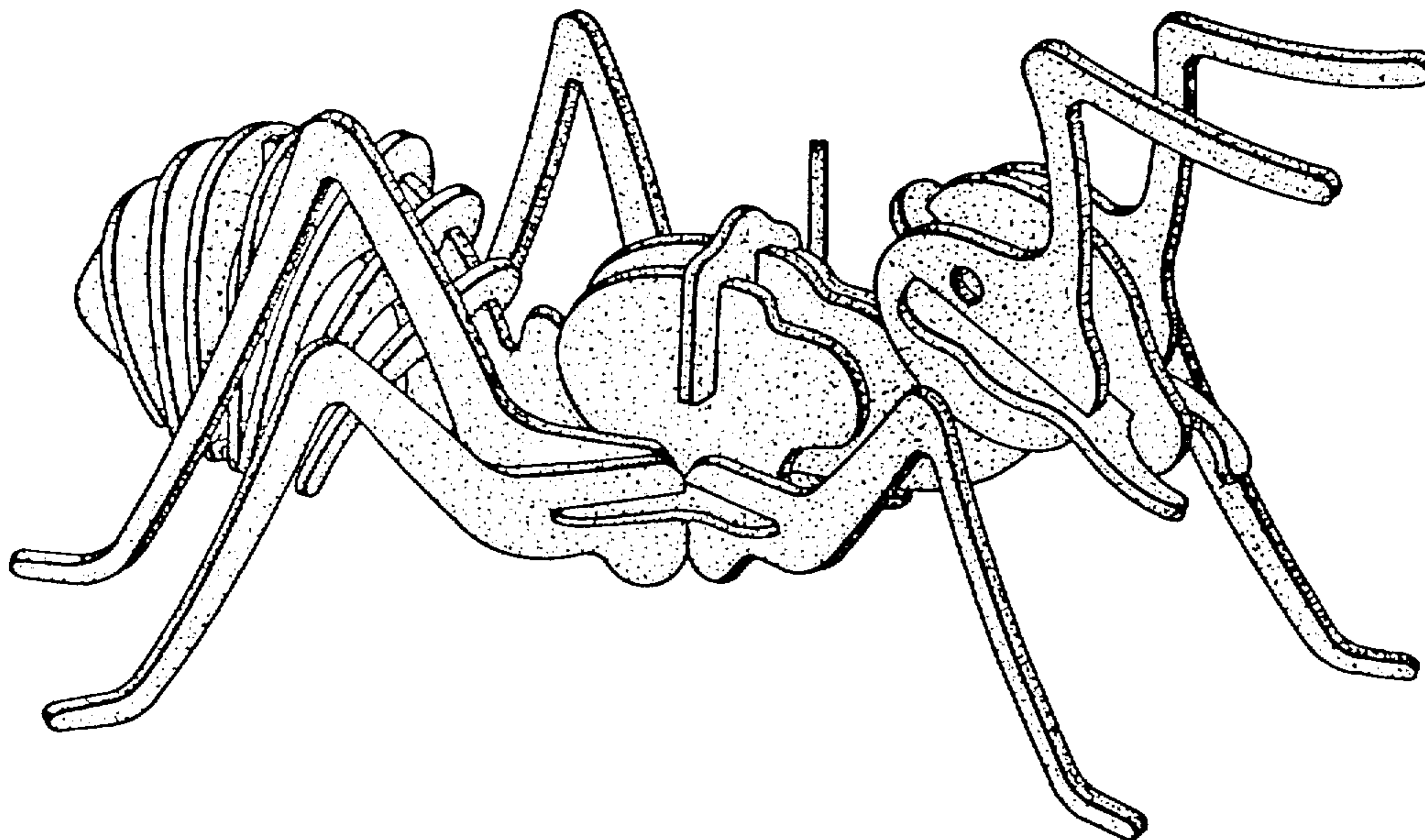
[57] **CLAIM**

FIG. 2 is a rear perspective view thereof.



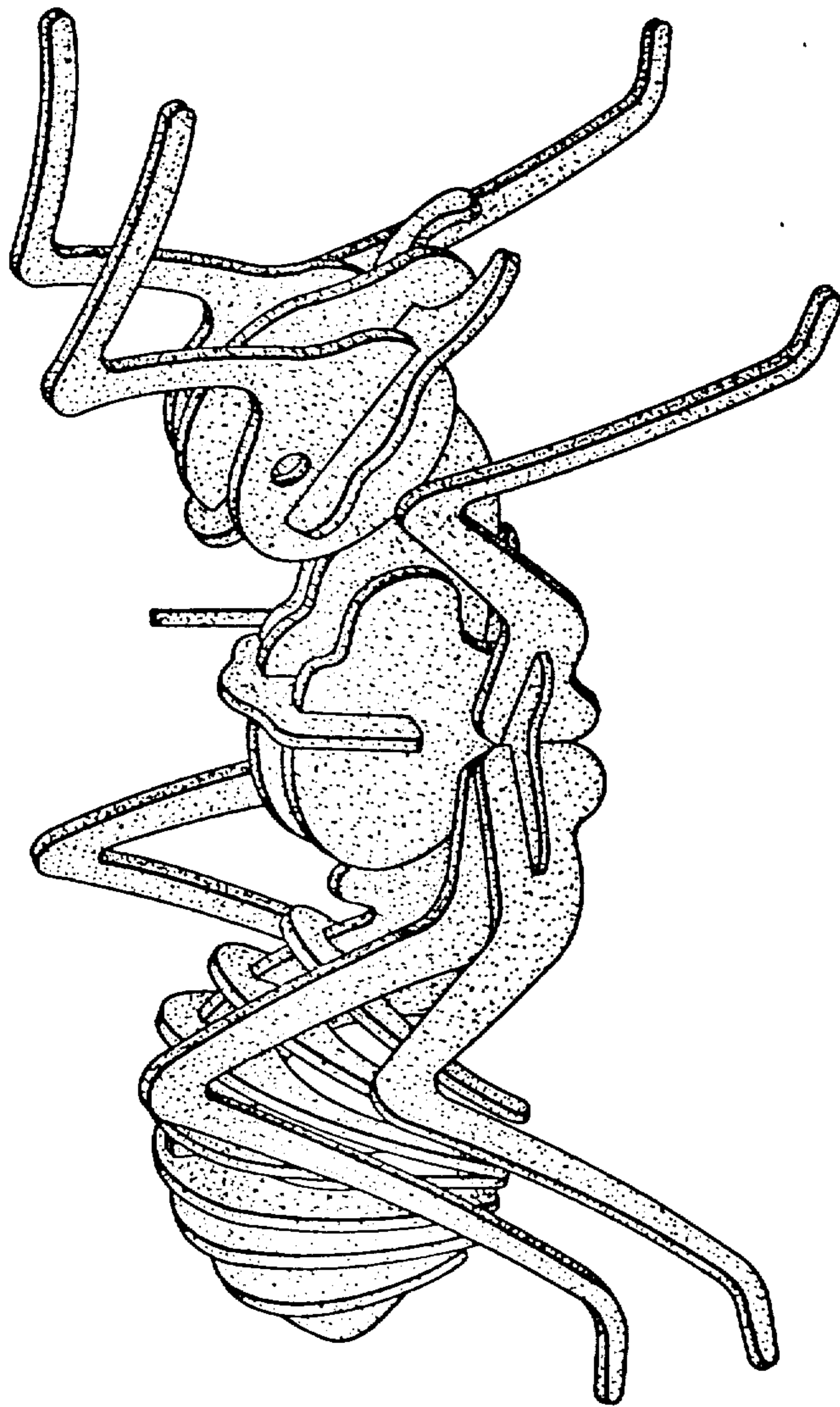

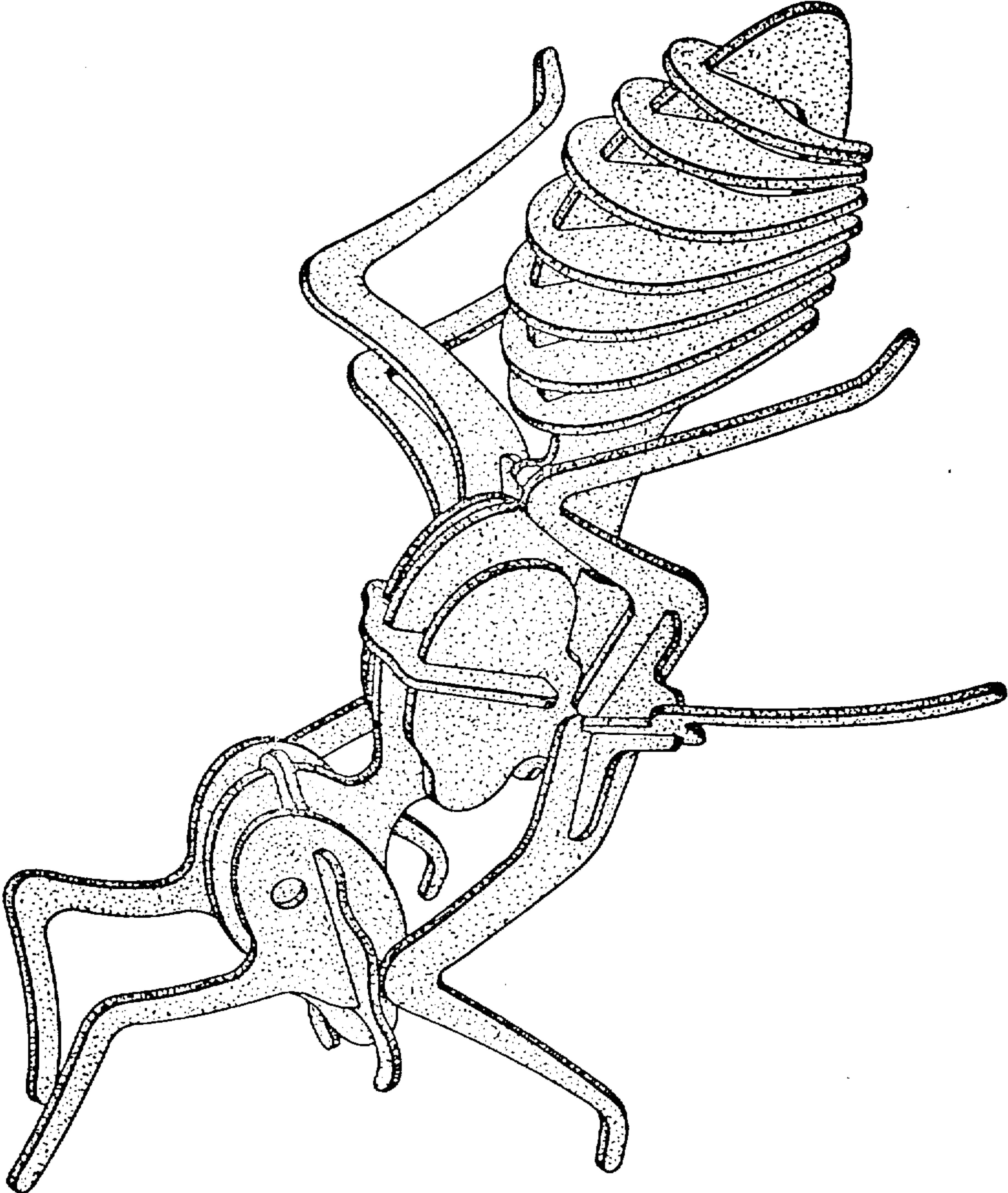
