vice, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

The FIGURE is a perspective view of an outdoor rec-
reational device showing my new design. The top por-
tion of the horizontal extension is a series of rungs. The
platform top is solid and unornamented and the swing
seat obscured by the slide is identical to that shown.
