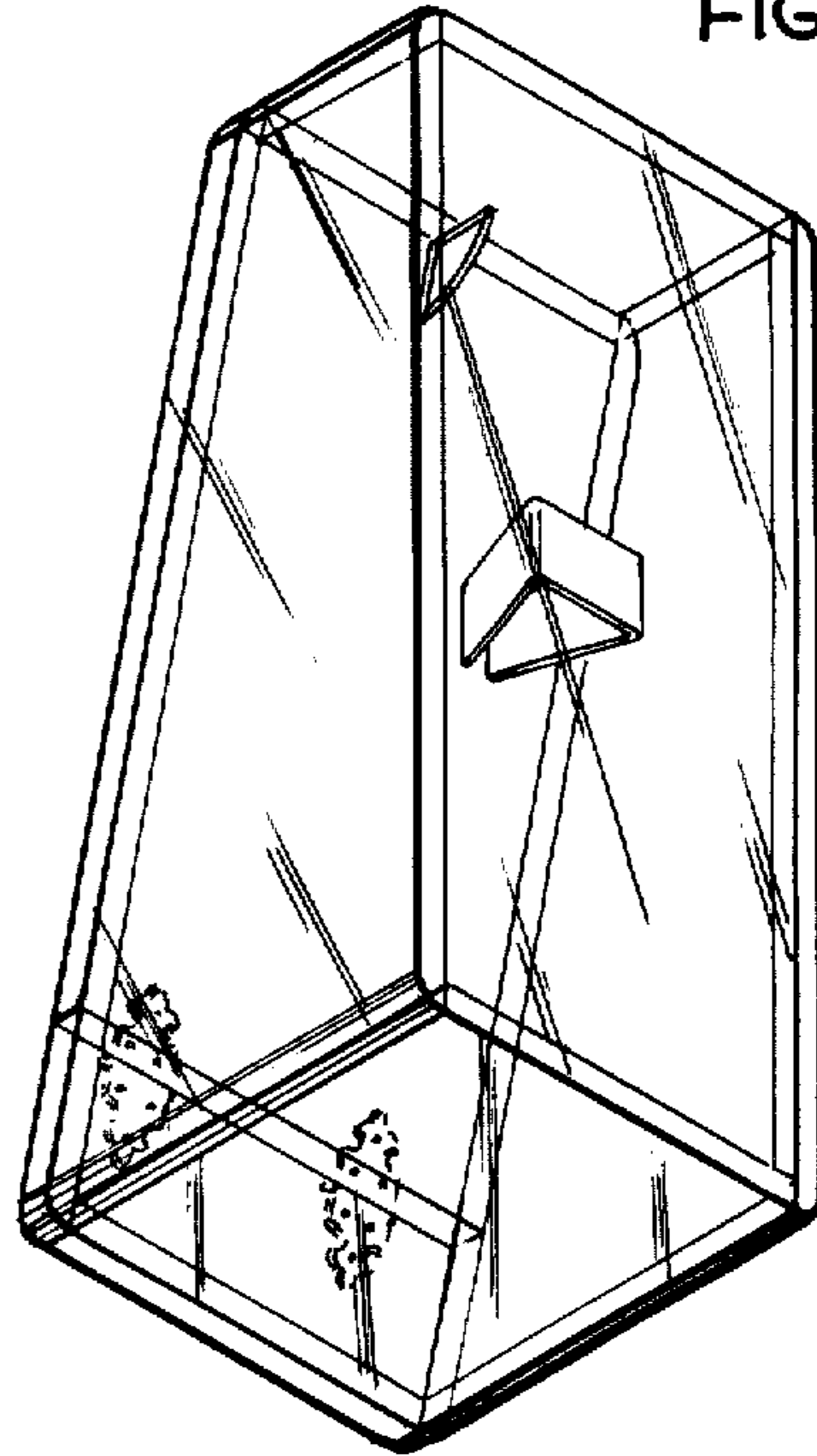

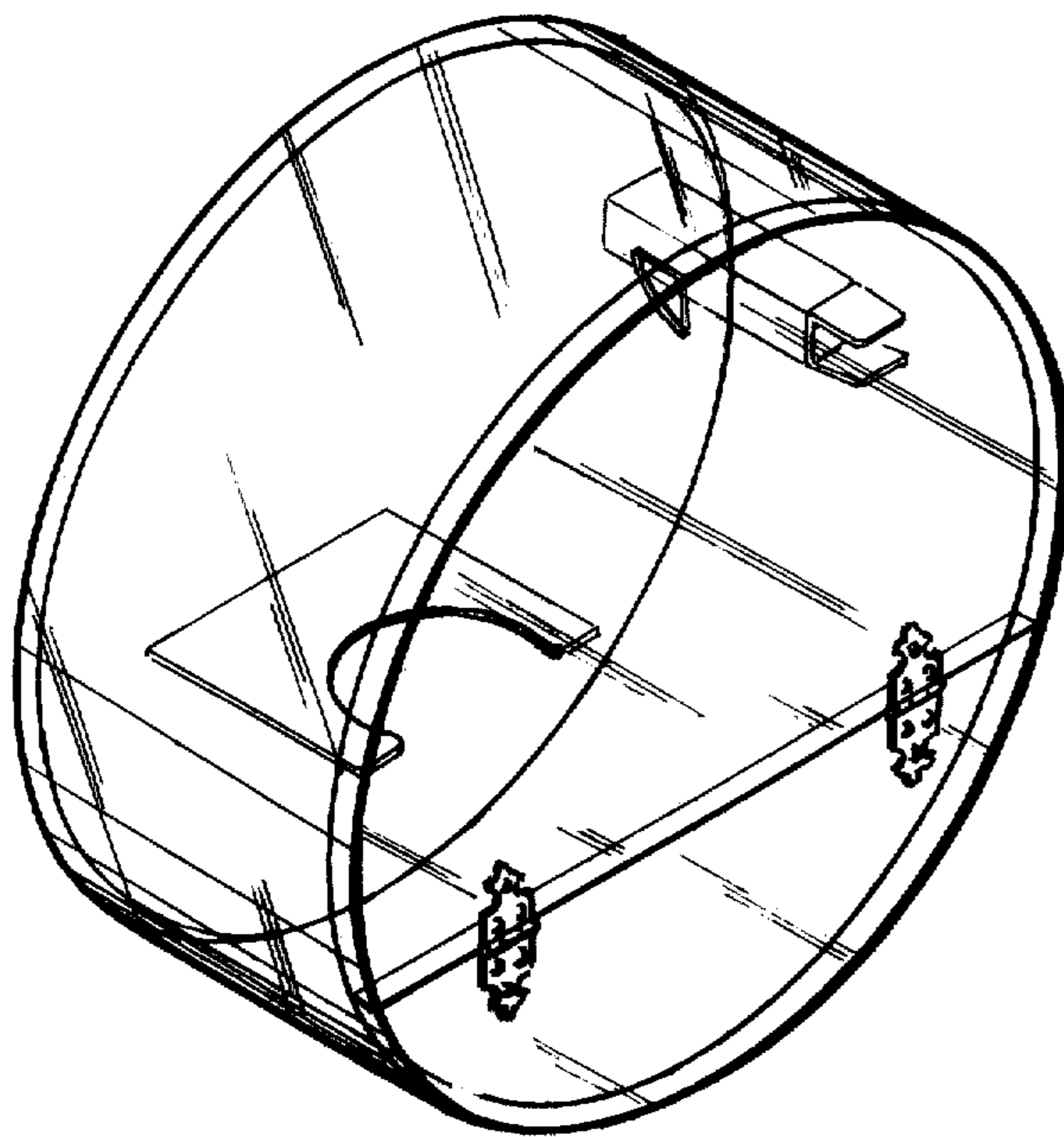

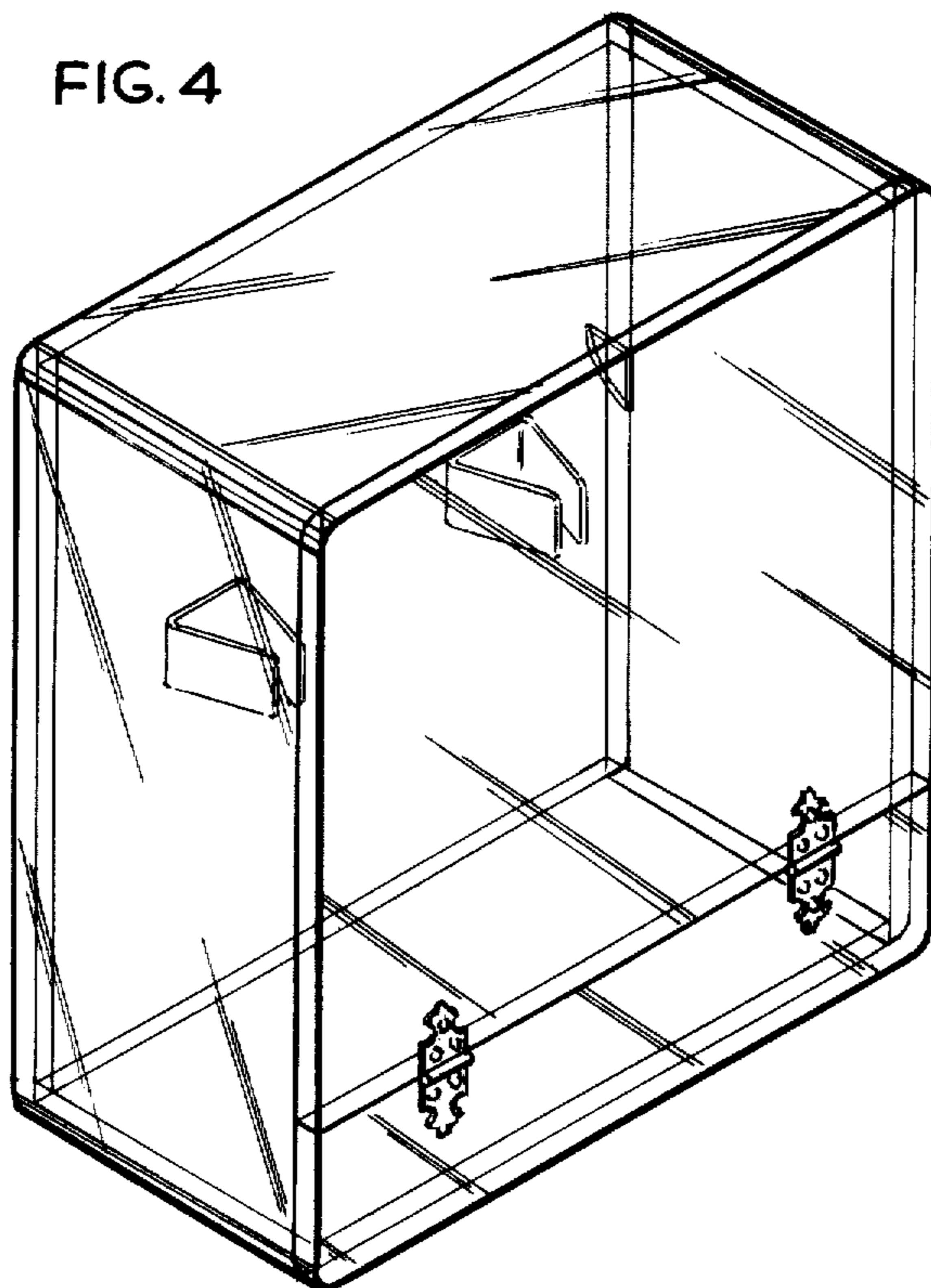
