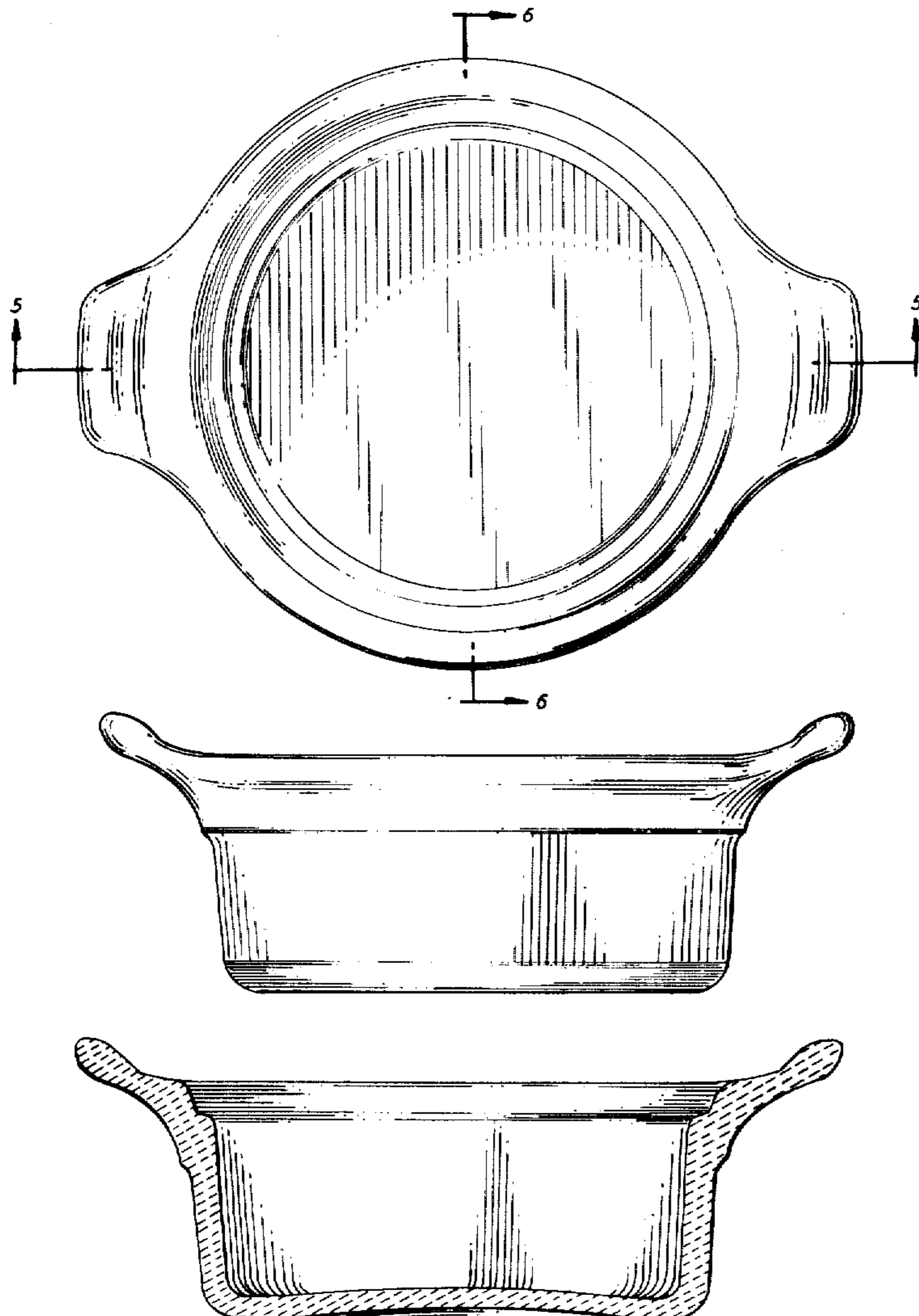

[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a casserole dish or similar article, as shown and described.

**DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 1 is a top plan view of a casserole dish showing my new design;  
FIG. 2 is a bottom plan view thereof;  
FIG. 3 is a front elevation thereof, the rear elevation being a mirror image;  
FIG. 4 is a right side elevation thereof, the left side elevation being a mirror image;  
FIG. 5 is a vertical sectional view thereof taken on line 5—5 of FIG. 1; and  
FIG. 6 is a vertical sectional view thereof taken on line 6—6 of FIG. 1.



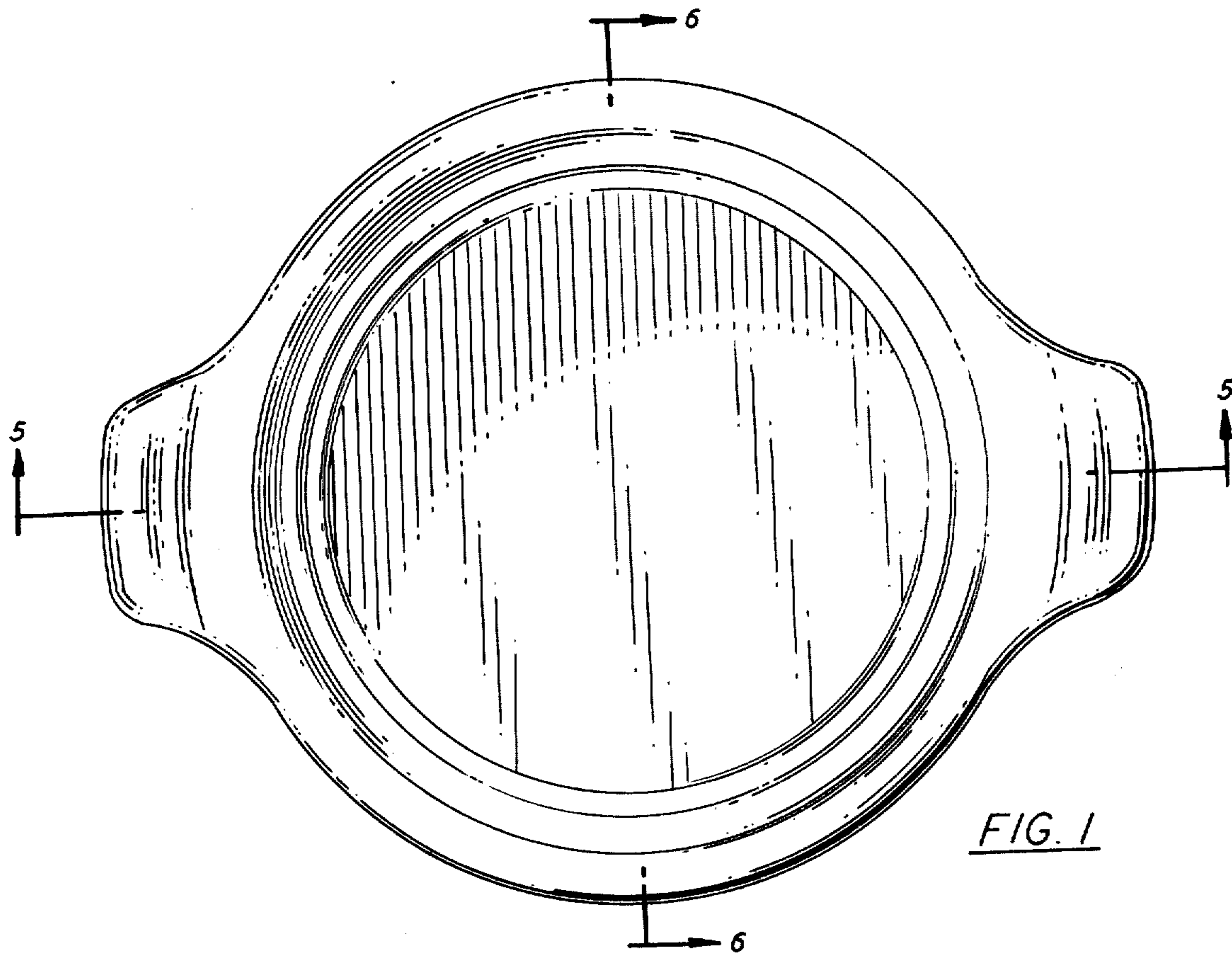

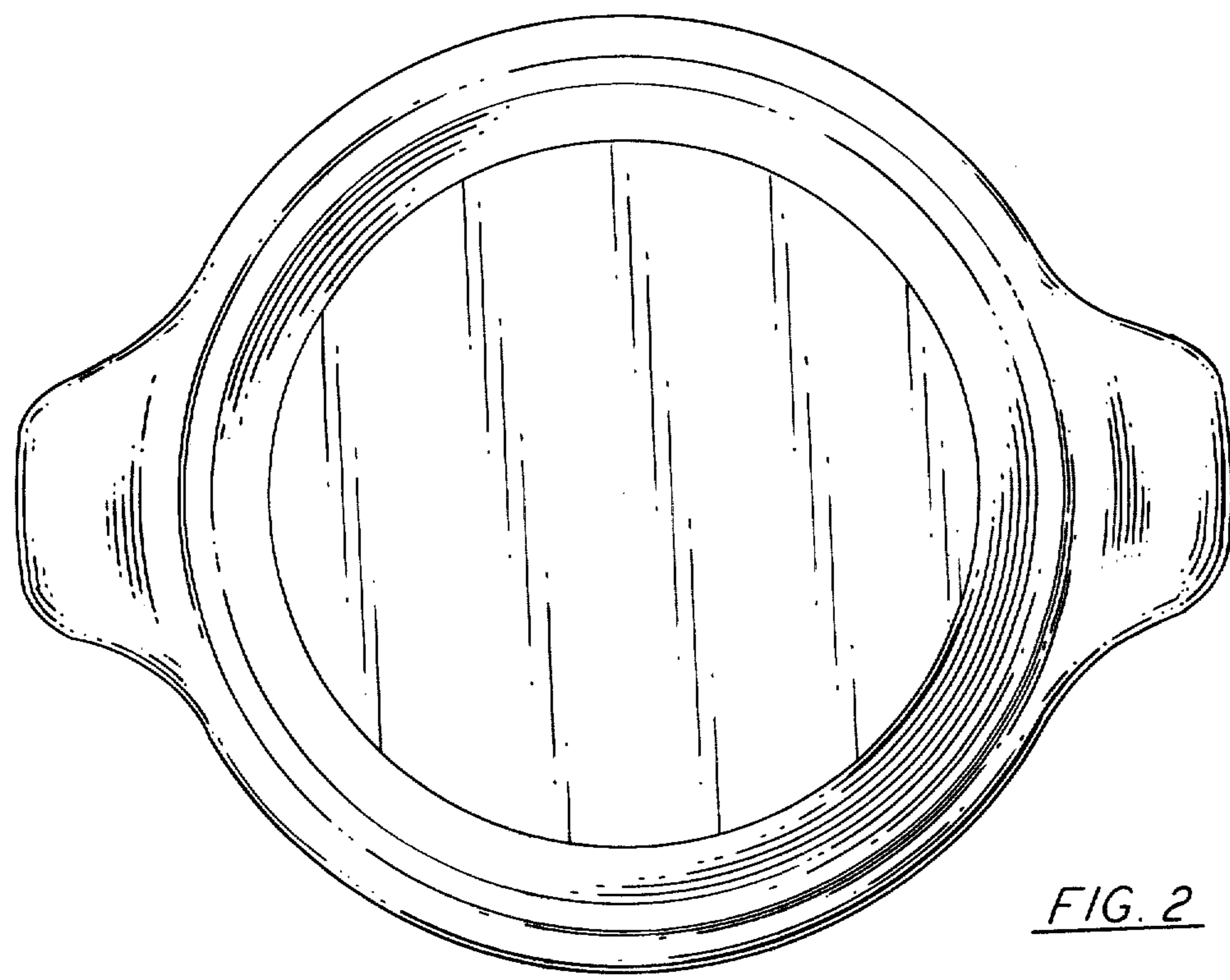

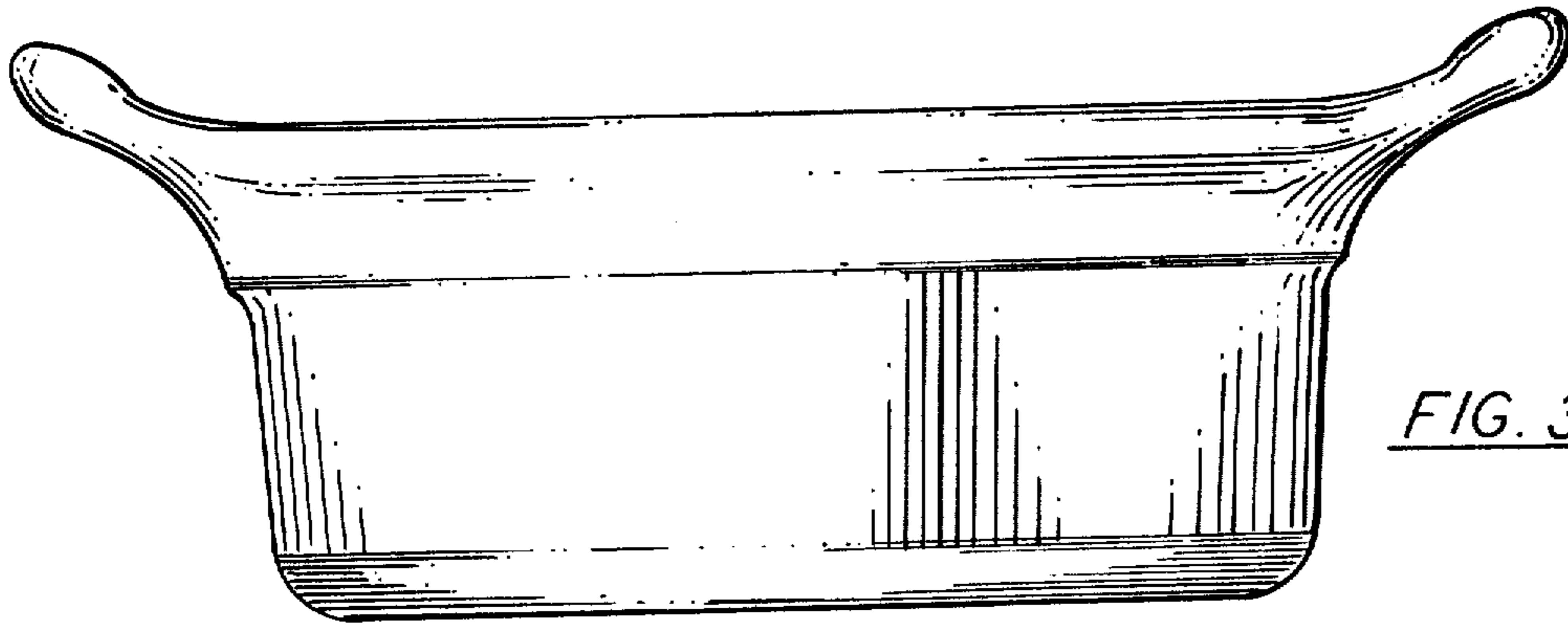

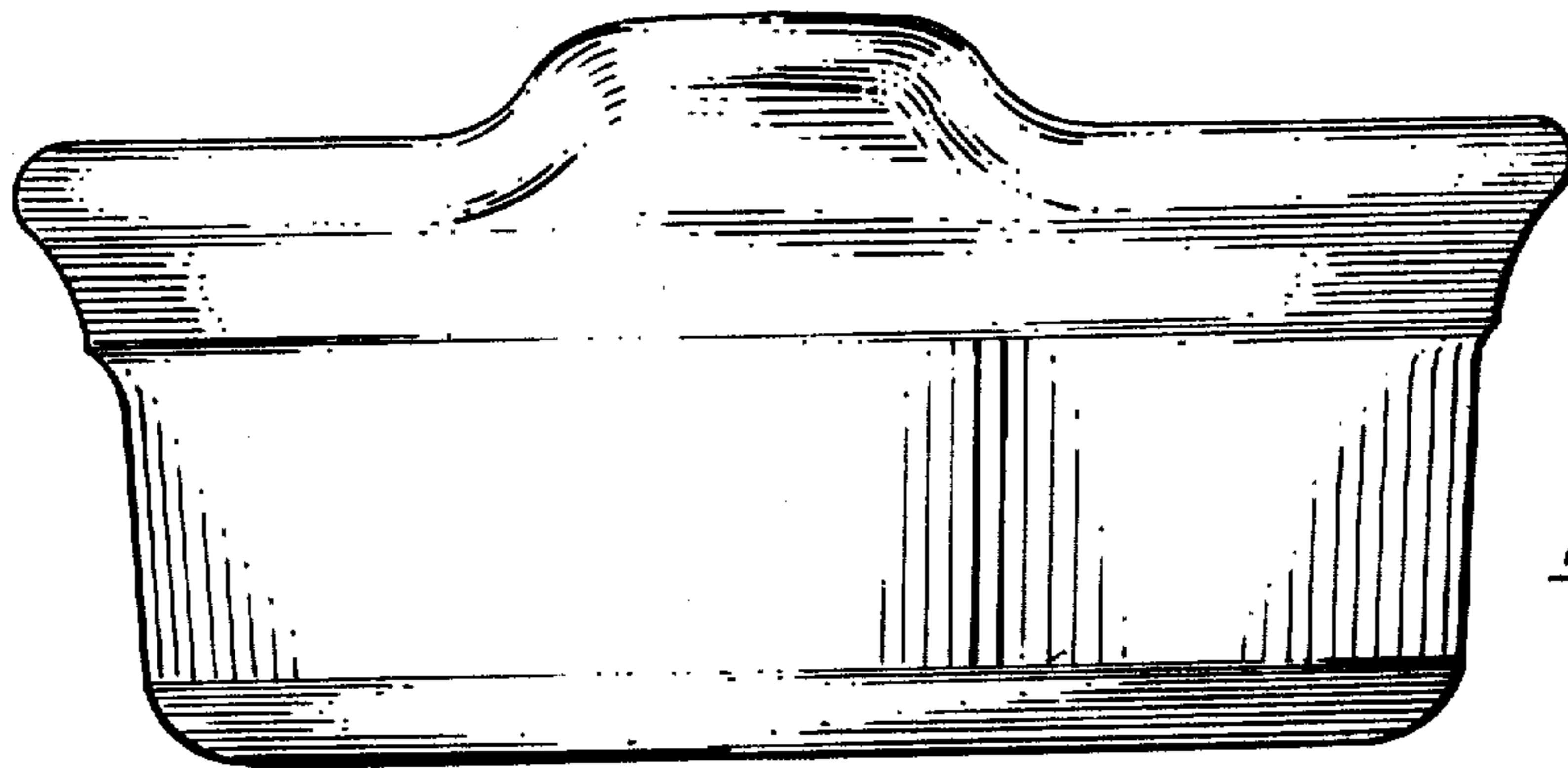

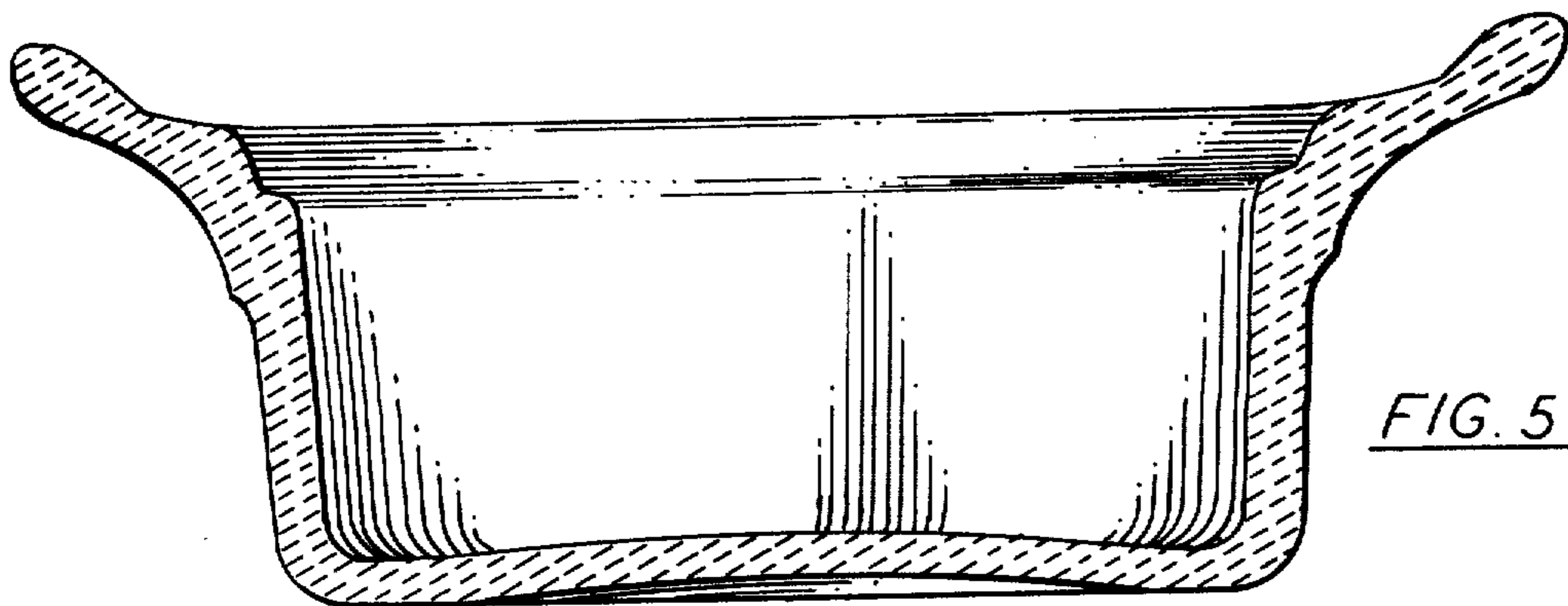

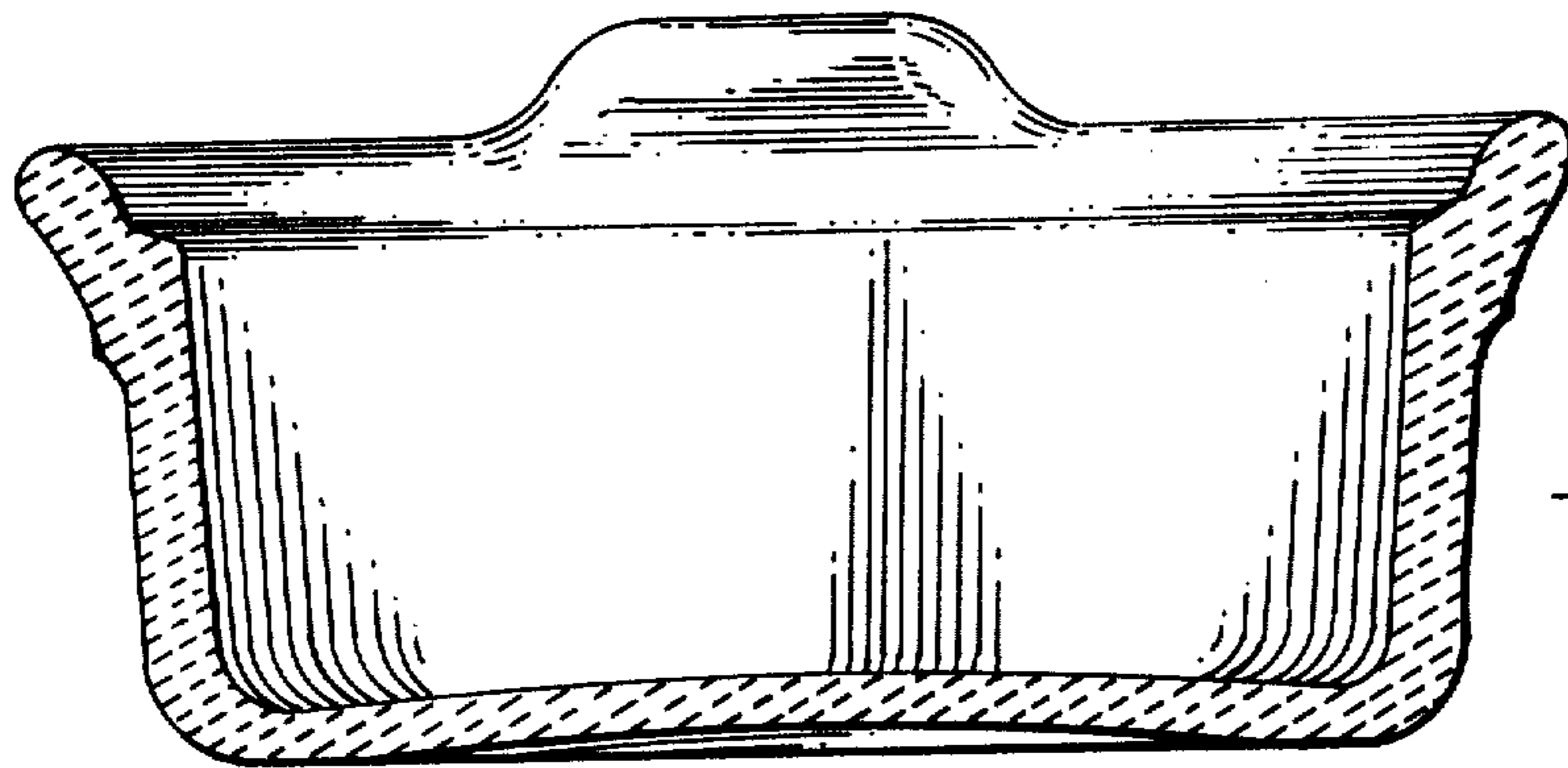
