DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a right-side elevational view of a box for video tapes showing my new design;

 FIG. 7 is a perspective front view thereof.

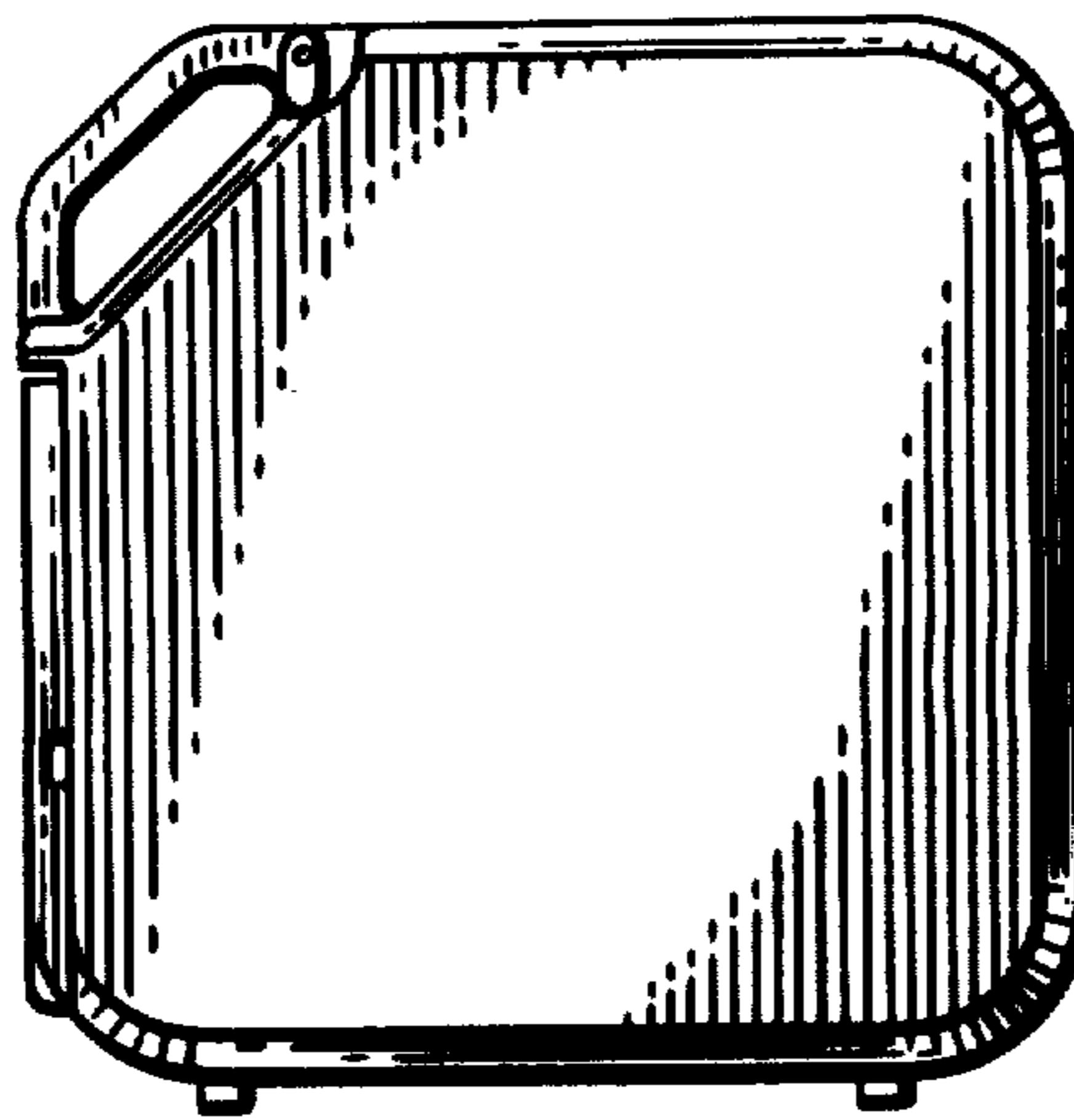

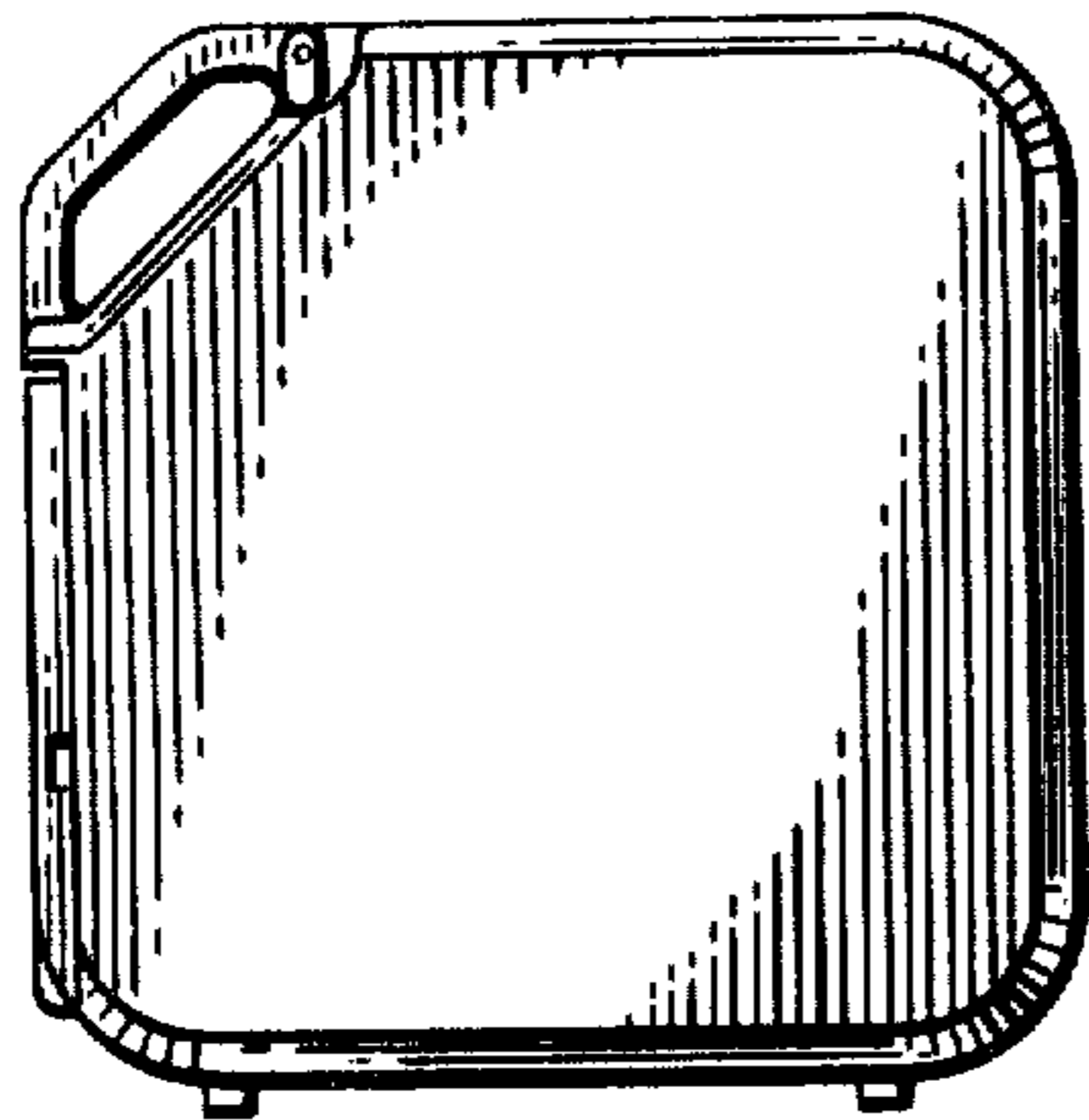

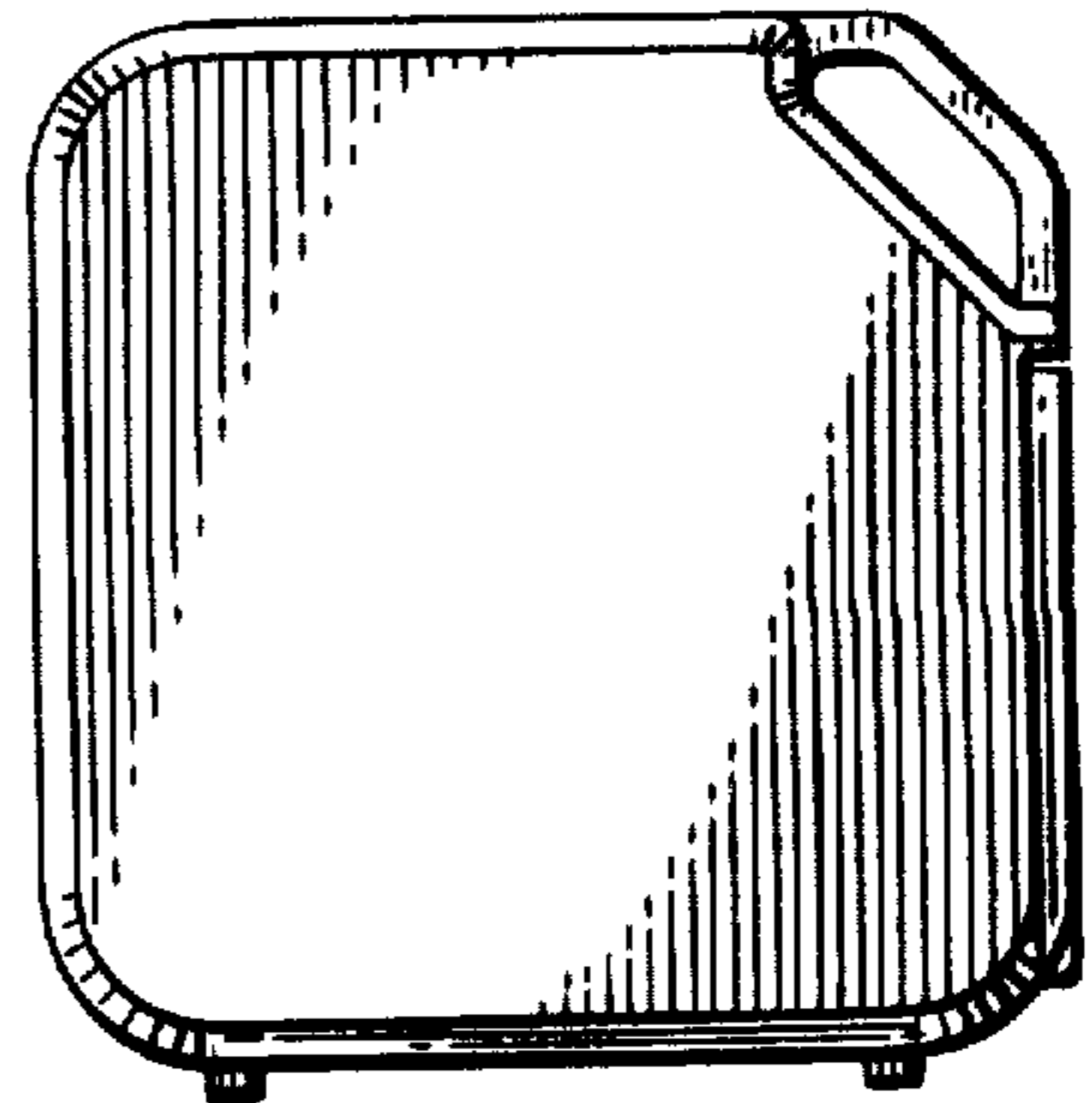

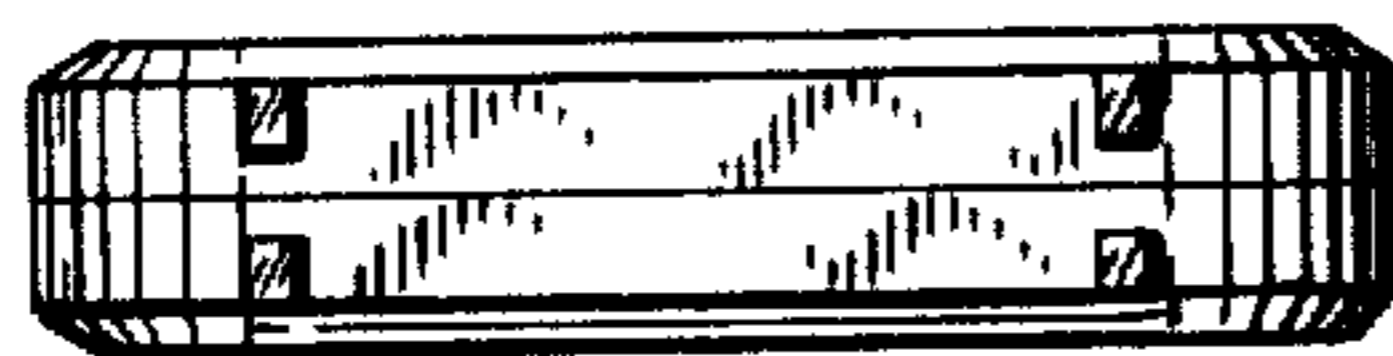
