DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top plan view of a serrefine, in an open condition, showing our new design;
 FIG. 2 is a side elevation thereof;
 FIG. 3 is an end elevation thereof;
 FIG. 4 is an elevation as seen from the opposite end of FIG. 3;
 FIG. 5 is a top plan view of the serrefine in a closed condition;
 FIG. 6 is a side elevation thereof;
 FIG. 7 is an end elevation thereof; and
 FIG. 8 is an elevation as seen from the opposite end of FIG. 7.

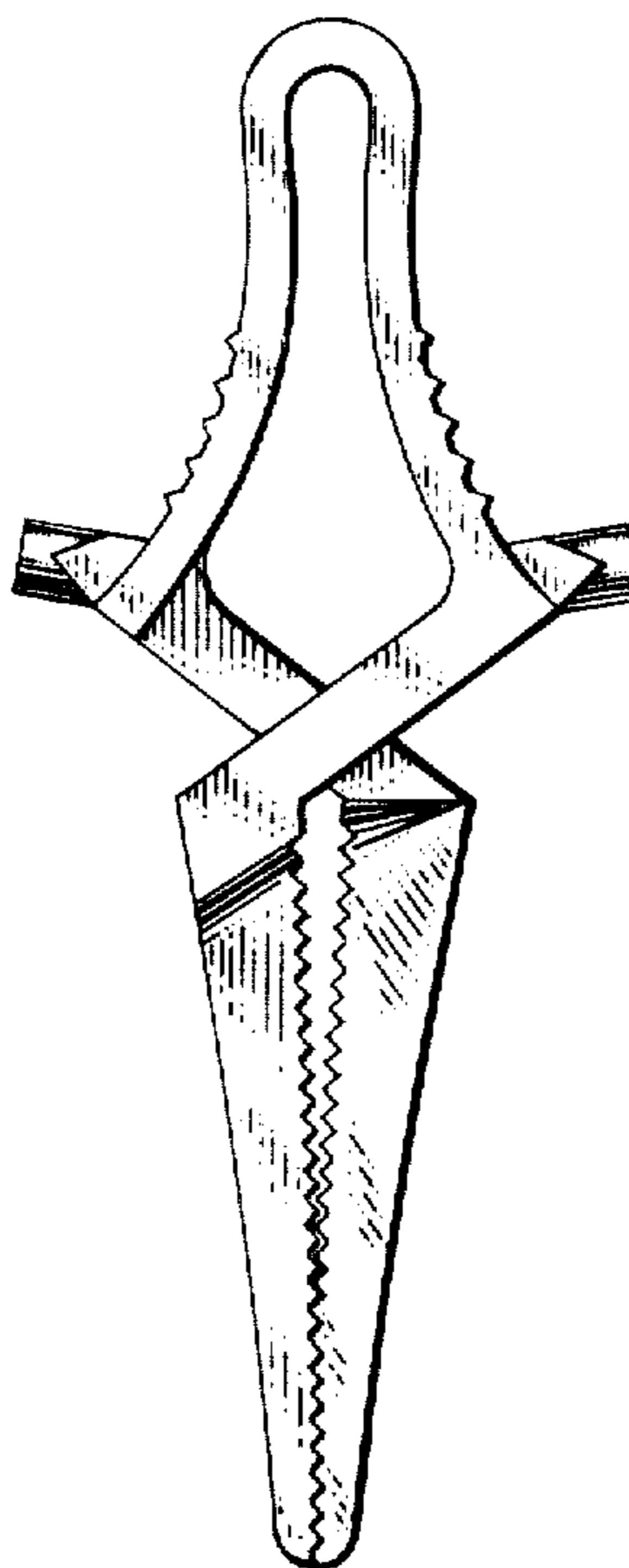
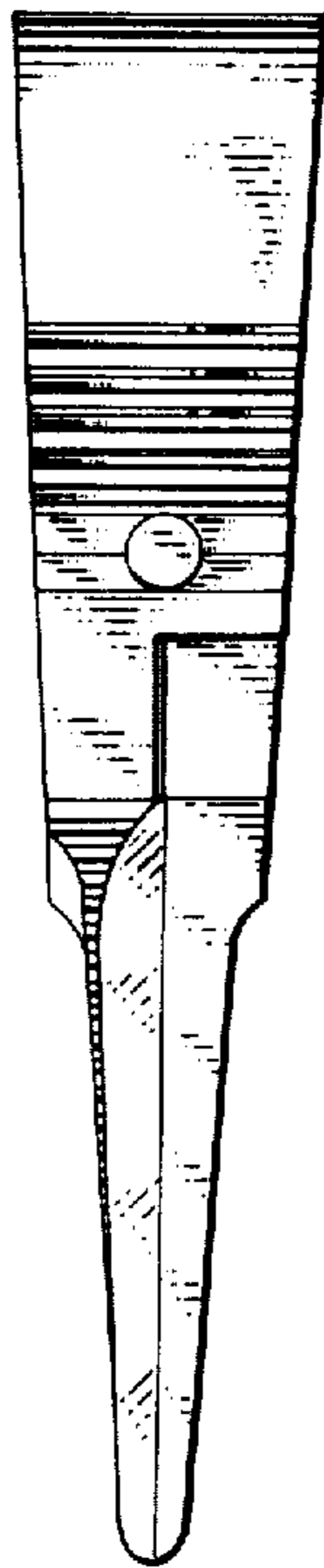

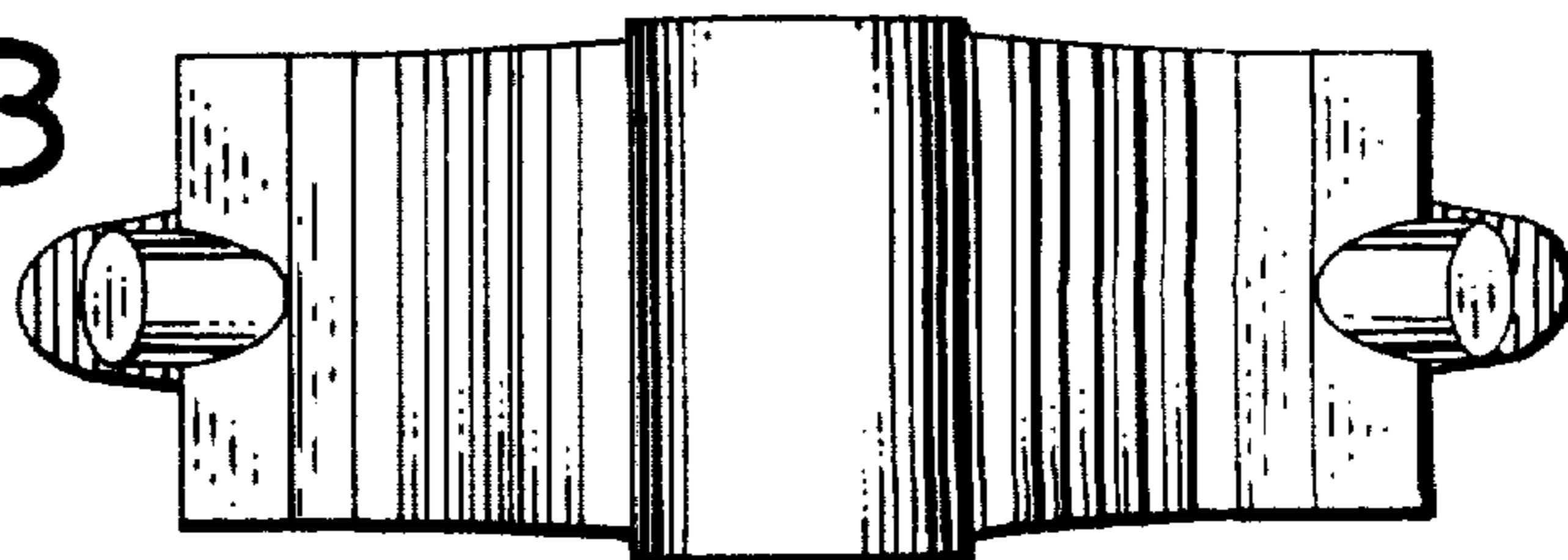

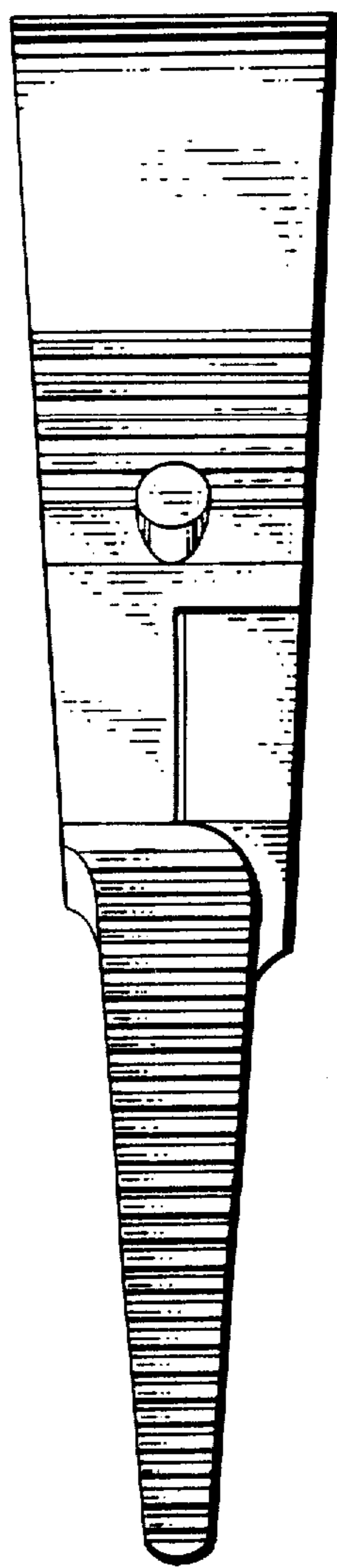

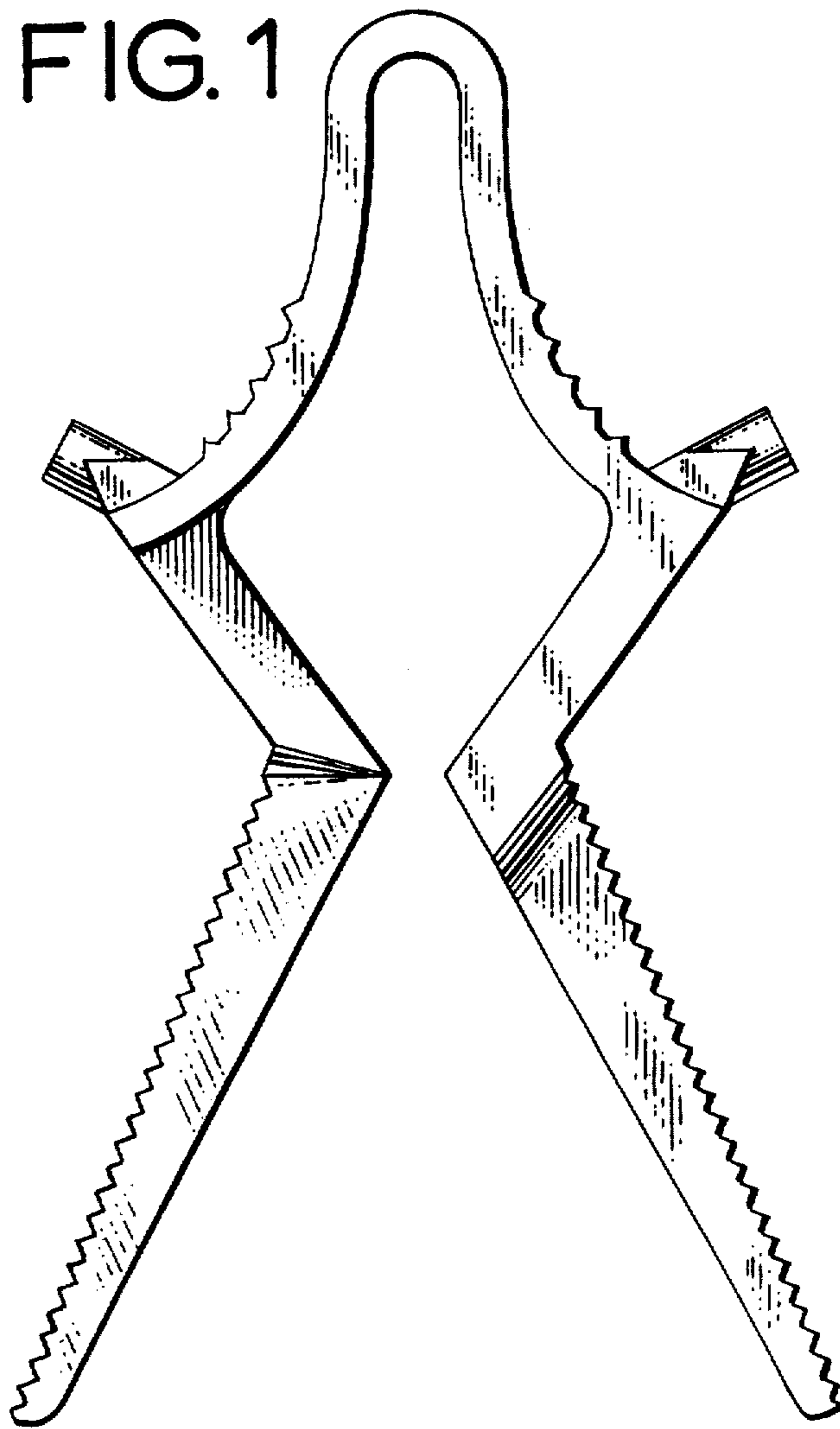

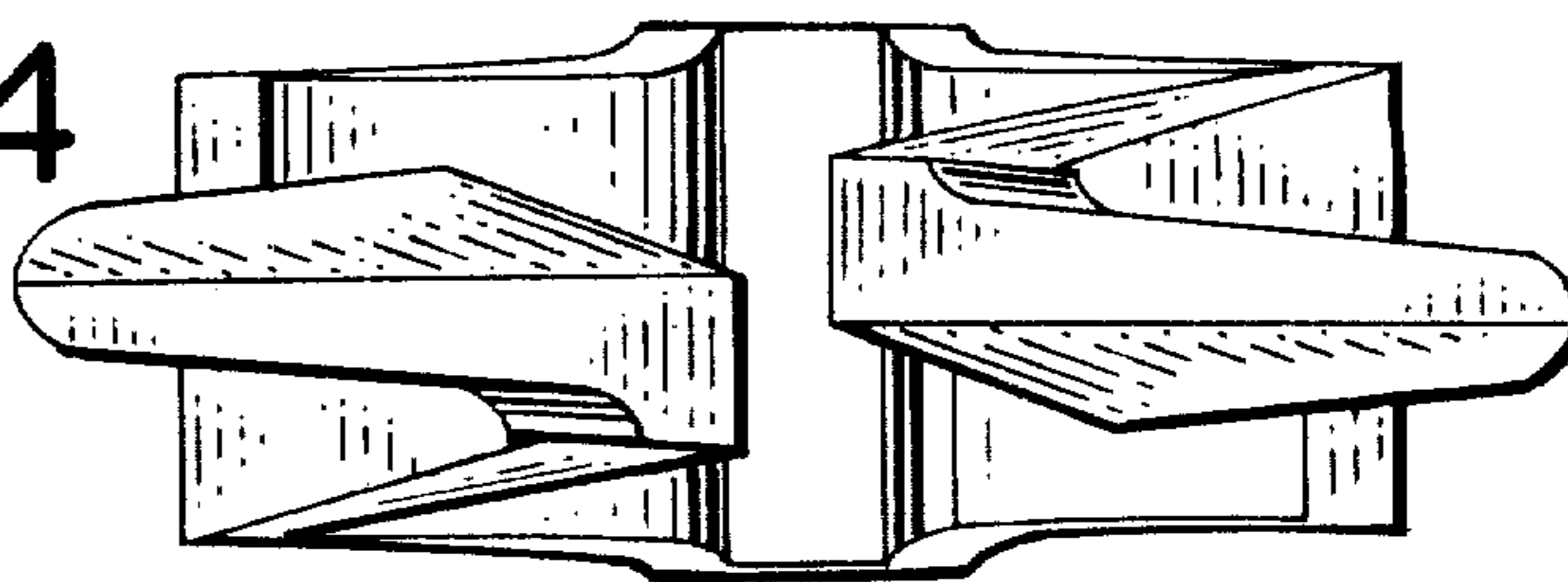

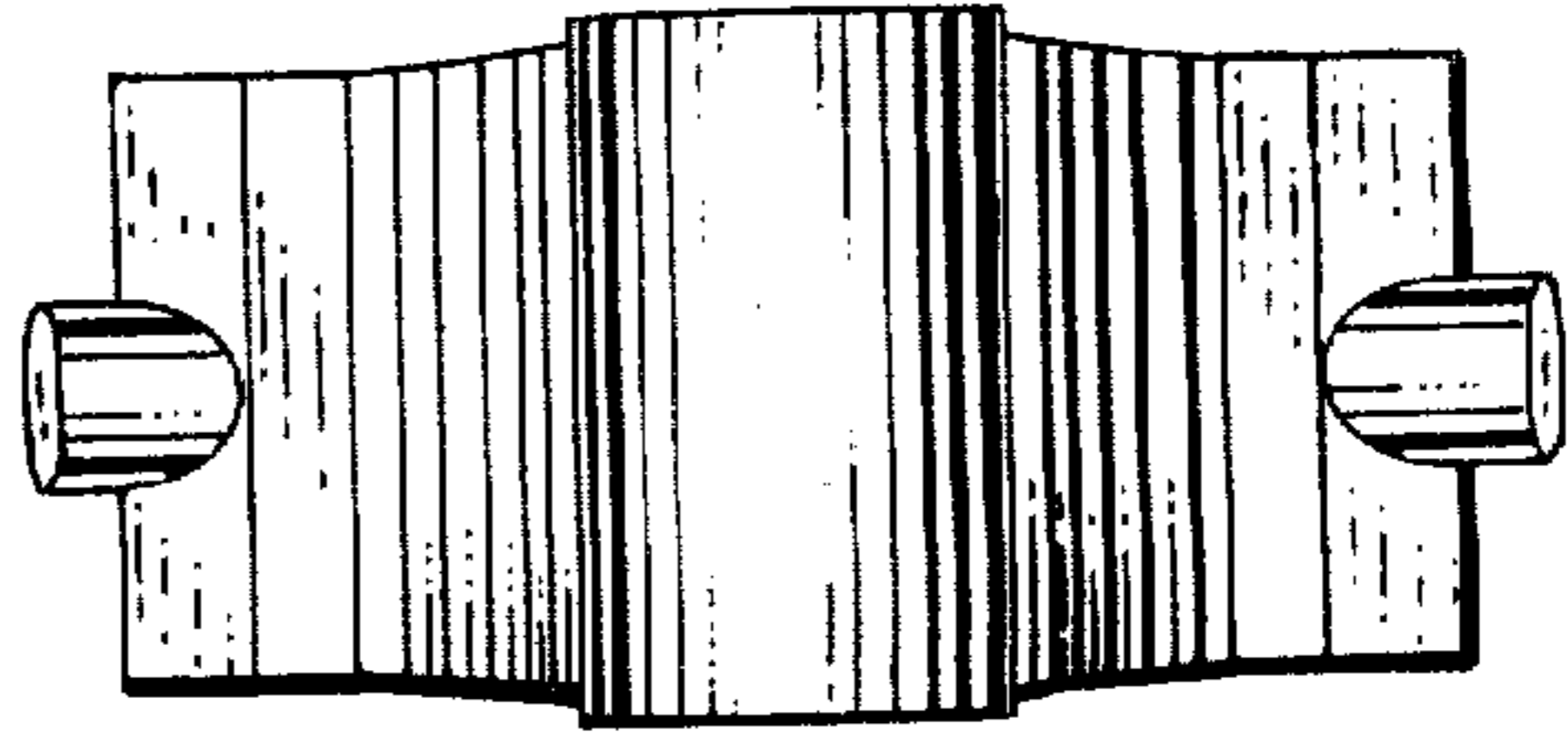

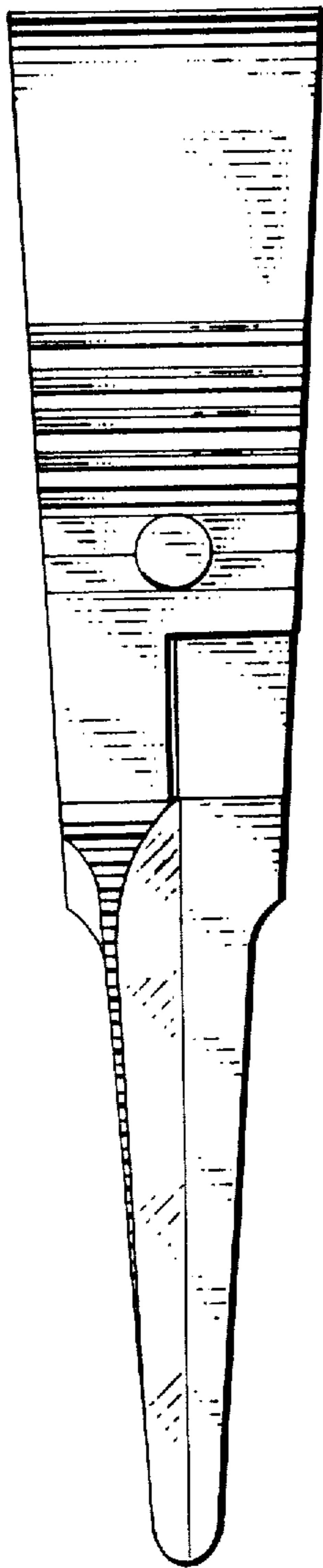

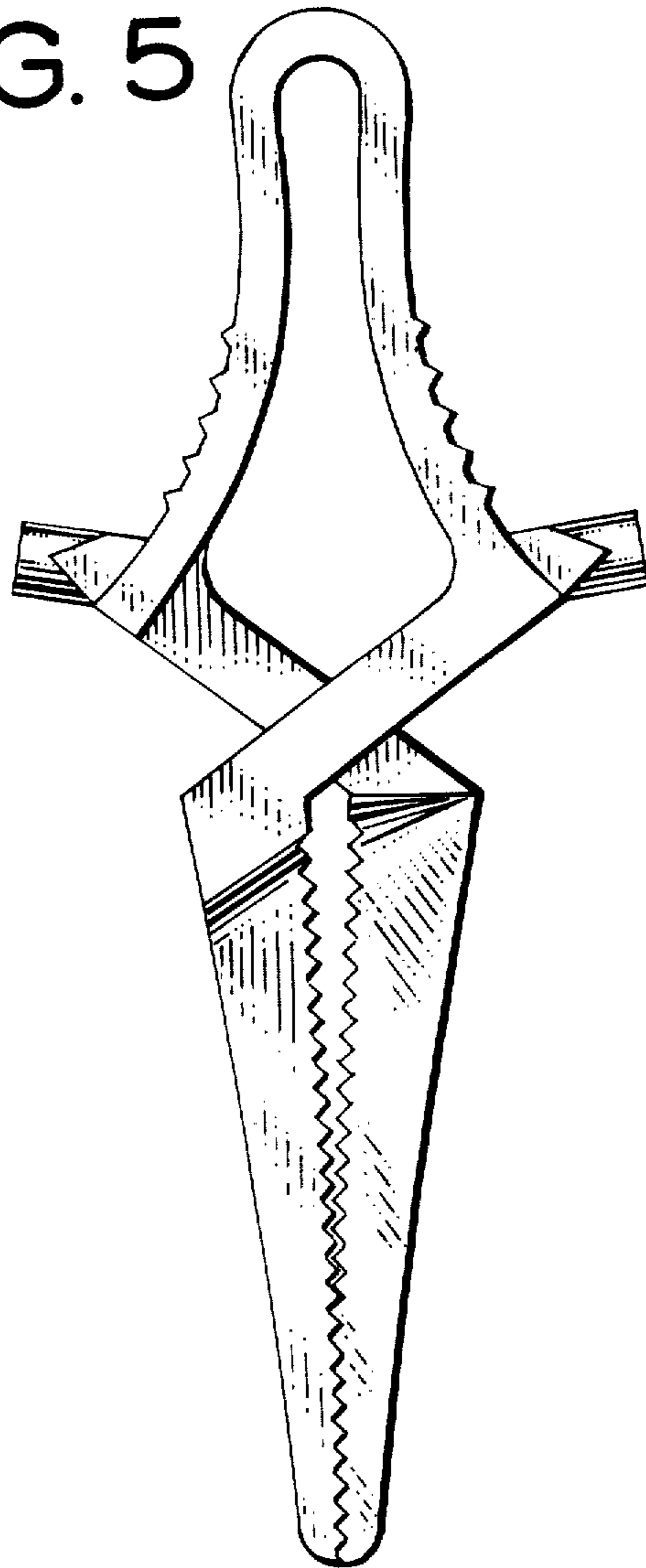
