The ornamental design for a lighting fixture, as shown  
and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a lighting fixture show-  
ing my new design;

FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof on an enlarged scale;

FIG. 3 is a front elevational view thereof on an enlarged  
scale;

FIG. 4 is a side elevational view on an enlarged scale  
taken from the right side as viewed in FIG. 3;

FIG. 5 is a rear elevational view thereof on an enlarged  
scale;

FIG. 6 is a side elevational view on an enlarged scale  
taken from the left as viewed in FIG. 3; and

FIG. 7 is a bottom plan view thereof on an enlarged  
scale.
