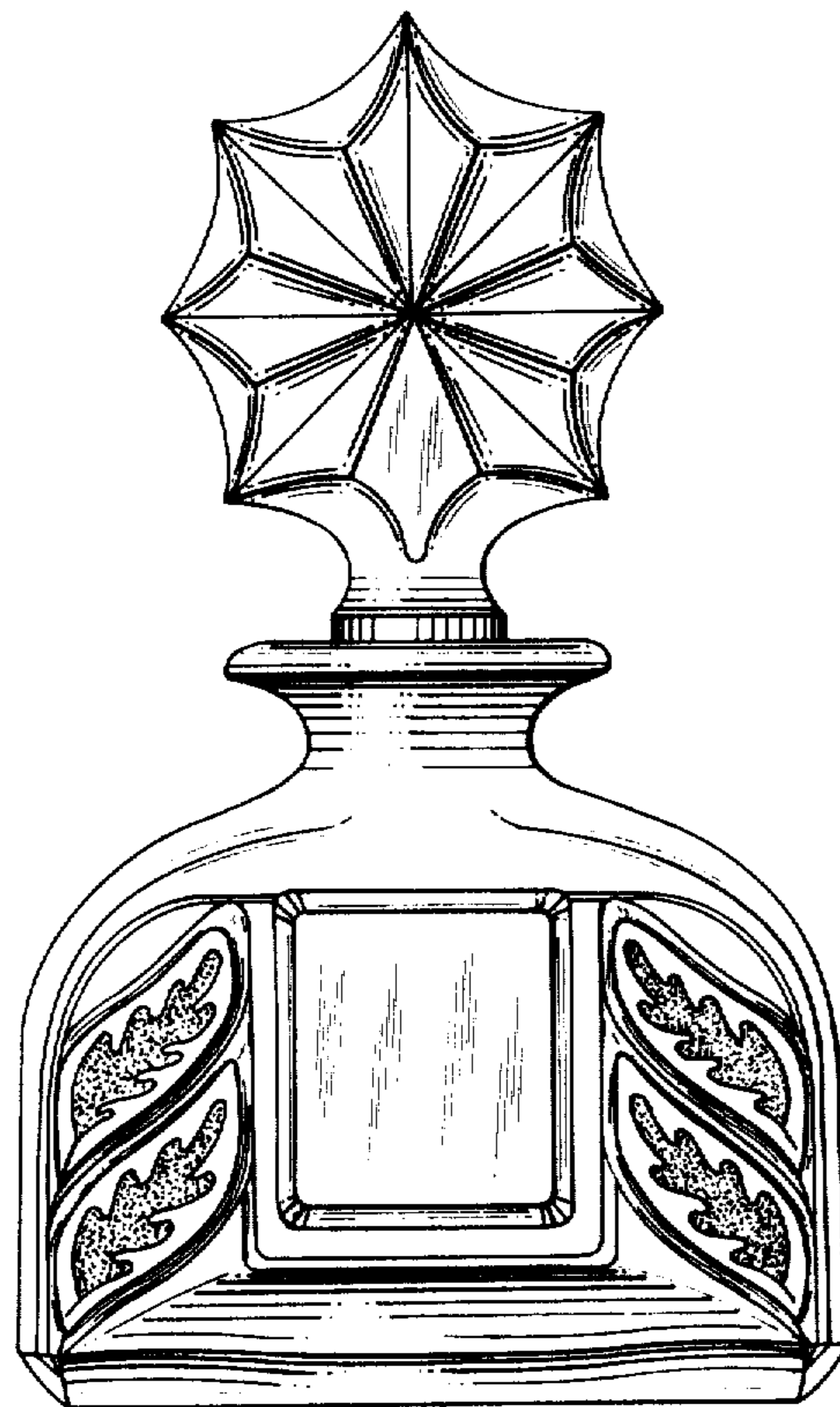

The ornamental design for a bottle, substantially as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a bottle showing my new design, the opposite side being the same in appearance;
FIG. 2 is a side elevational view, the opposite side being the same in appearance;
FIG. 3 is a top plan view; and
FIG. 4 is a bottom plan view thereof.



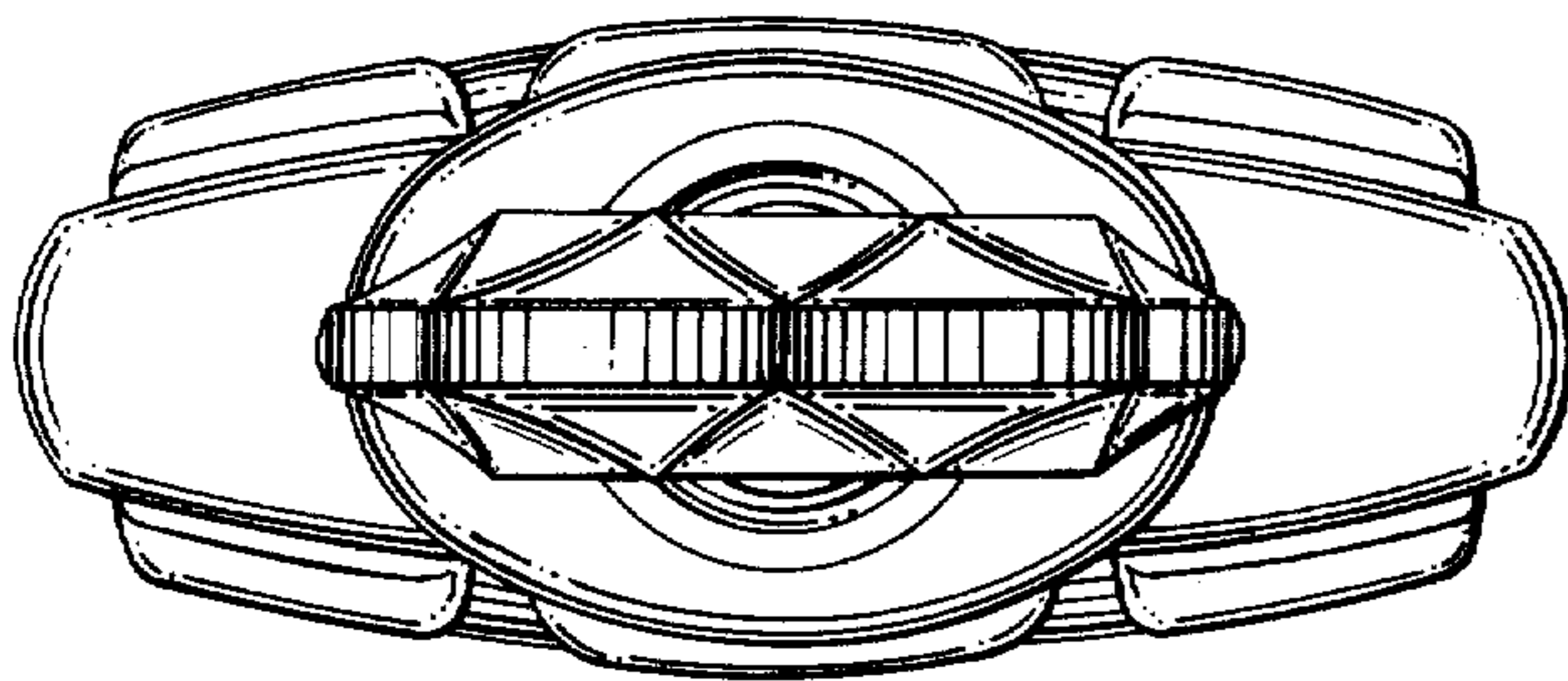

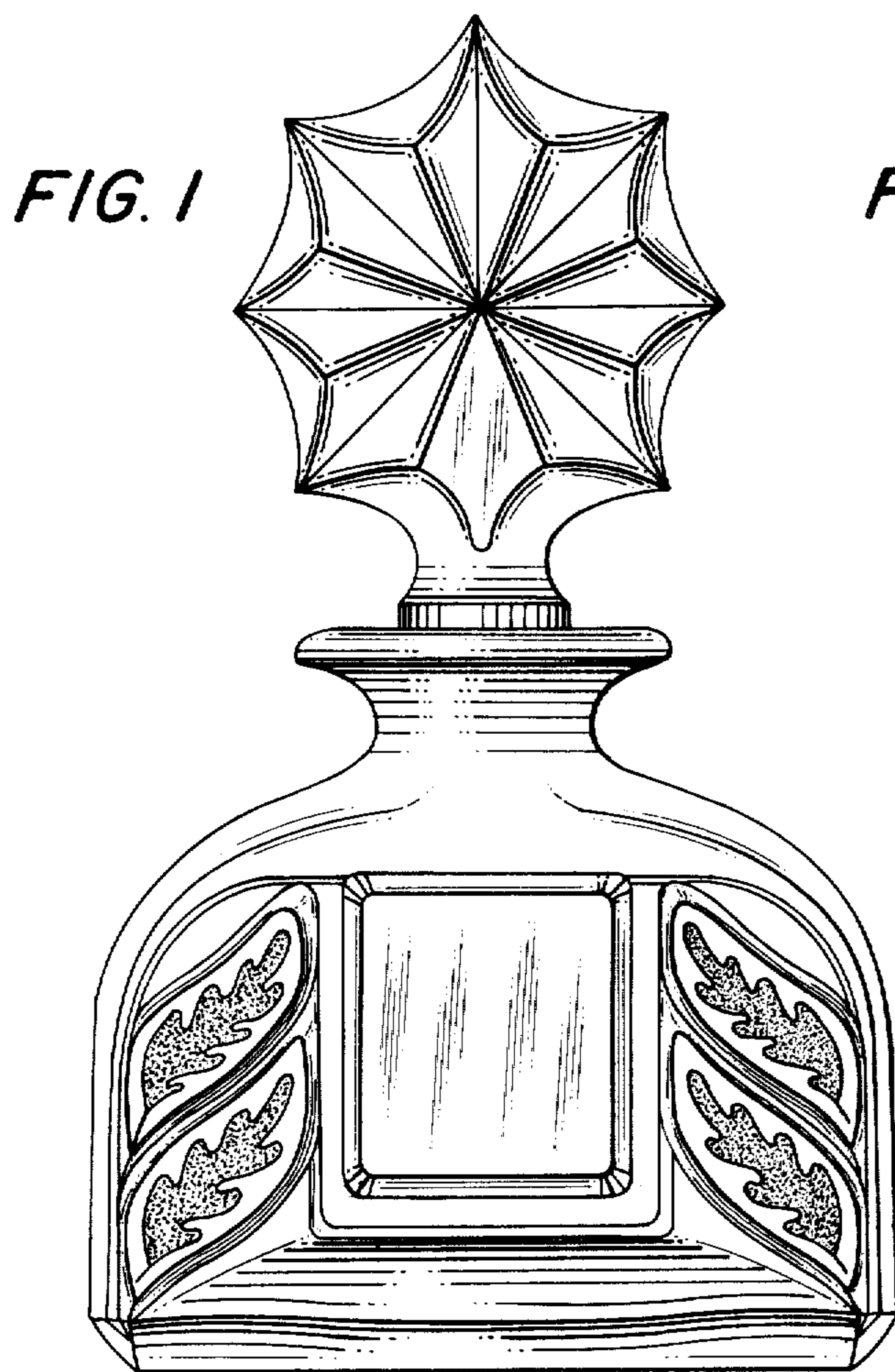

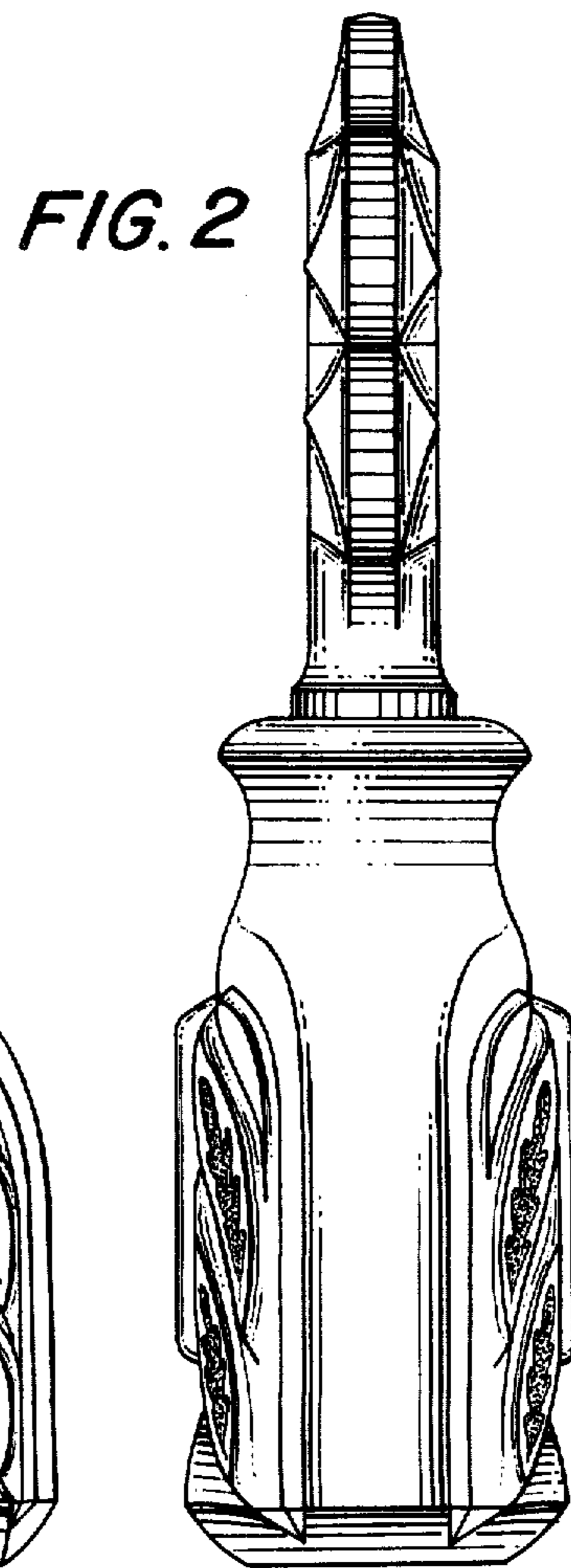

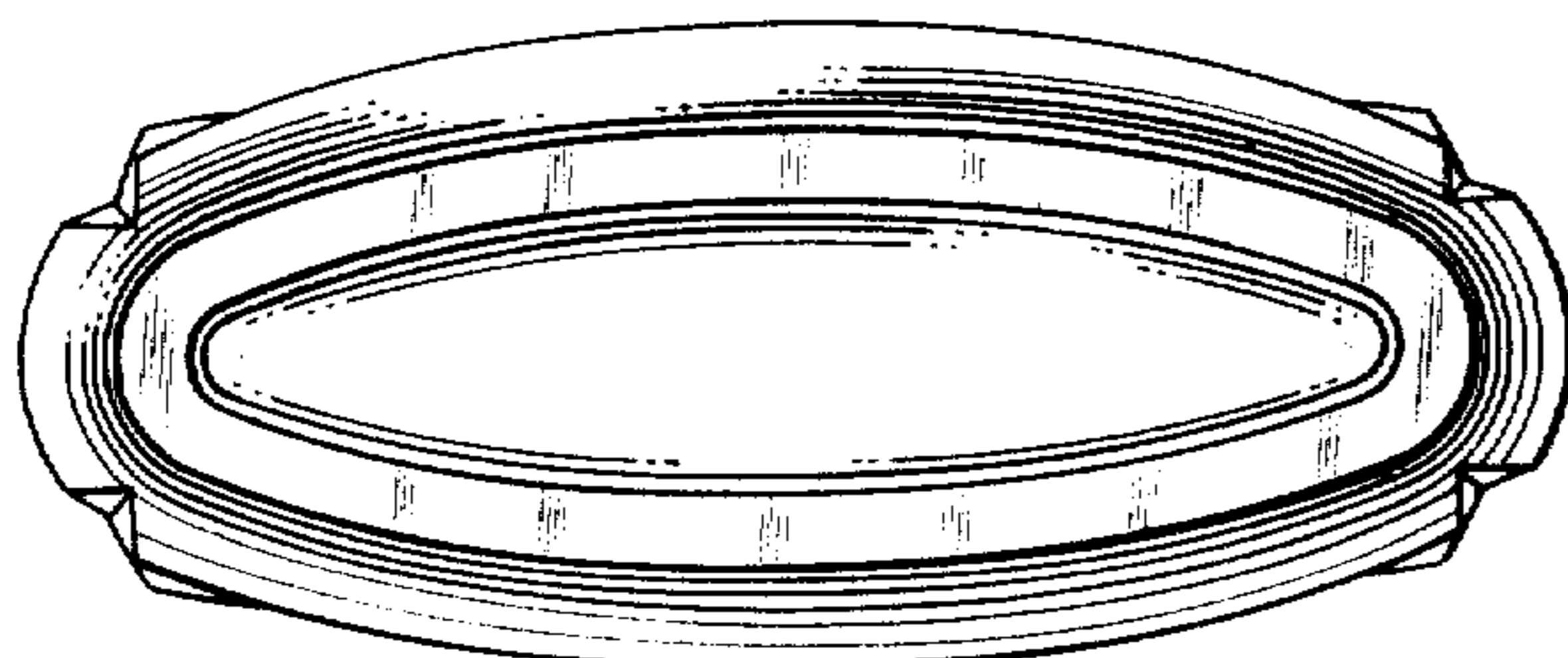
