The ornamental design for a vacuum insulated food jar or similar article, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top rear perspective view of a vacuum insulated food jar or similar article showing my new design; FIG. 2 is a side elevational view thereof; FIG. 3 is a front elevational view thereof; FIG. 4 is a rear elevational view thereof; and FIG. 5 is a top plan view thereof, the handle having been omitted for convenience of illustration.

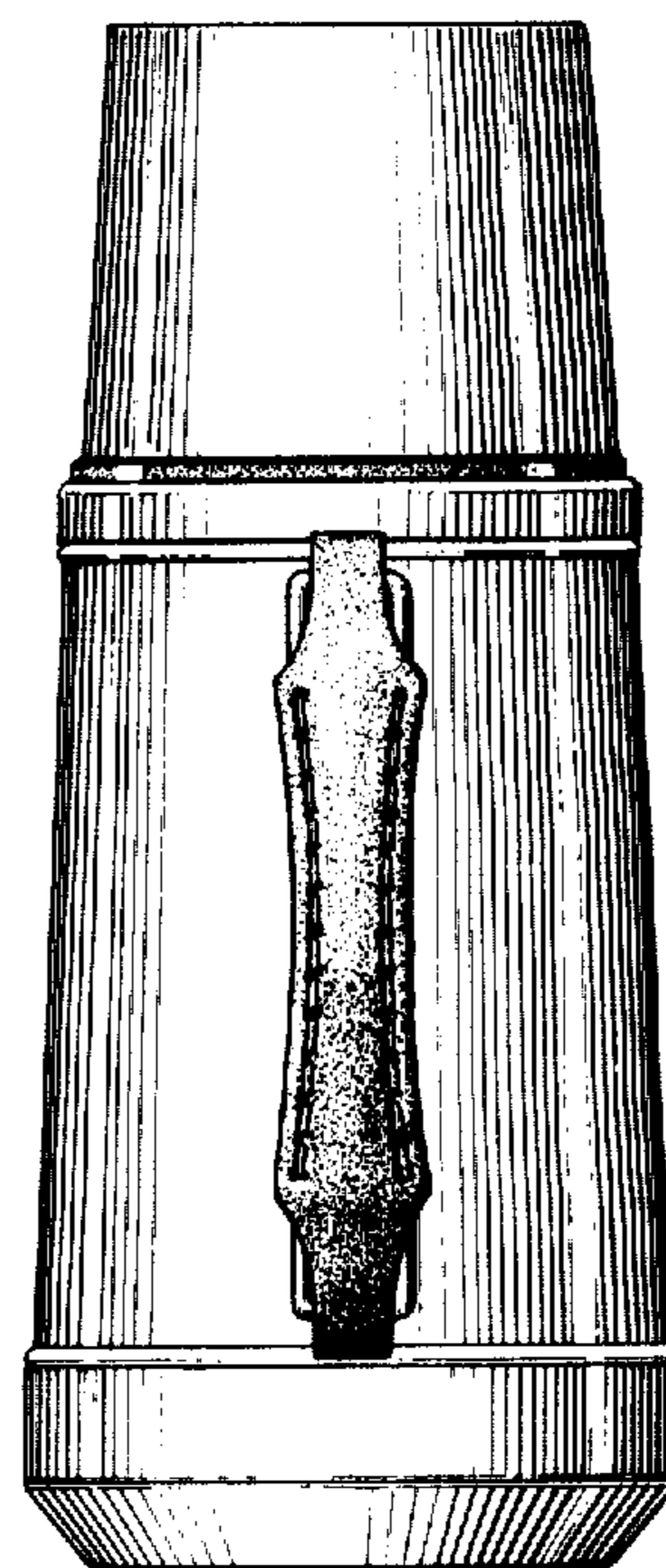
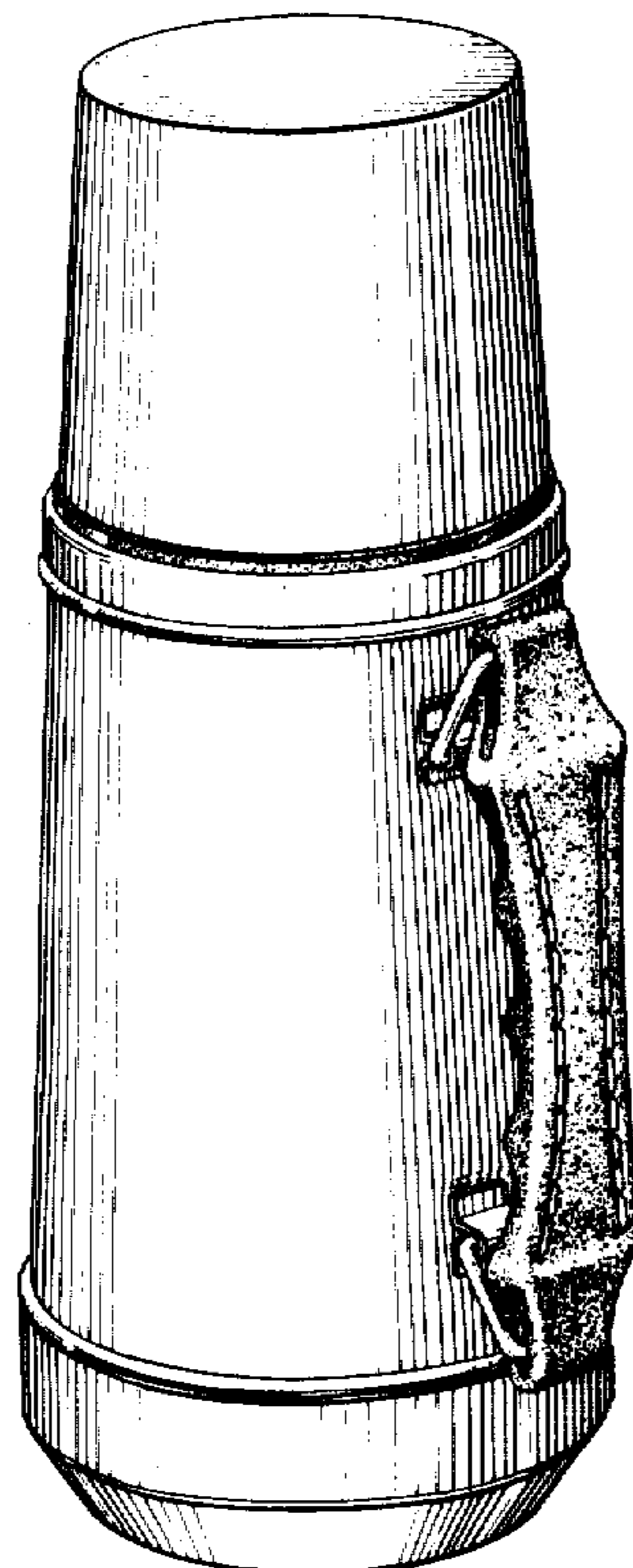

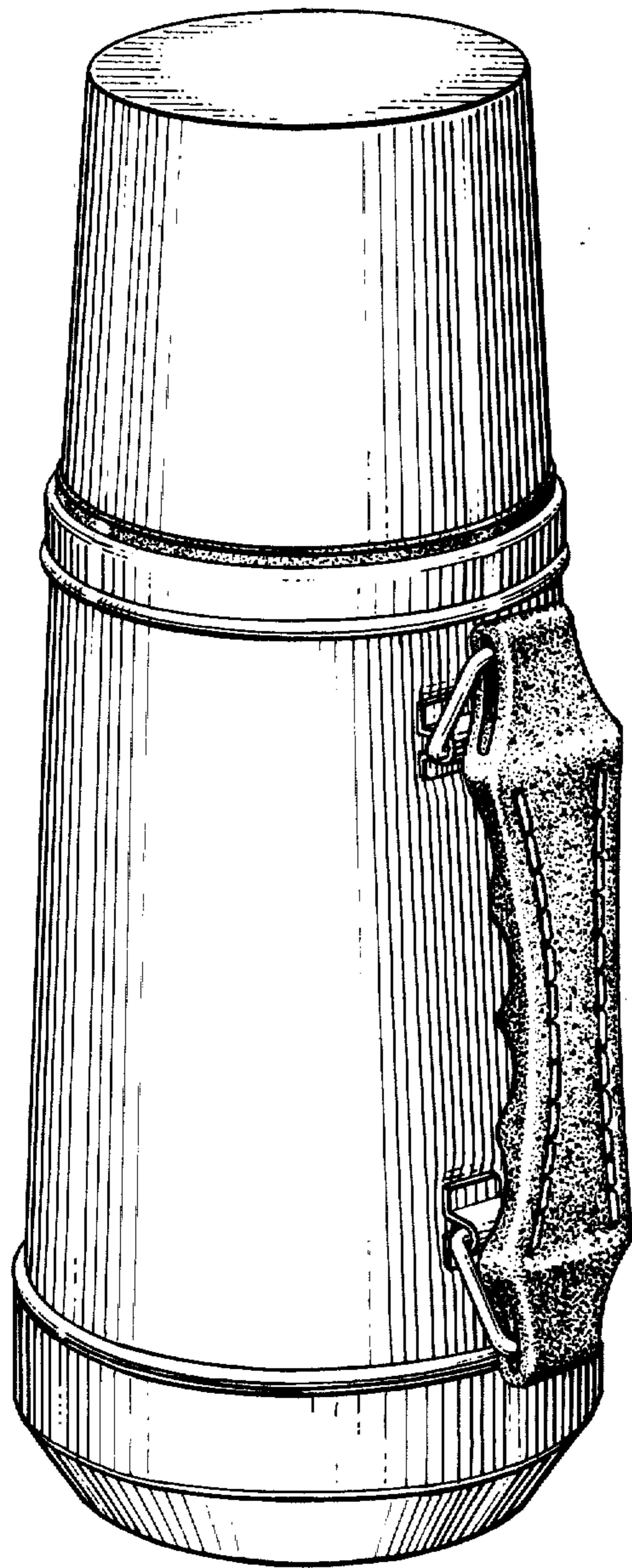

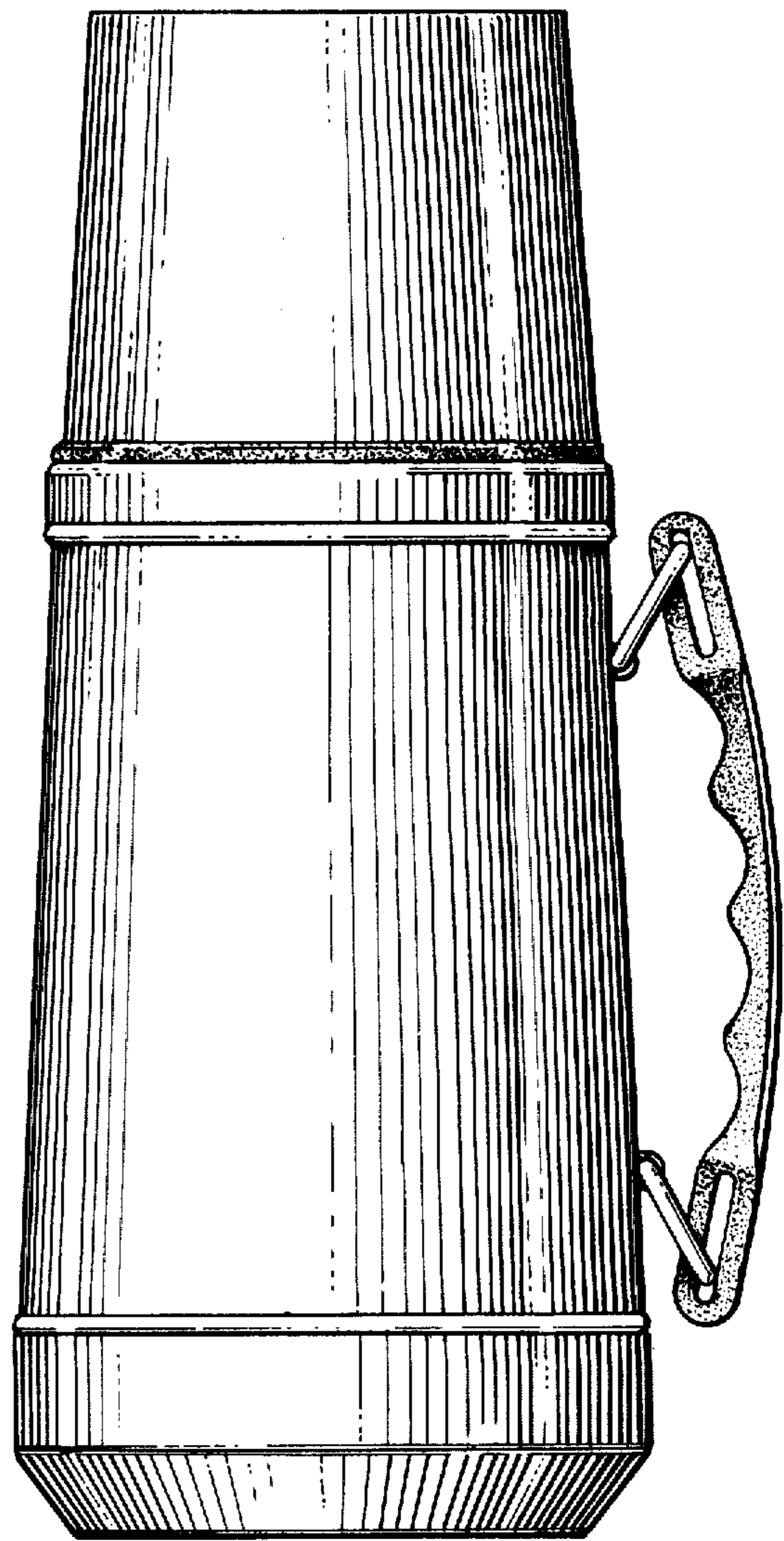

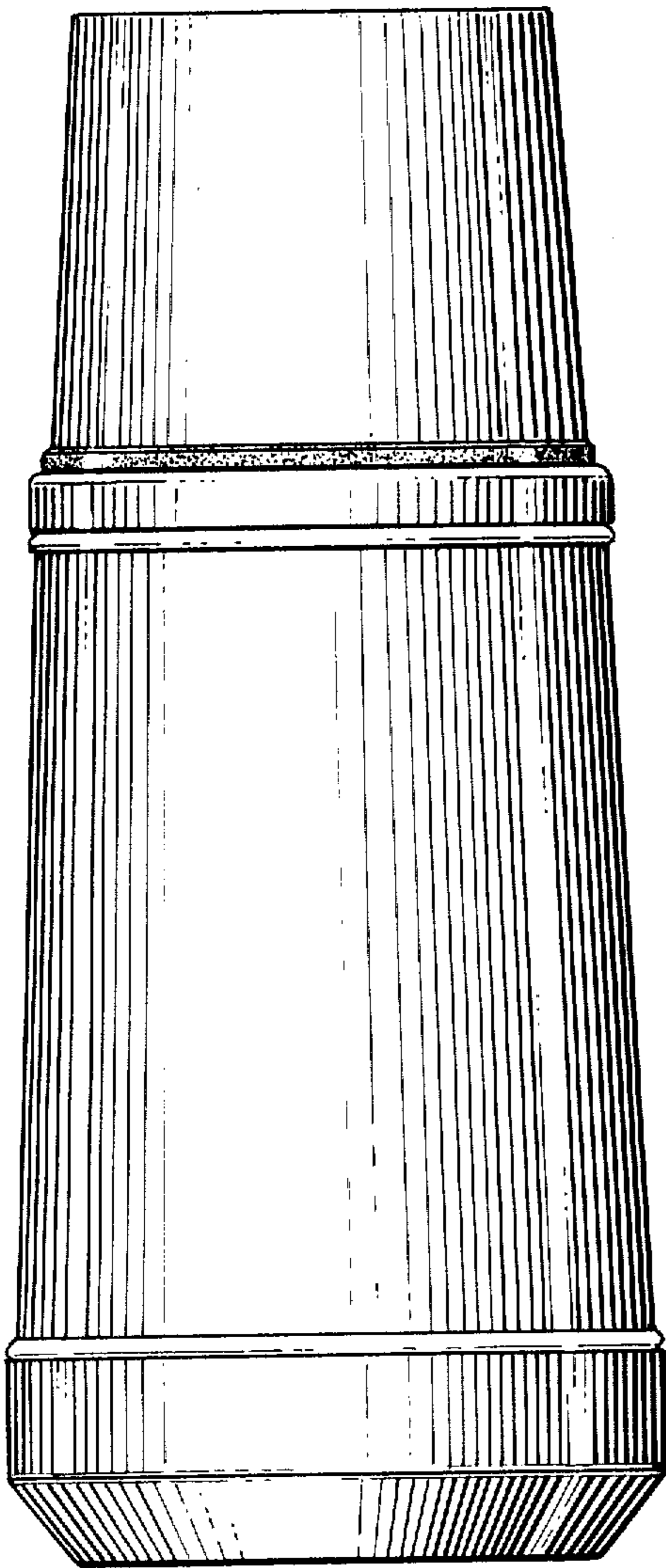

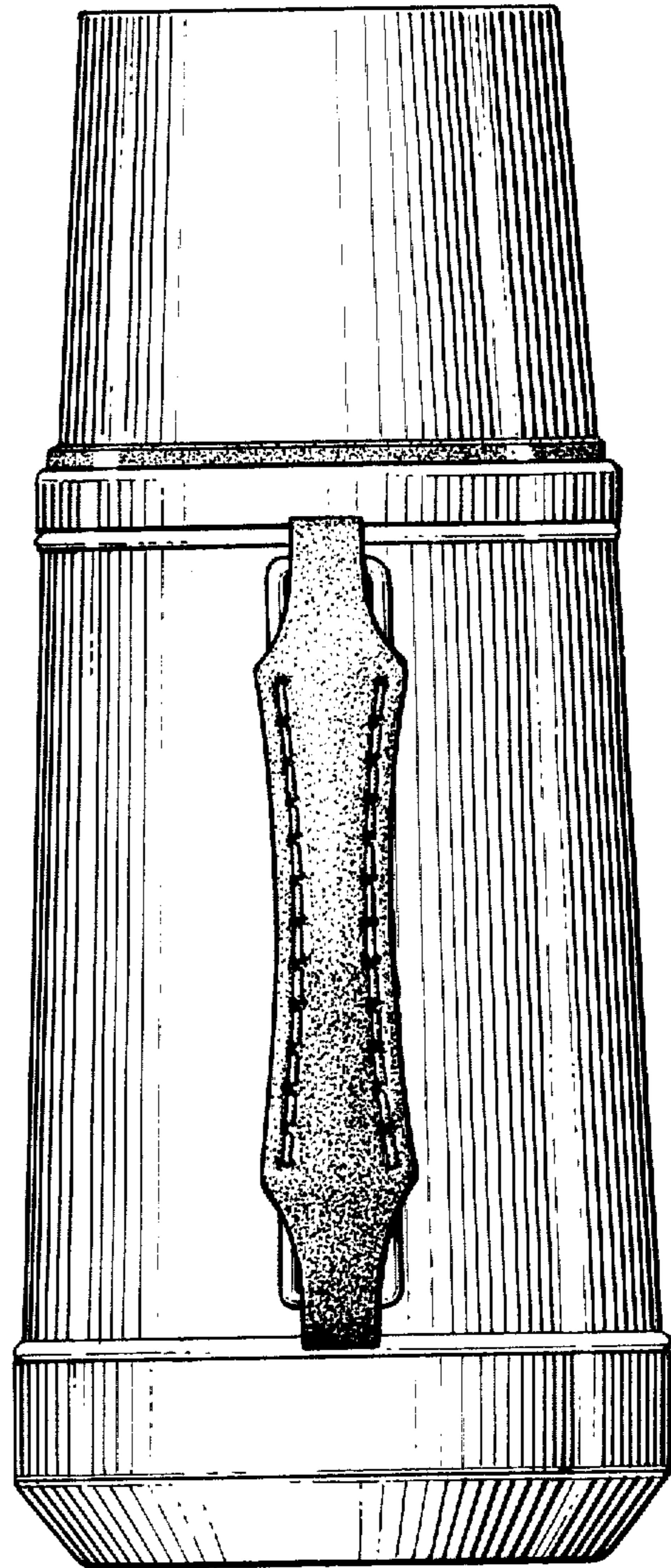
