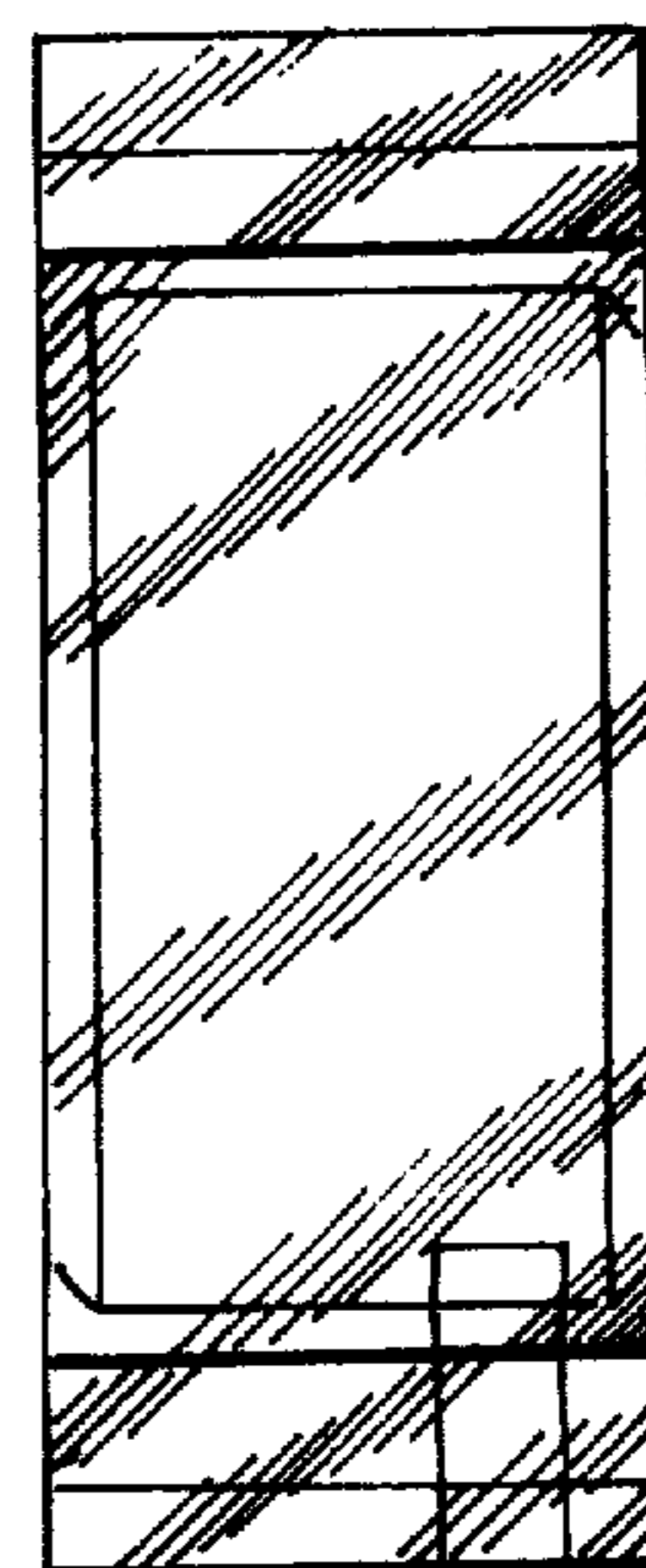
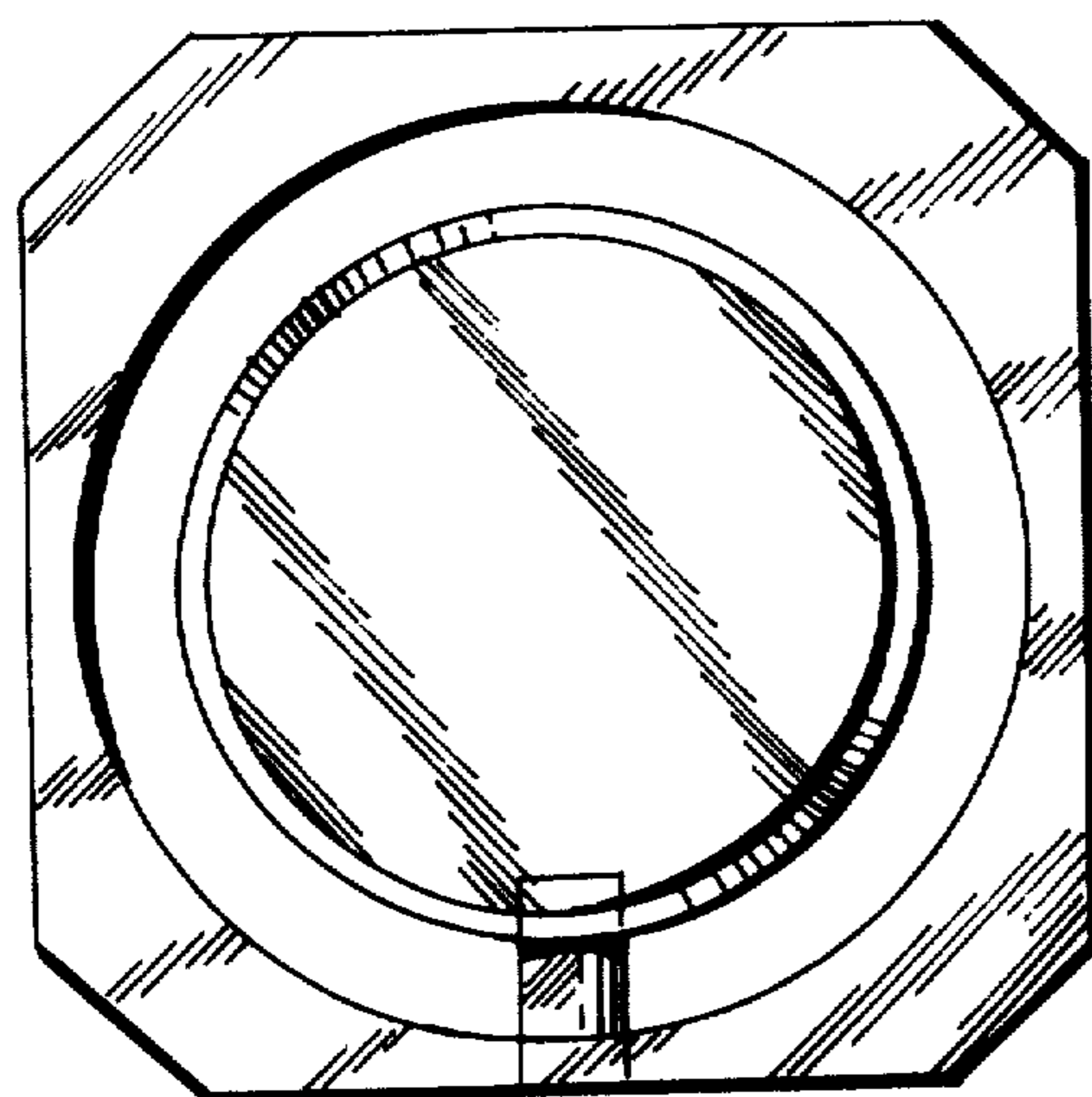

The ornamental design for a paperweight, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a paperweight showing my new design, the rear elevational view being a mirror image thereof;
FIG. 2 is a right side elevational view, the left side elevational view being a mirror image thereof;
FIG. 3 is a top plan view thereof; and
FIG. 4 is a bottom plan view thereof.



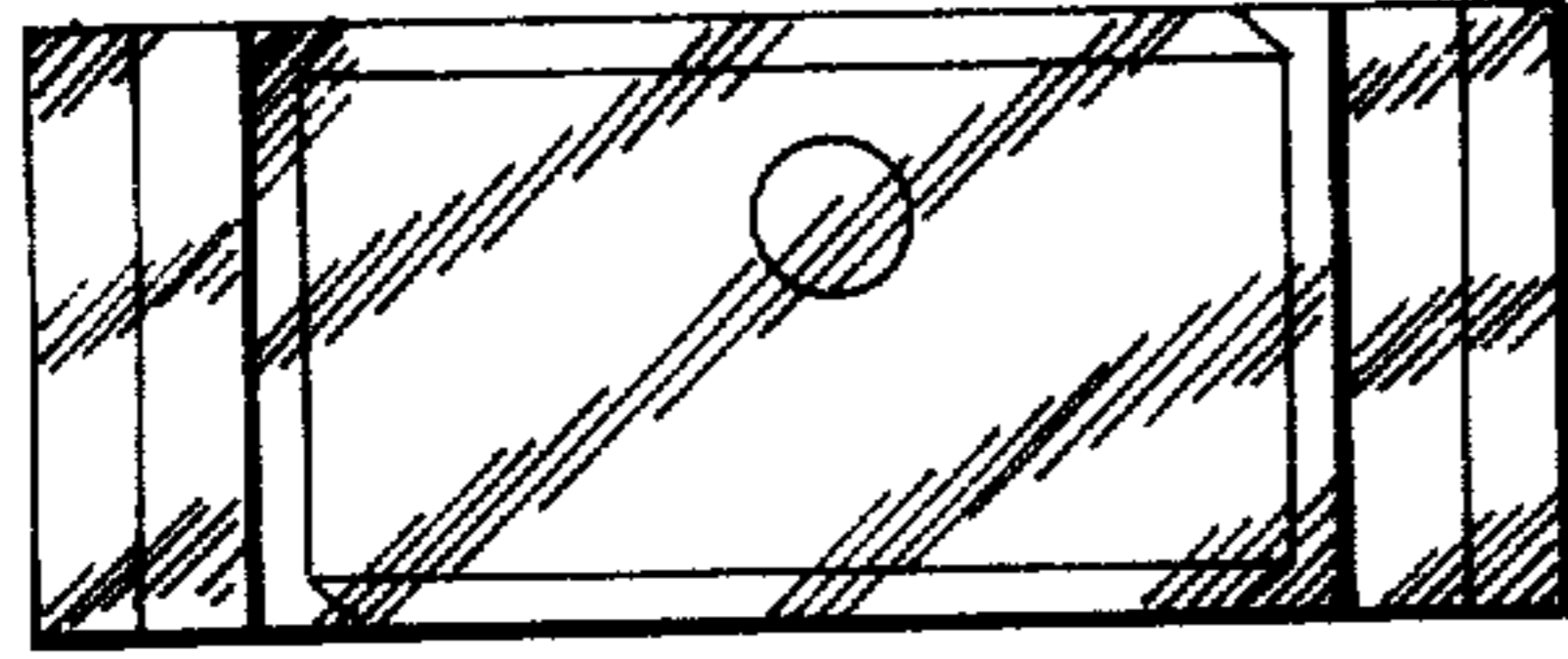

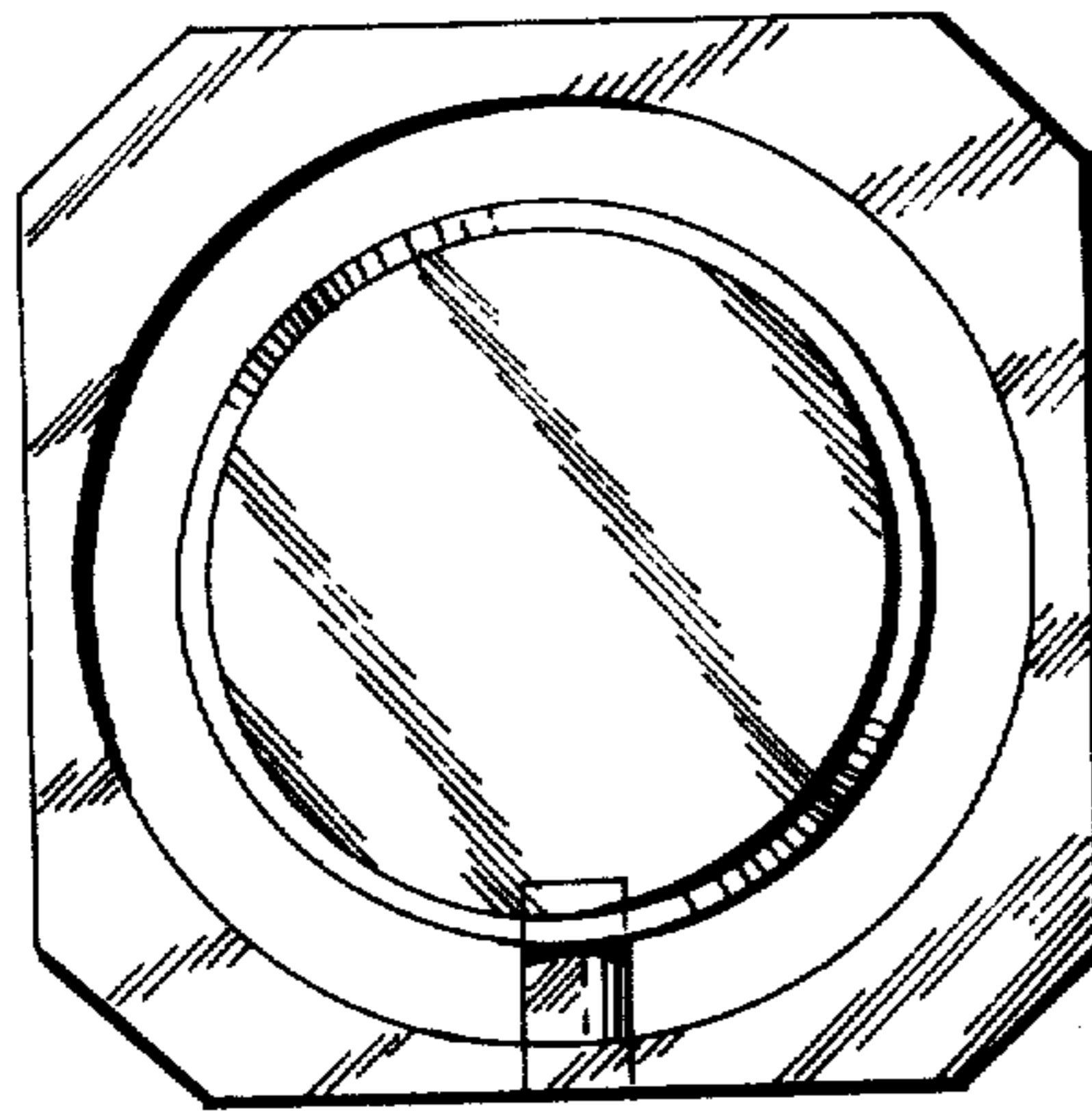

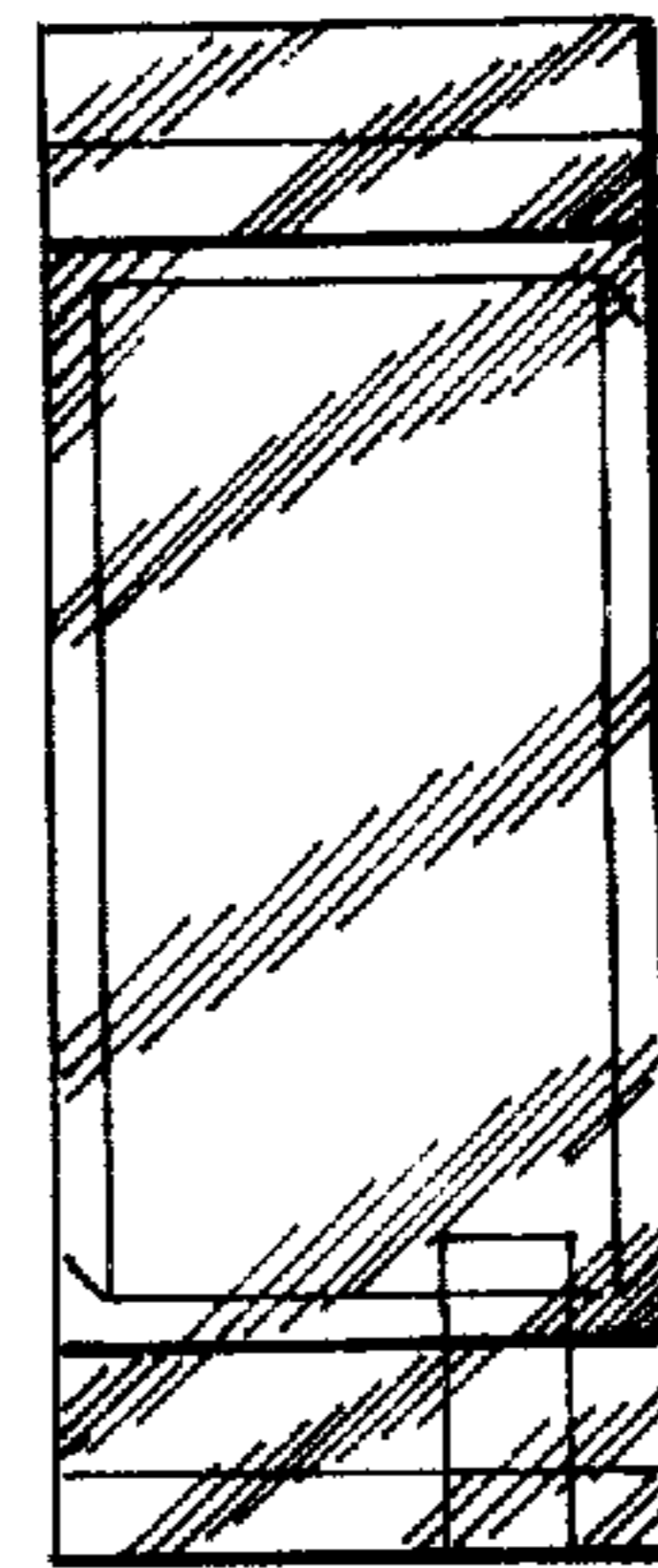

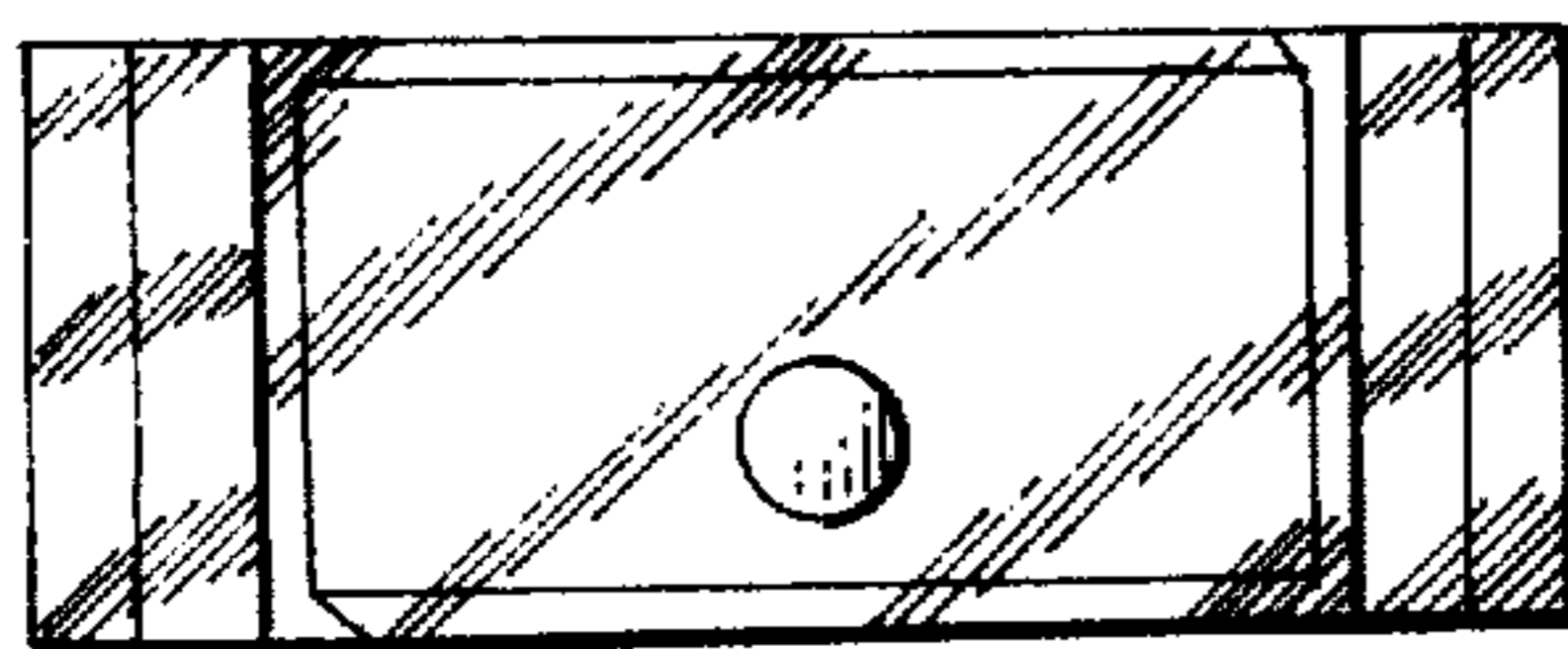
