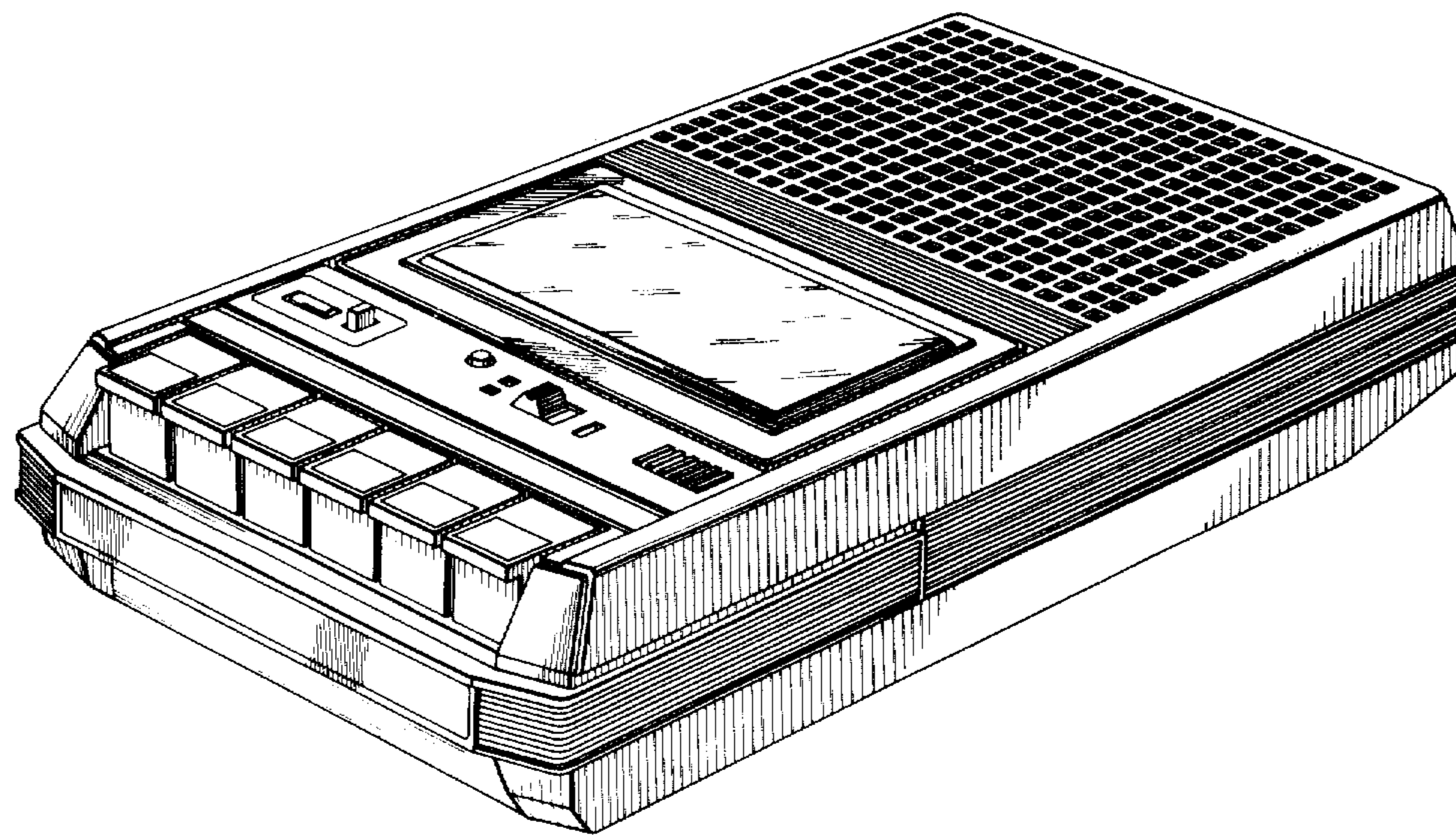
[57] CLAIM

FIG. 2 is a rear, bottom and left side perspective view.



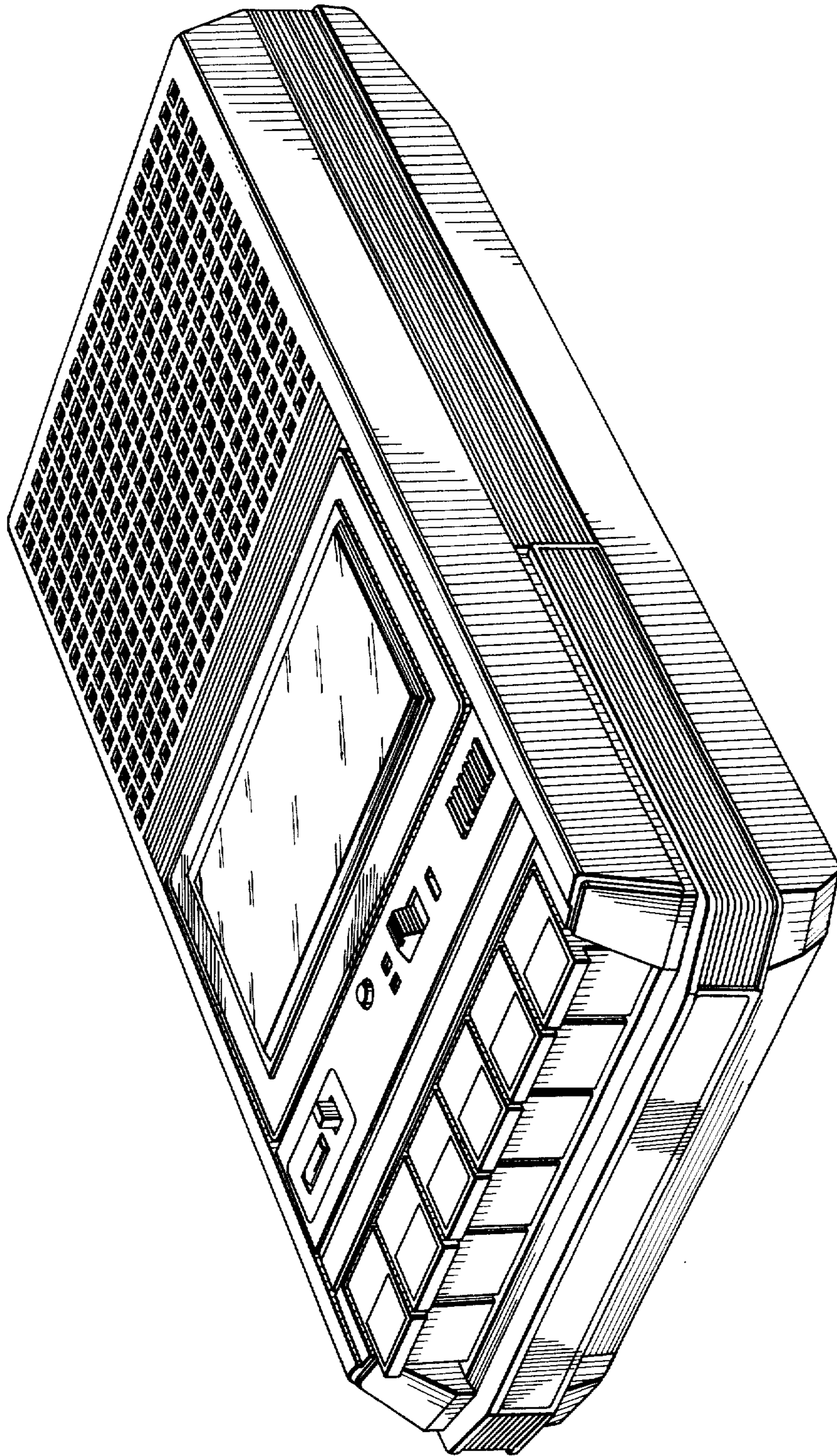
