[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for an outdoor recreational device, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

The FIGURE is a perspective view of an outdoor recreational device showing my new design. The top portion of the horizontal extension is a series of rungs. The platform top is solid and unornamented and the swing seat obscured by the slide is identical to that shown.
