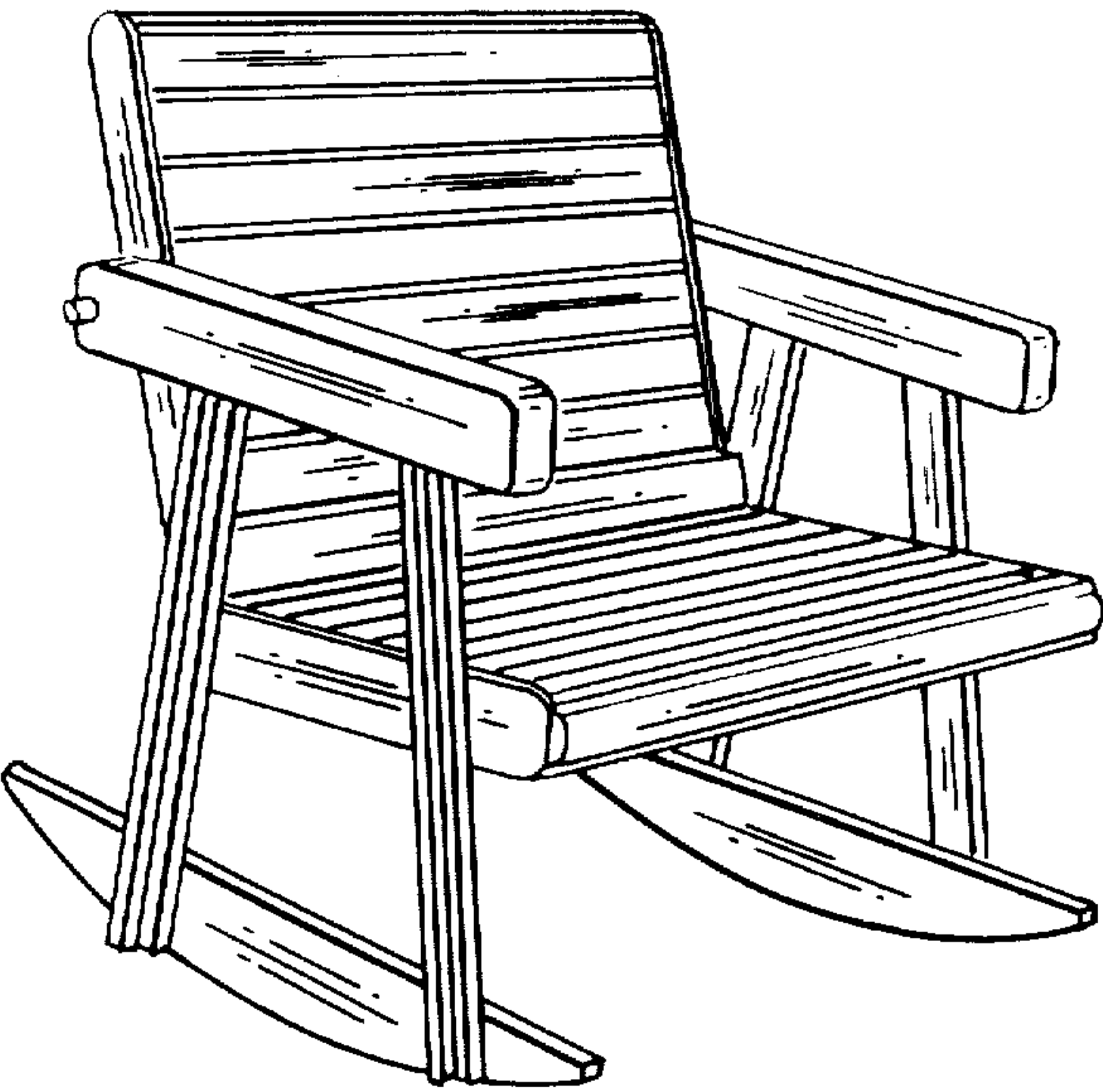

image of the side shown.



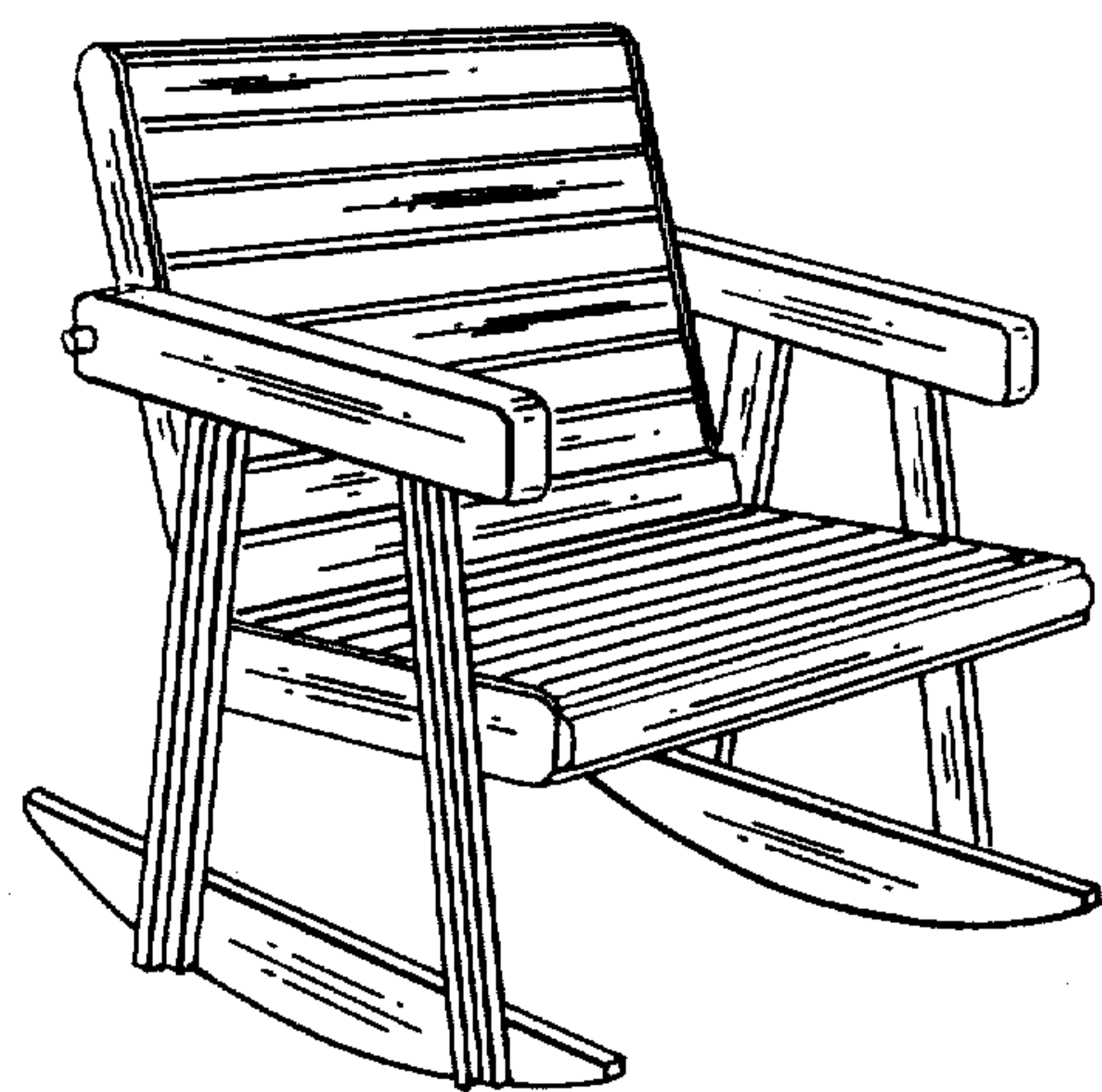

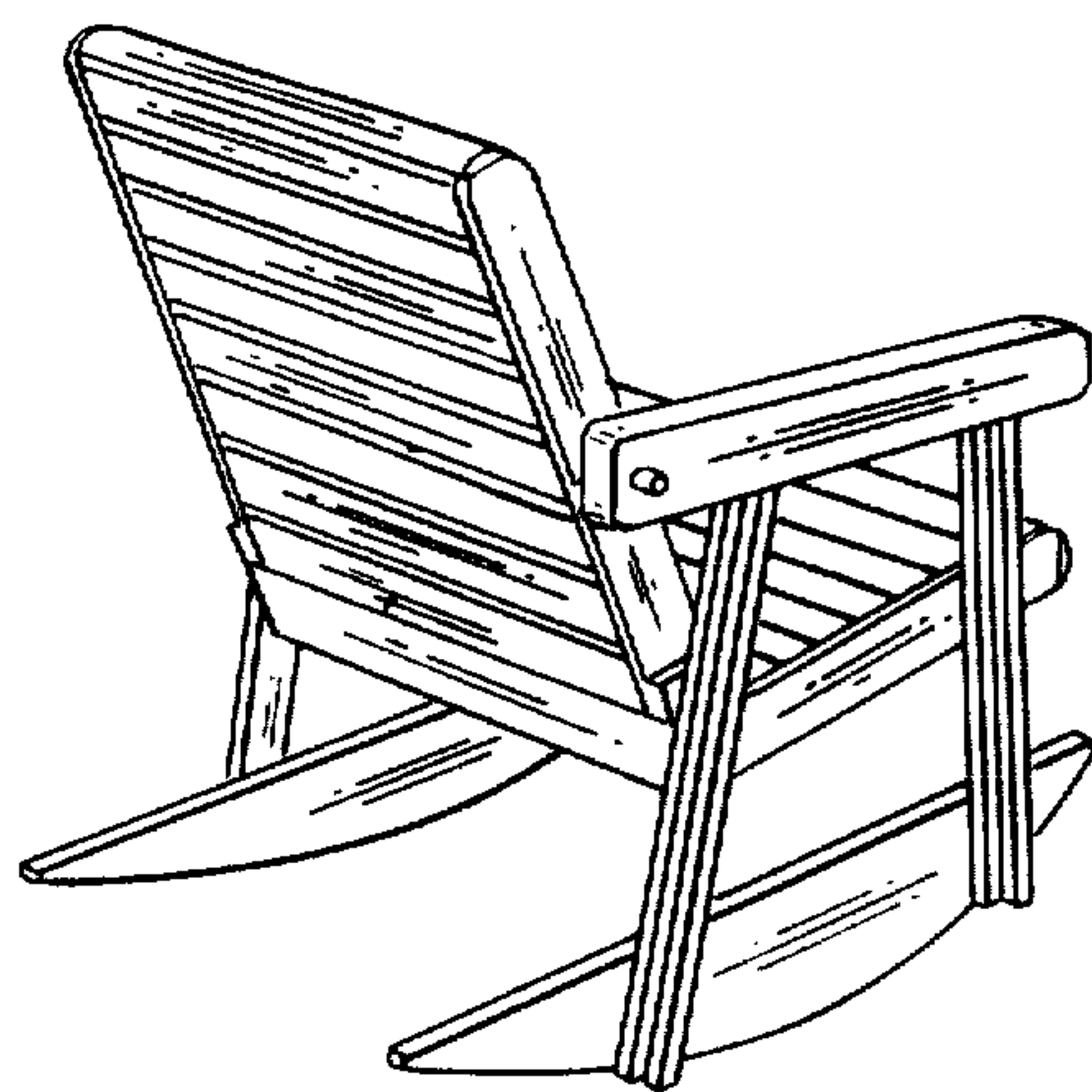
