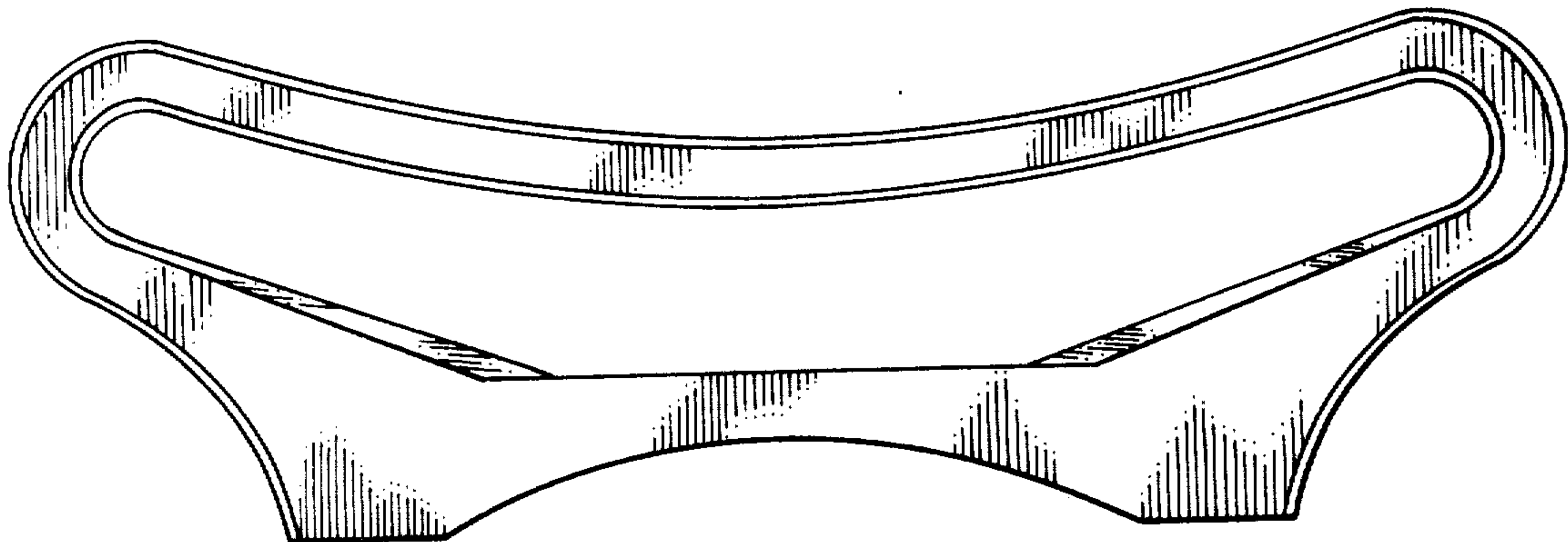

FIG. 4 is a front perspective view thereof shown on a slightly enlarged scale.



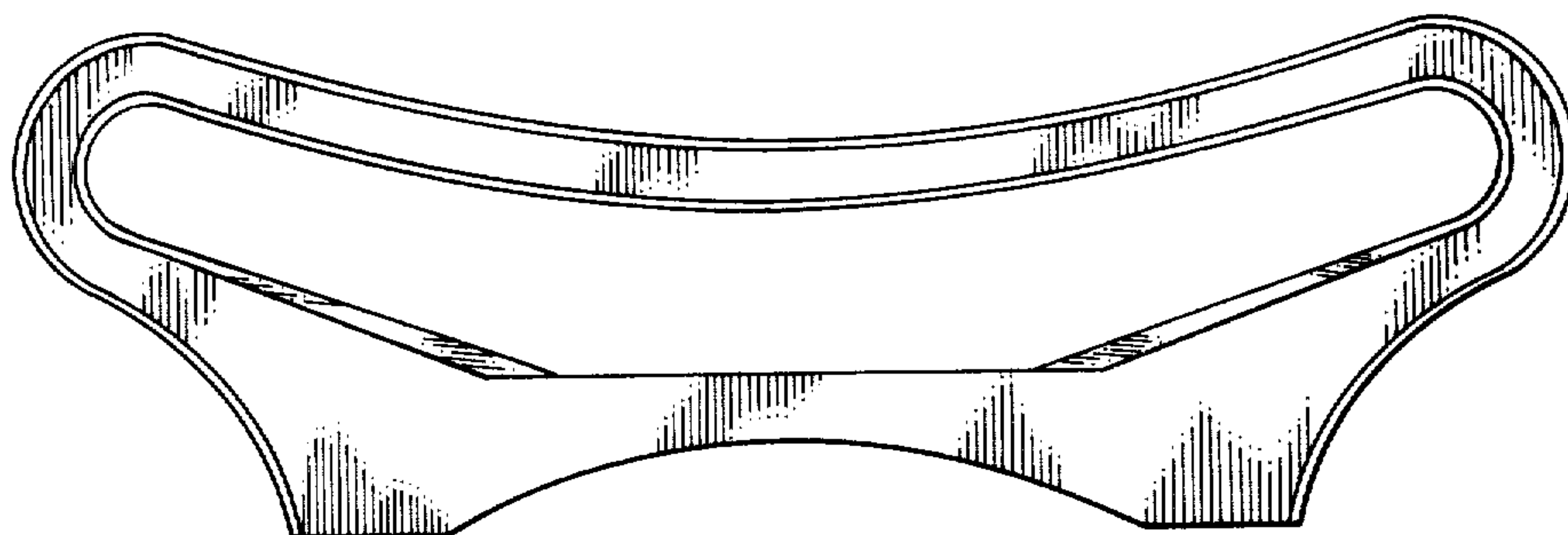

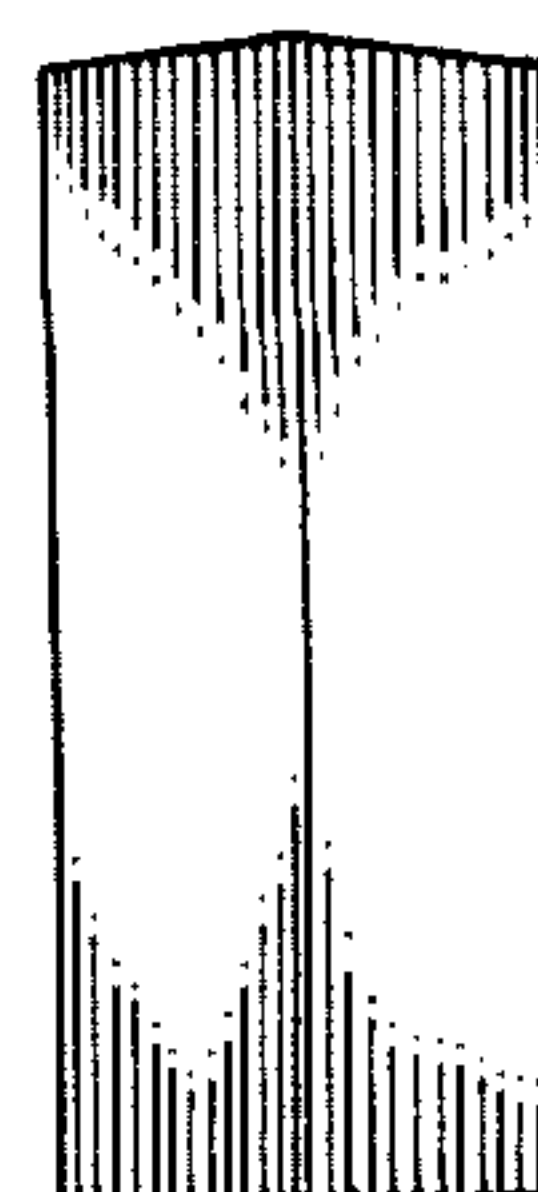

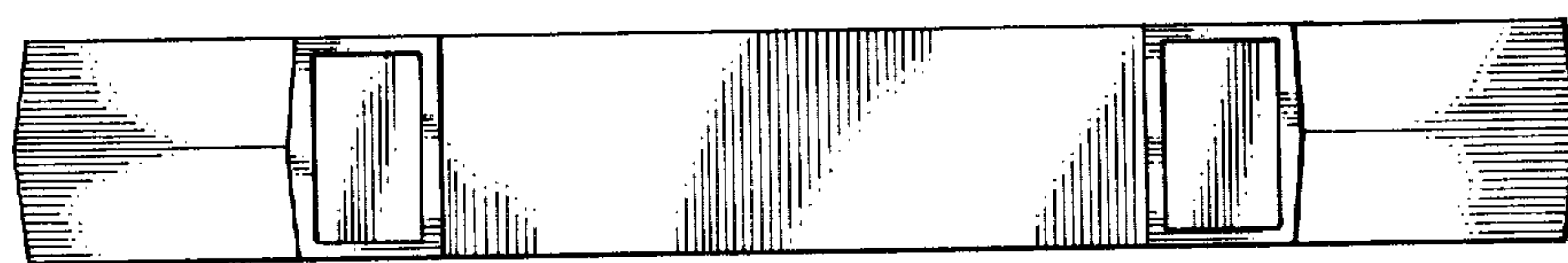

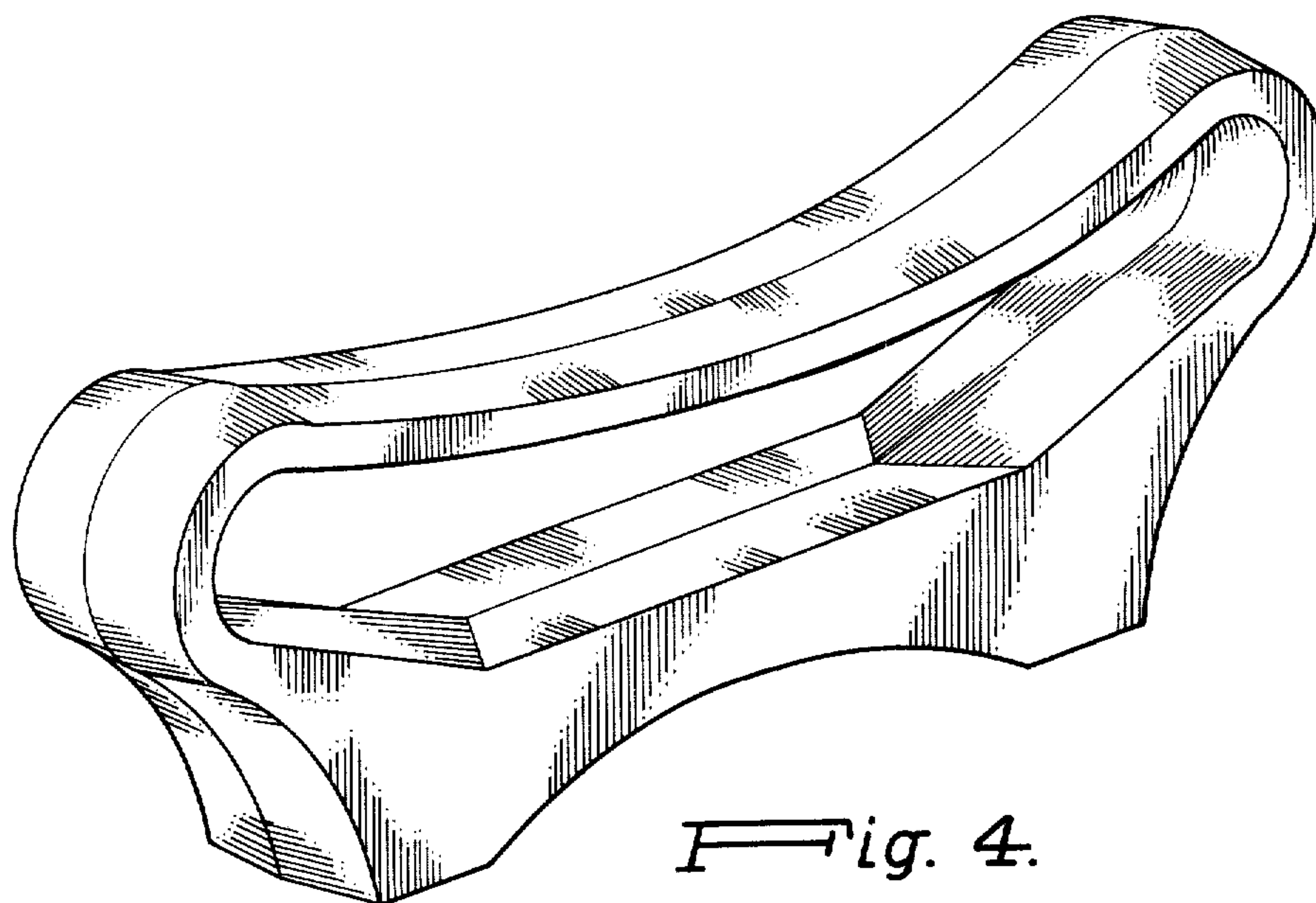
