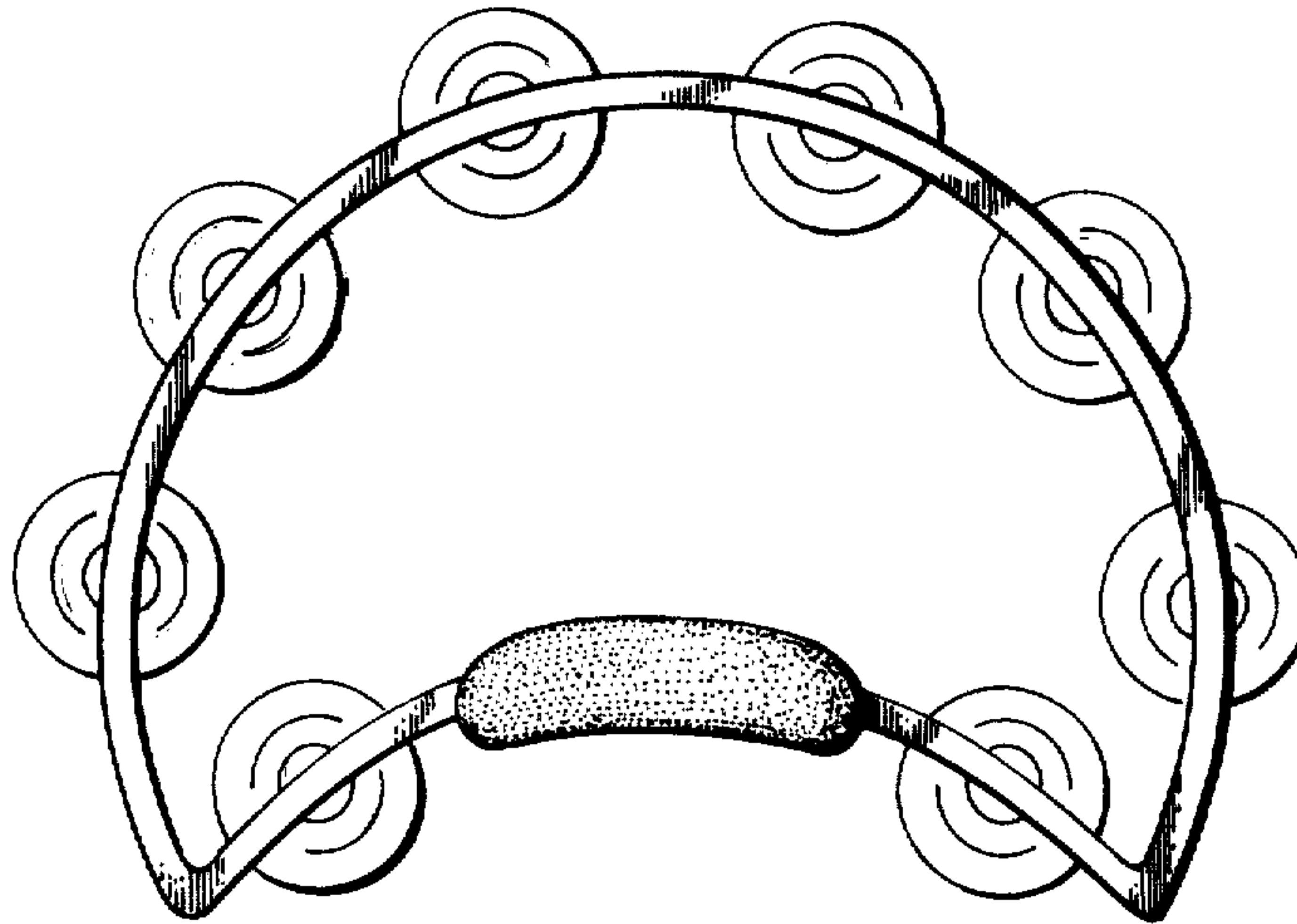

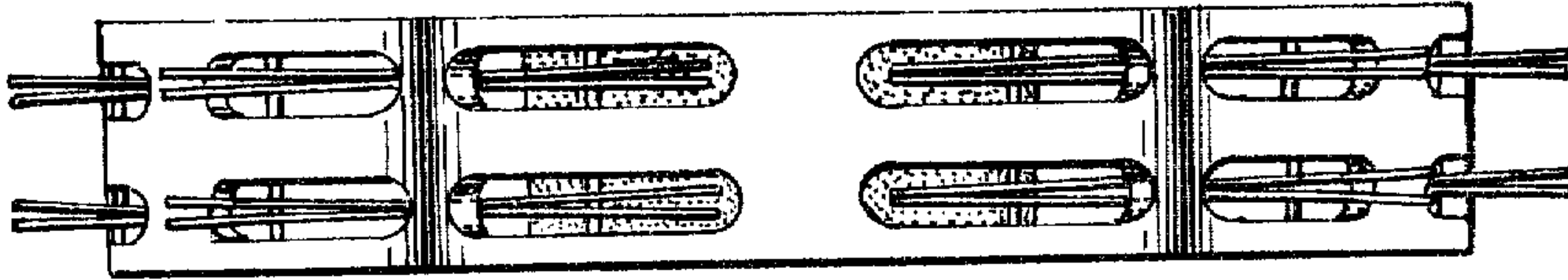
[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a tambourine, as shown and described.

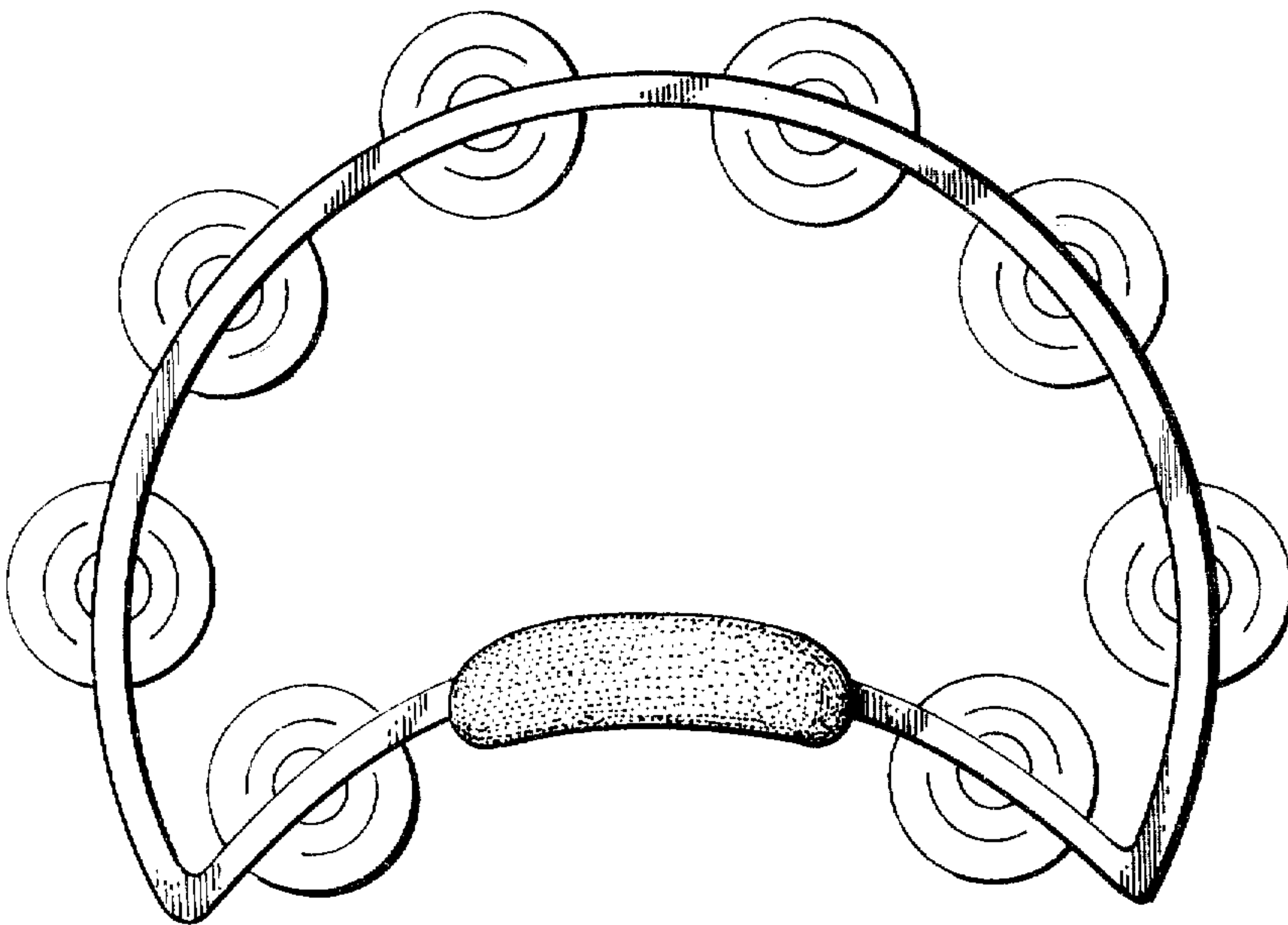
**DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 1 is a top plan view of a tambourine showing my new design; the bottom plan view is identical; FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof; FIG. 3 is a side elevational view thereof; the side elevational view from the opposite side is identical; and FIG. 4 is a back elevational view in the direction of the handle thereof.

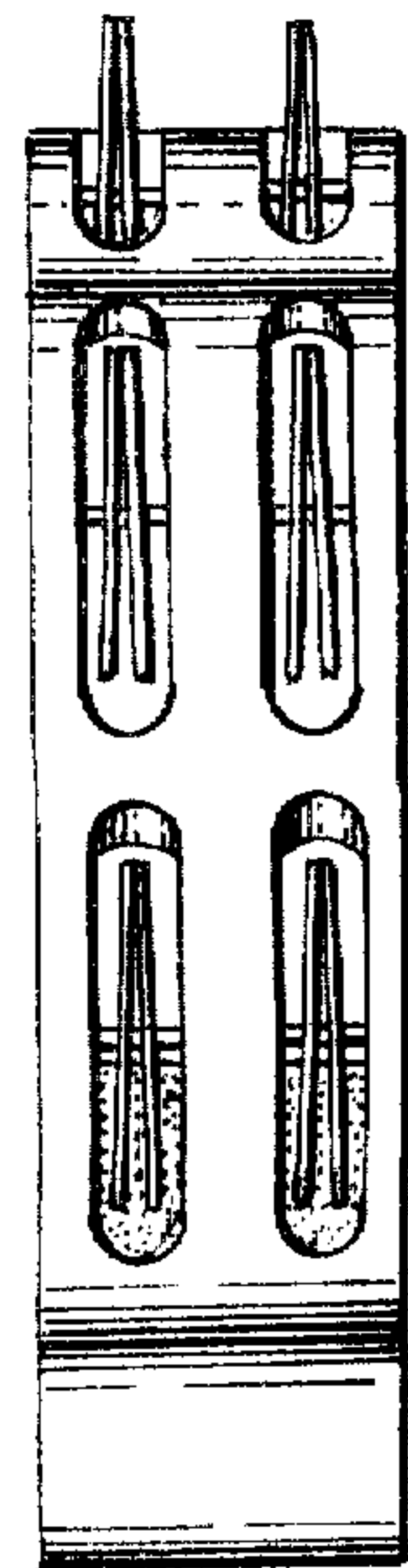




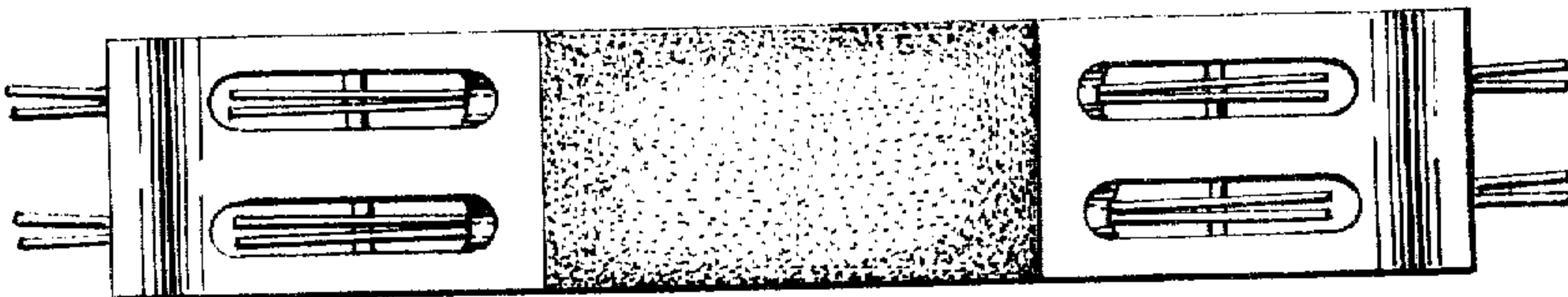
