DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a frame for a chair embodying my new design, and showing chair pillows in dotted lines;

FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof;

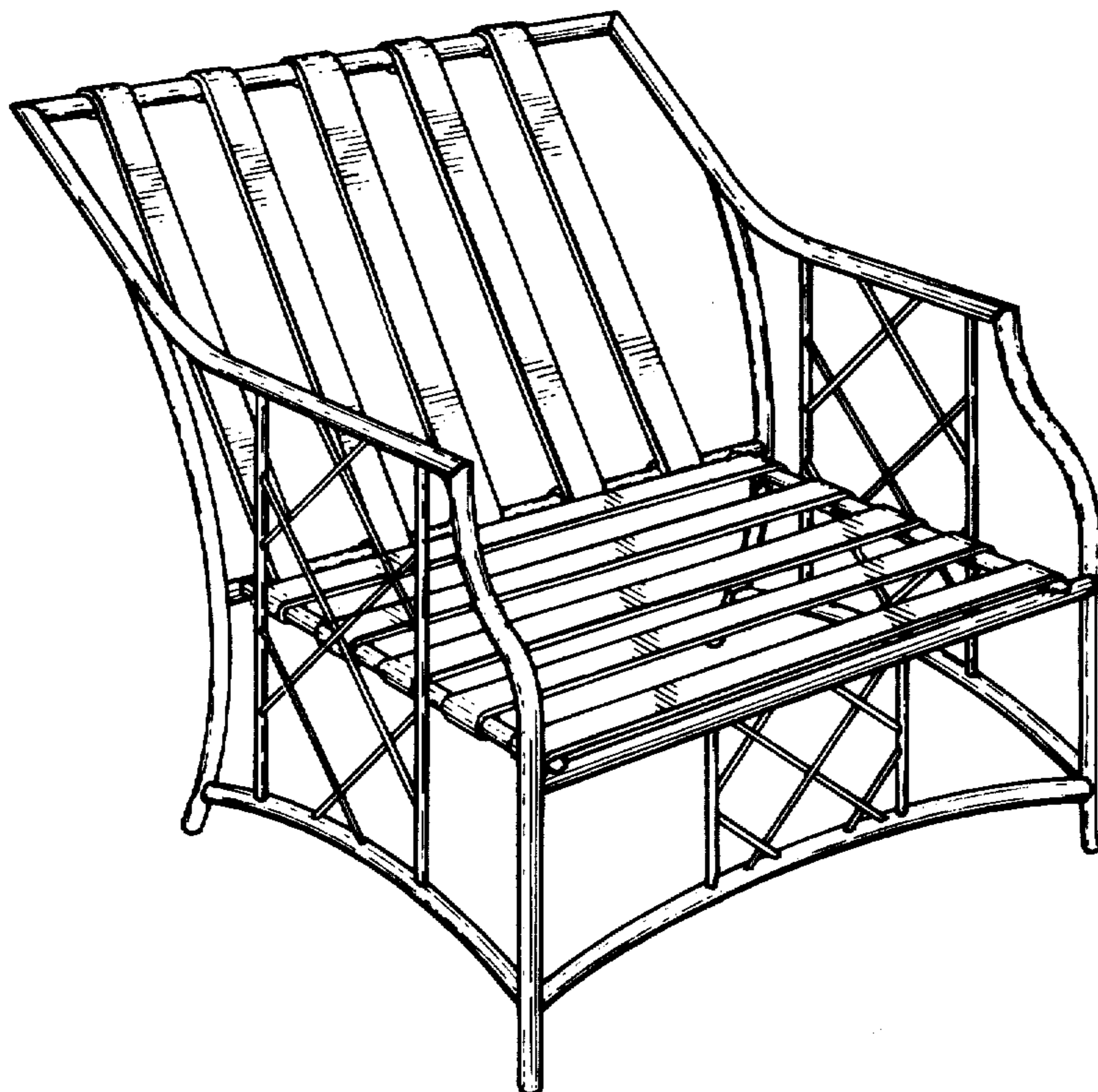
FIG. 3 is a front elevational view thereof;

The opposite side elevational view of FIG. 4 is identical to the side shown.



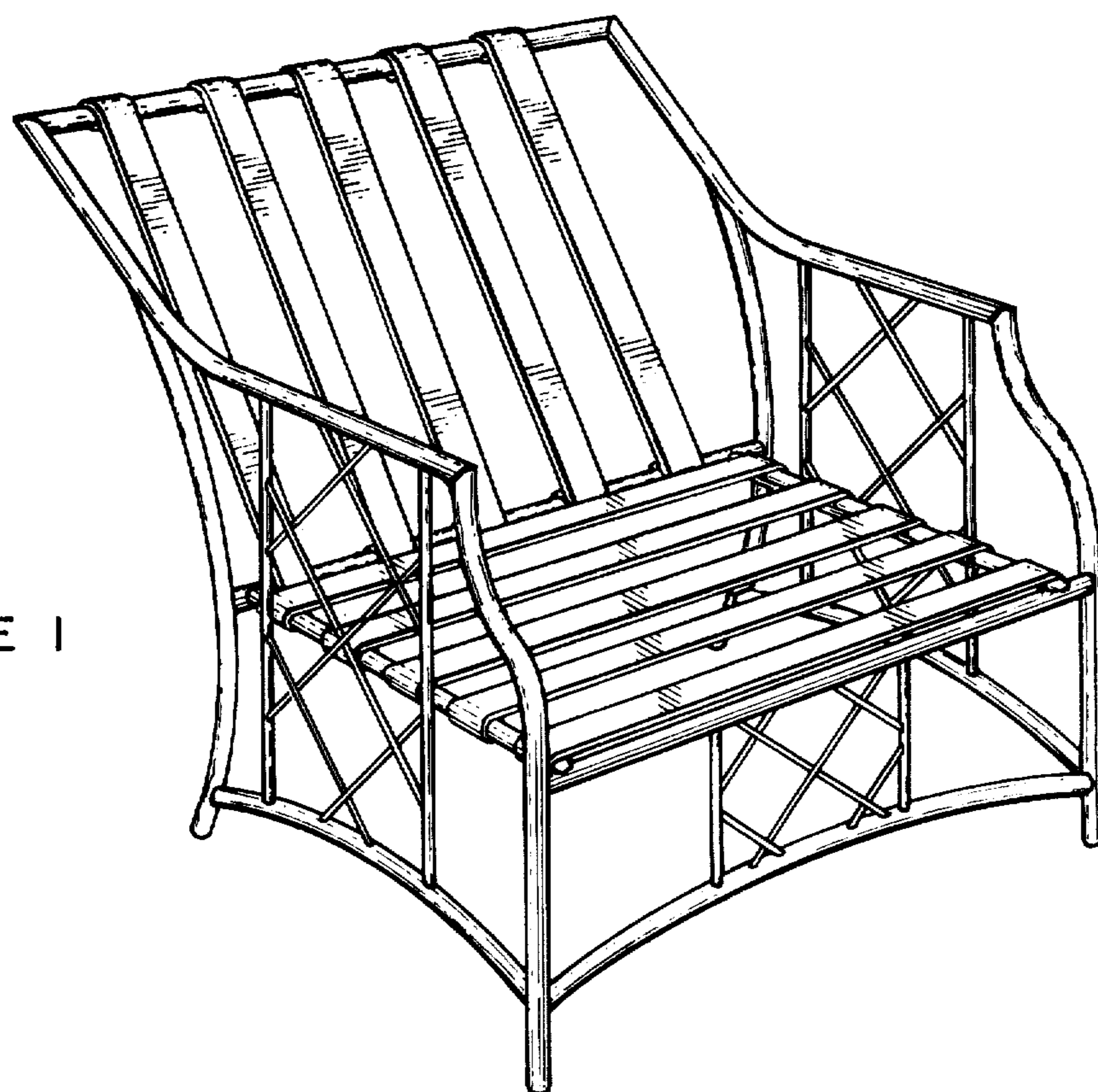

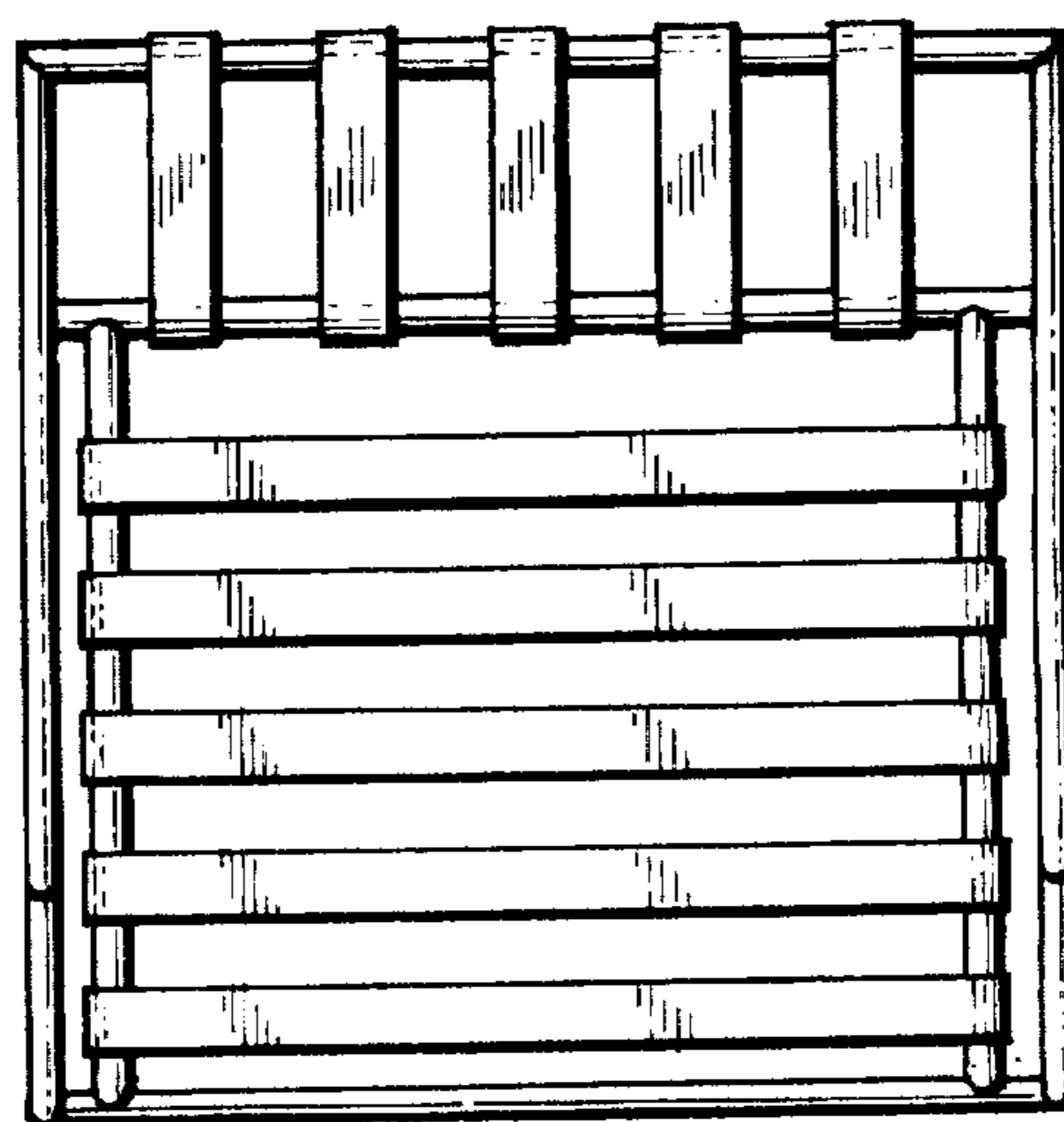

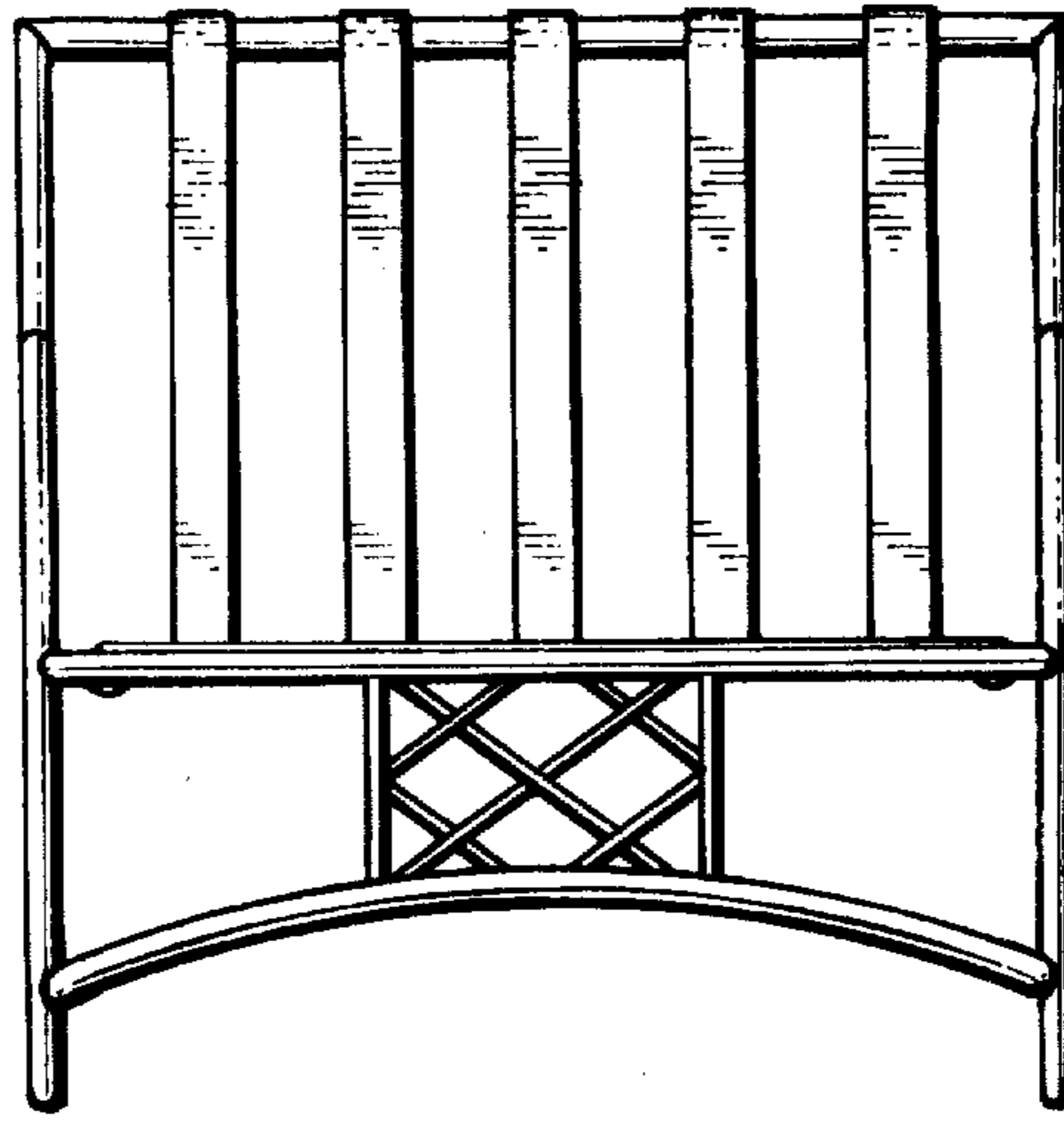

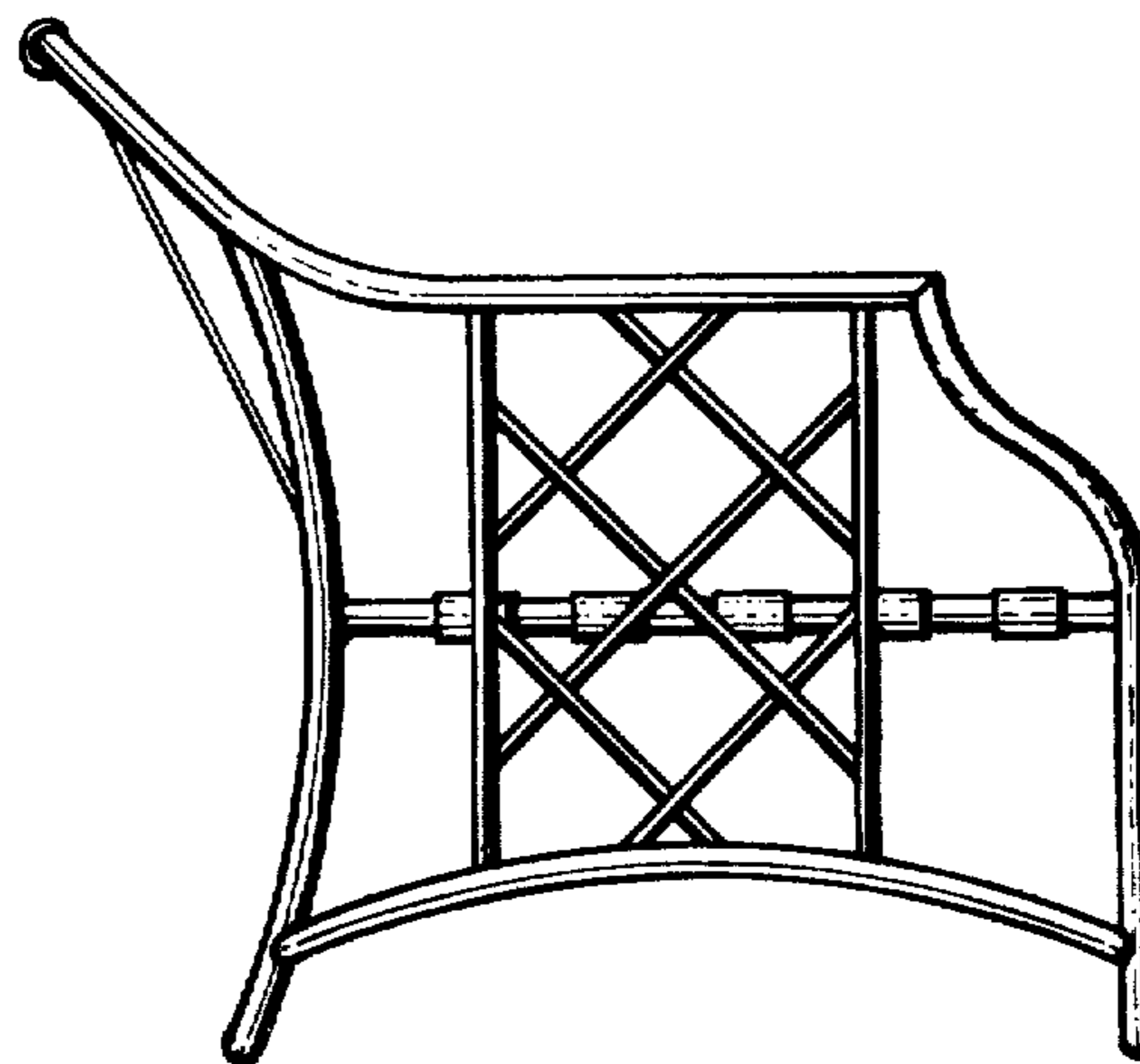

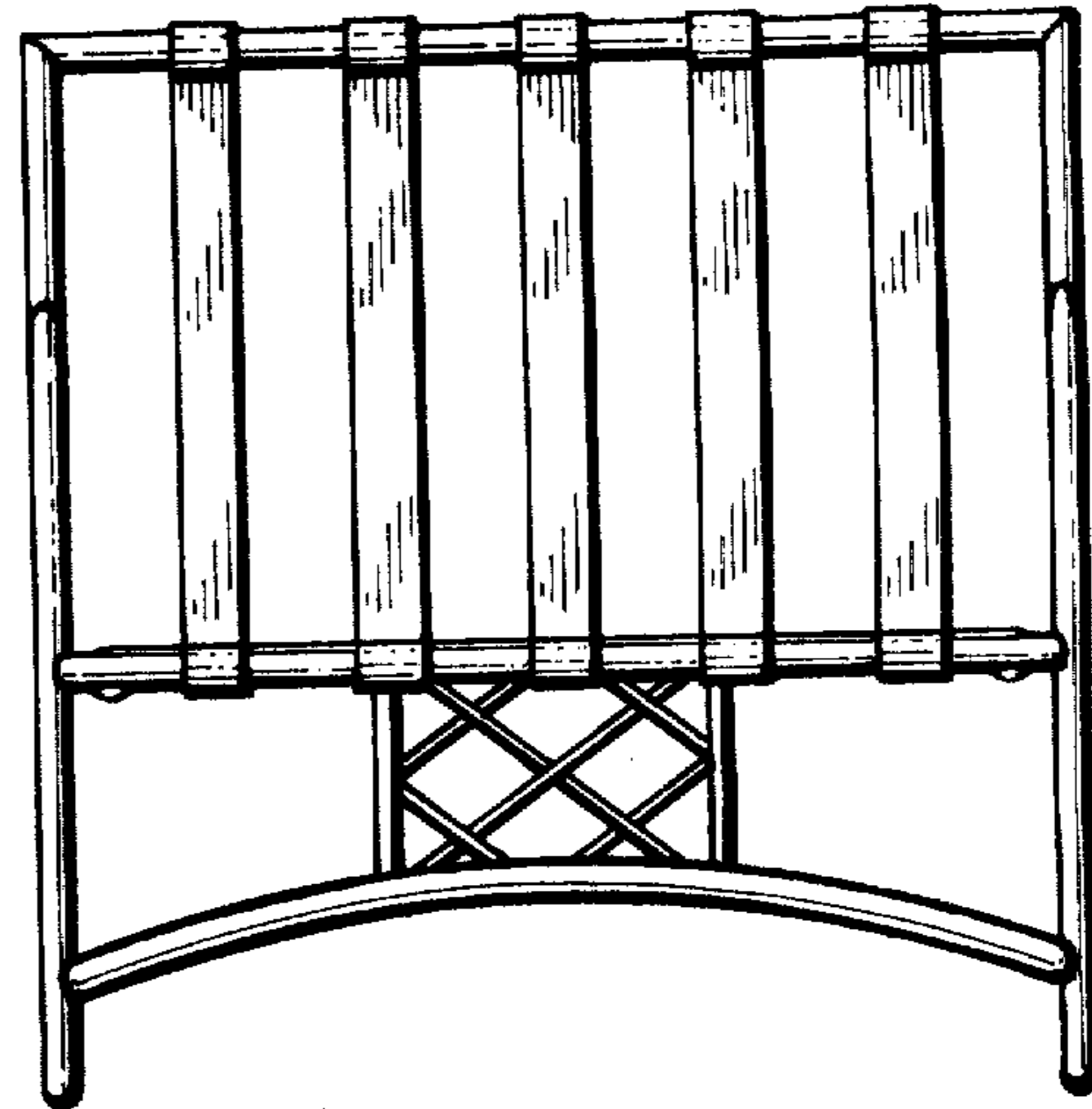
