FIG. 1 is a perspective view of an armchair showing my design.

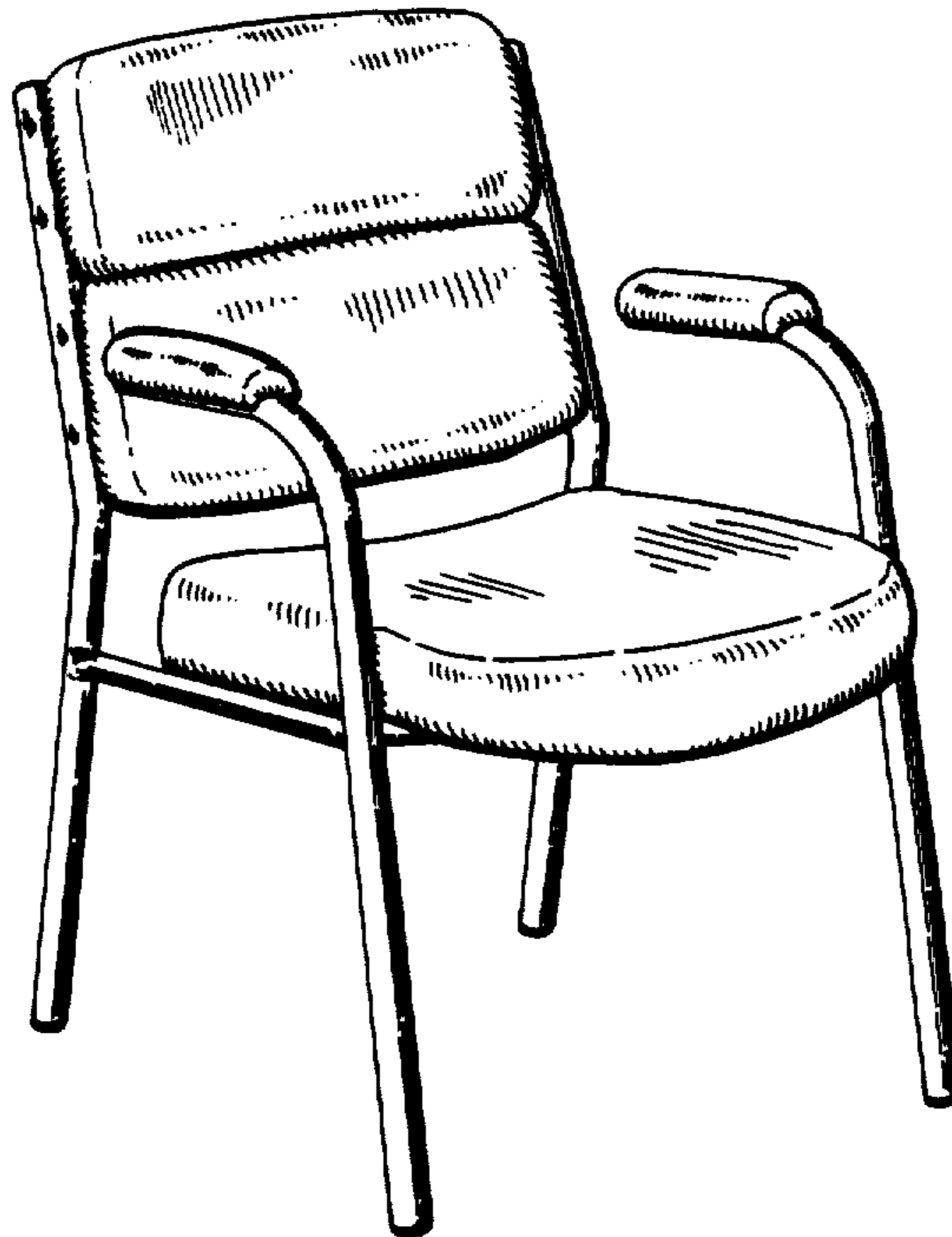
FIG. 2 is a front elevation.

The side of the chair not shown is a mirror image of the side shown in FIG. 3.



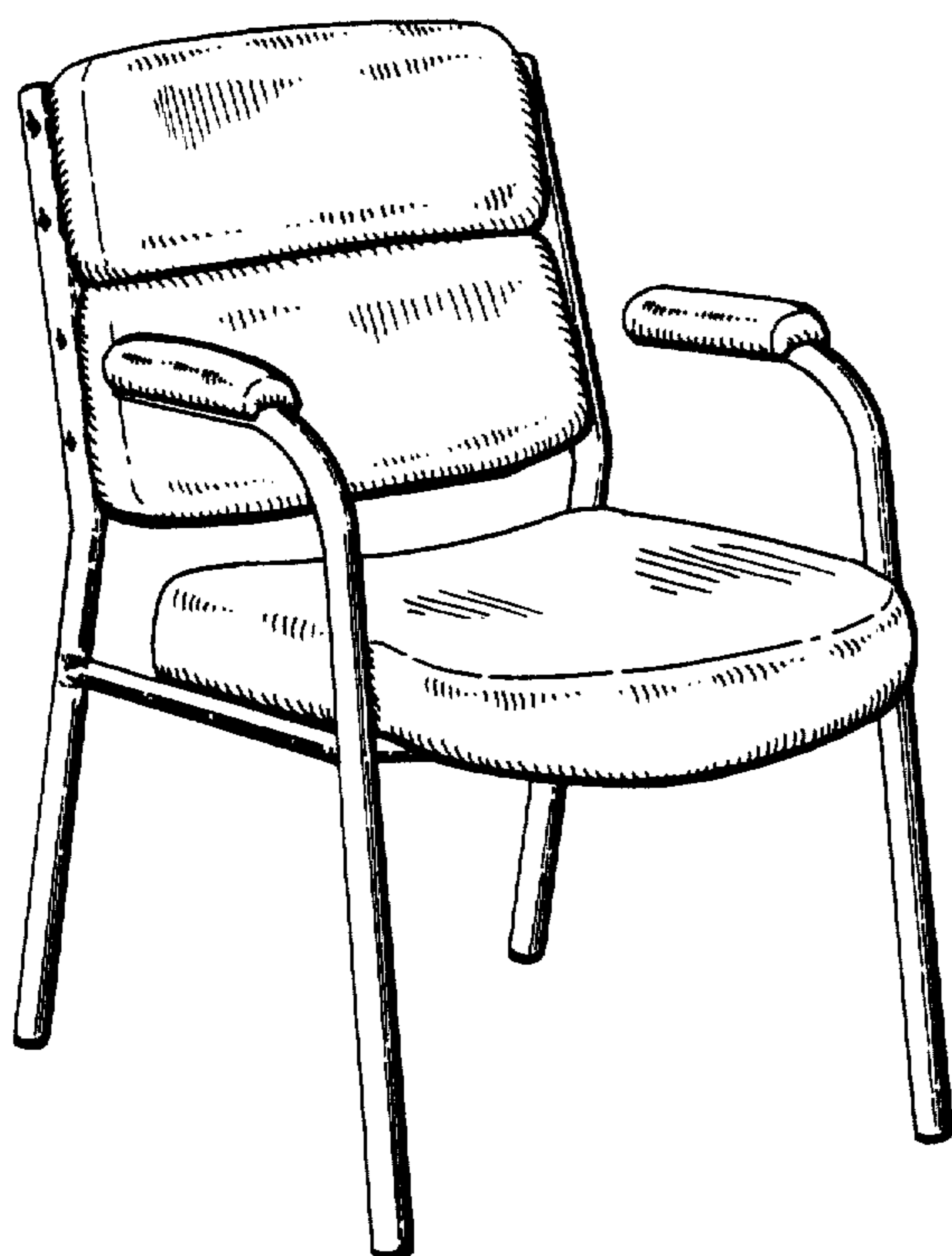

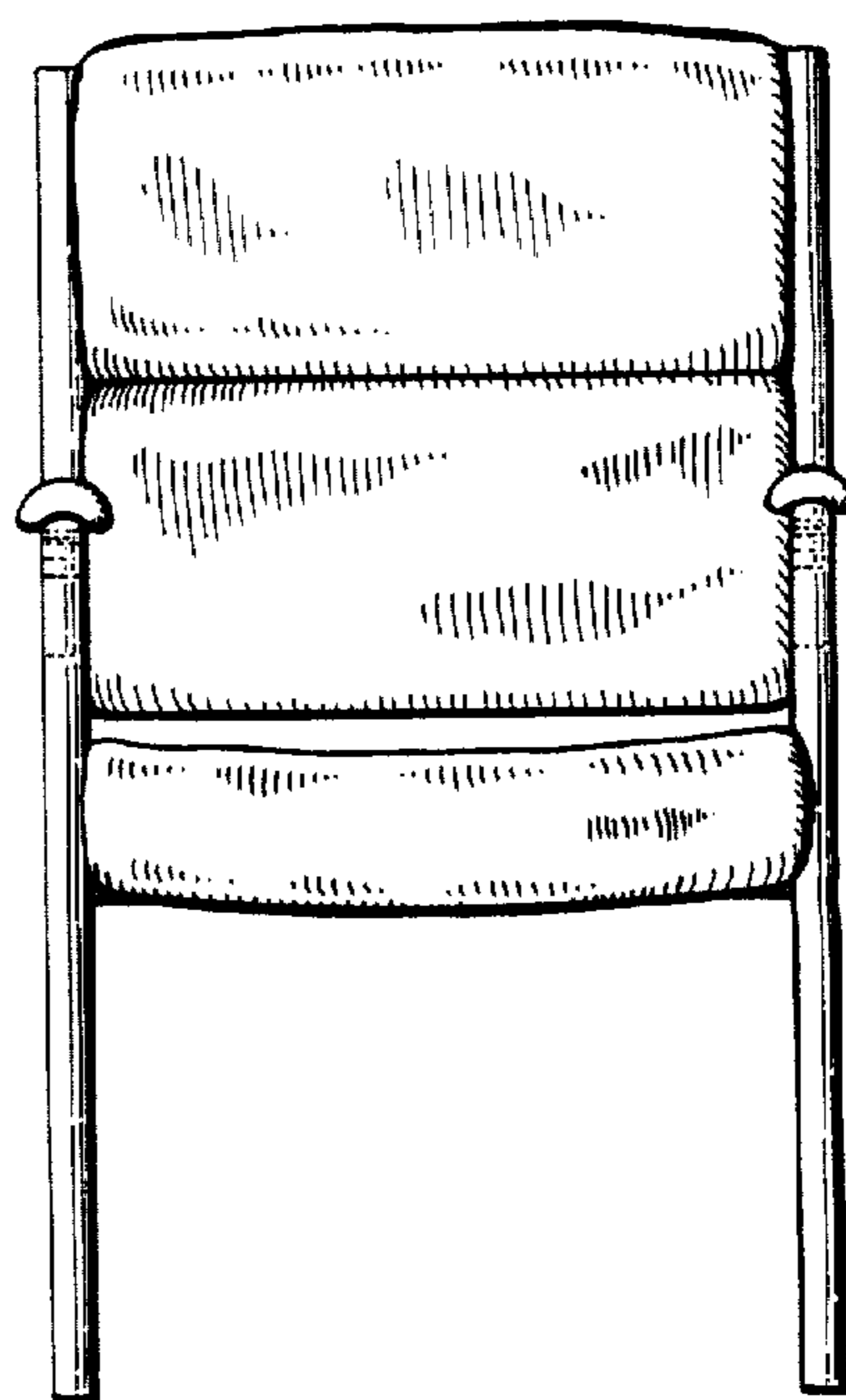

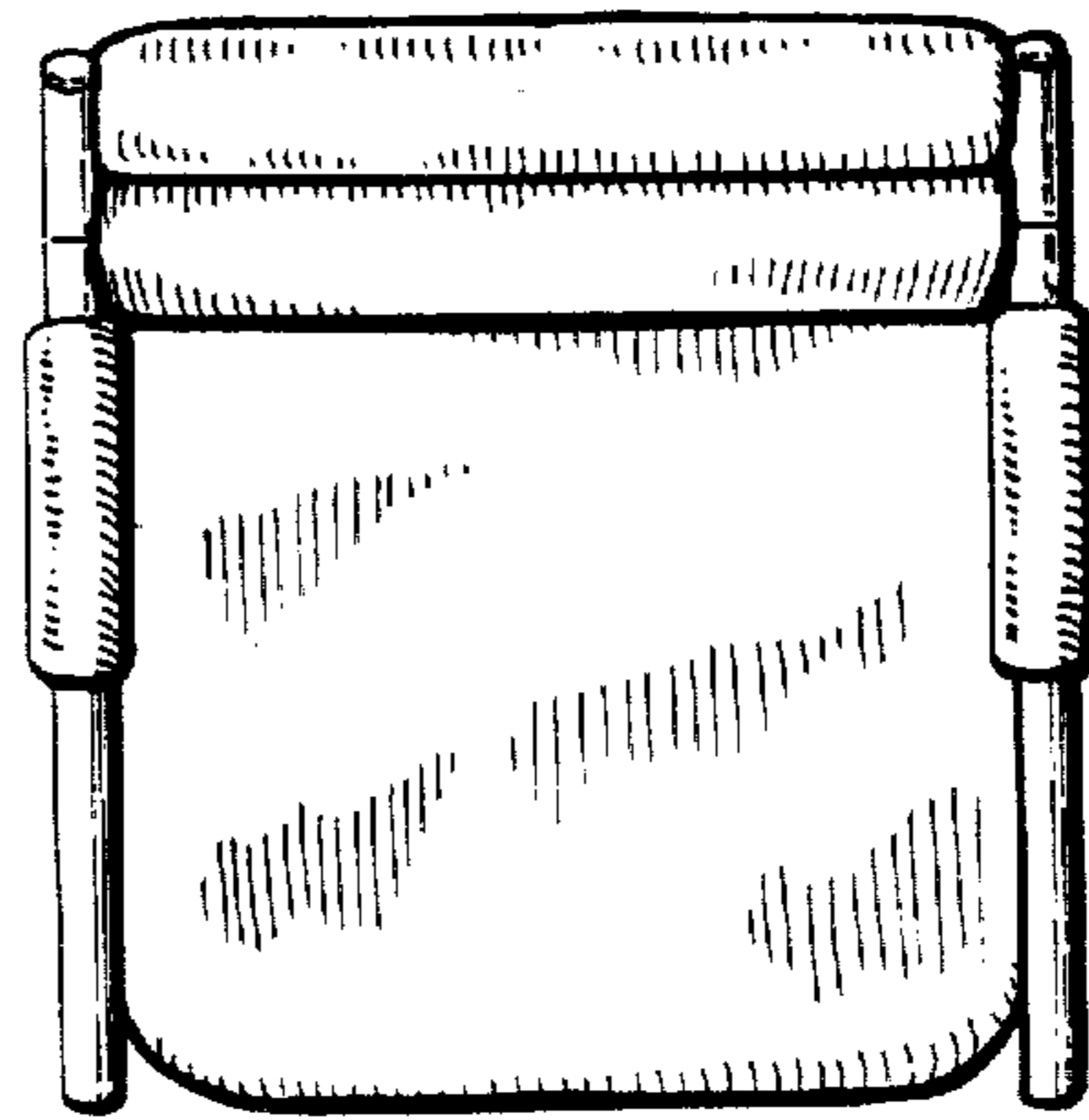
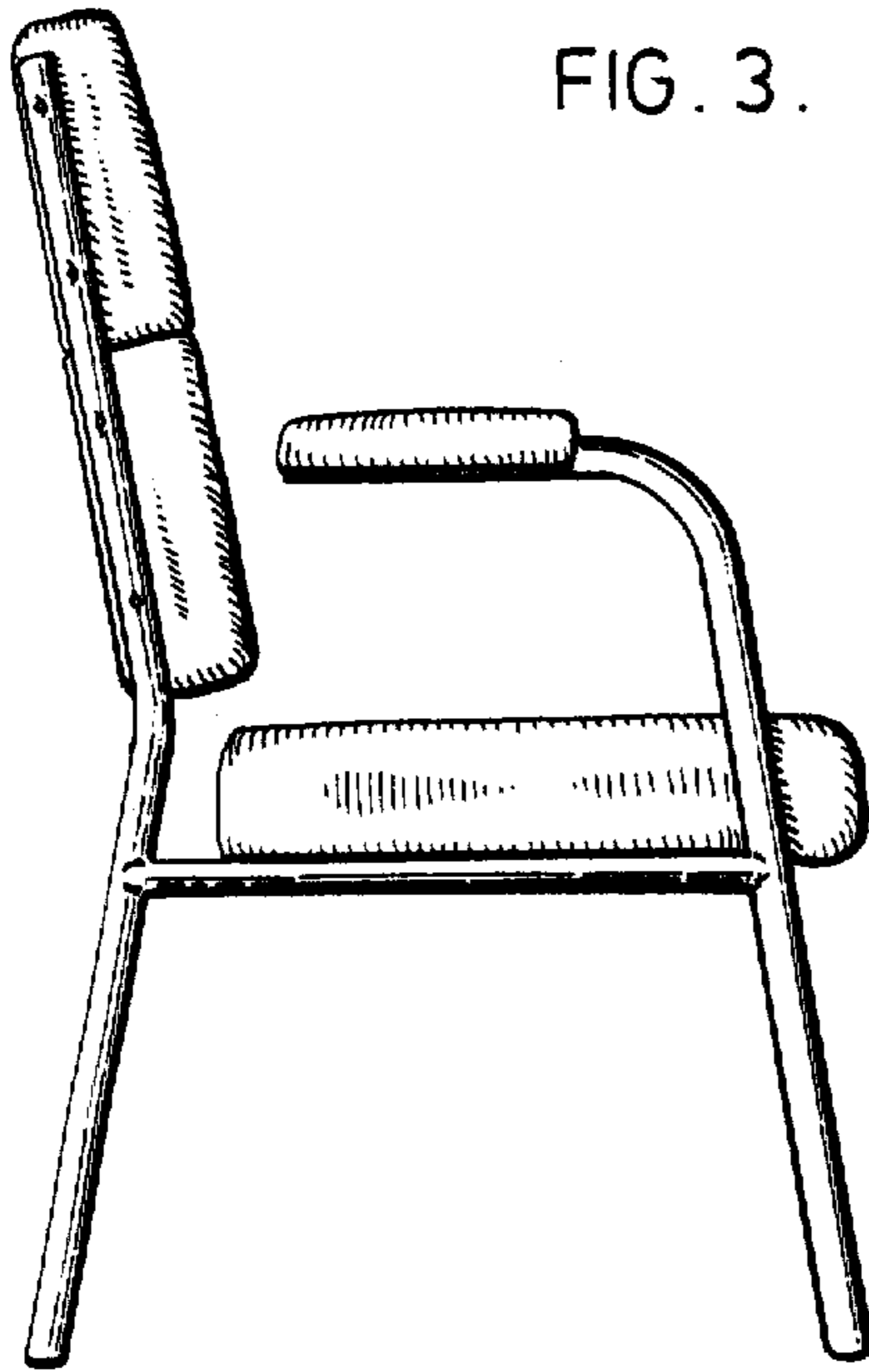

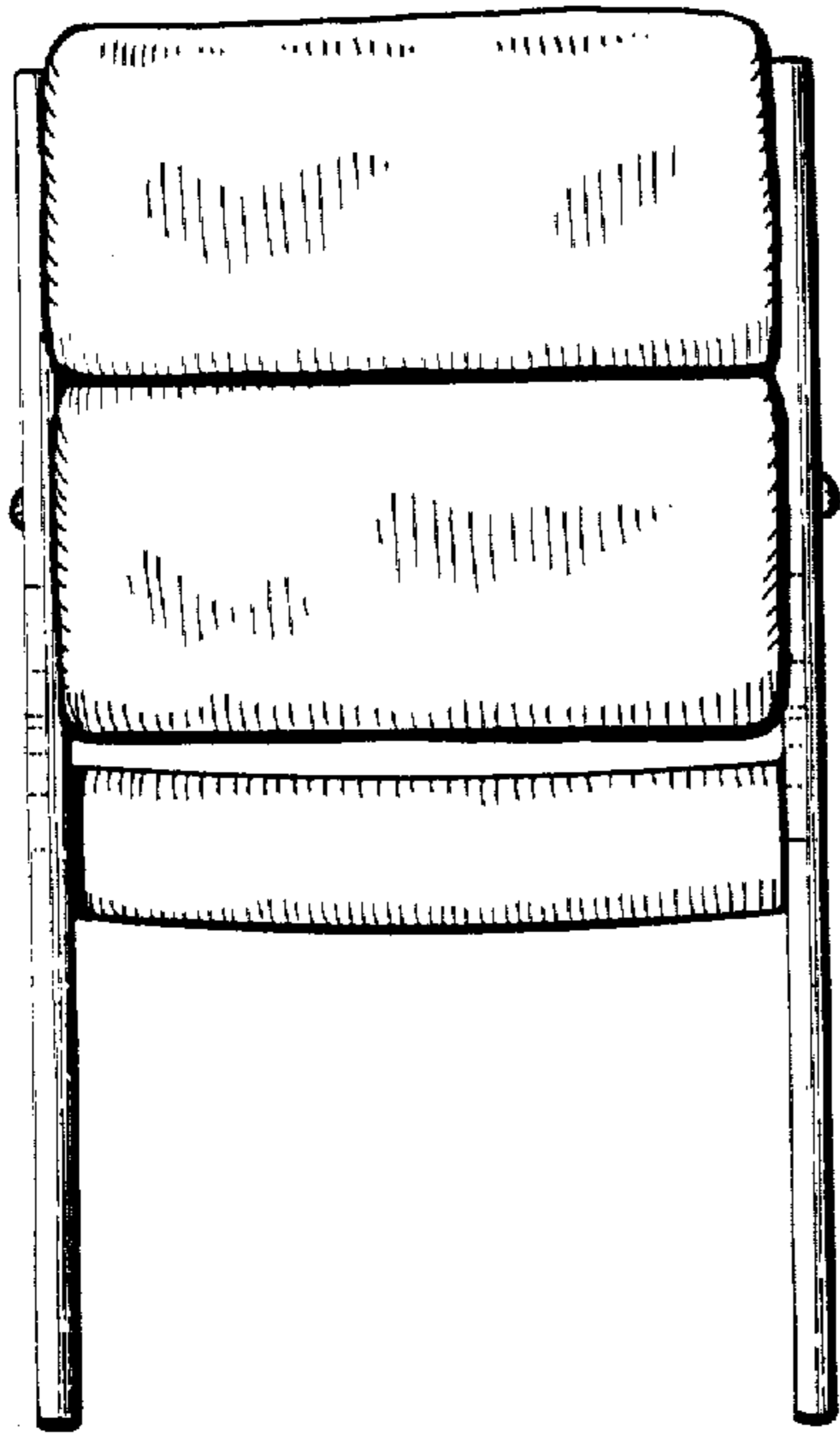
